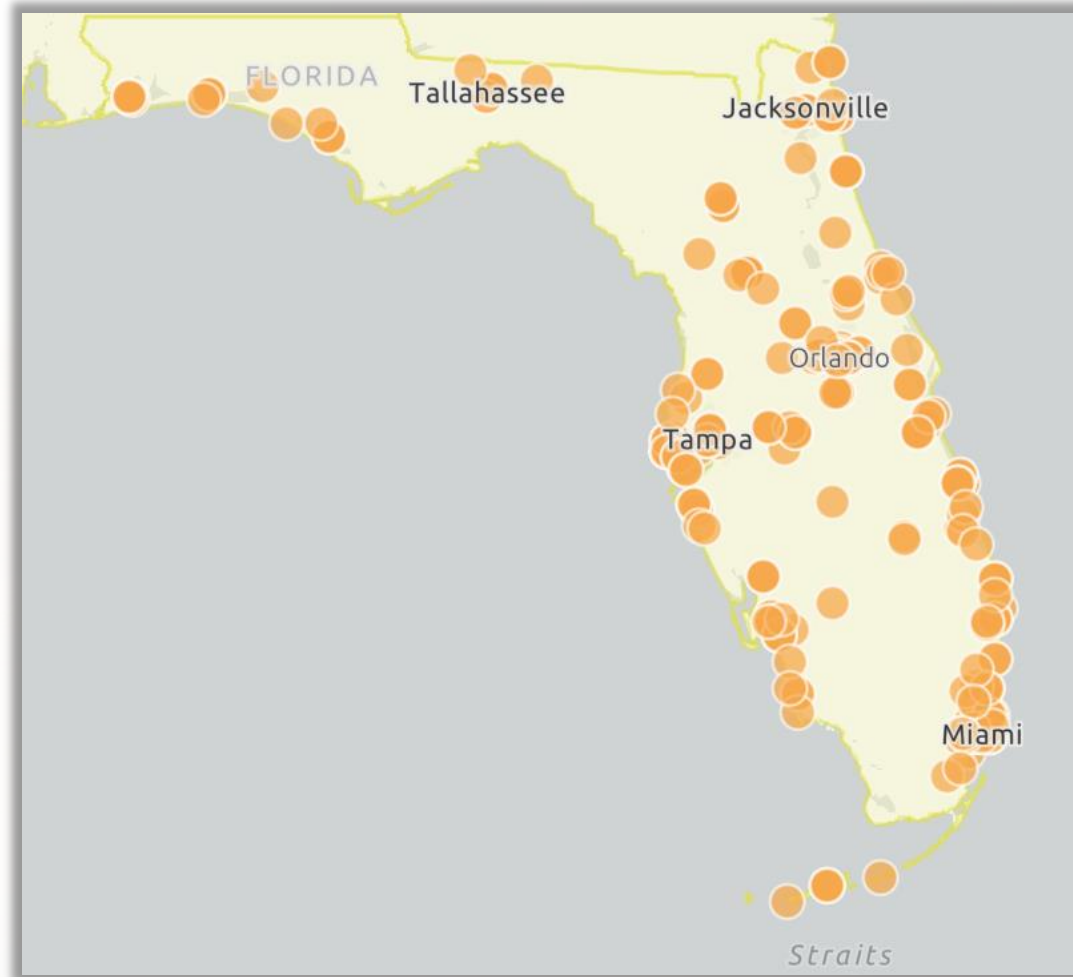

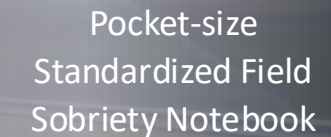
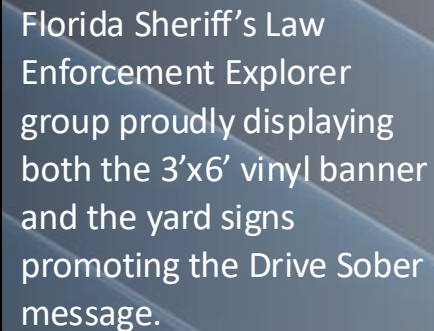

Overview

- ▶ The 2022 National Impaired Driving Campaign, ***Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over*** ran from December 14, 2022, through January 1st, 2023.
- ▶ Reports were collected electronically from January 2, 2023, through February 28, 2023.
- ▶ Florida Law Enforcement Liaison Program promoted the campaign through quarterly meetings, social media, emails, LEL website, and in person visits .

IMPLIED CONSENT WARNINGS
(NOT APPLICABLE WITH VOLUNTARY CONSENT)**

BREATH TESTING

I am now requesting that you submit to a lawful test of your **BREATH** for the purpose of determining its alcohol content.

Will you take the test?

NOTE: READ ONLY IF THE ANSWER TO THE ABOVE IS "NO"

If you refuse to take the test I have requested of you, your driving privilege will be suspended for a period of one (1) year for a FIRST REFUSAL, or eighteen (18) months if your driving privilege has been PREVIOUSLY SUSPENDED for refusing to submit to a lawful test of your breath, urine, or blood. Additionally, if you refuse to take the test I have requested of you, and if your driving privilege has been previously suspended for a refusal to submit to a lawful test of your breath, urine, or blood, you will be committing a misdemeanor, in addition to any other penalties which can be imposed by law. Refusal to submit to the test I have requested is admissible into evidence in any criminal proceeding.

Do you still refuse to submit to this test?

NOTE: IF THE SUBJECT POSSESSES A COOL ENDORSEMENT, READ THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS OF WHETHER THE SUBJECT IS OPERATING A COMMERCIAL VEHICLE.

In addition, if you are a COOL holder, or were driving a CMV, your refusal to submit to testing will result in the loss of your commercial driving privileges for one year from today. If/Ifs is your second refusal, you will be permanently disqualified from operating a commercial motor vehicle.

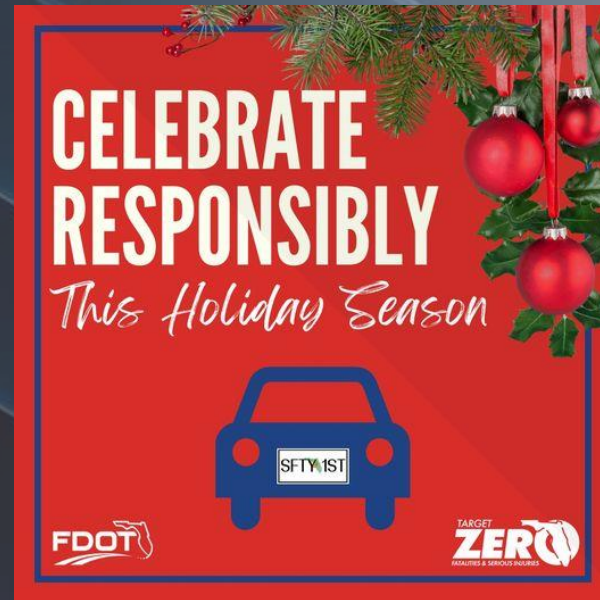





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Social Media

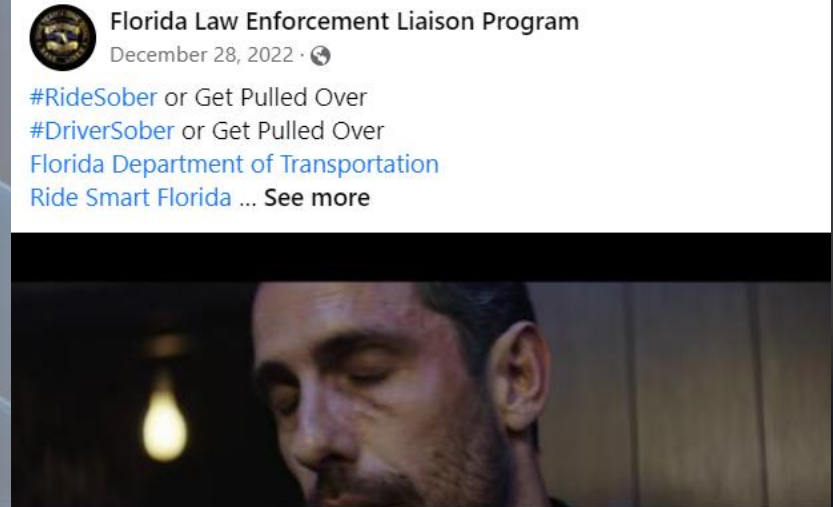

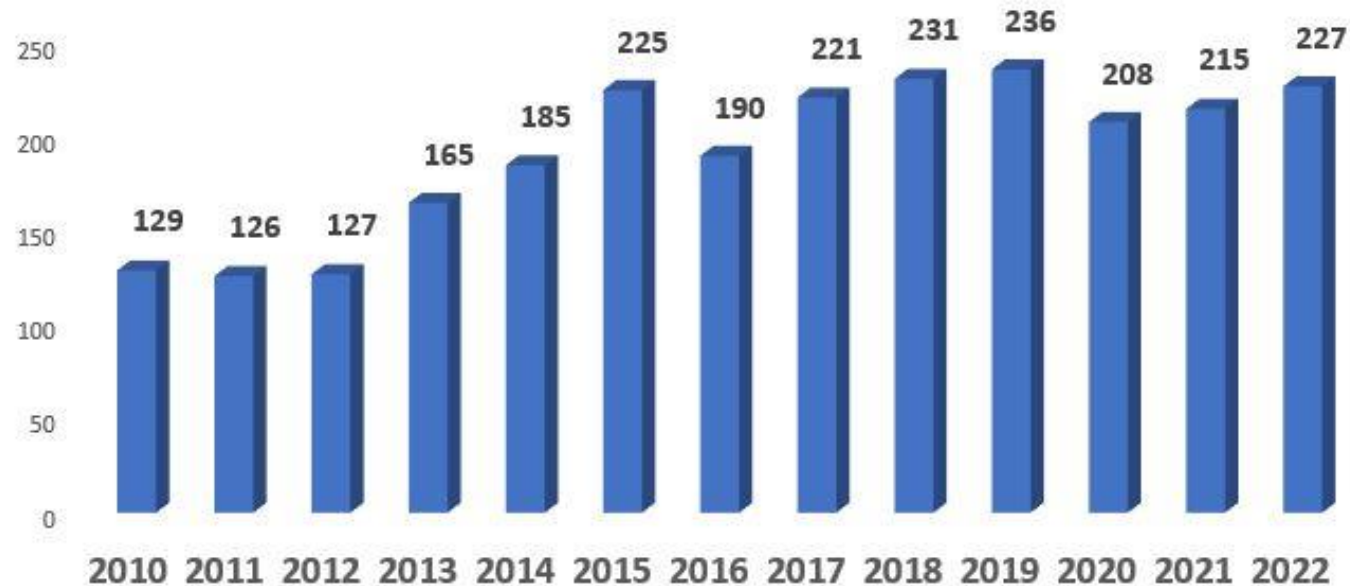
