# The Houston Based MSP That Covers San Antonio

**Real Name: Meriplex** 

Illusion: Claims to cover the area but they're nowhere close.

🌃 Location Fact: They're headquartered in Houston—almost 3 hours away. Their site mentions "surrounding areas in Texas," but doesn't actually list San Antonio.

## The Top Ranked MSP That's Not Even From Here

**Real Name: IT Goat** 

Illusion: Says they're San Antonio's top provider... but are they even here?

Curse: Support tickets vanish, just like their real office. Location Fact: They're originally from Fort Worth. Their Google profile shows

vague office images—just a coffee and a notebook. That's not a workspace.

## The Out of State INSP Hiding Behind a UPS Store

**Real Name: TSR** 

Illusion: Claims to have a San Antonio presence but the address is sketchy.

Curse: Their "local support" disappears when things go wrong.

**It Location Fact:** They're headquartered in Wisconsin. The image on their GBP suggests the "office" is either a Safe Outlet or UPS mailbox.

#### The Infrastructure INSP That Doesn't Exist Here

**Real Name: Dyopath IT** 

Illusion: Tries to look like a local IT hero but you won't find them here.

Curse: All talk, no team on the ground.

**Location Fact:** They list no San Antonio address anywhere. Nothing on Google. No pin. No local presence.
