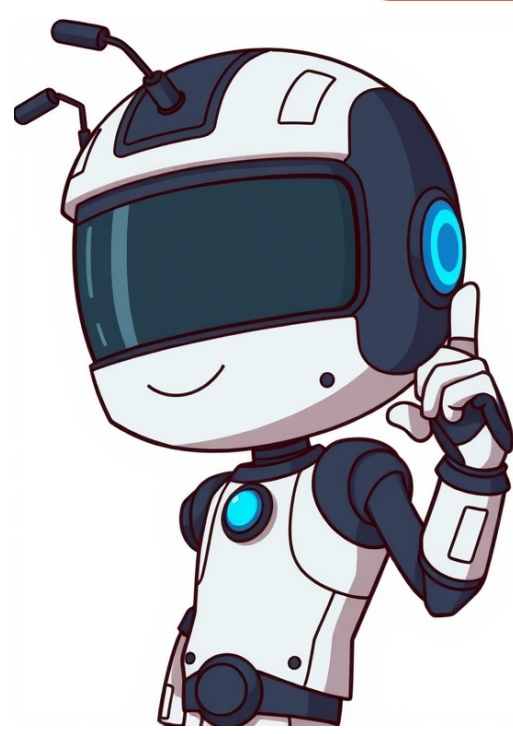

The degree symbol is an essential character used in various contexts such as indicating temperature °C or °F and angles like 45°. Knowing how to type this symbol can be very handy whether you use a Windows PC, Apple Mac, Android phone, or iPhone. Typing the degree symbol on a Windows PC is easy. There are several methods - using the Num Lock Key, Alt code, opening Character Map, or copying the Unicode character 00B0. On a Mac, you can type the degree symbol by pressing Option + Shift + 8 or using the Character Viewer to find and insert it. Android phones allow you to access the degree symbol through the numeric keyboard. First, switch to numbers and symbols, tap the ?123 button, find the degree symbol, open Gboard, switch to numbers again, and then select it by sliding your finger over it. iPhone users can easily insert the degree symbol using their keyboard. In math, the degrees symbol is used to represent an angle measured in degrees. It's typically used in expressions like this: In plain language, this represents a 45-degree angle. The degrees symbol is also used in physics as a unit of temperature for Fahrenheit and Celsius. We can measure angles in degrees. There are 360 degrees in one full rotation or 1 degree per day when measuring time around the North Star.
