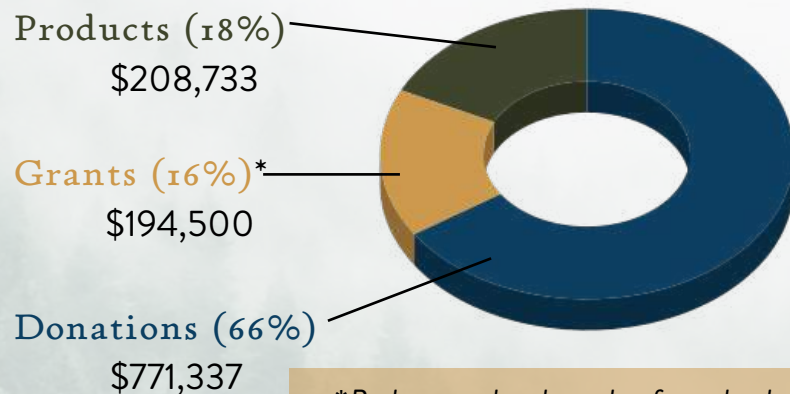

2022 Total Income

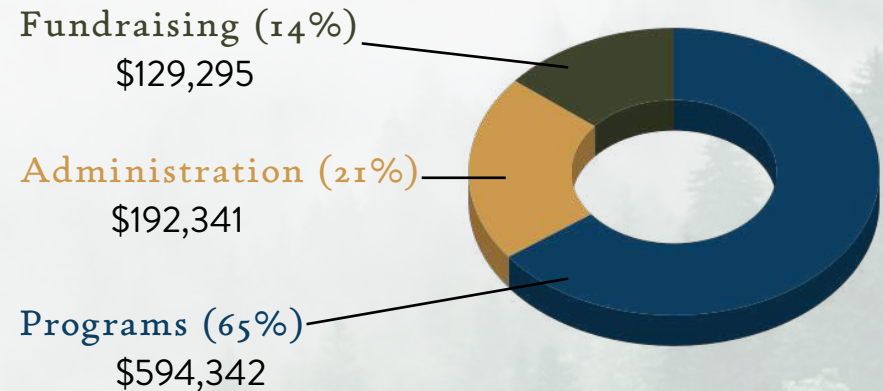
