Detailed Methodology

- The survey was conducted by the Sociological Group “Rating” on behalf of the Center for Insights in Survey Research (CISR) of the International Republican Institute (IRI).
- IRI conducted the survey throughout Ukraine (except for the occupied territories of Crimea and Donbas) from September 27 - October 1, 2024, through computer-assisted telephone interviews (CATI) based on a random sample of mobile telephone numbers.
- The total sample consists of n= 2,000 Ukrainians aged 18 and older. The sample excludes any Ukrainians not currently in Ukraine.
- The survey data obtained was weighted by regional (oblast of residence and type of settlement, except for Vinnytsia, Lutsk, Luhansk, Rivne, and Khmelnytskyi where only oblast of residence was used) and age indicators using data by the State Statistics Service of Ukraine as of January 1, 2022. Unlike its polls in Ukraine prior to 2022, IRI did not use a gender weight due to uneven temporary migration outside Ukraine.
- IRI used special software to randomly generate mobile numbers using 12 codes of the three largest mobile operators in Ukraine: KYIVSTAR, VODAFONE Ukraine and LIFECCELL. Each randomly generated number package includes an equal quantity of each code (050, 063, 066, 067, 068, 073, 093, 095, 096, 097, 098, 099).
- The margin of error at the 95 percent confidence level does not exceed ± 2.2 percentage points for the full sample.
- The response rate was 7 percent.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.
- The study was funded by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID).

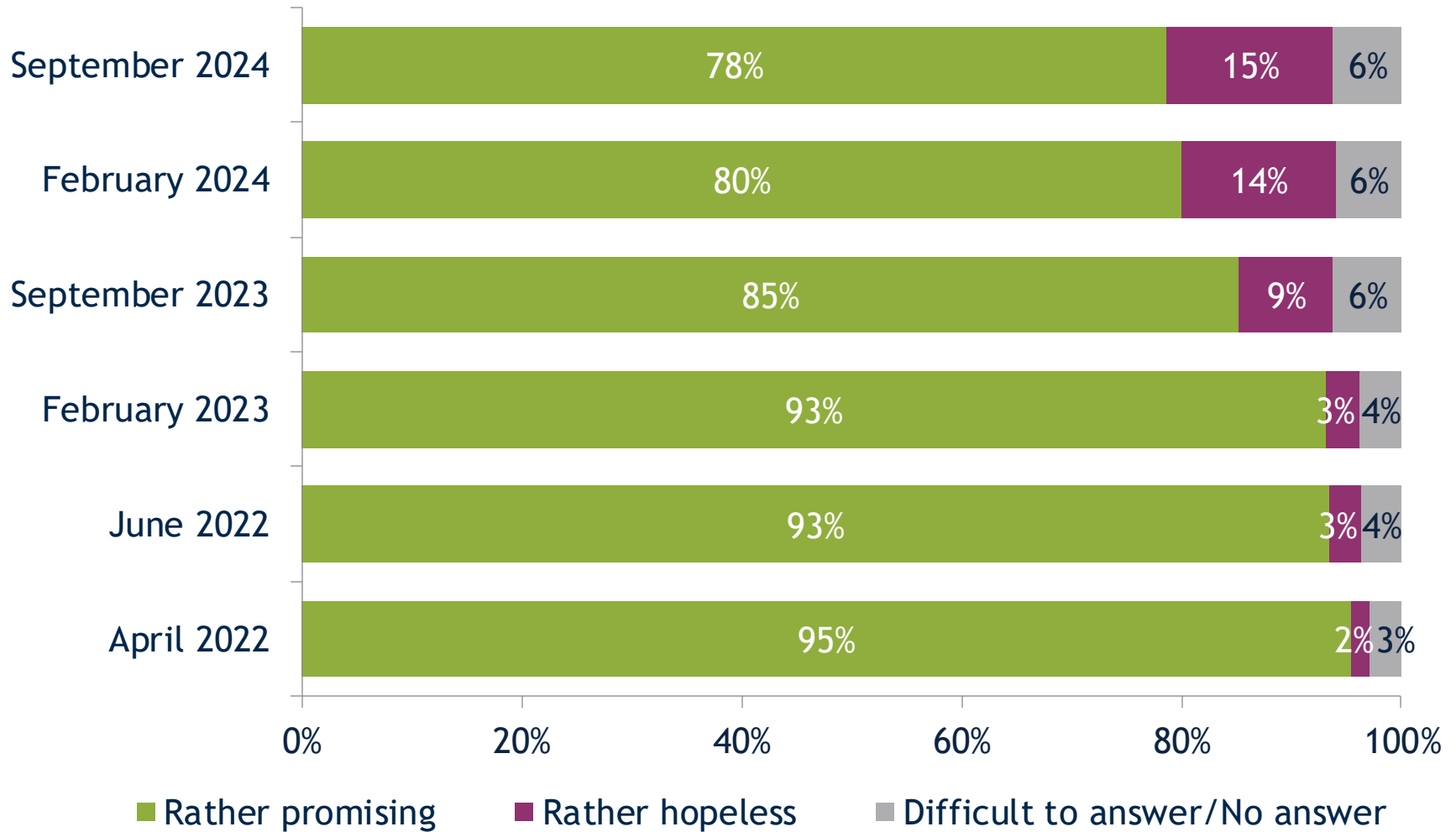

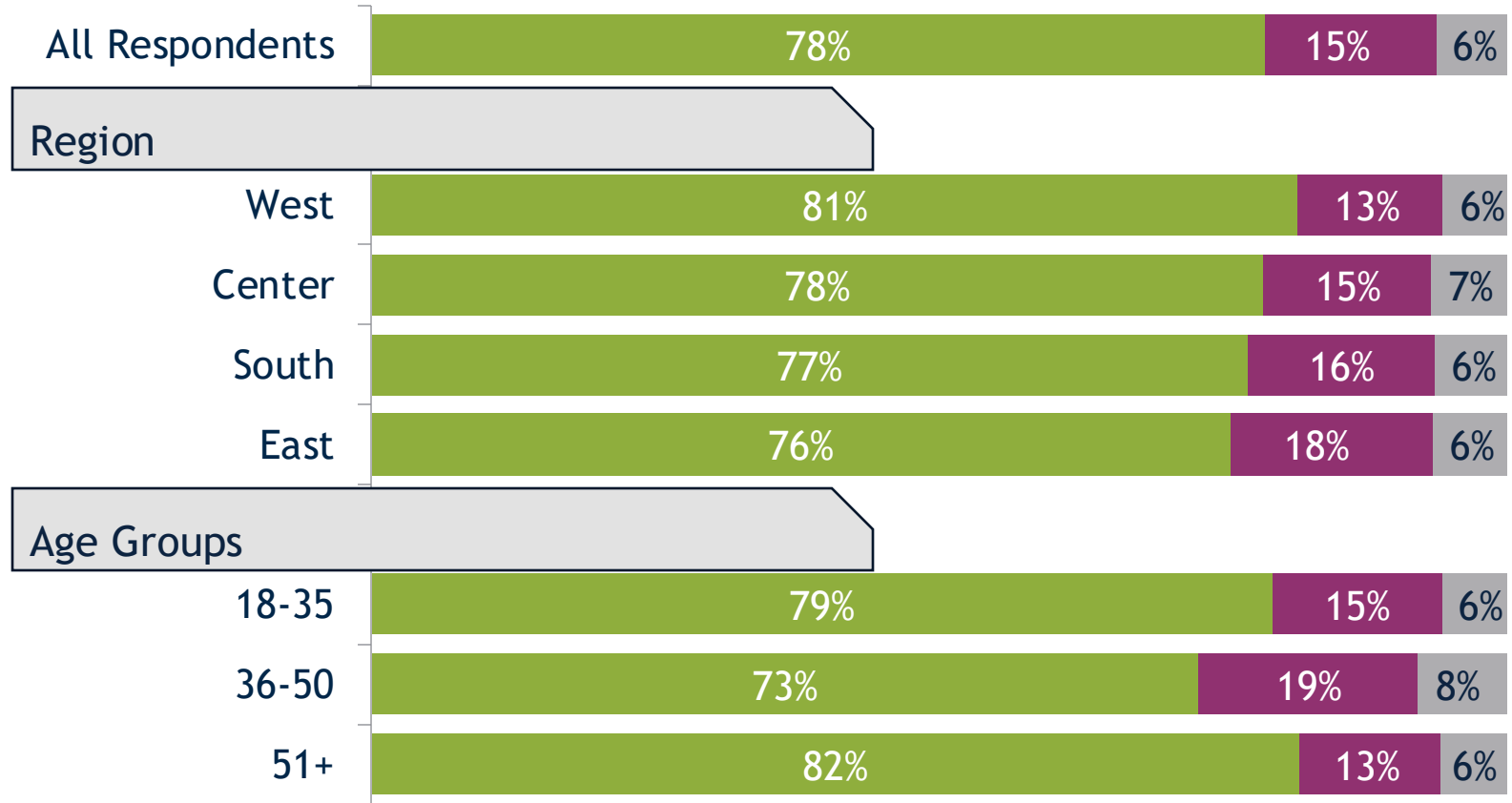

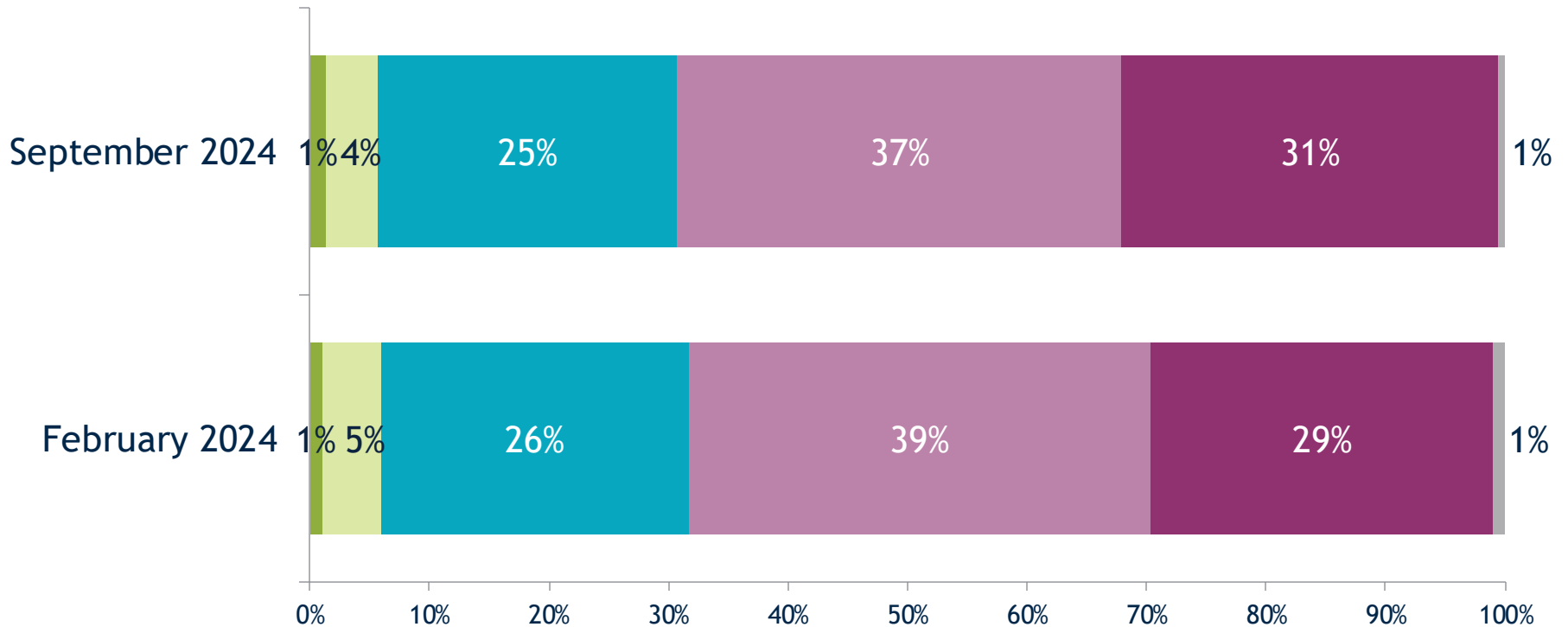

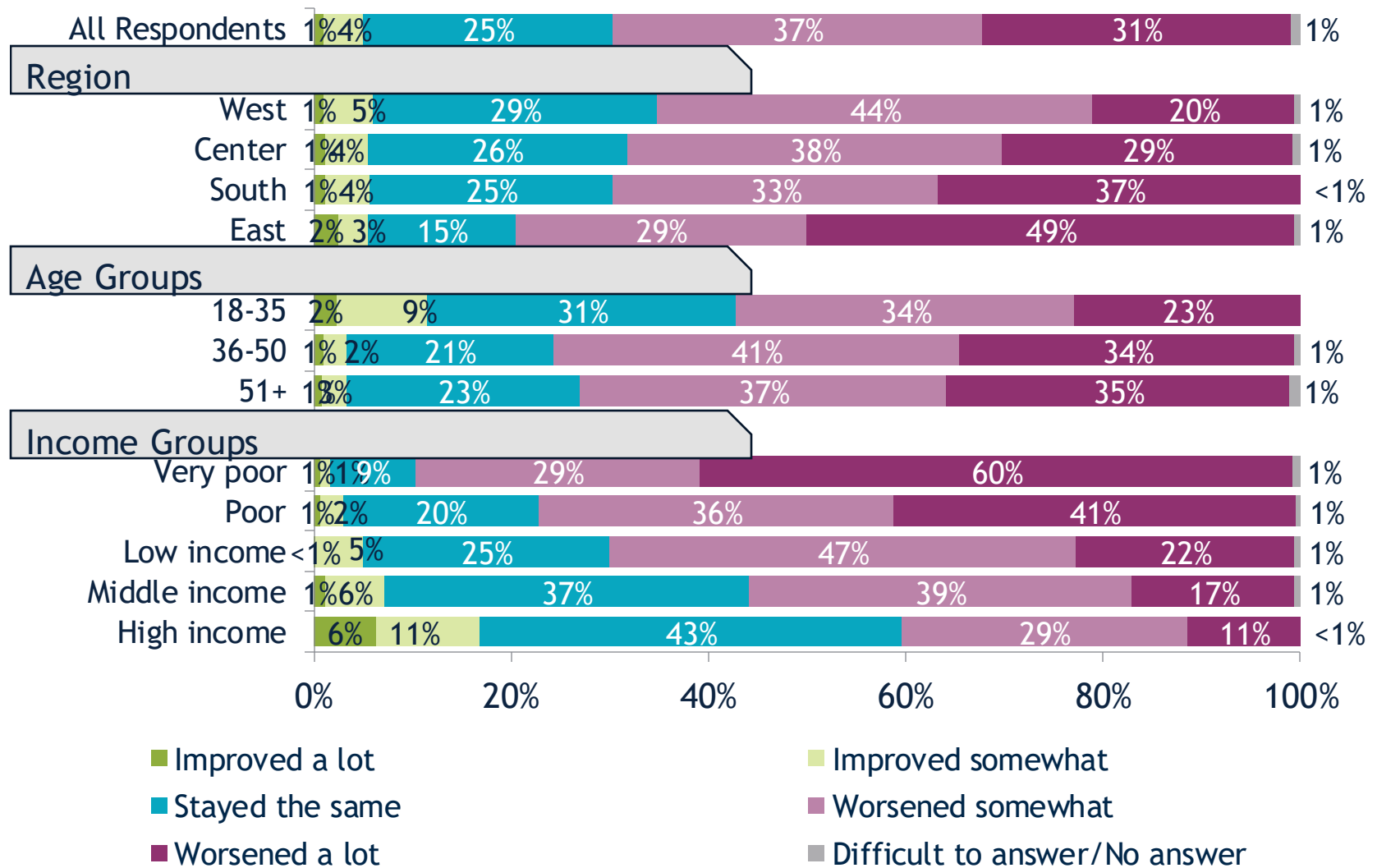
Compared to the period before the full-scale invasion, how has the economic situation of your household changed?



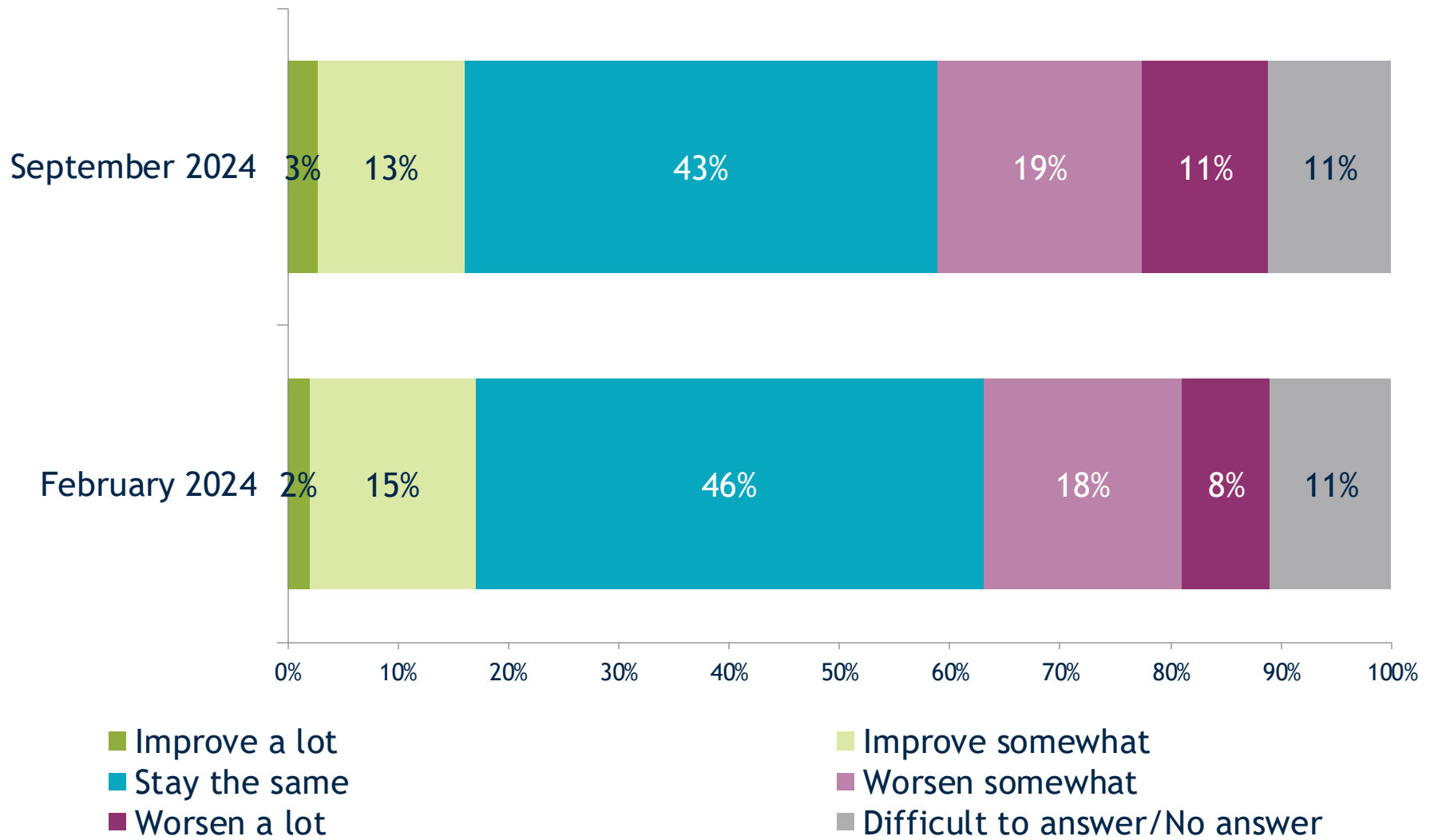

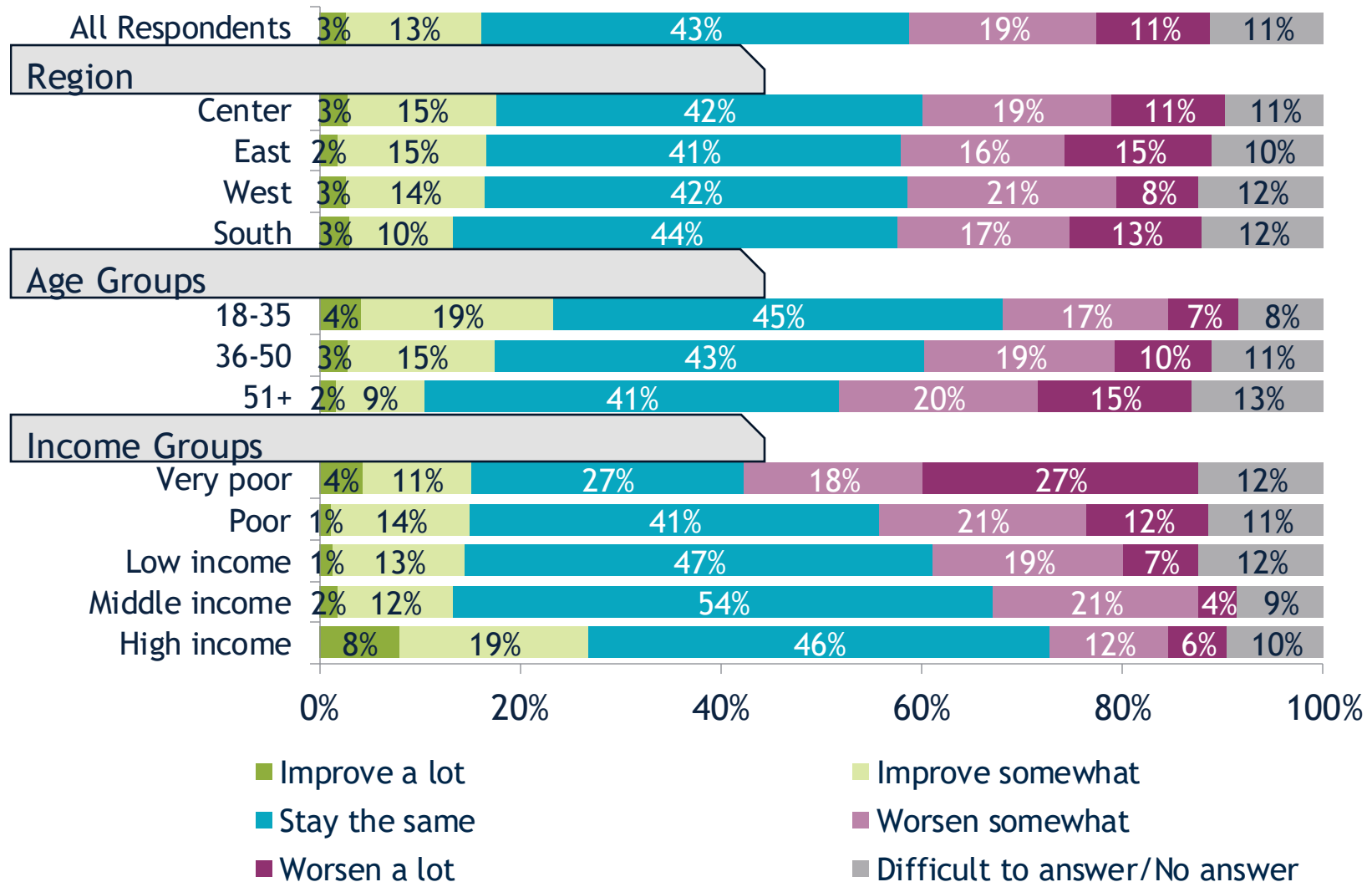

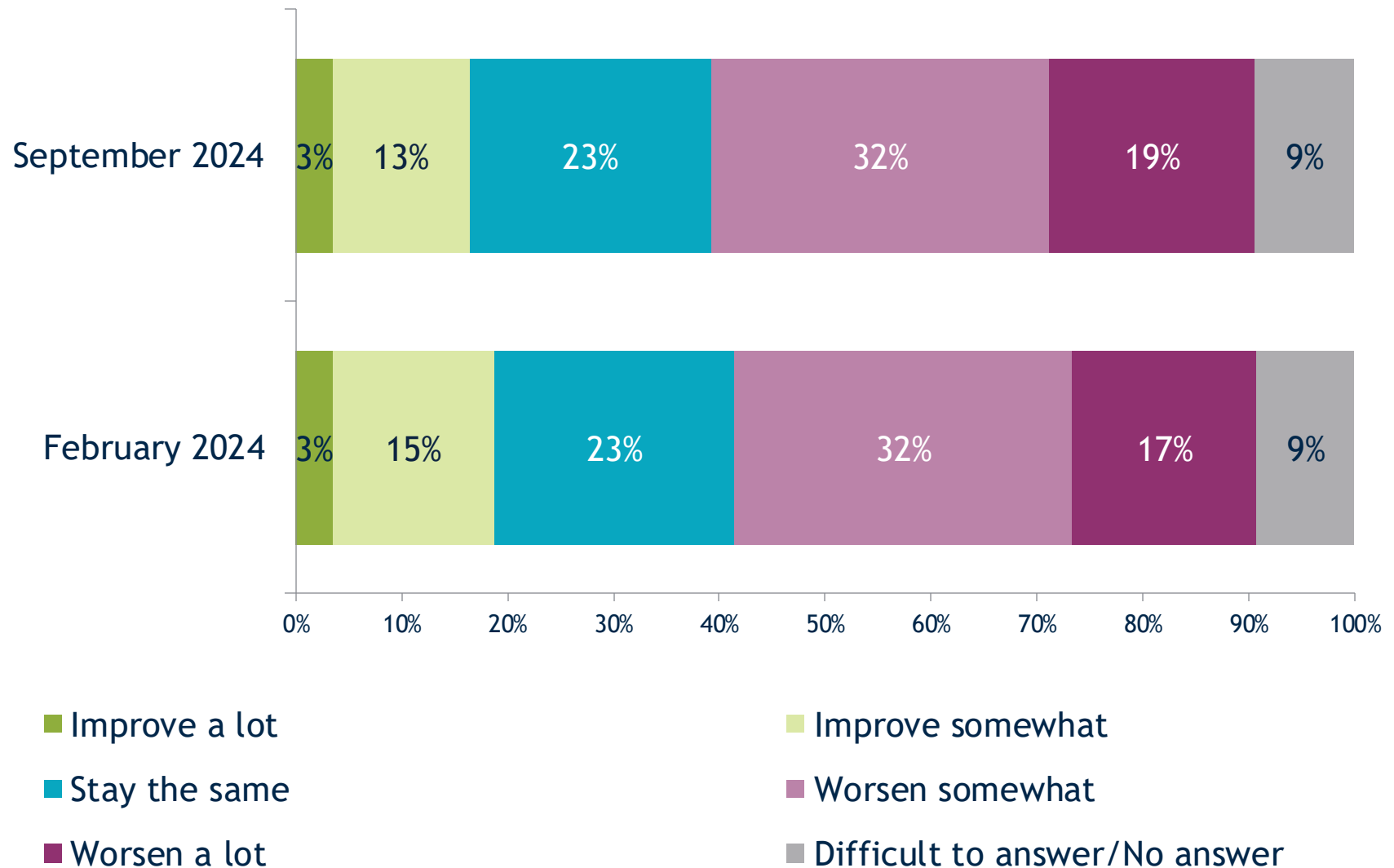
In the next 12 months, how do you expect the economic situation of your household to change?



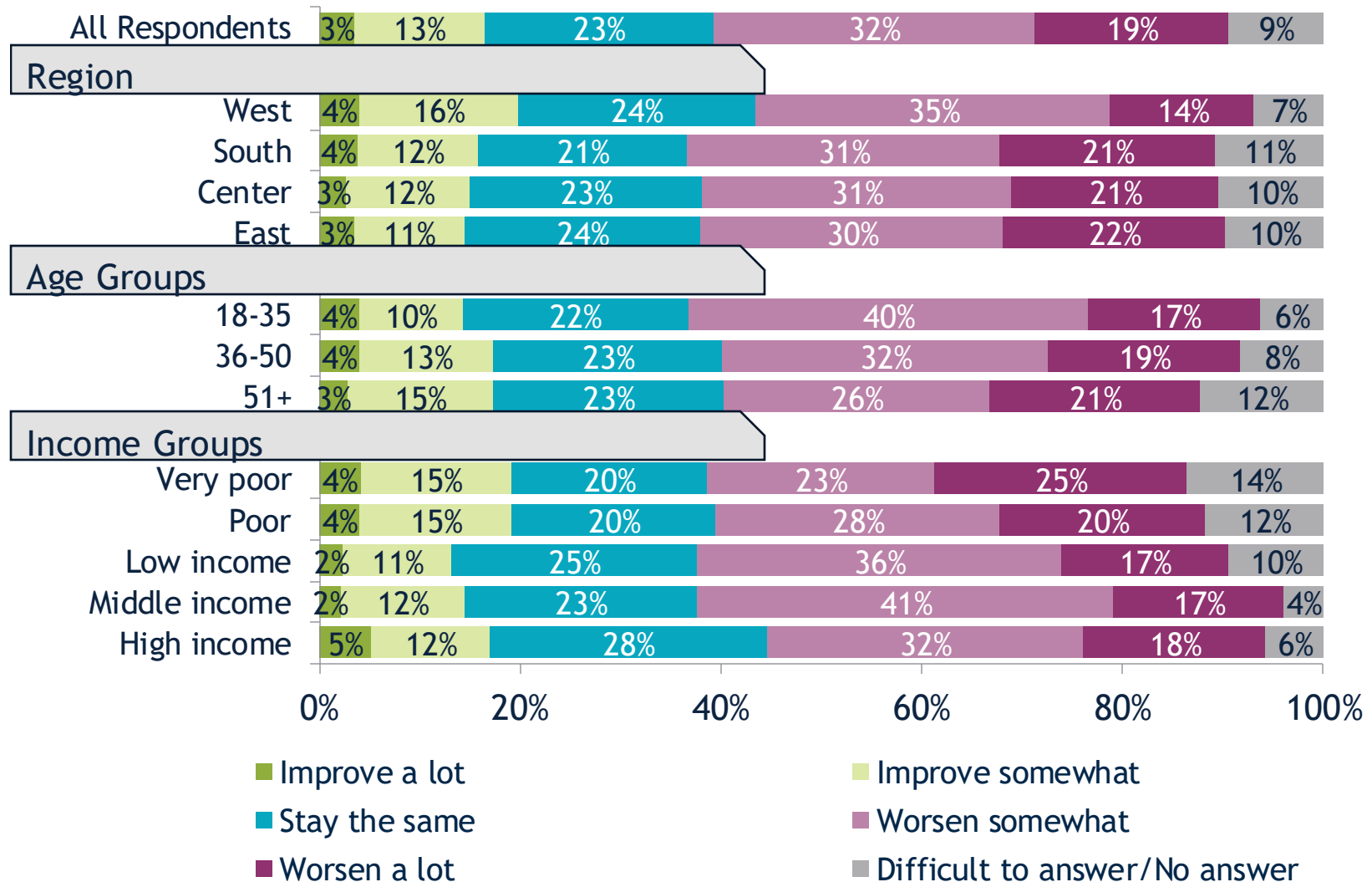

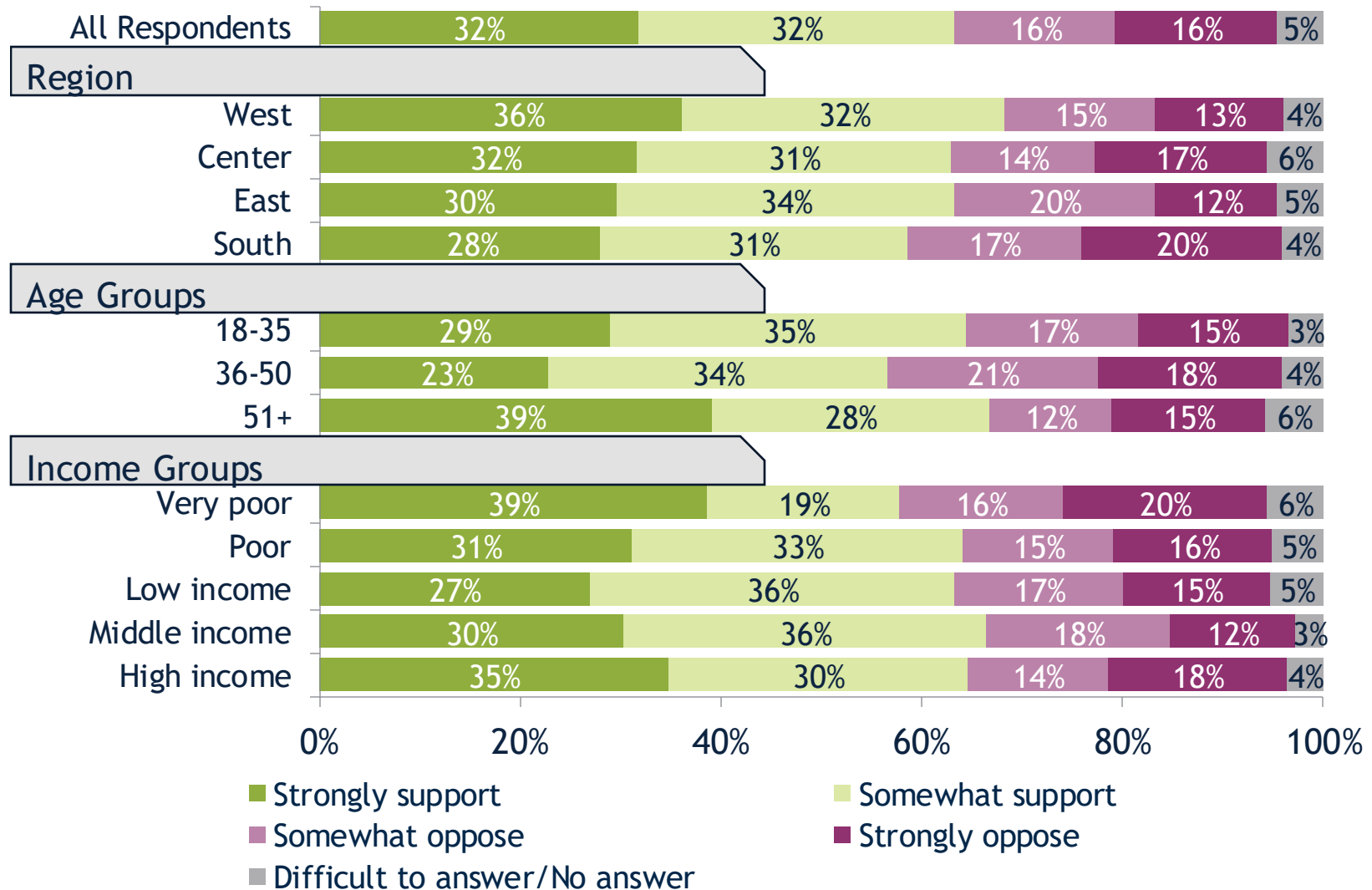

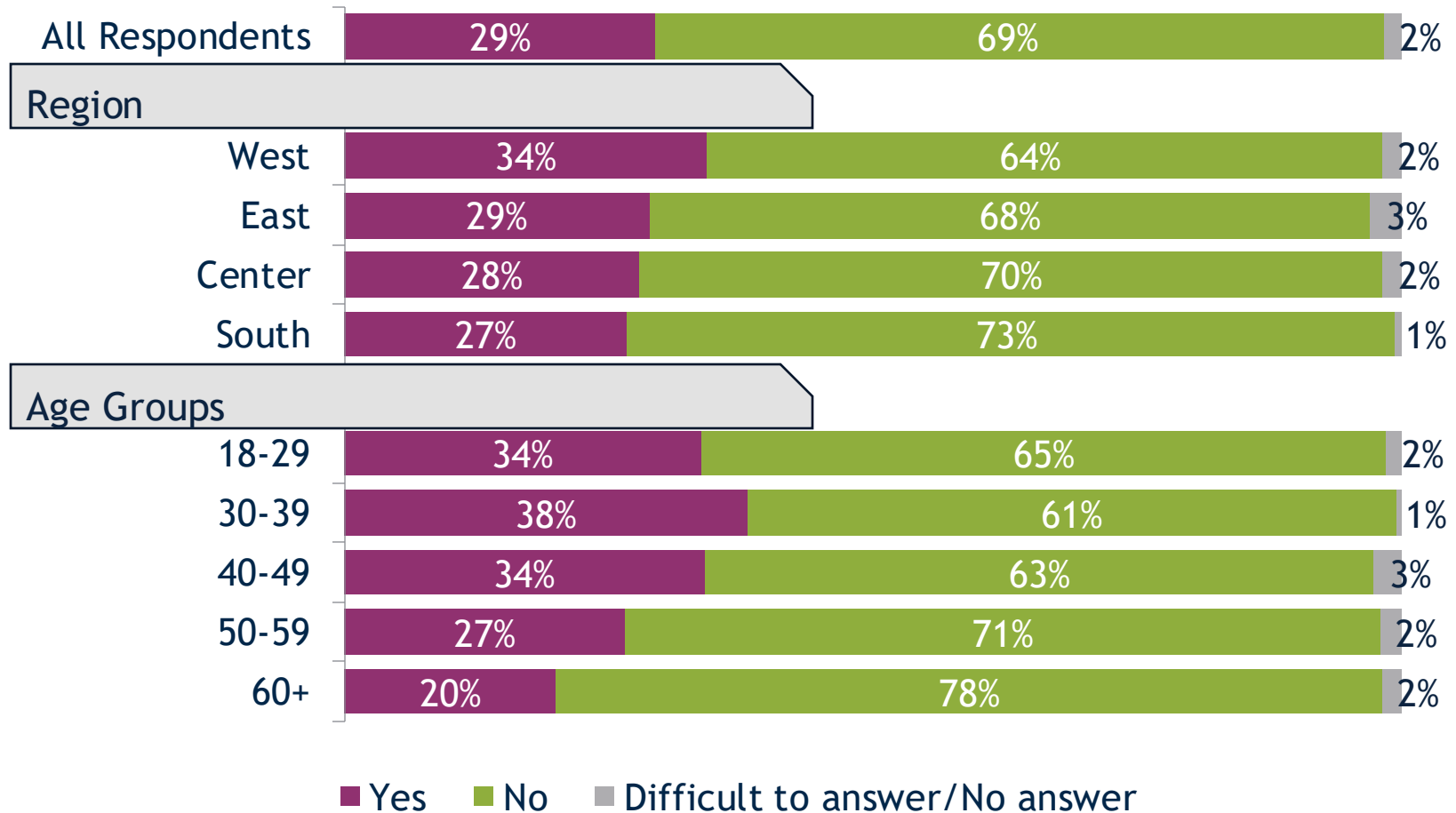

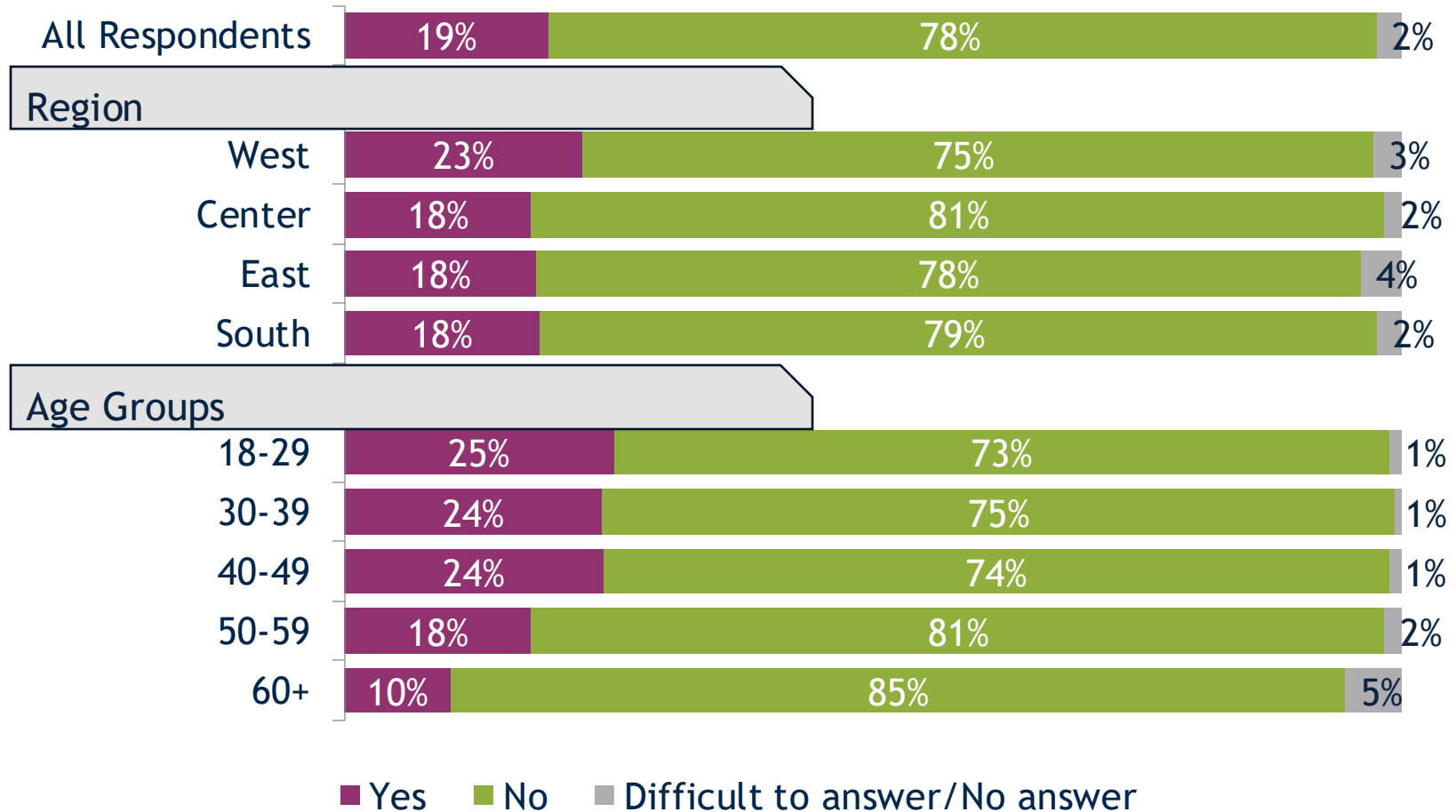
Do you support or oppose raising the military tax from 1.5% to 5% in Ukraine?



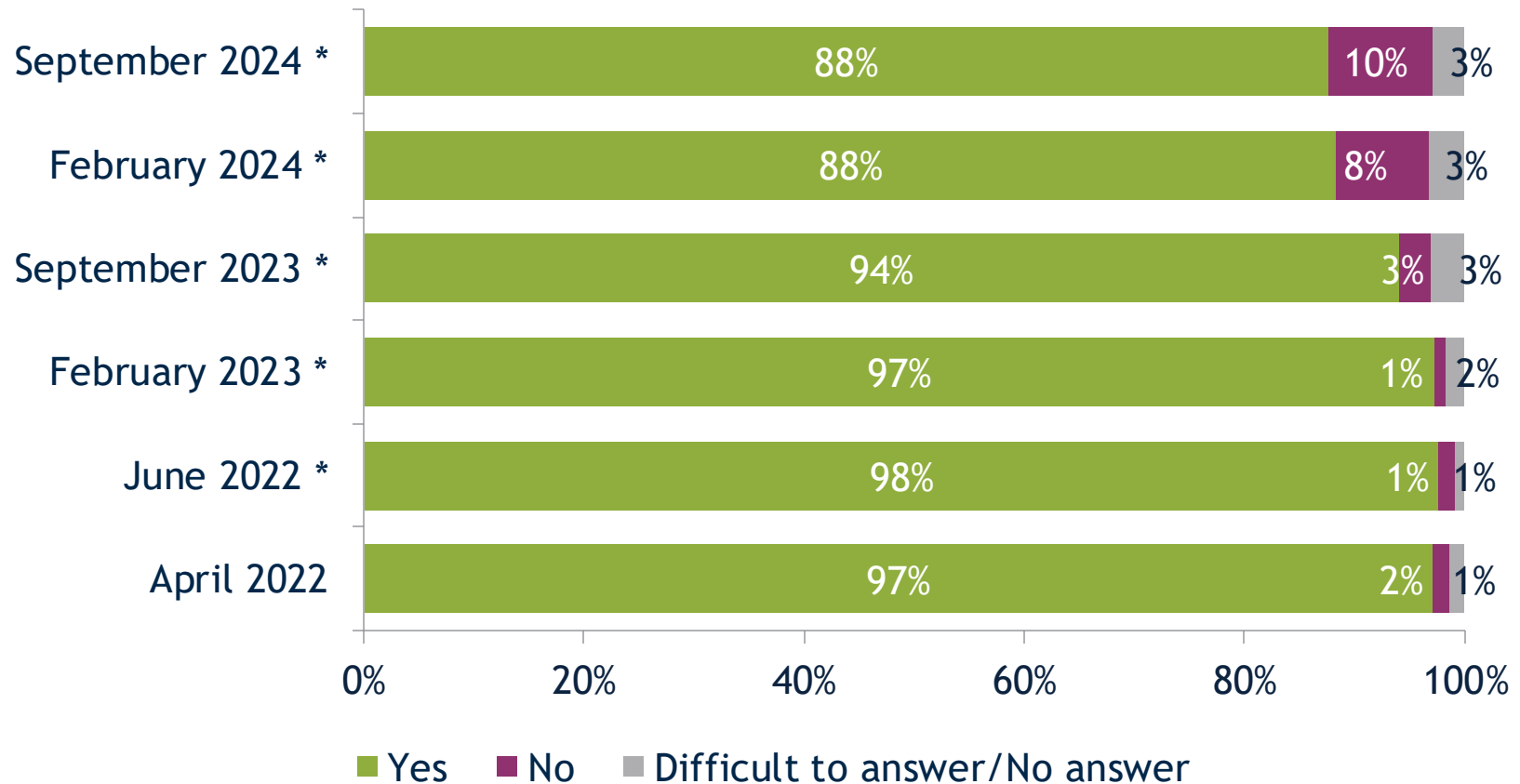
Do you have acquaintances who quit their jobs due to mobilization within the last 6 months and are working without official employment status now?

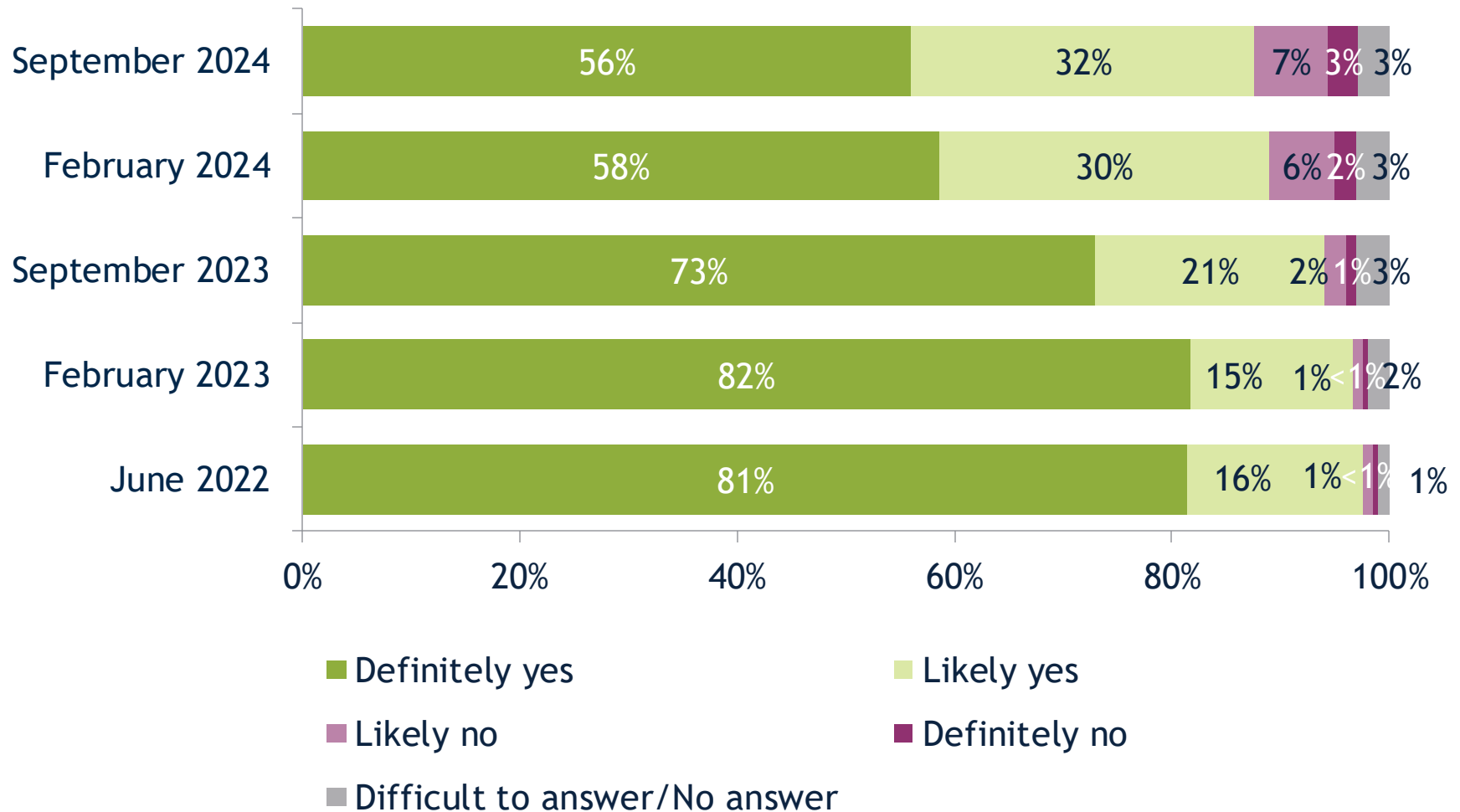

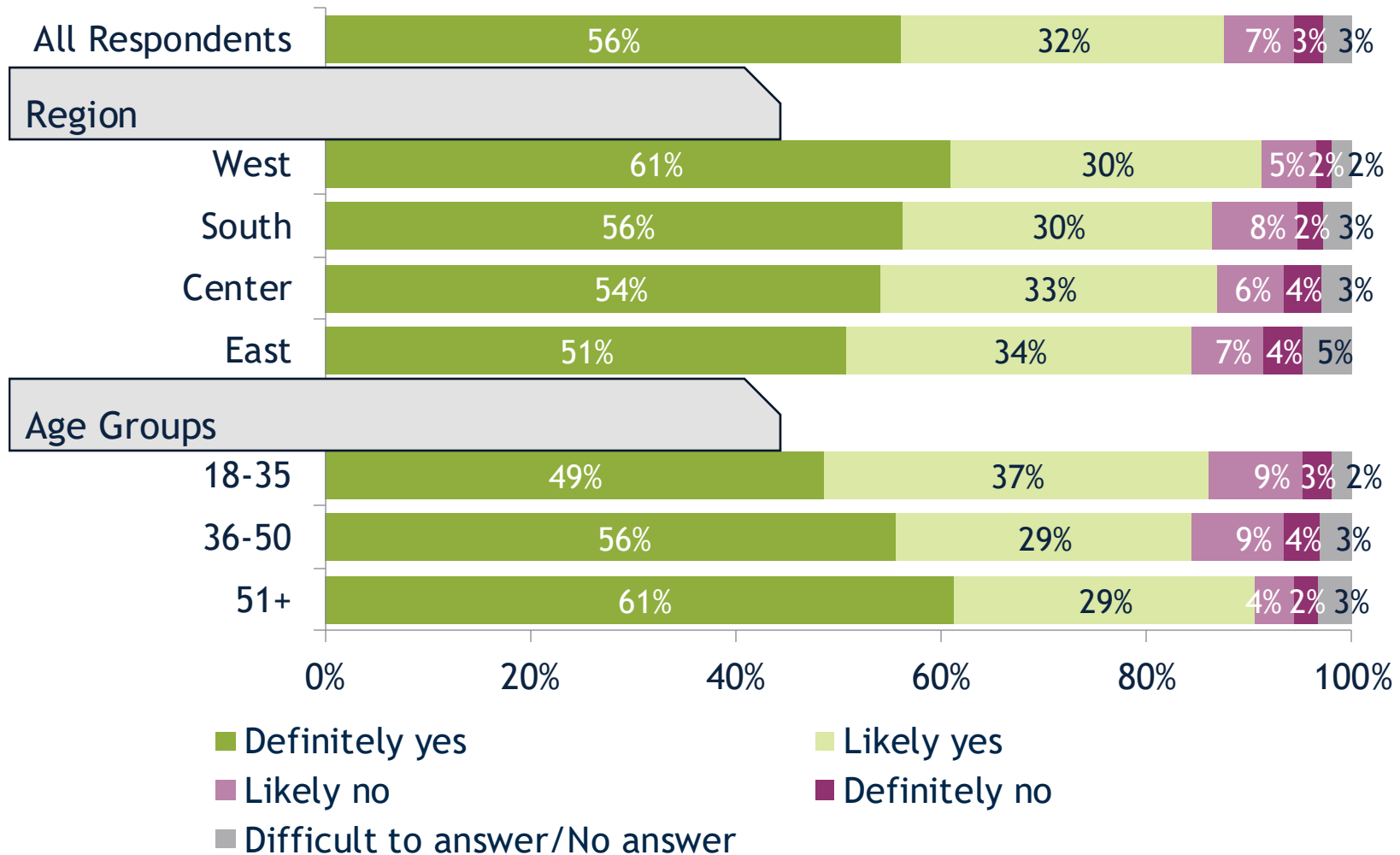

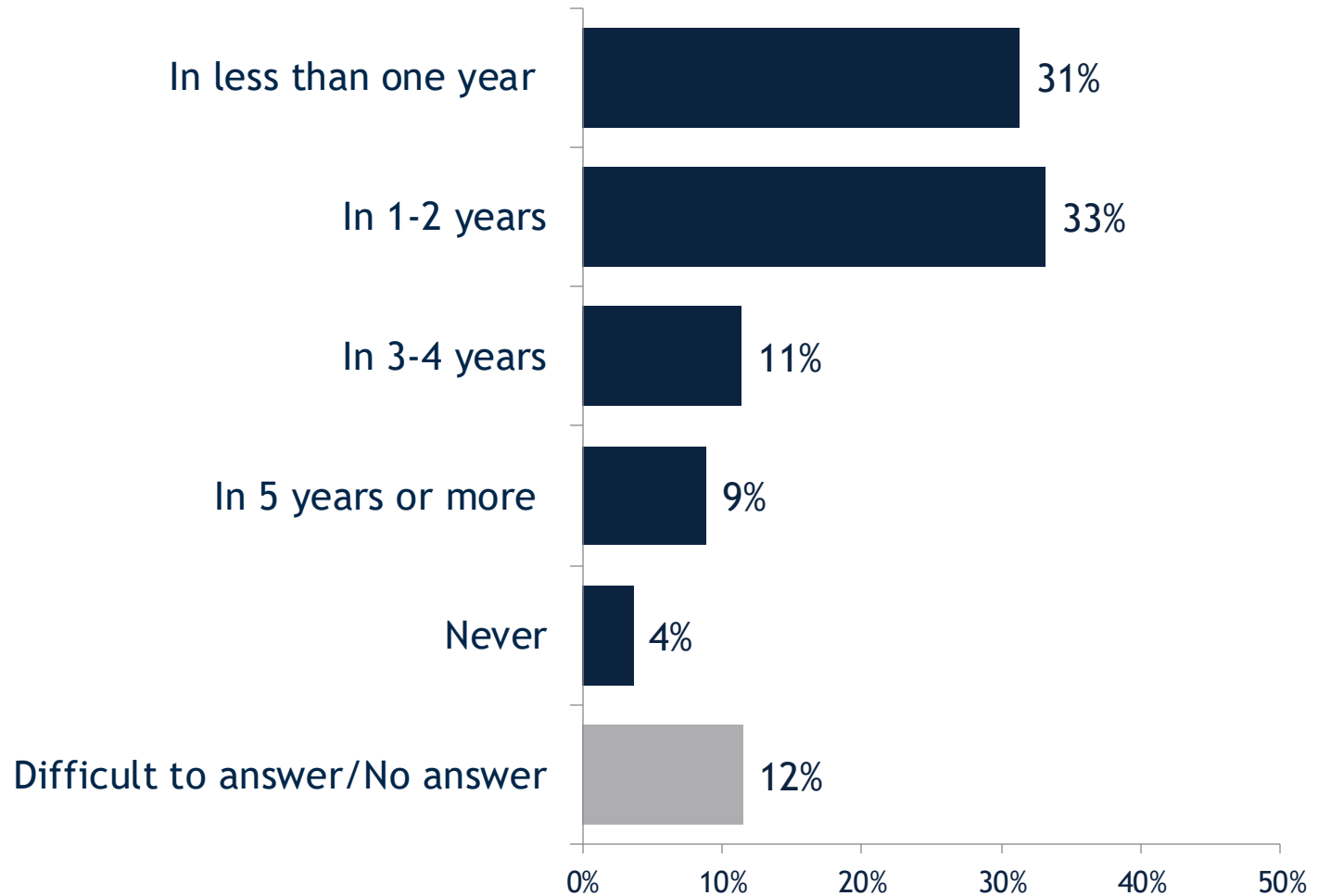

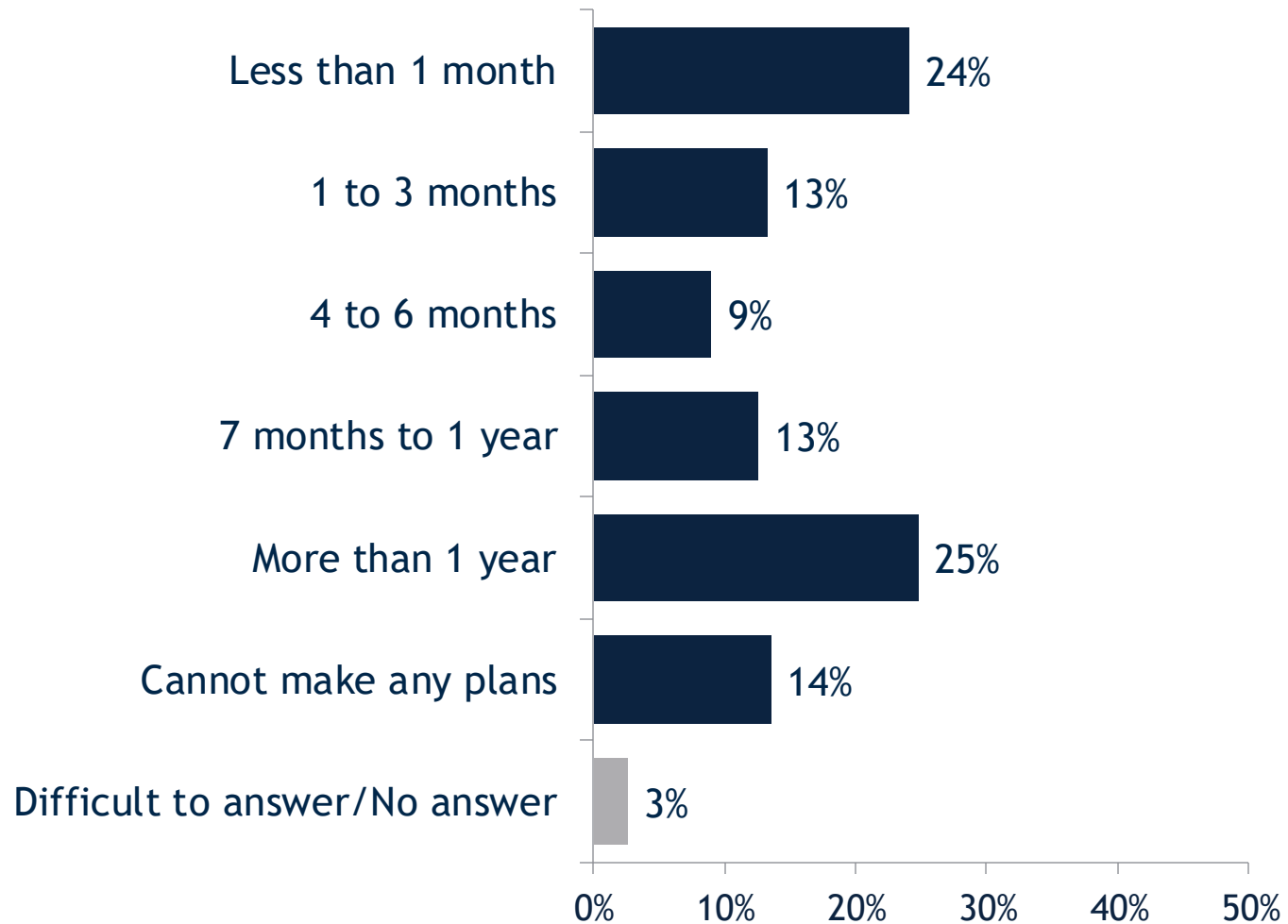

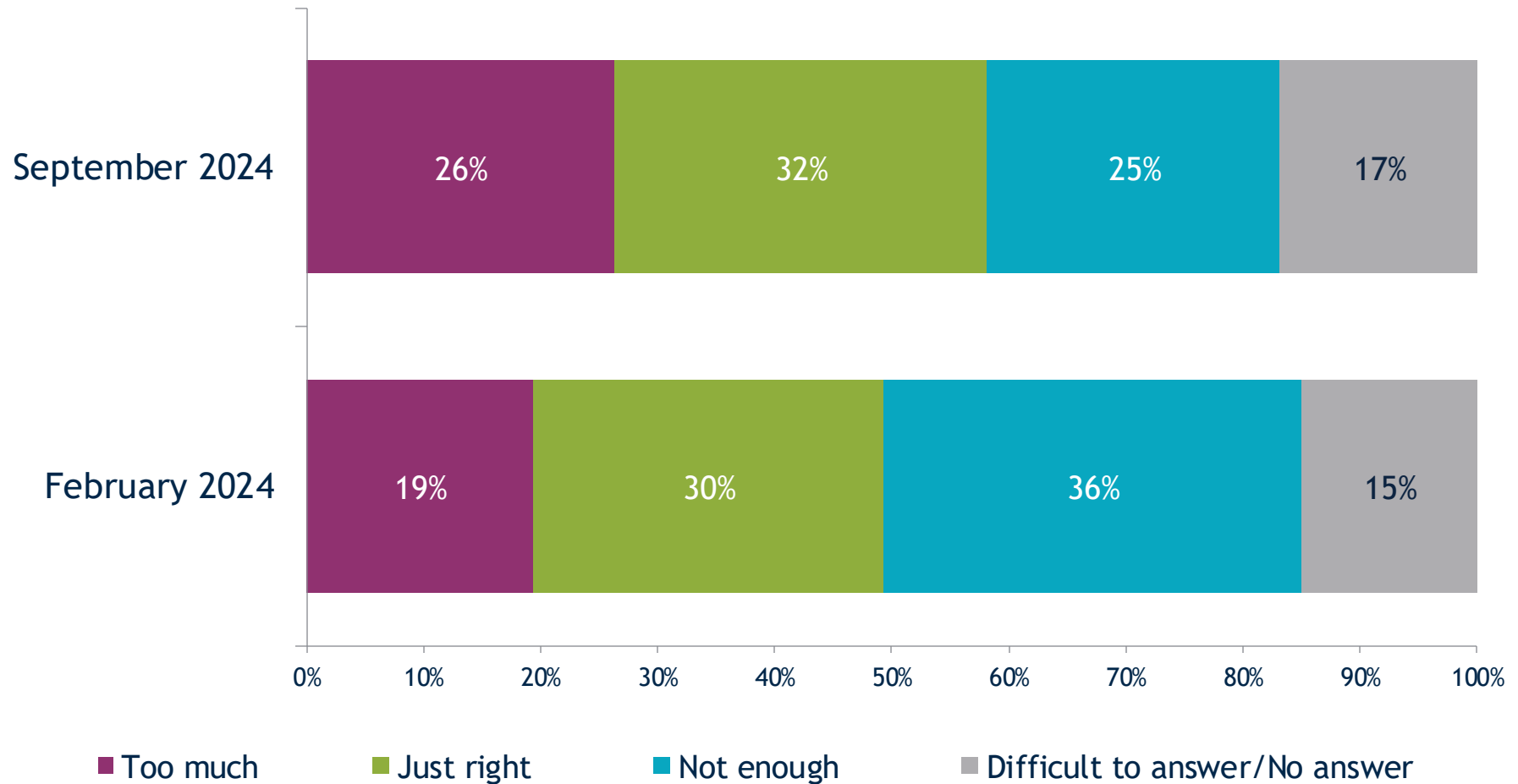

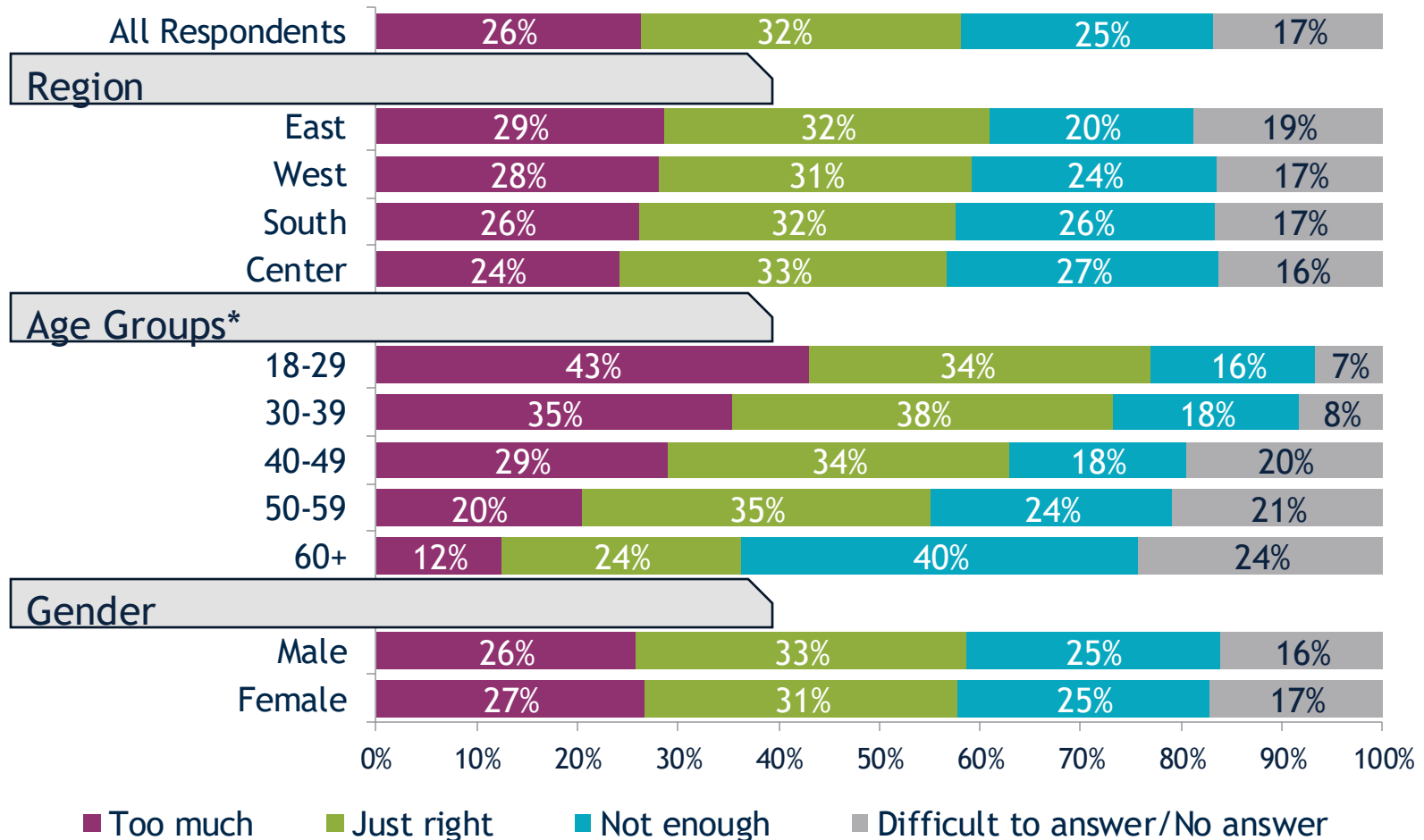




How do you feel about the current level of mobilization in Ukraine, is it ?



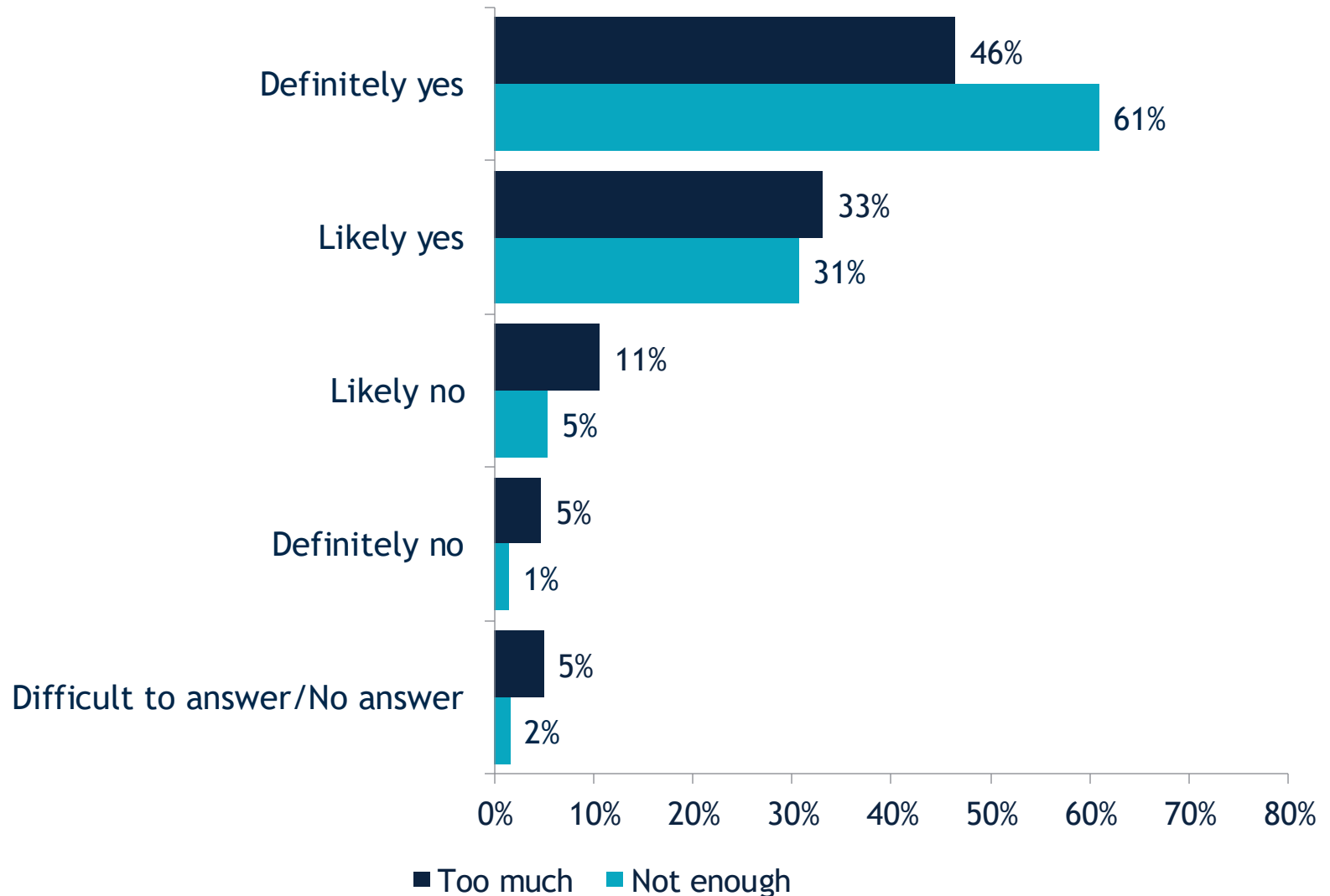

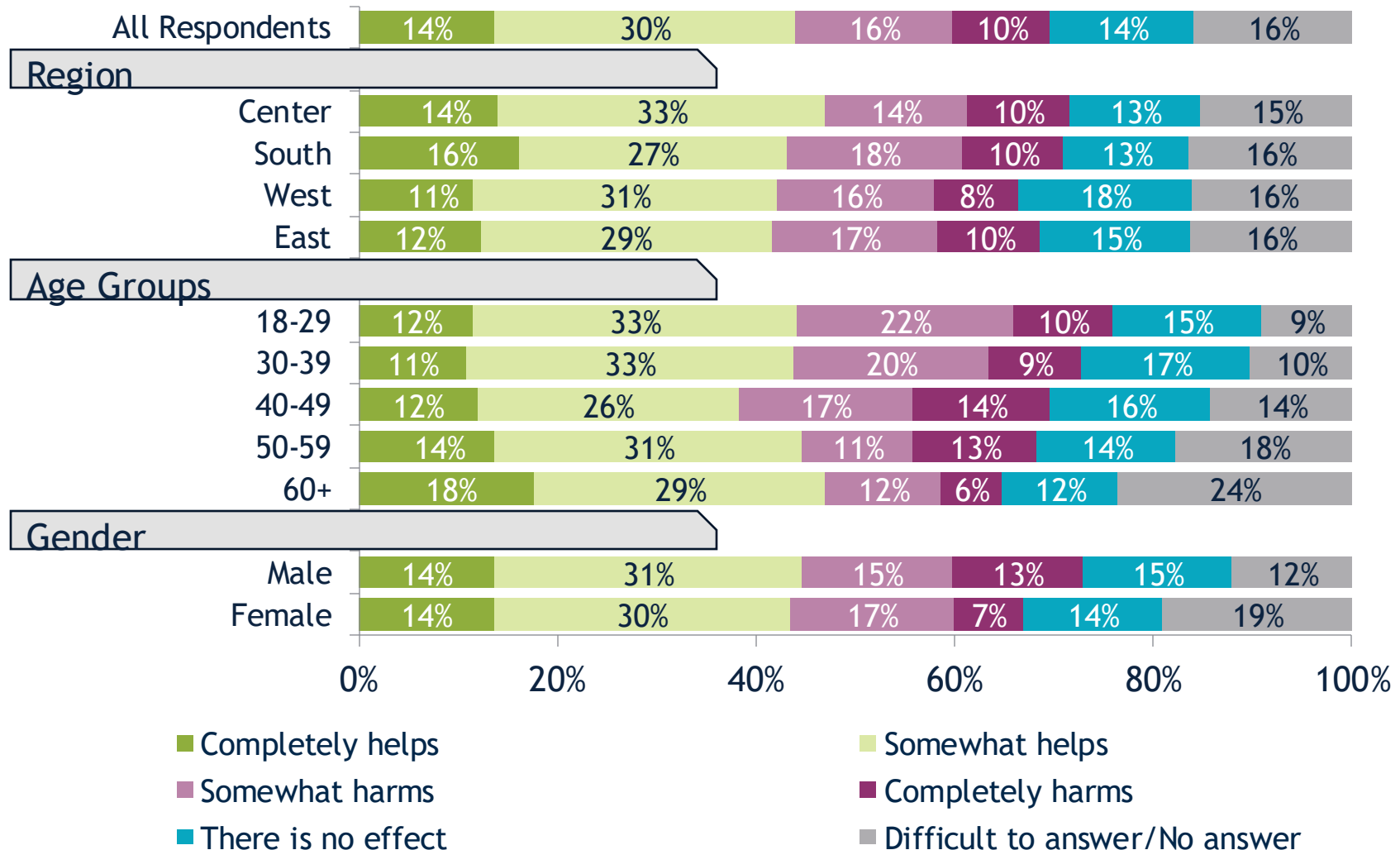

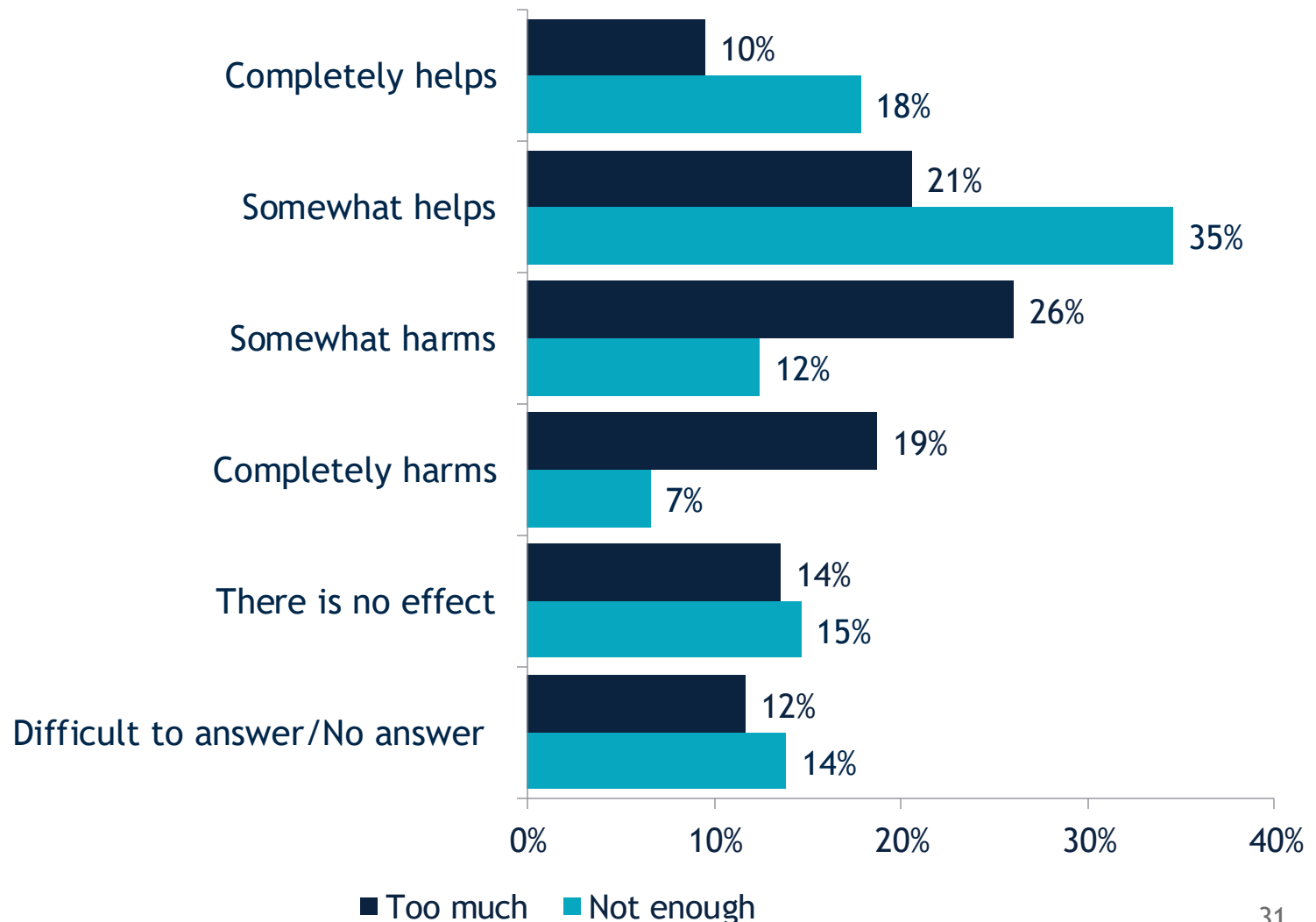


In your opinion, does the new mobilization law, which took effect in May 2024, help or harm Ukraine in its fight against Russia?



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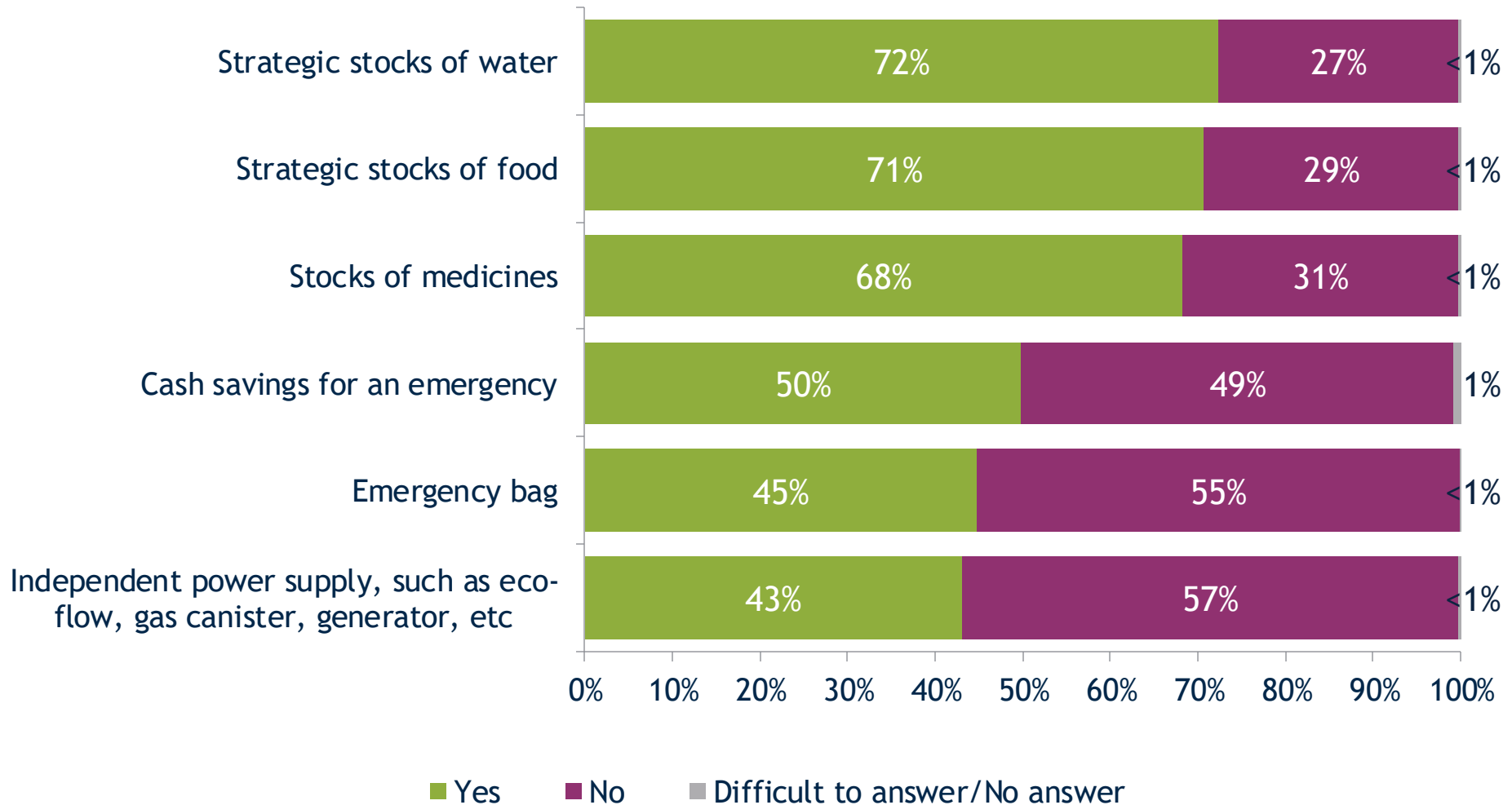

Do you currently have these items in your household?



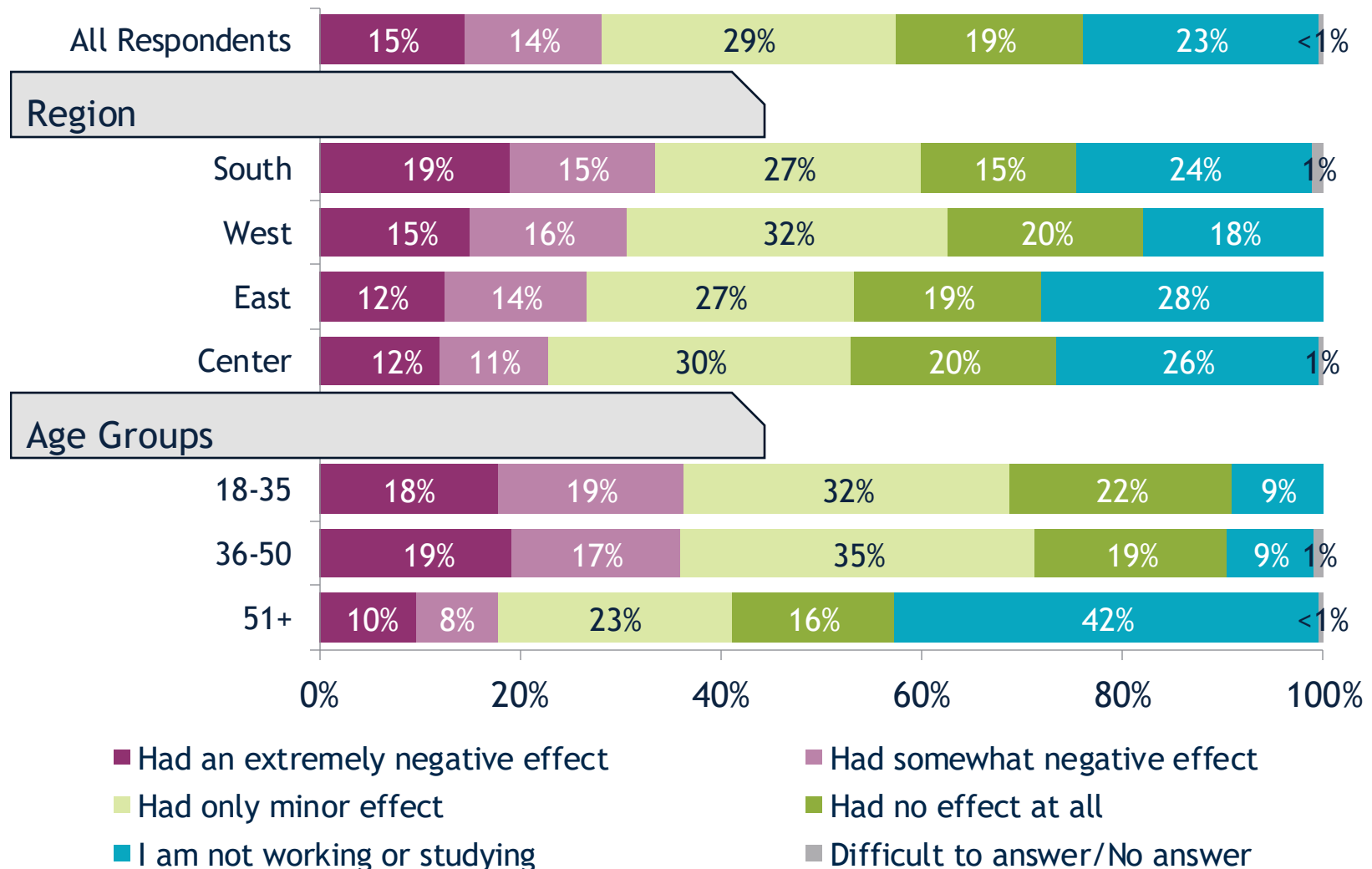

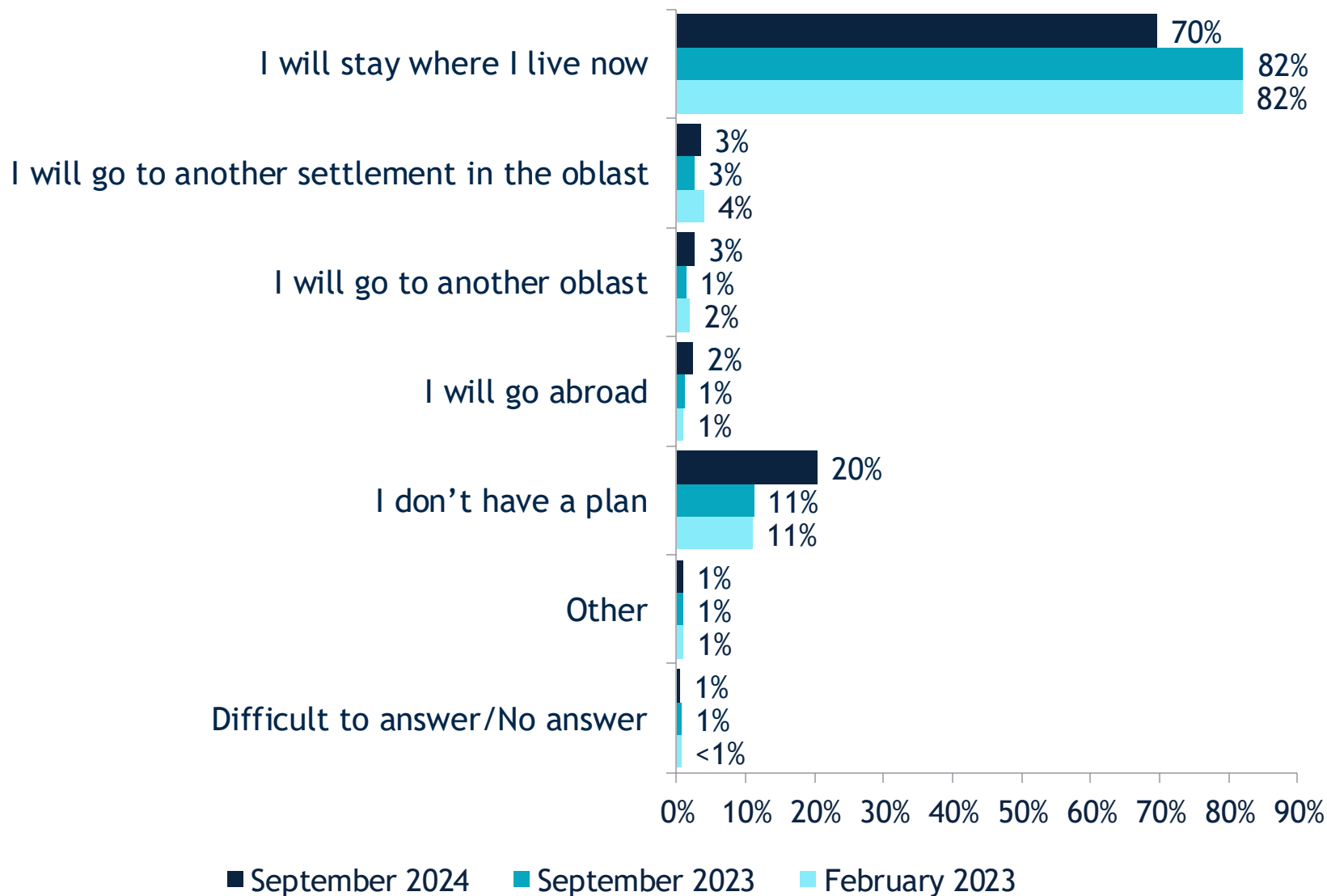

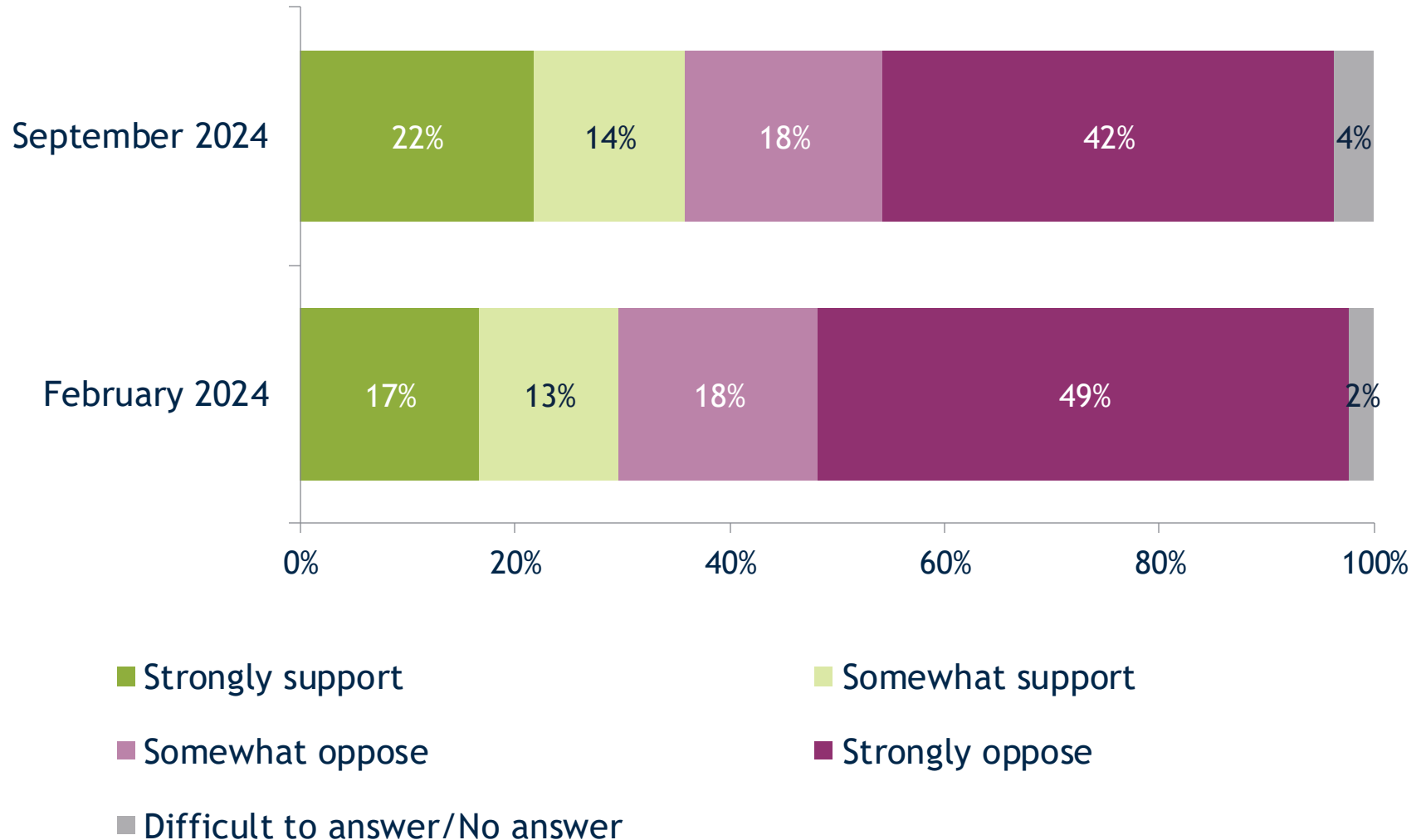
Please tell me if you support or oppose the idea of conducting elections for the Verkhovna Rada while the war is ongoing?



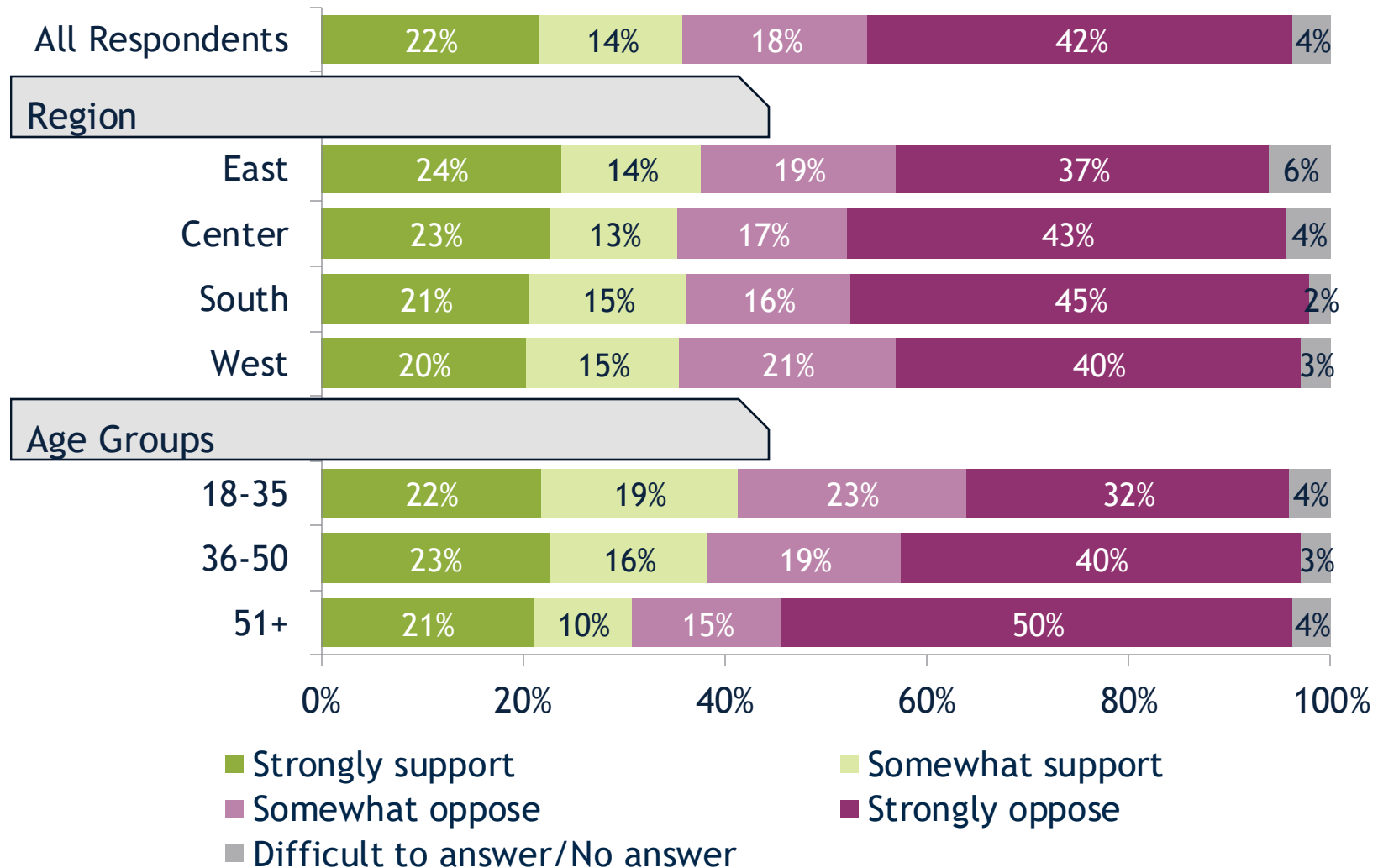

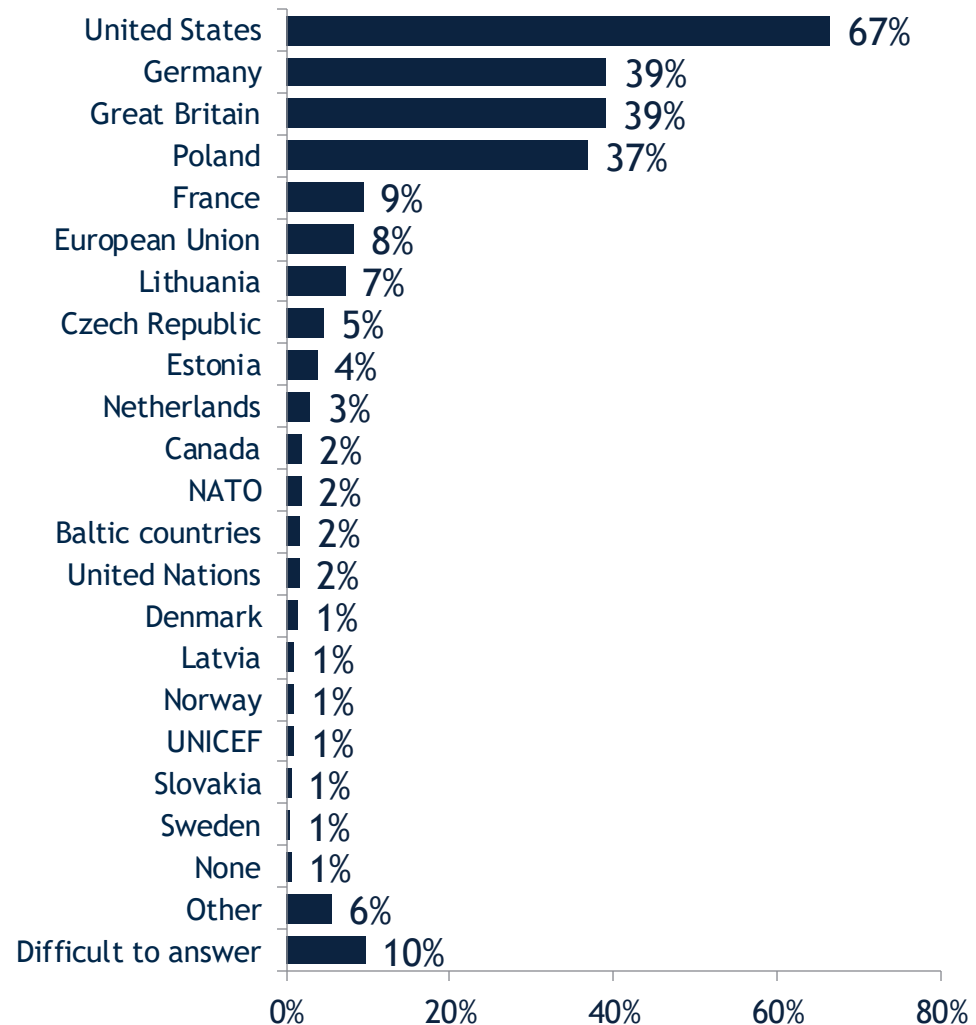

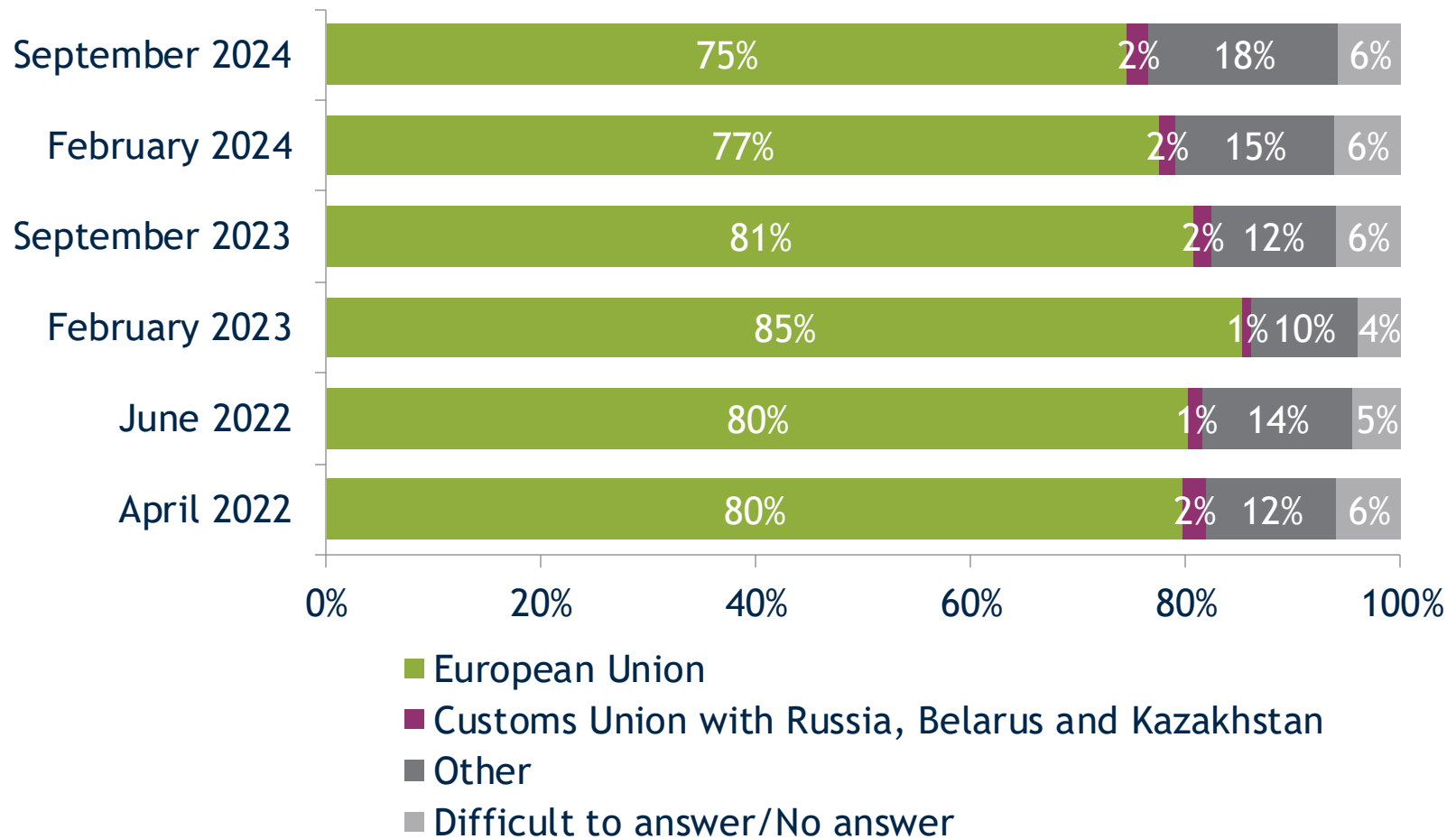

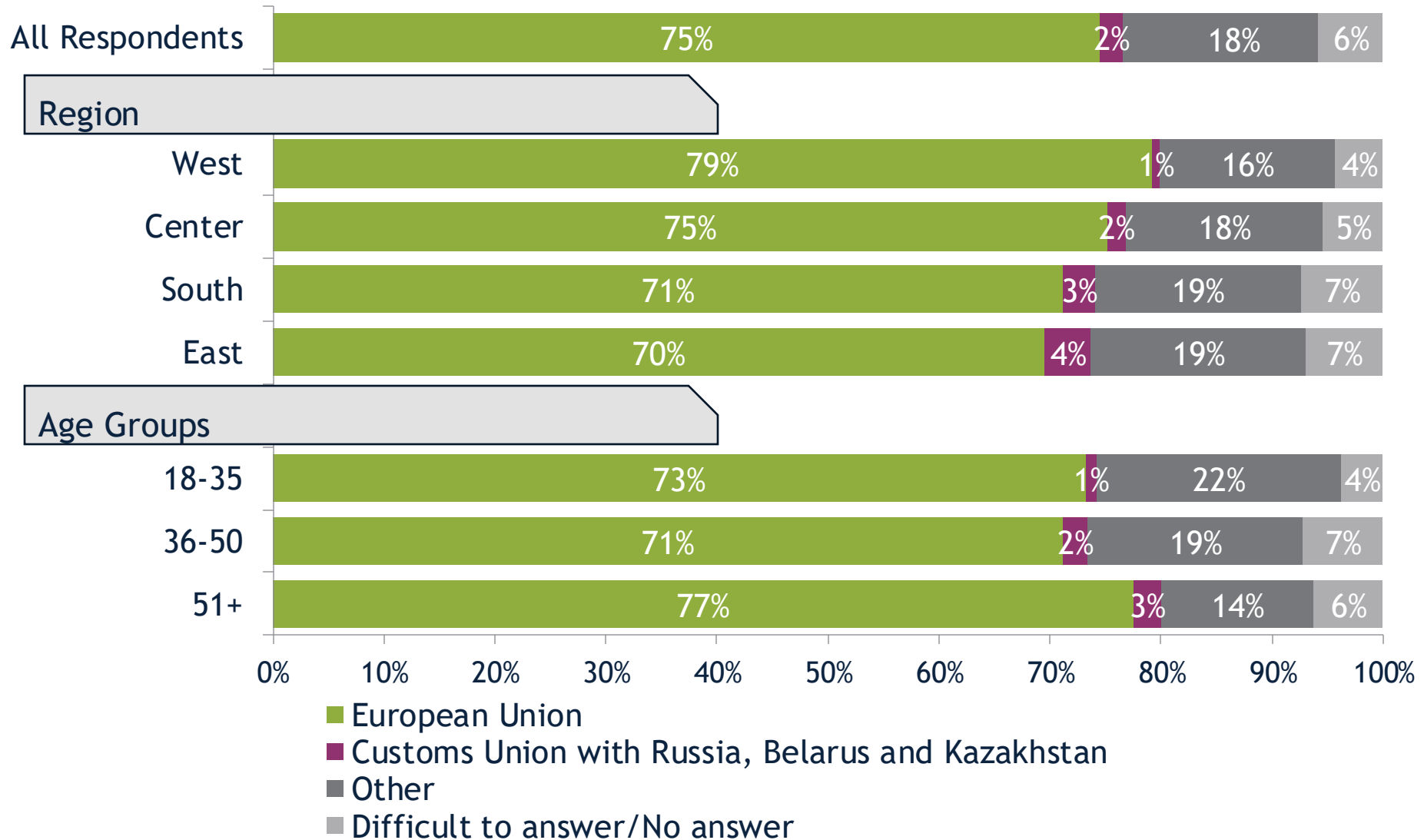

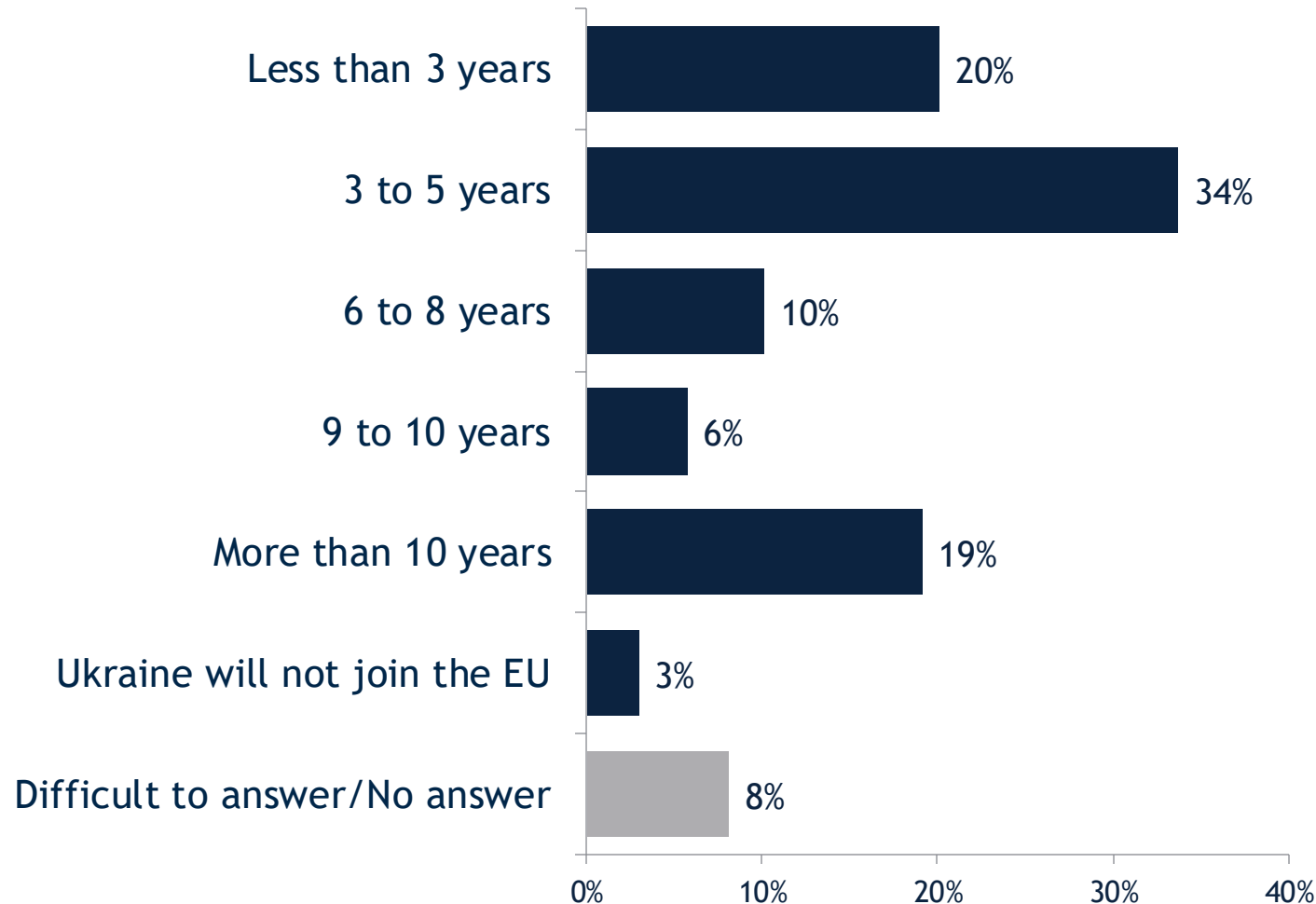
If Ukraine was able to enter only one international economic union, which one of the following should it be?

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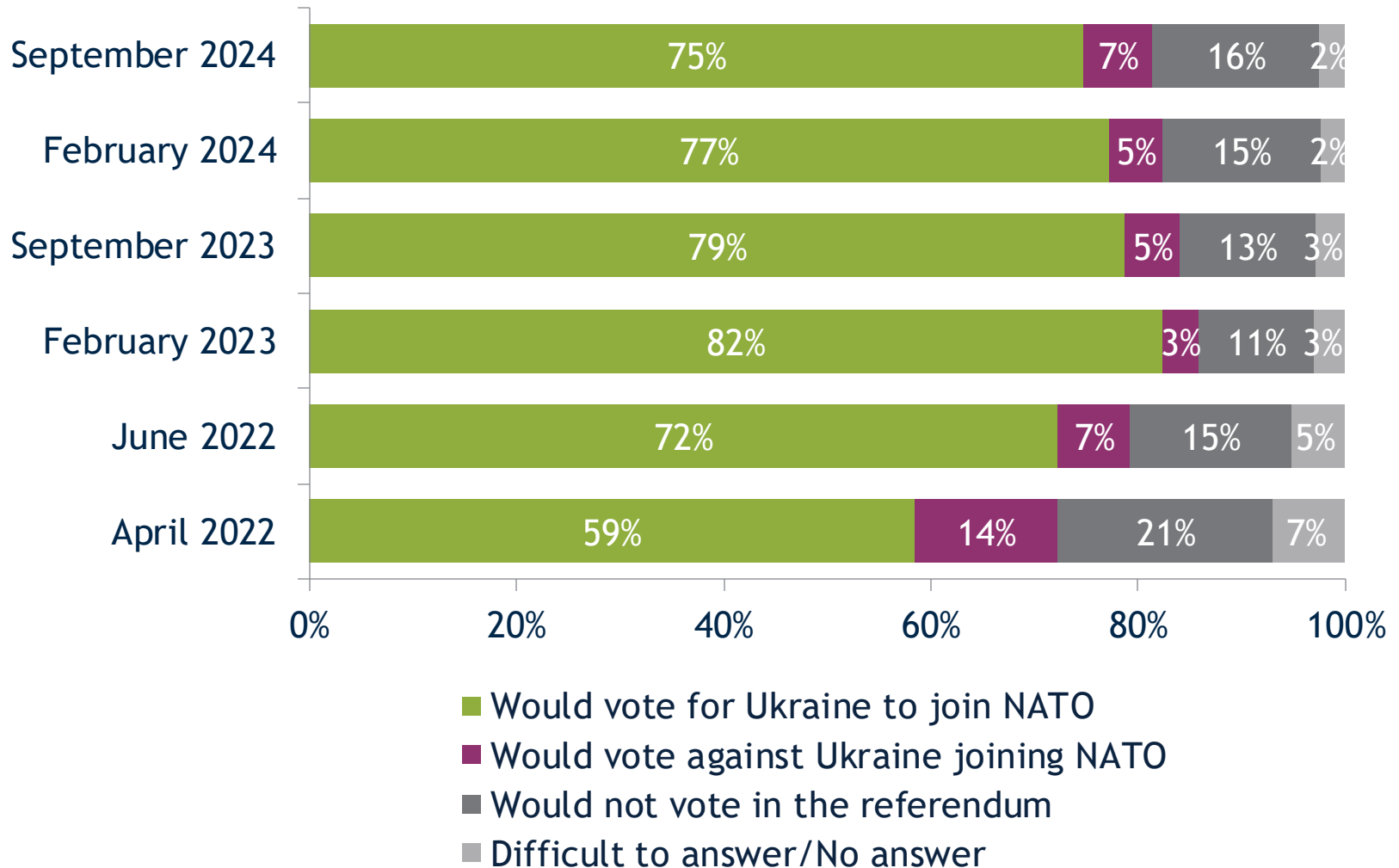

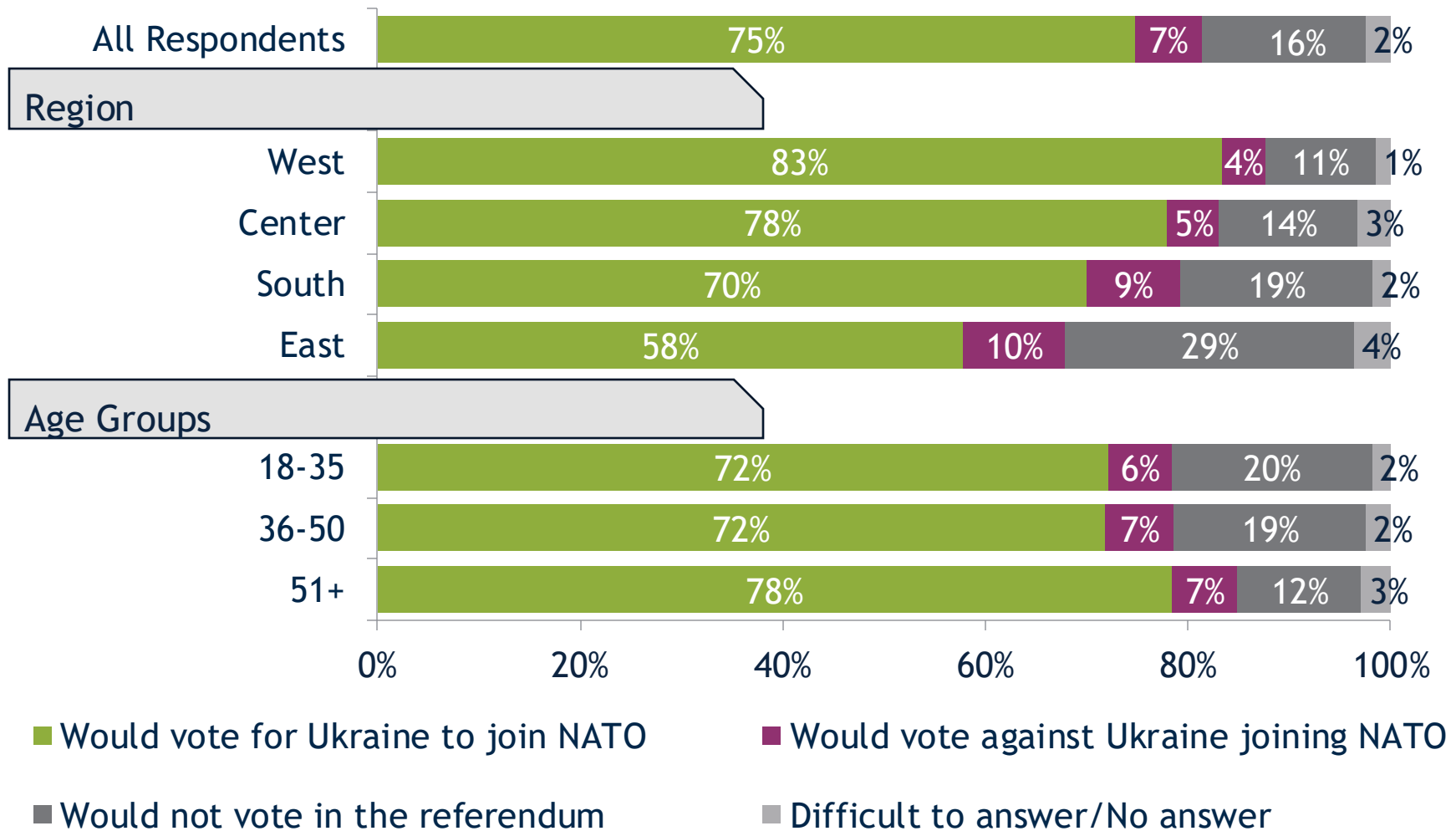

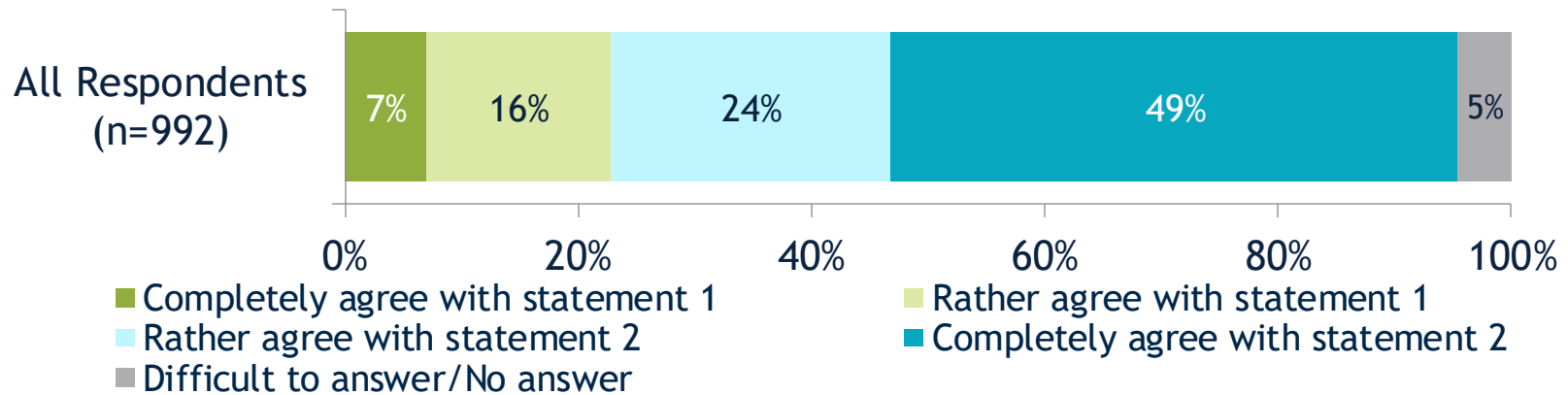
If a referendum was held today on Ukraine joining NATO, how would you vote?



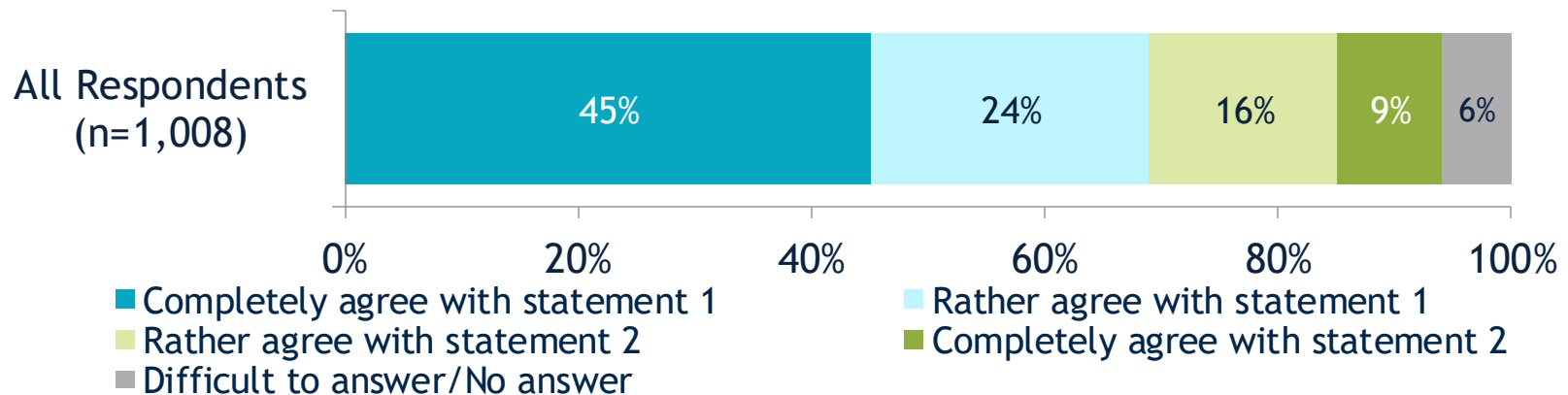

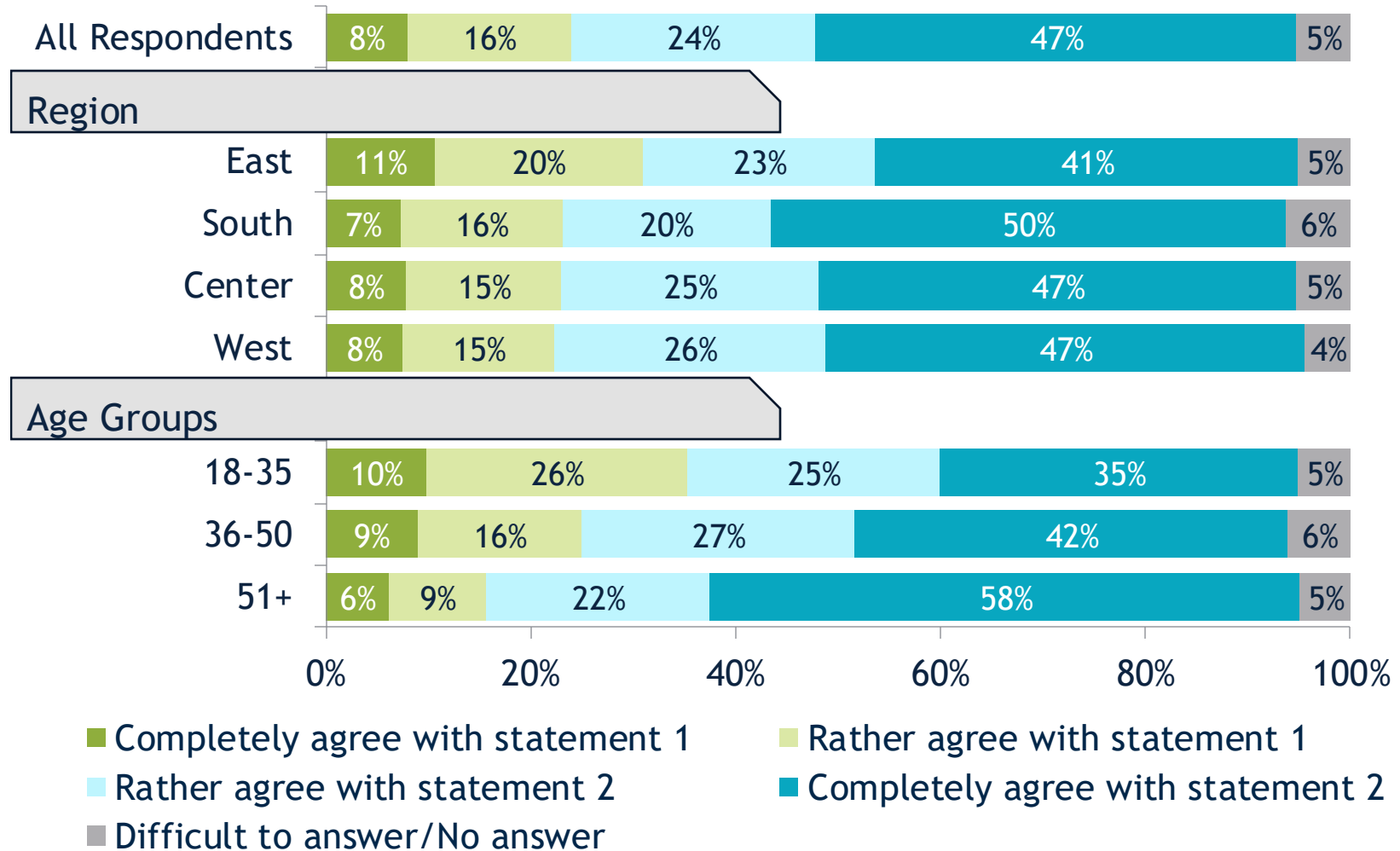

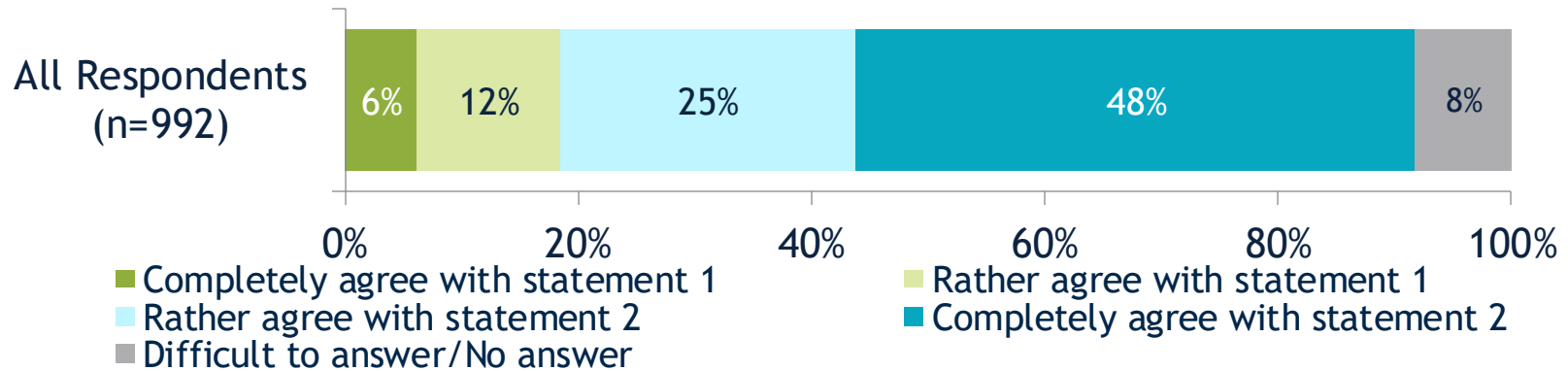

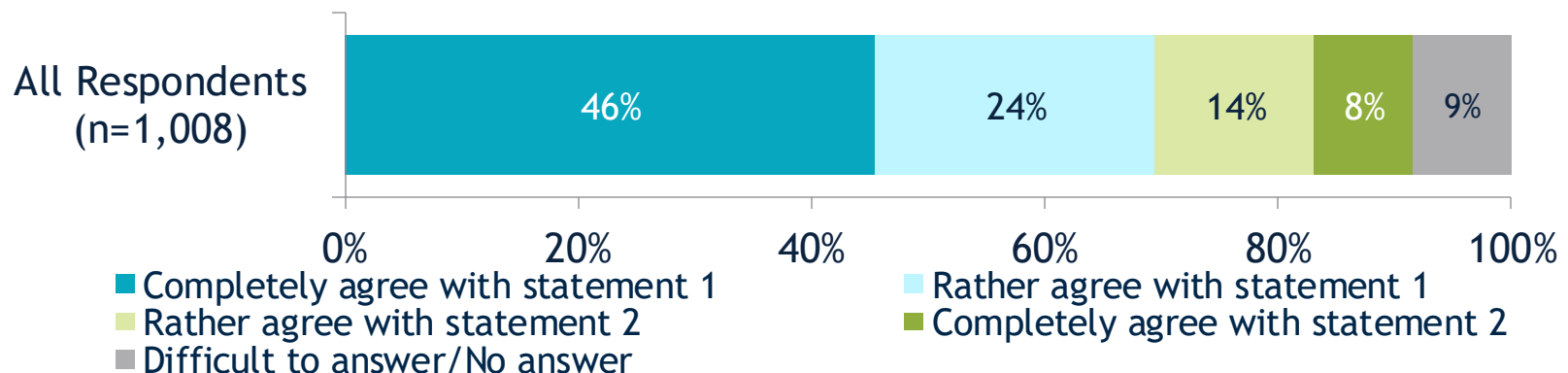

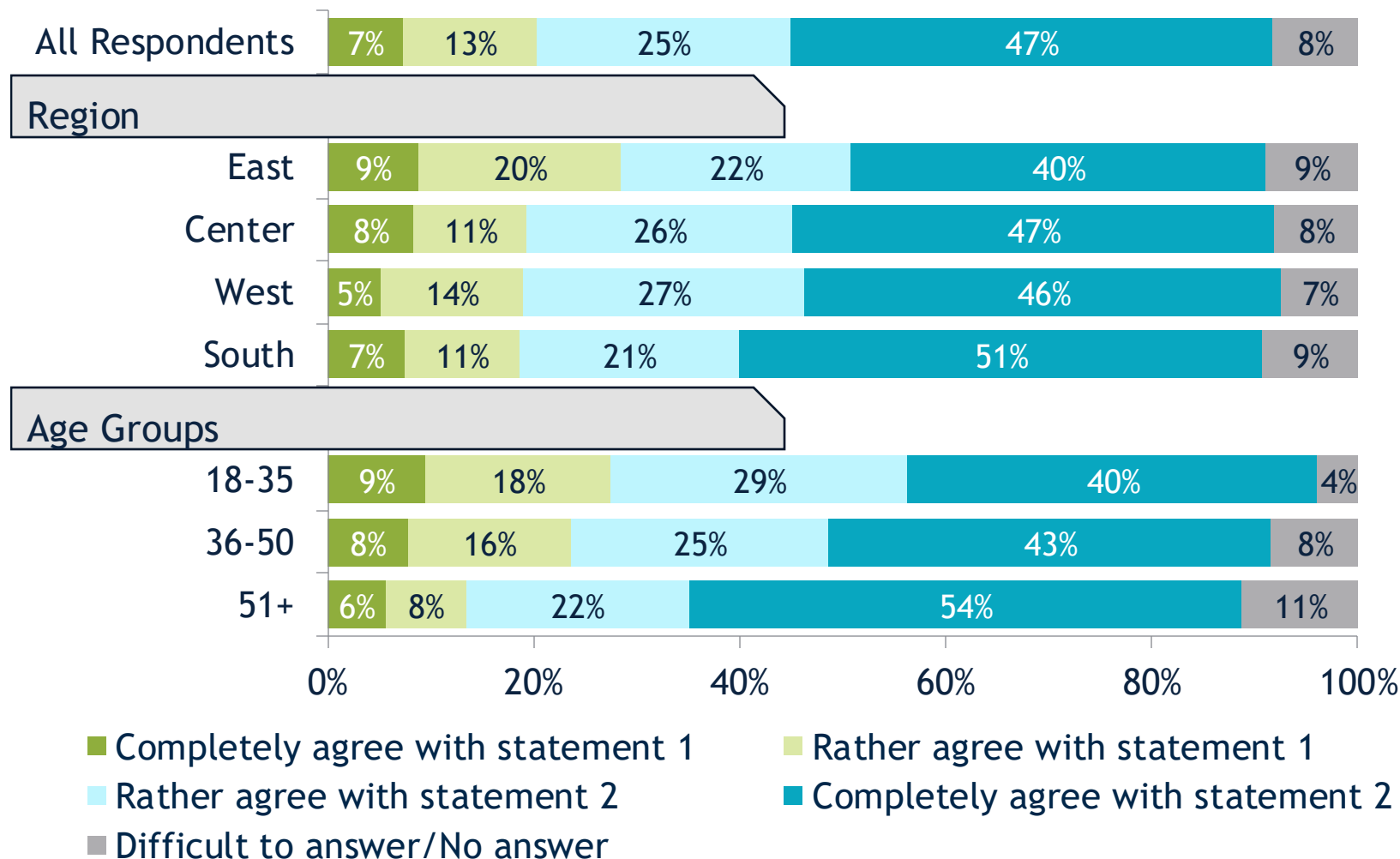

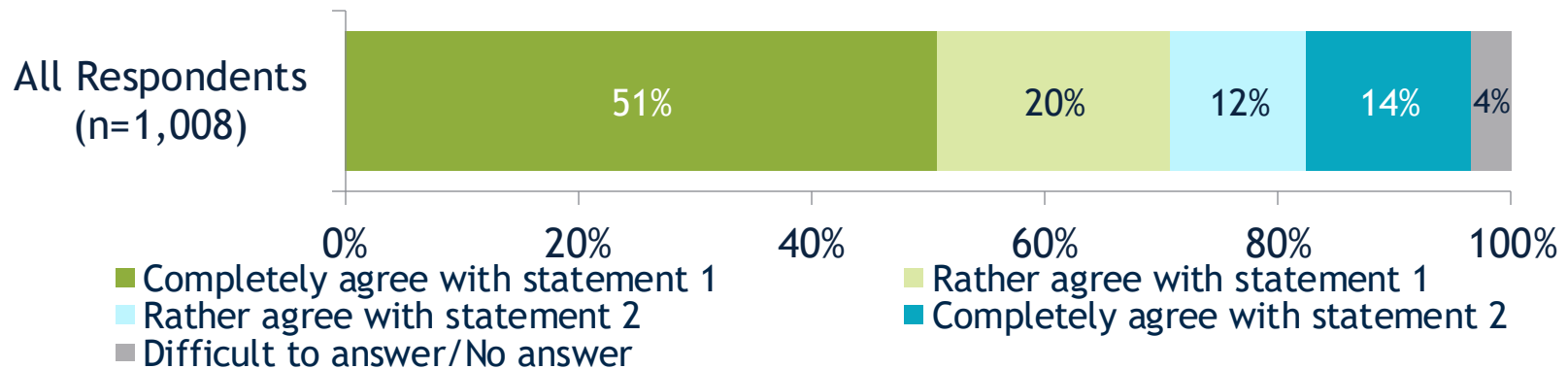

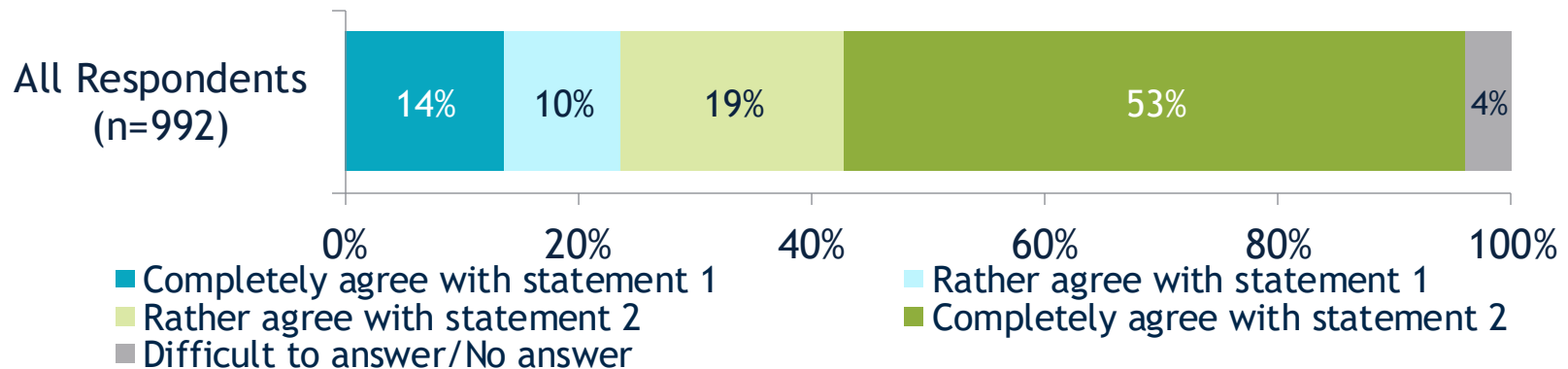

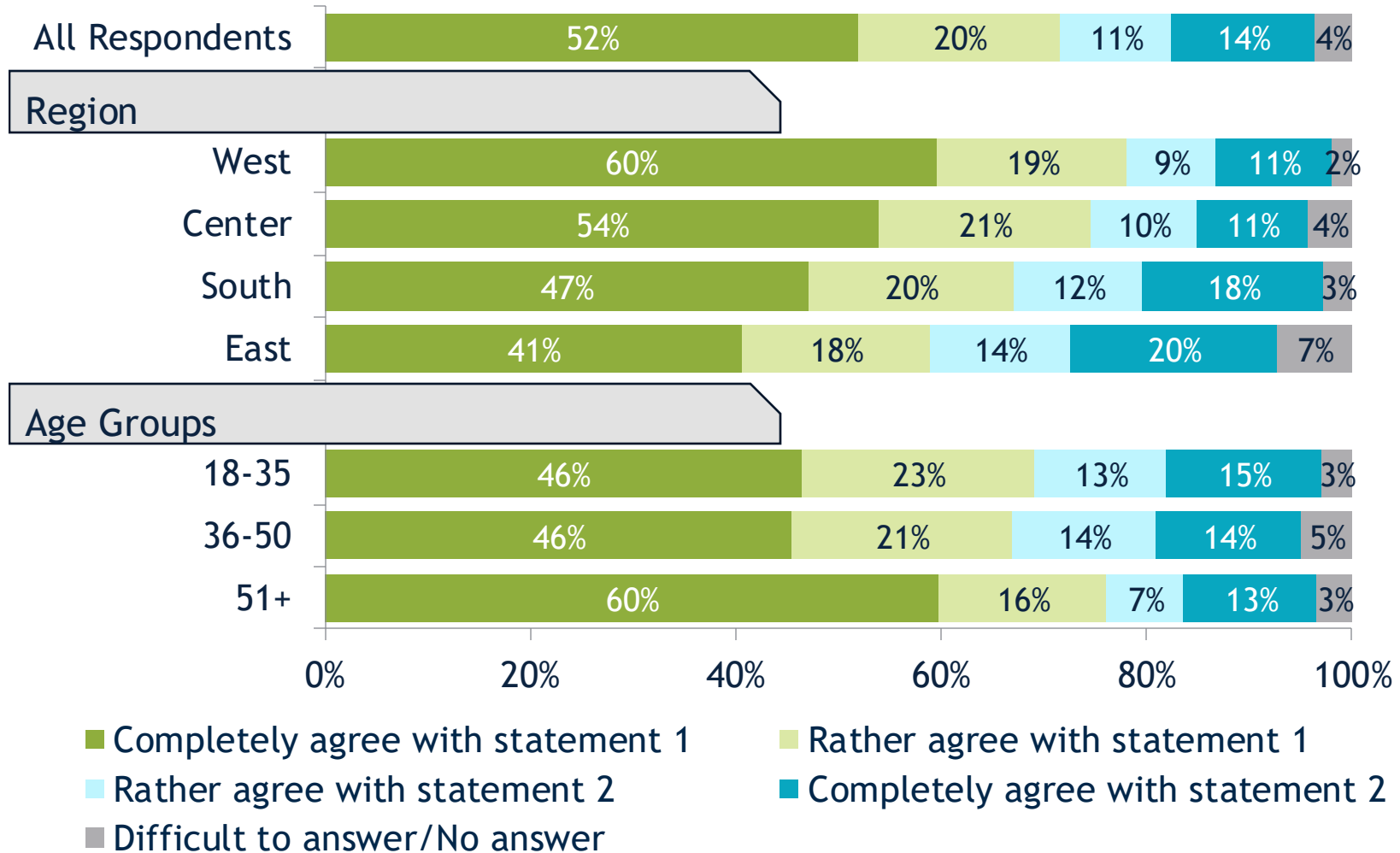

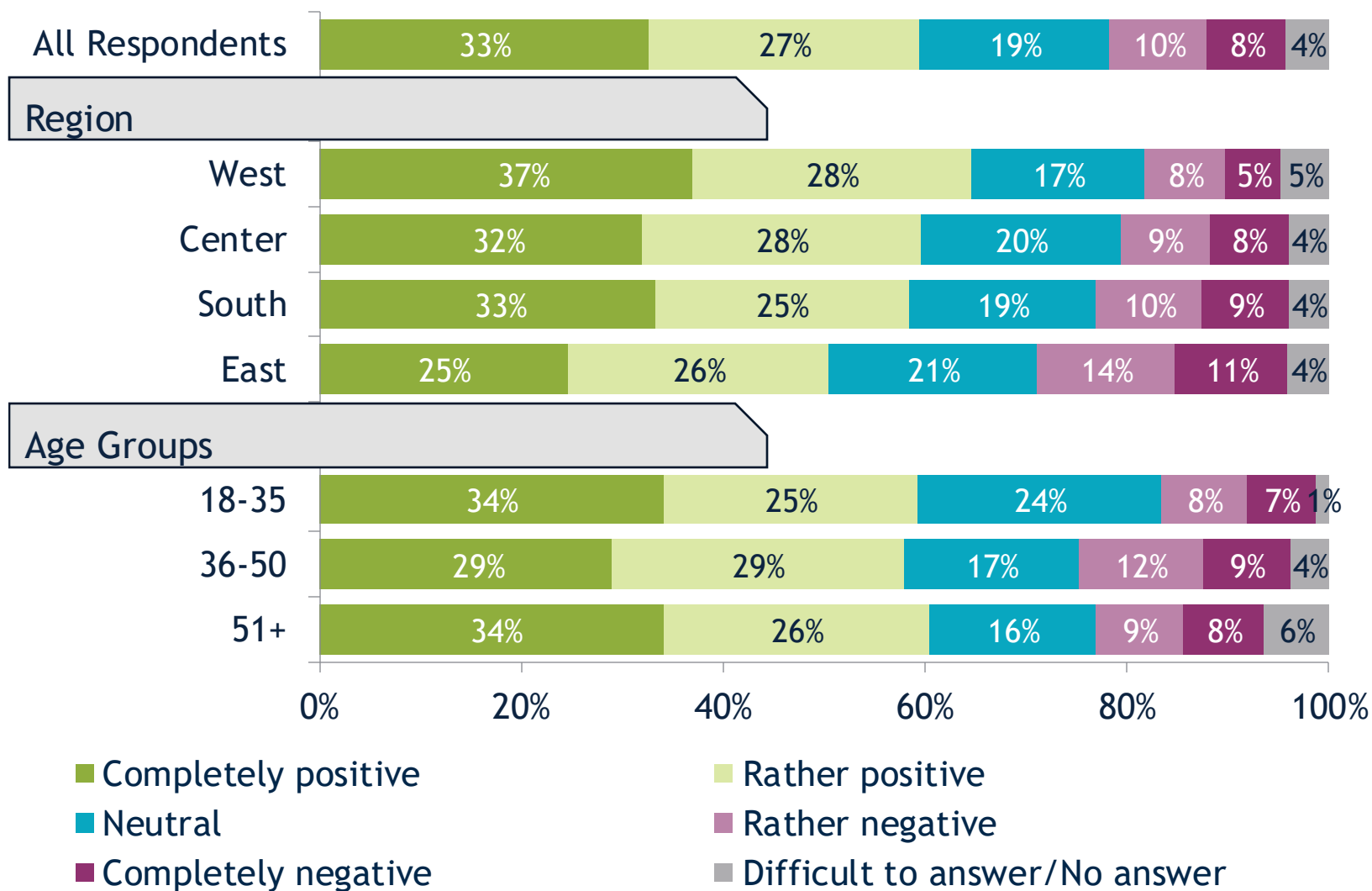

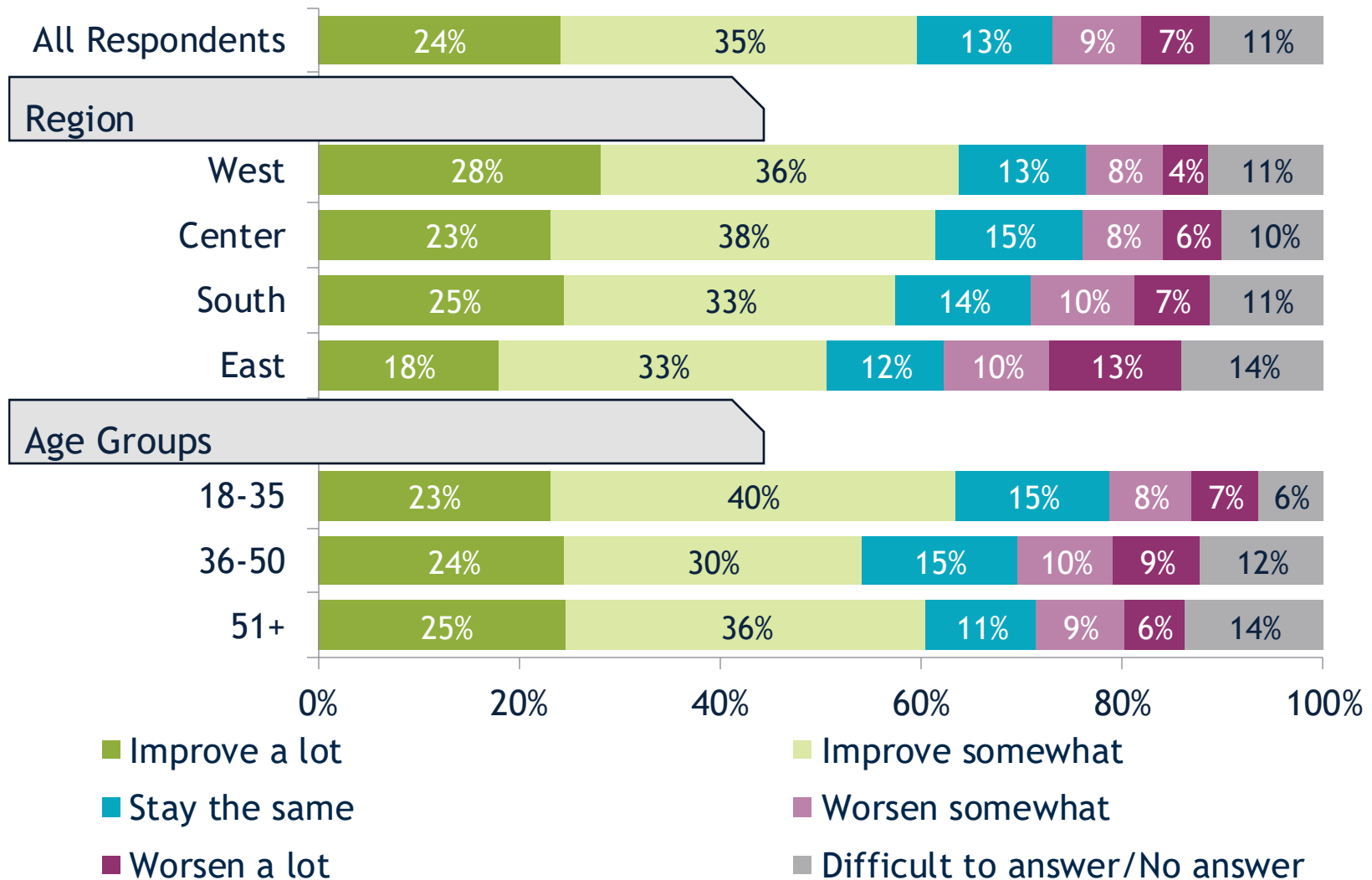

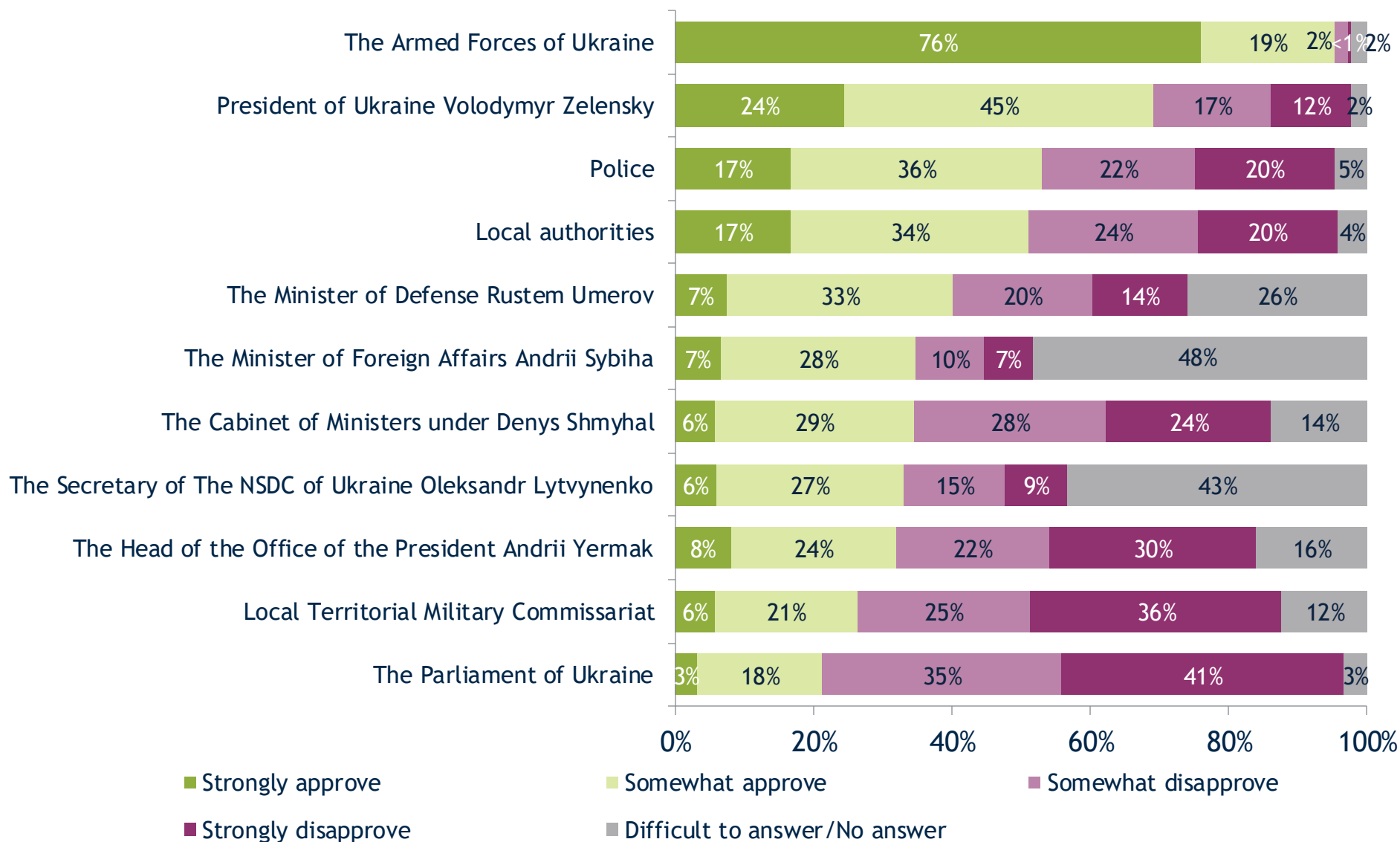

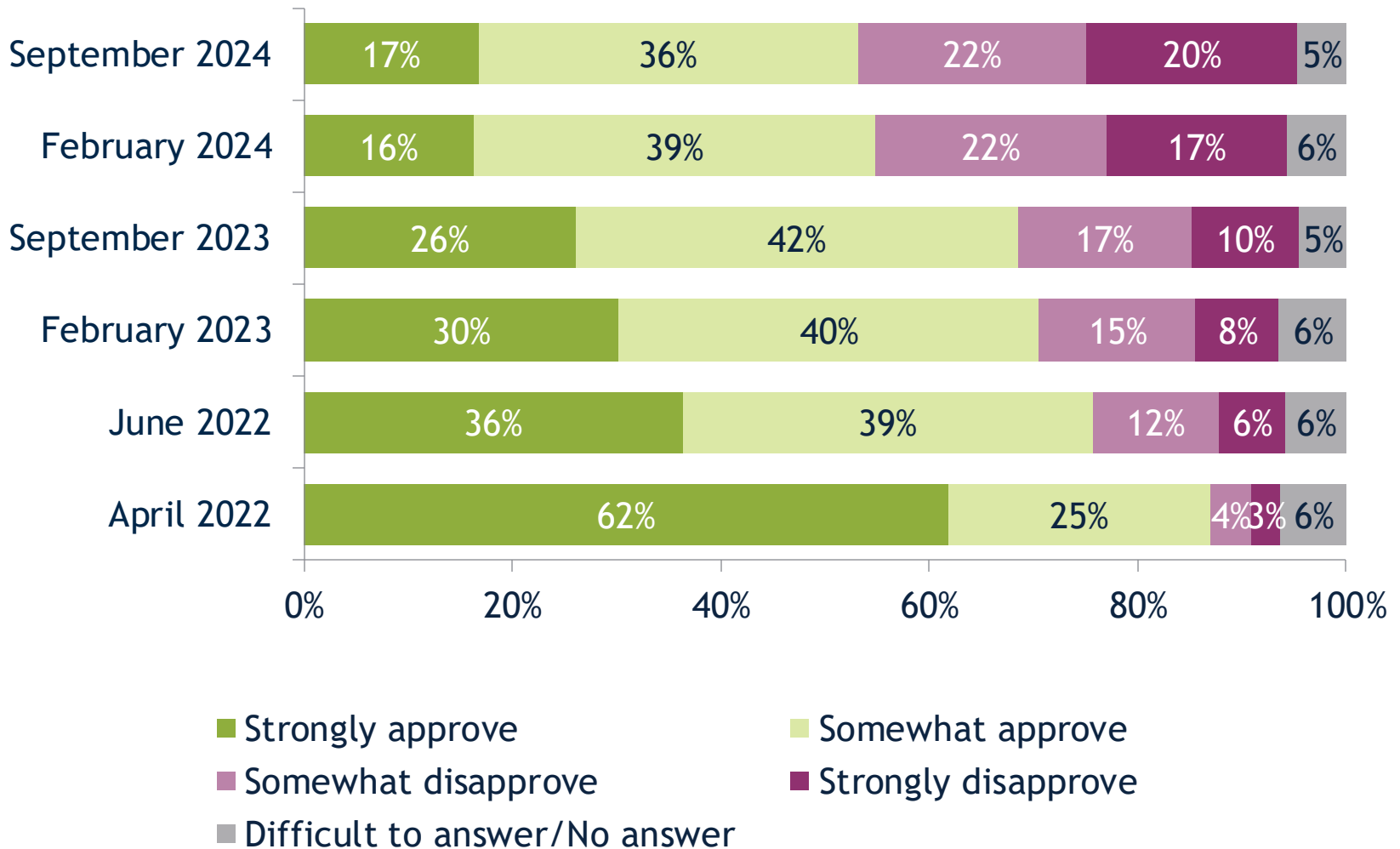

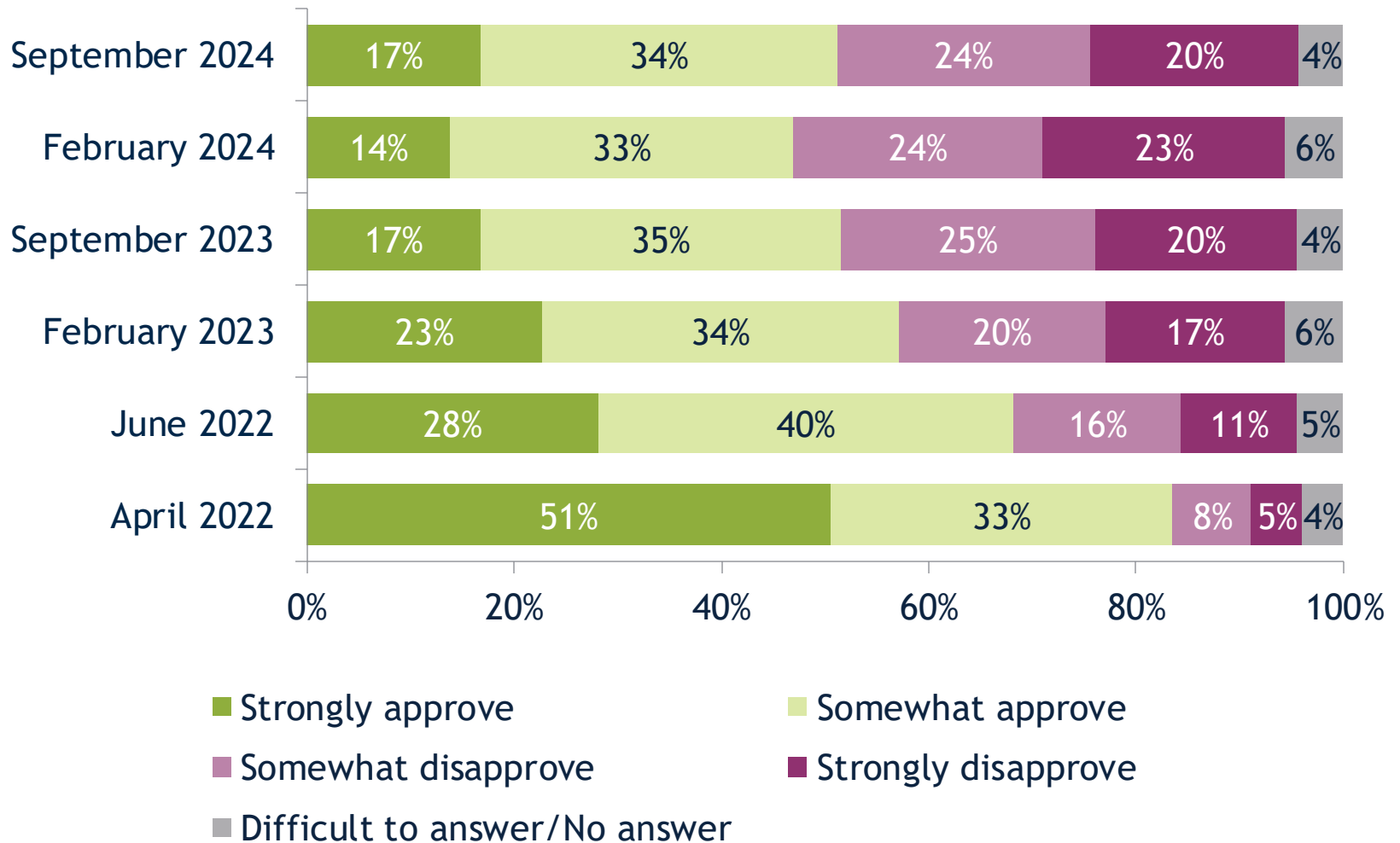
Do you approve or disapprove of the activities of President of Ukraine Volodymyr Zelensky?



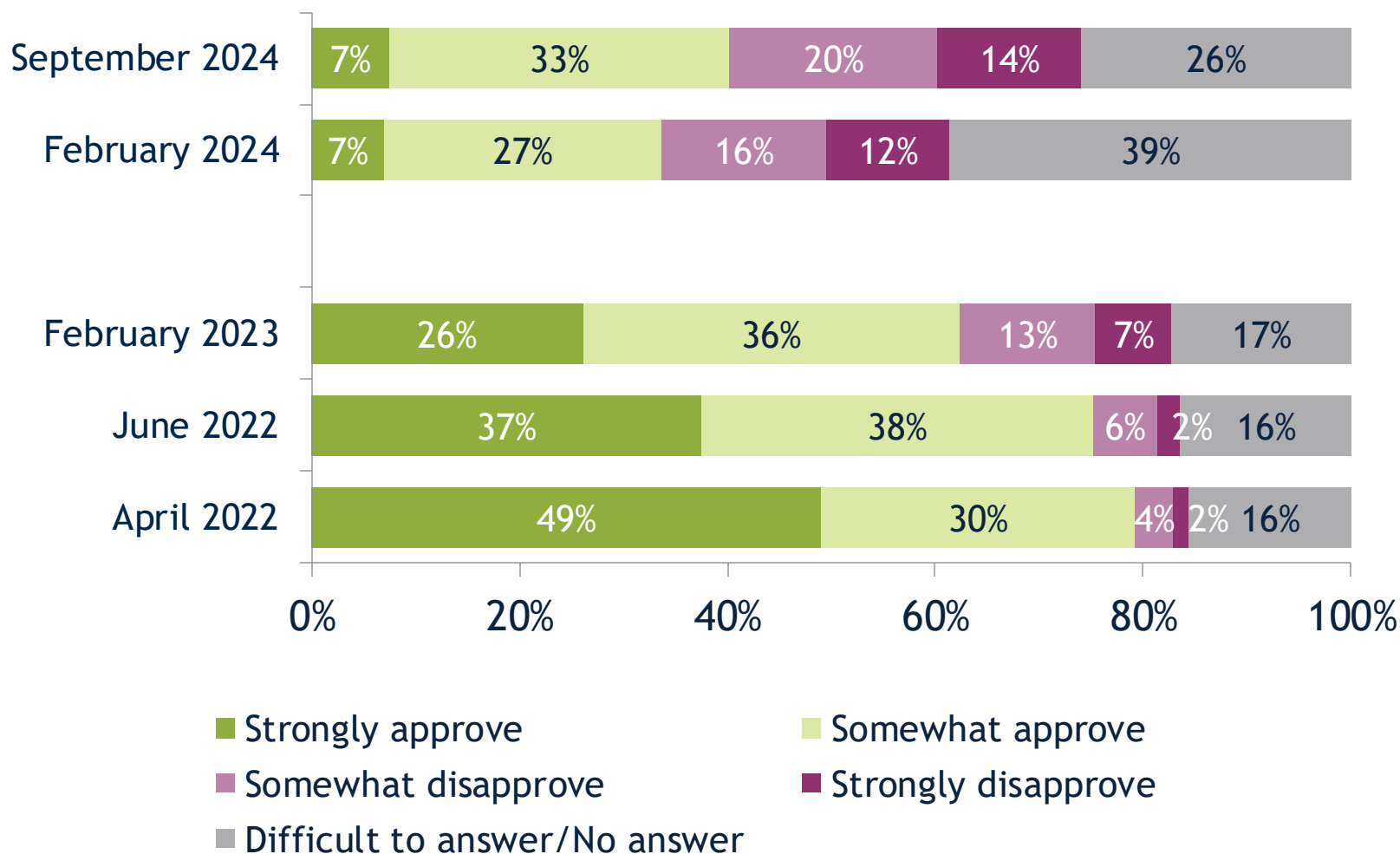
Do you approve or disapprove of the activities of the police?

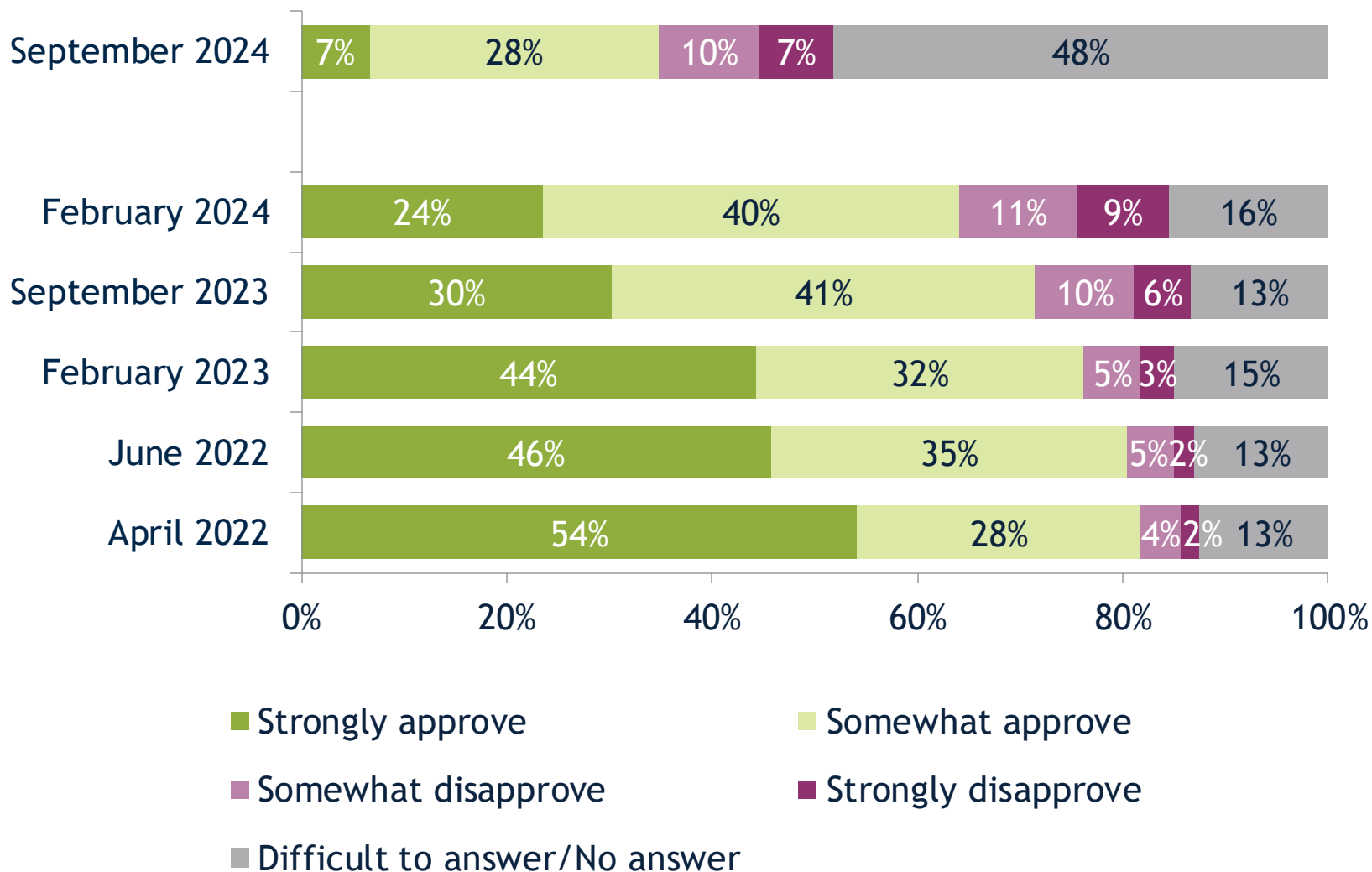


Do you approve or disapprove of the activities of the Minister of Defense Rustem Umerov*?



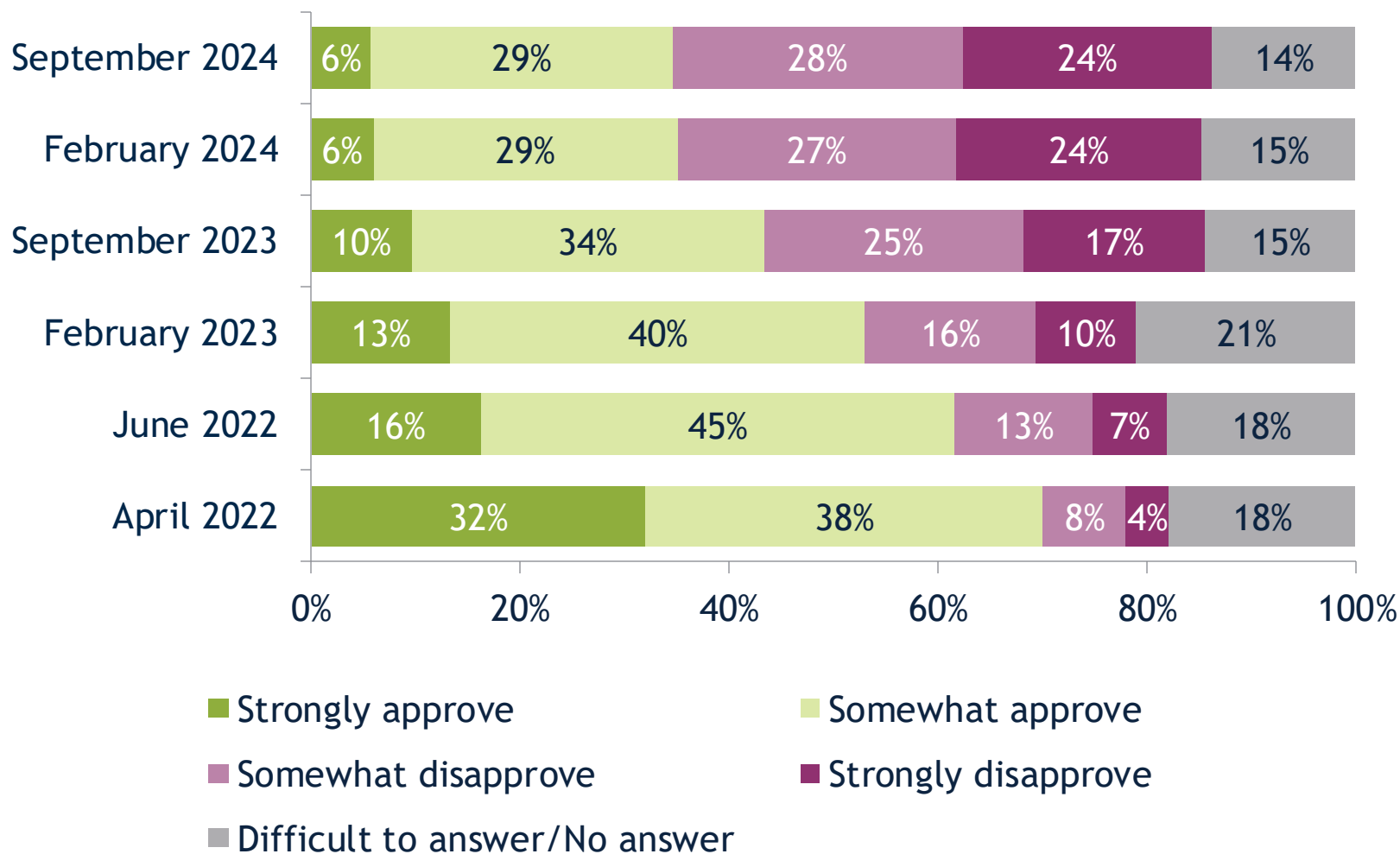

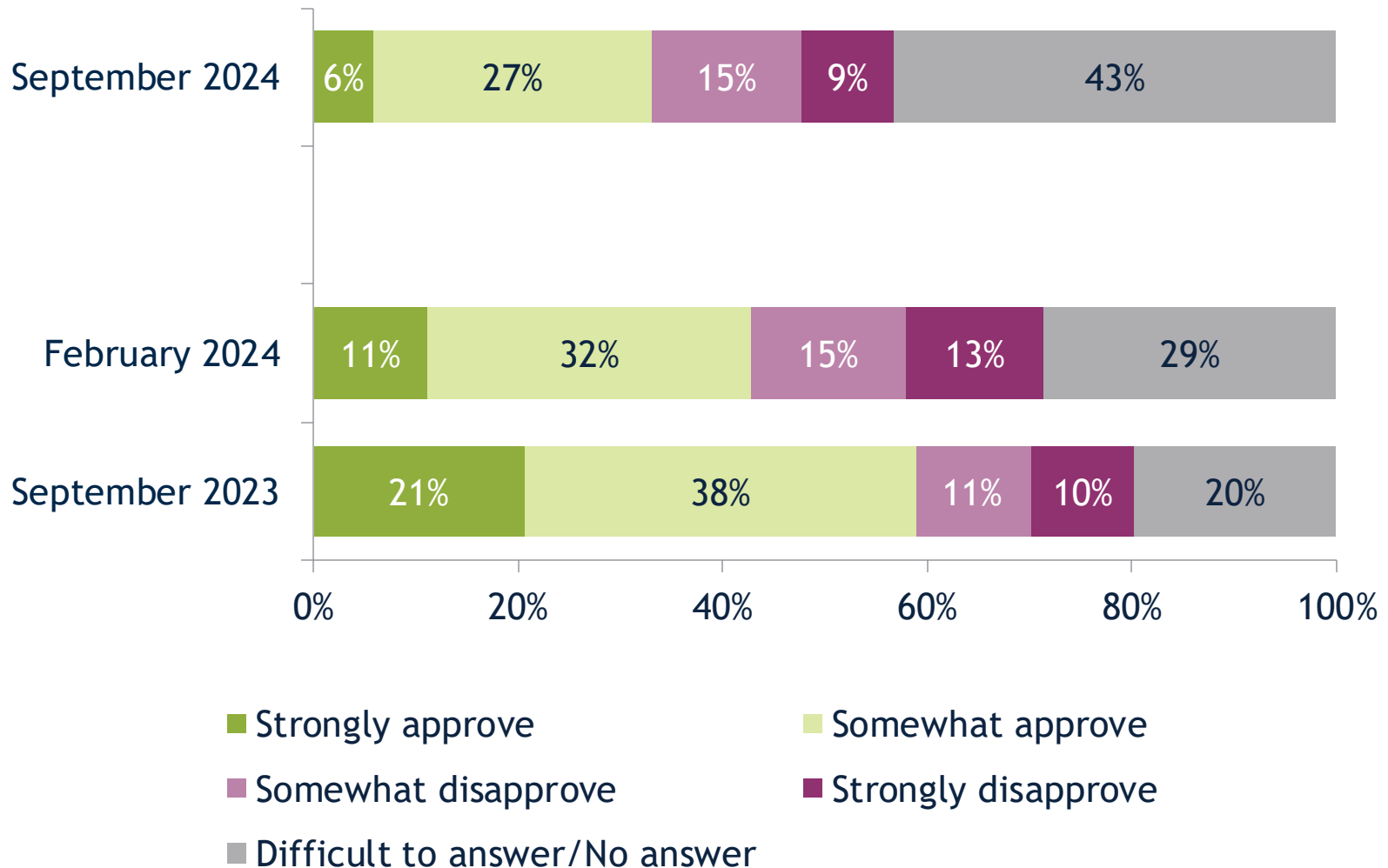

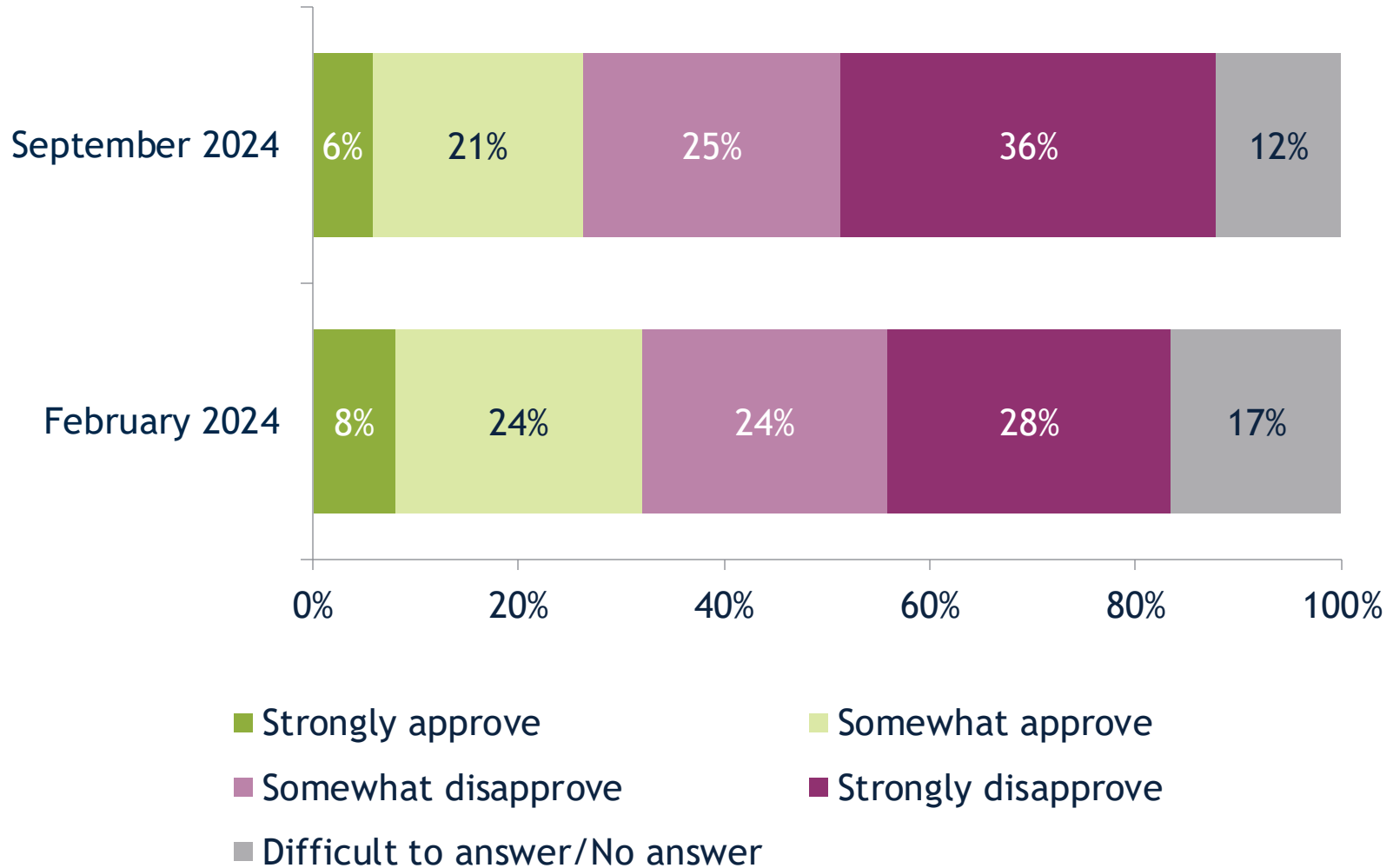
Do you approve or disapprove of the activities of the Cabinet of Ministers under Denys Shmyhal?



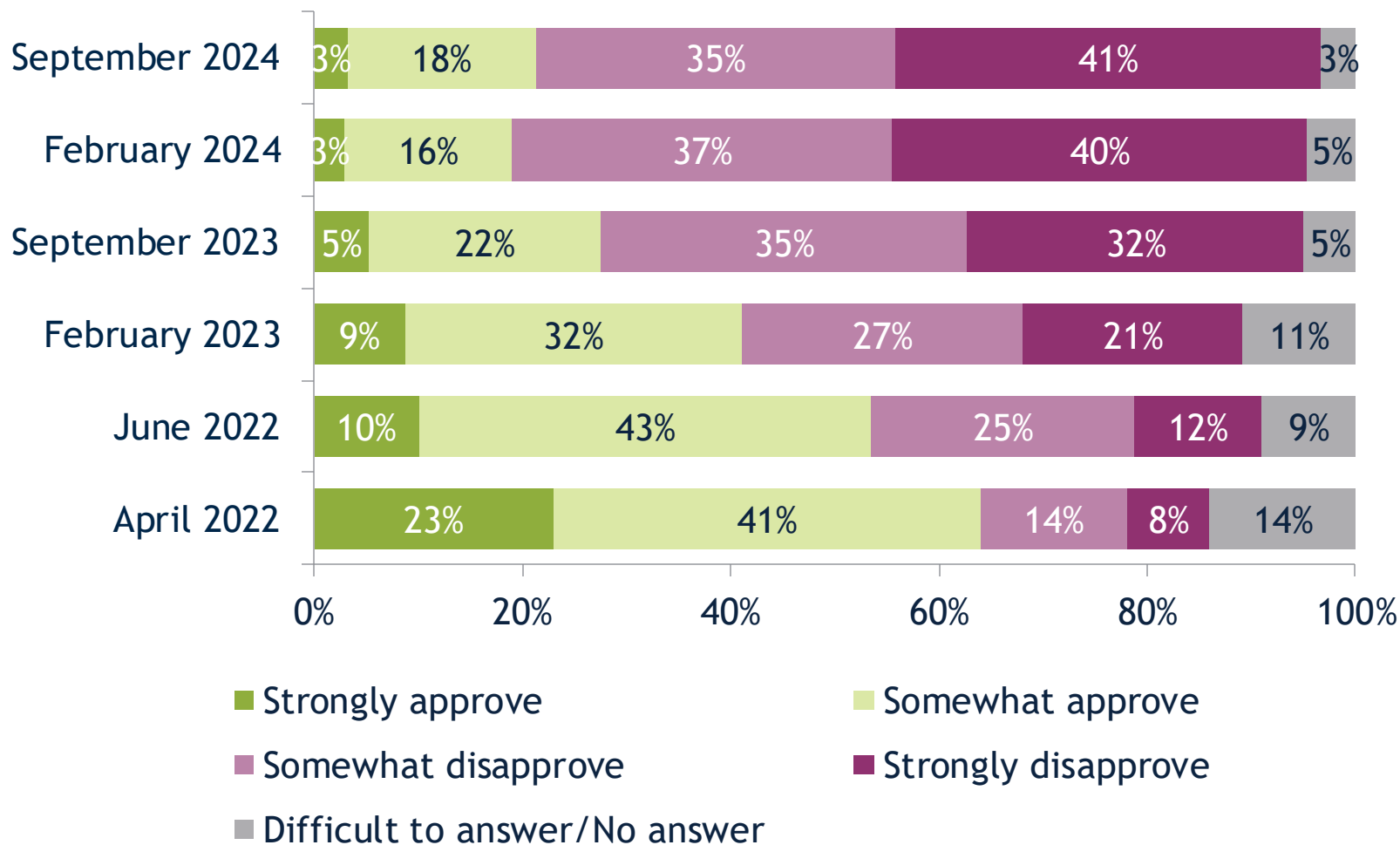

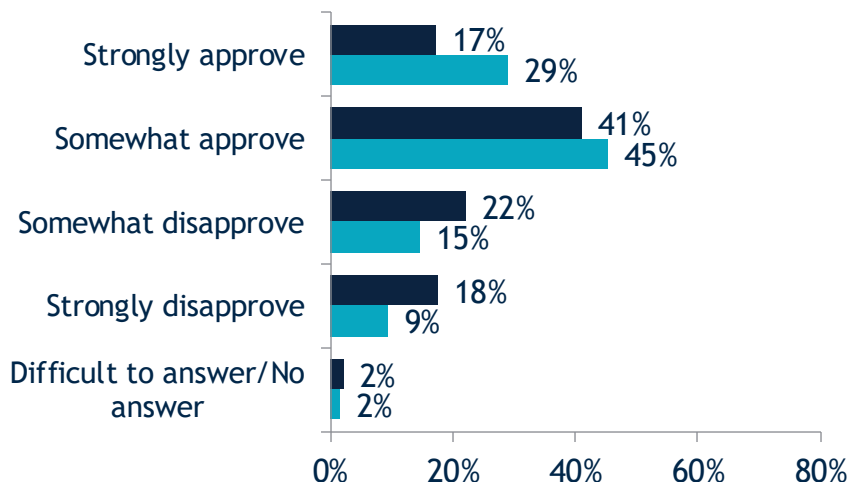

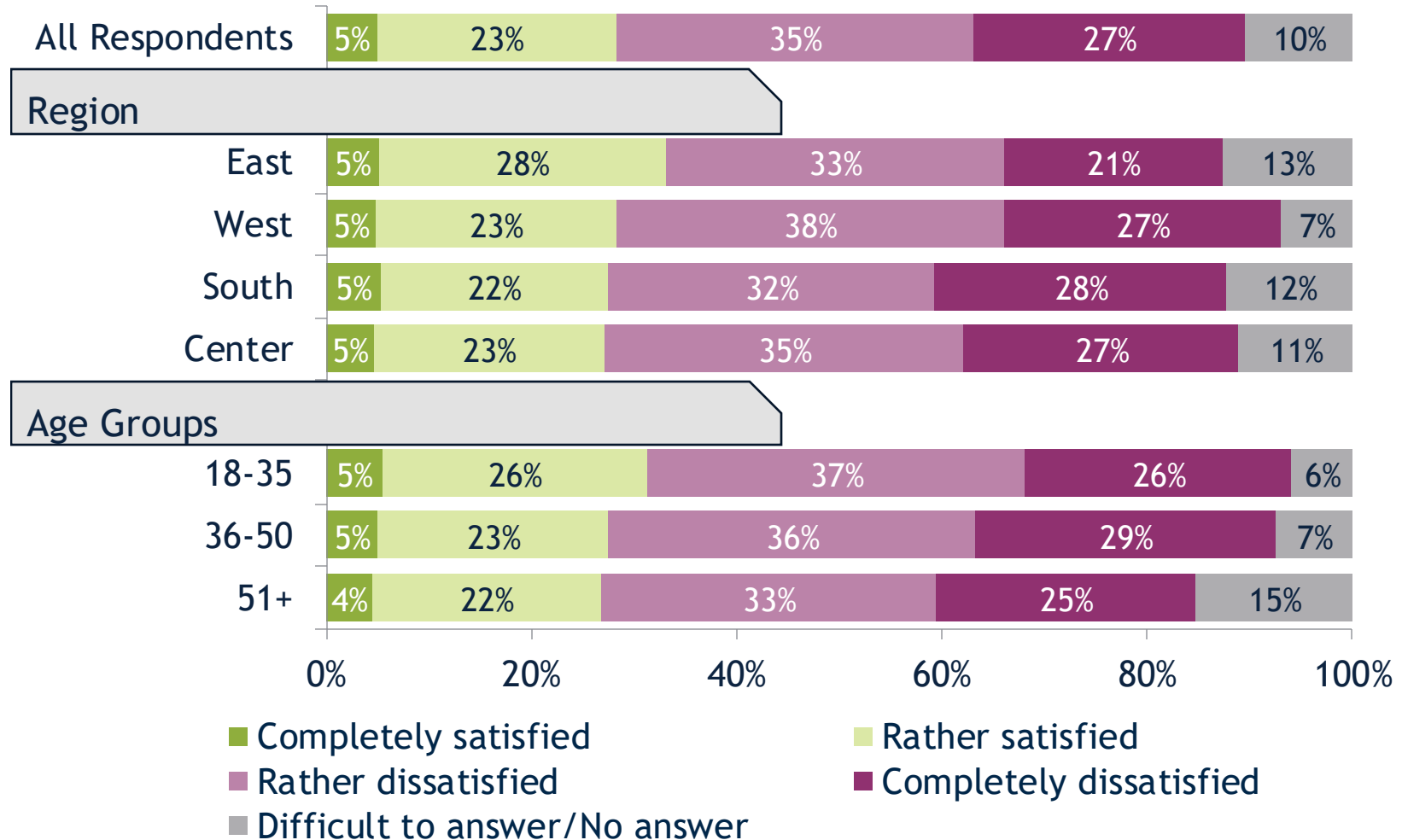

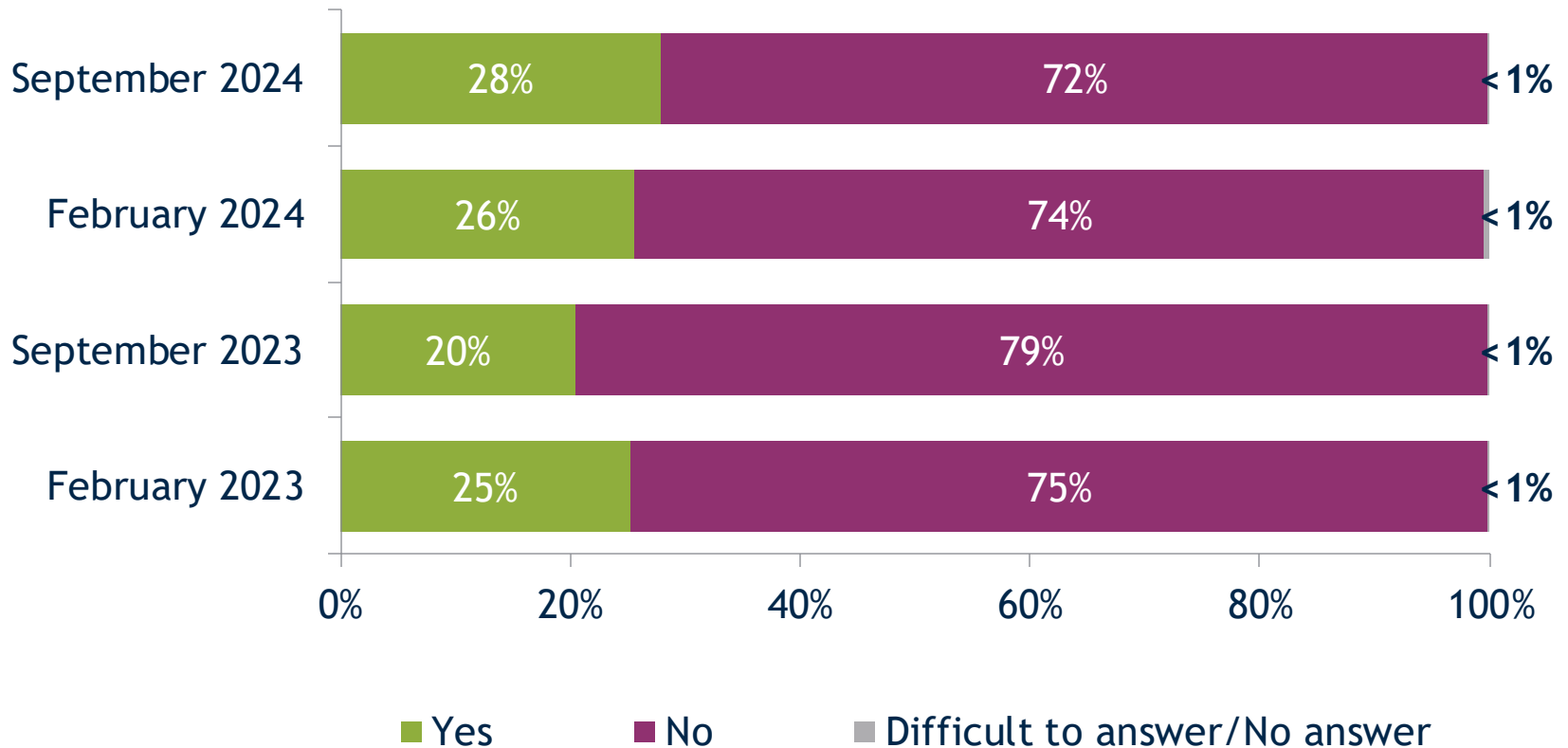

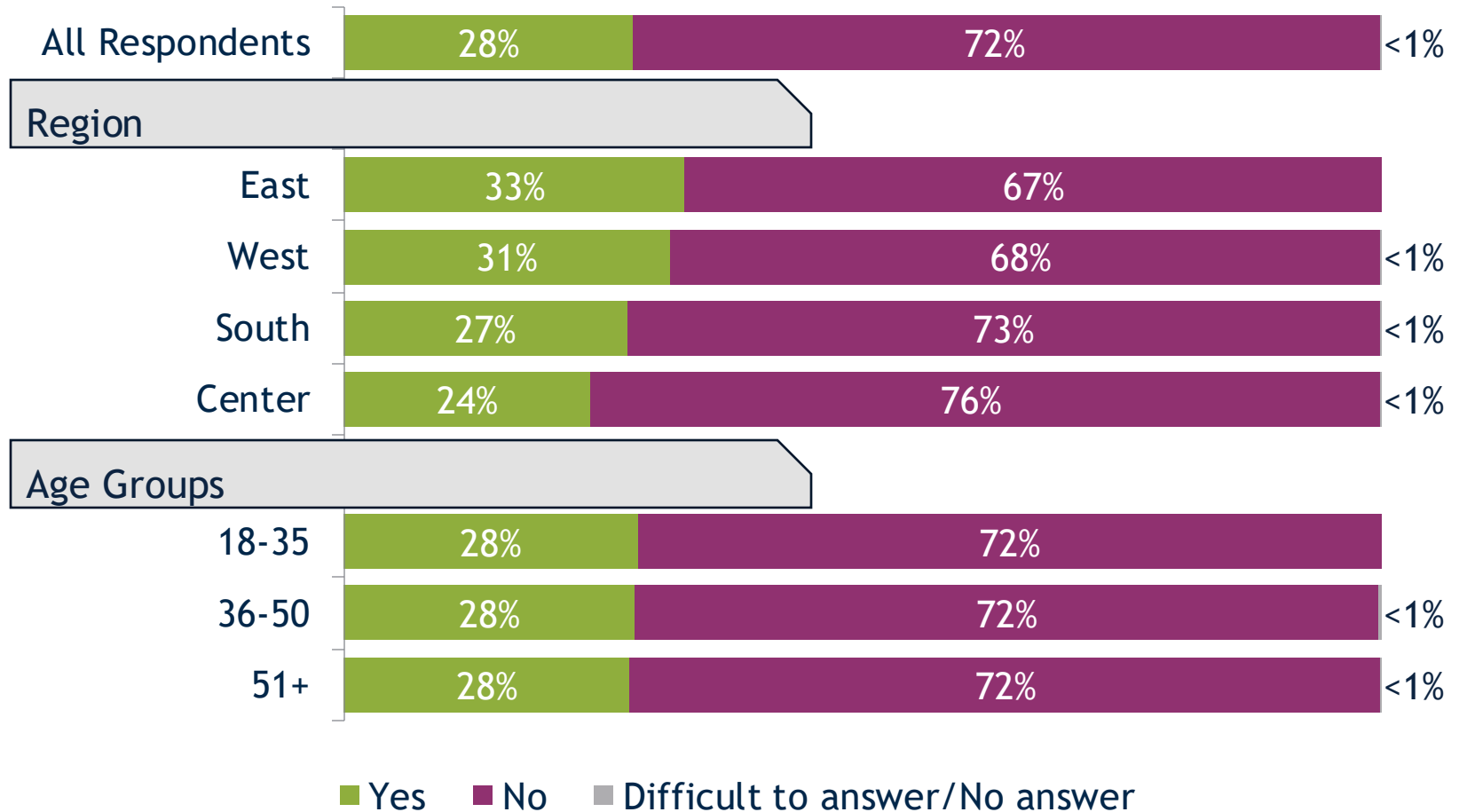

Do you have close relatives, for example husband, wife, parents or children, who are currently abroad due to Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine?

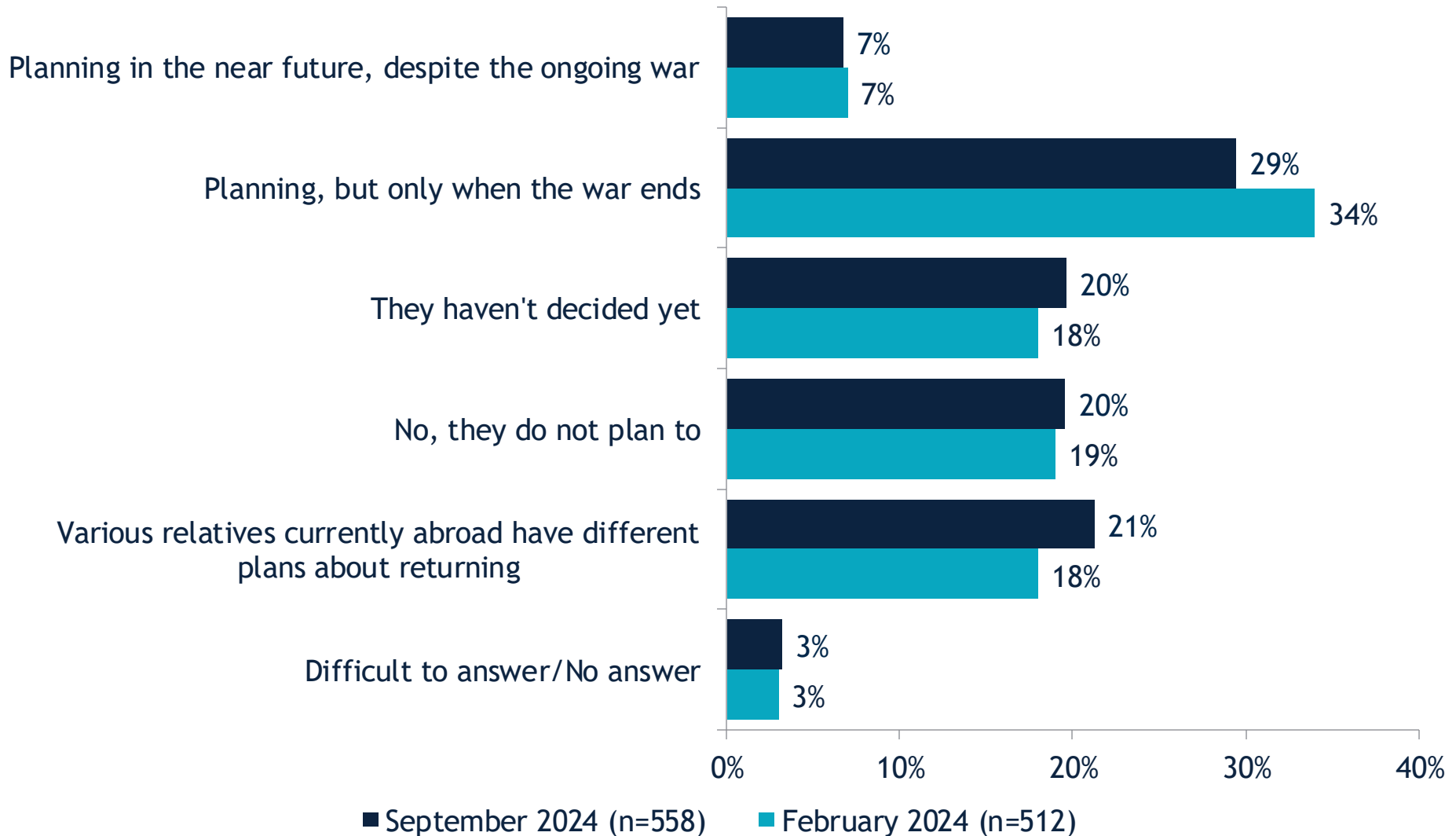


Do you have close relatives, for example husband, wife, parents or children, who are currently abroad due to Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine?



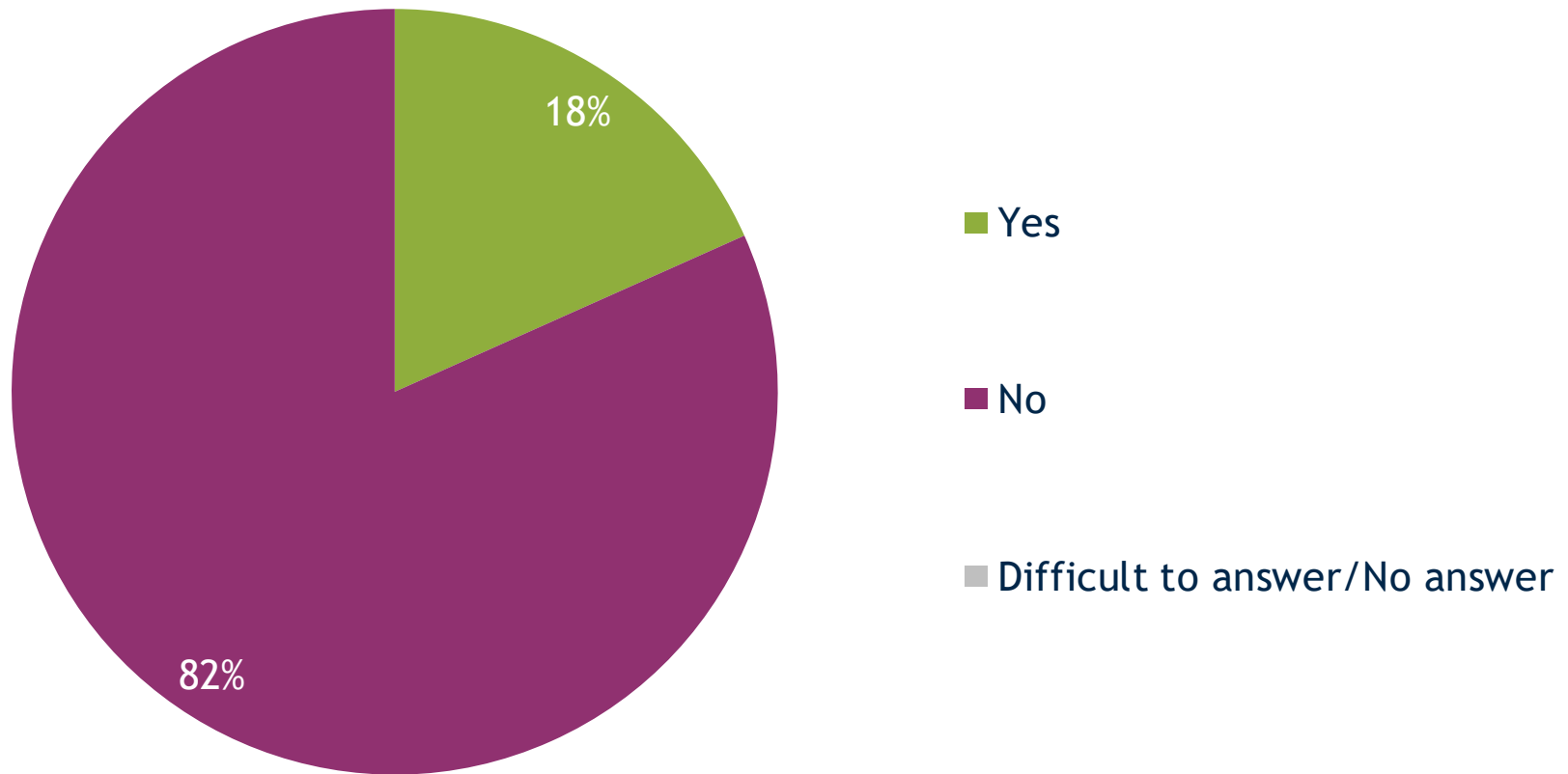

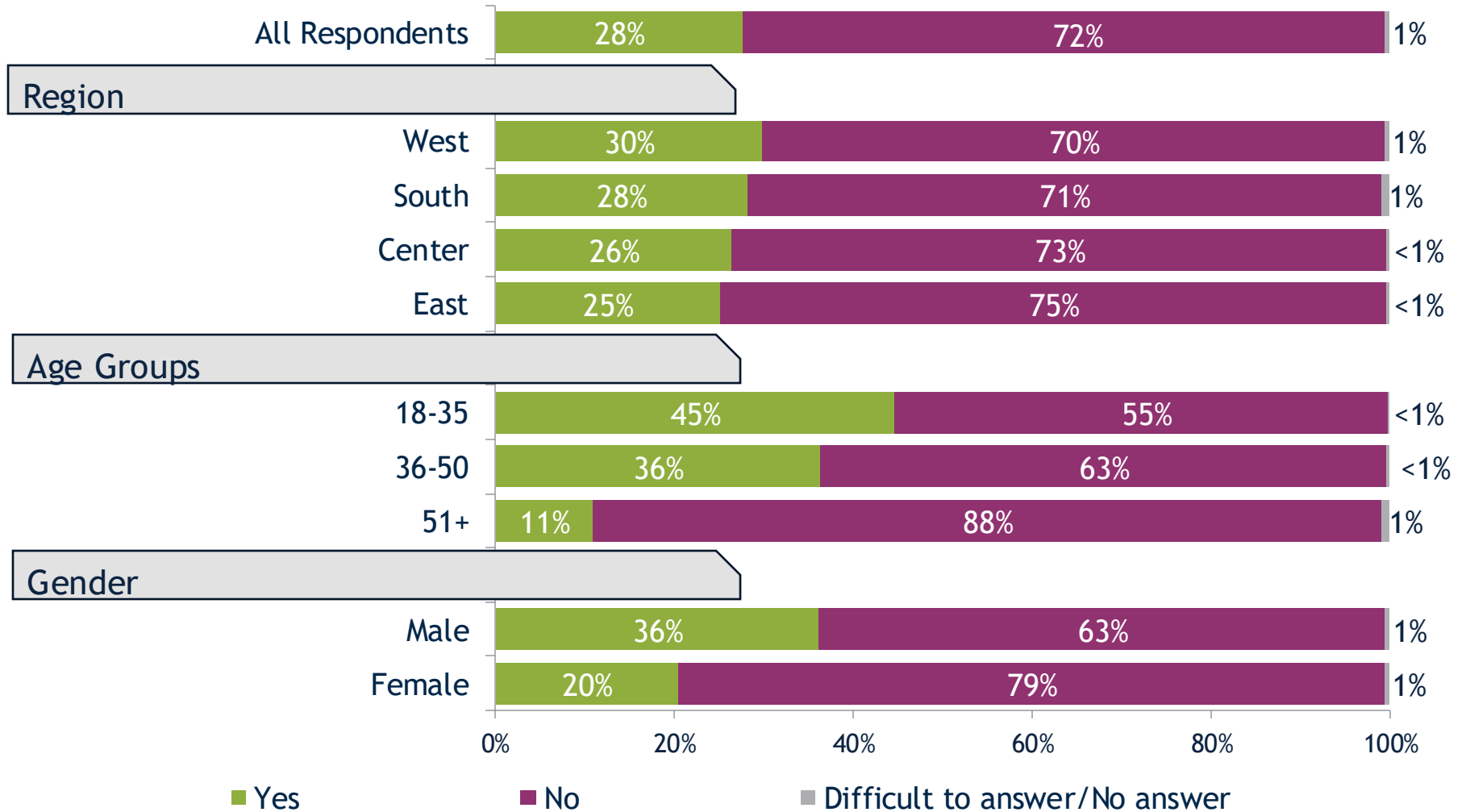


Do you or any family members receive financial assistance from close relatives who are currently abroad due to Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine?

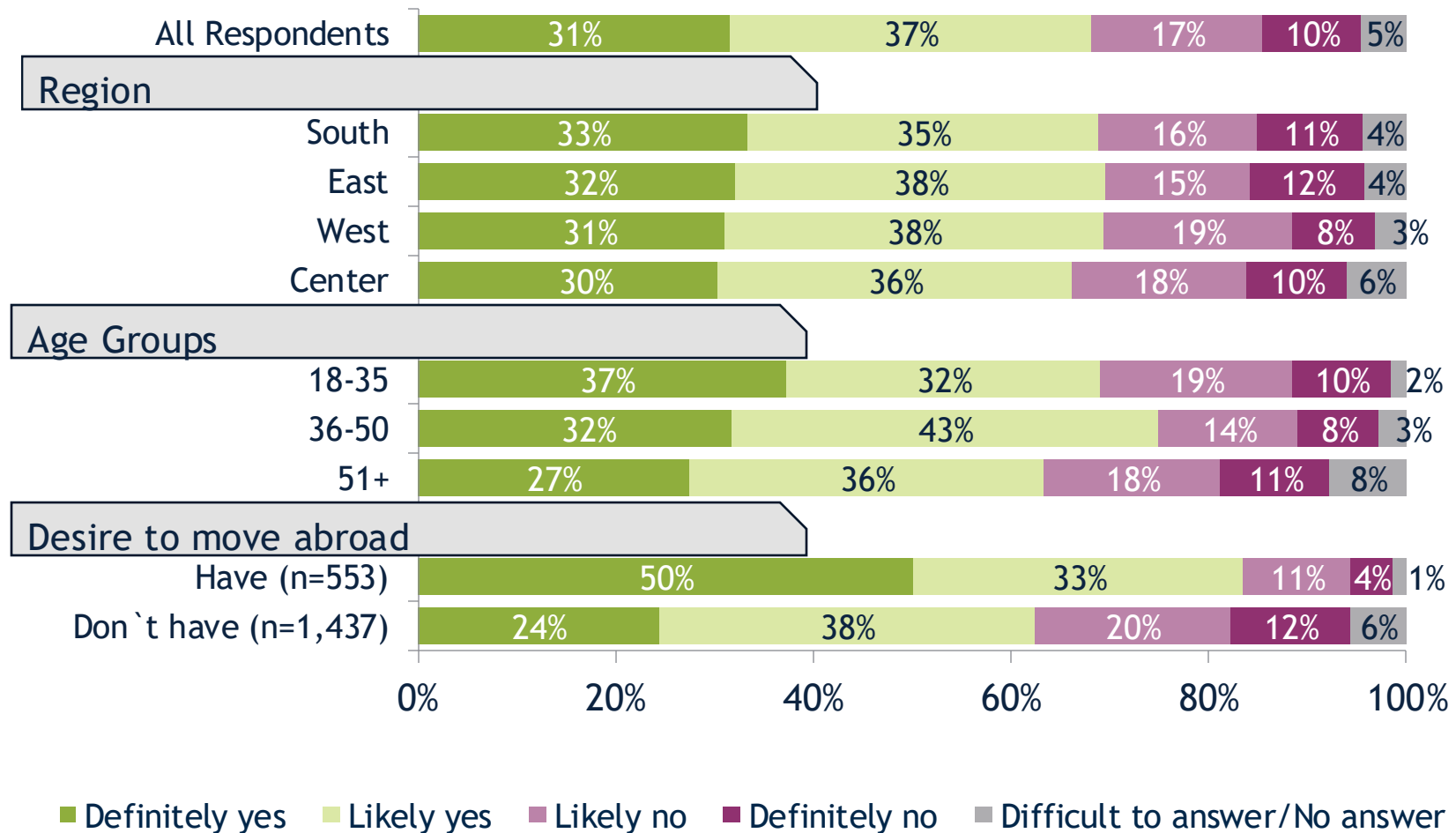

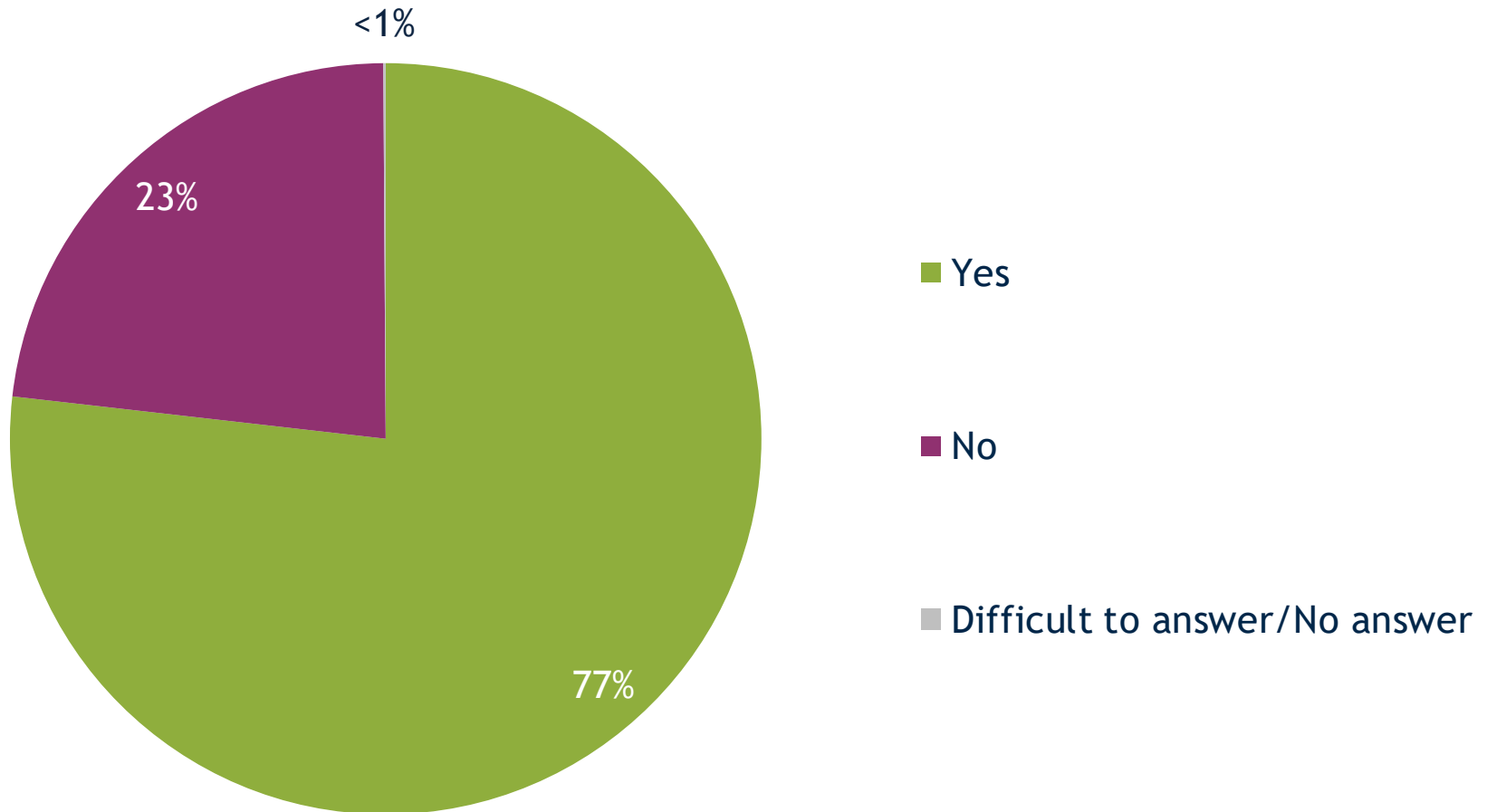
Have you ever had a desire to move abroad?



Do you think that Ukrainians who moved abroad have more opportunities for self-realization than those who stayed in Ukraine?

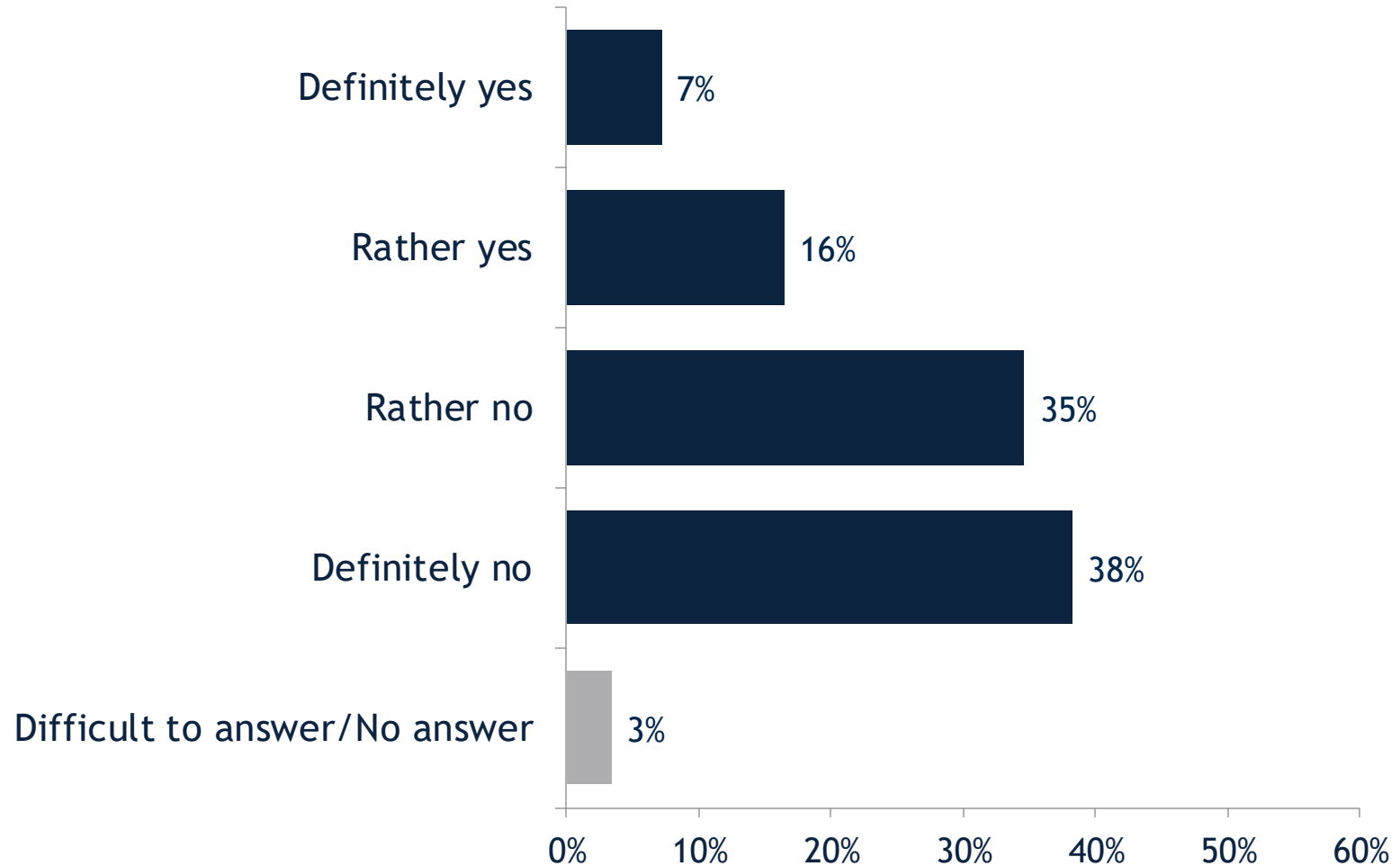

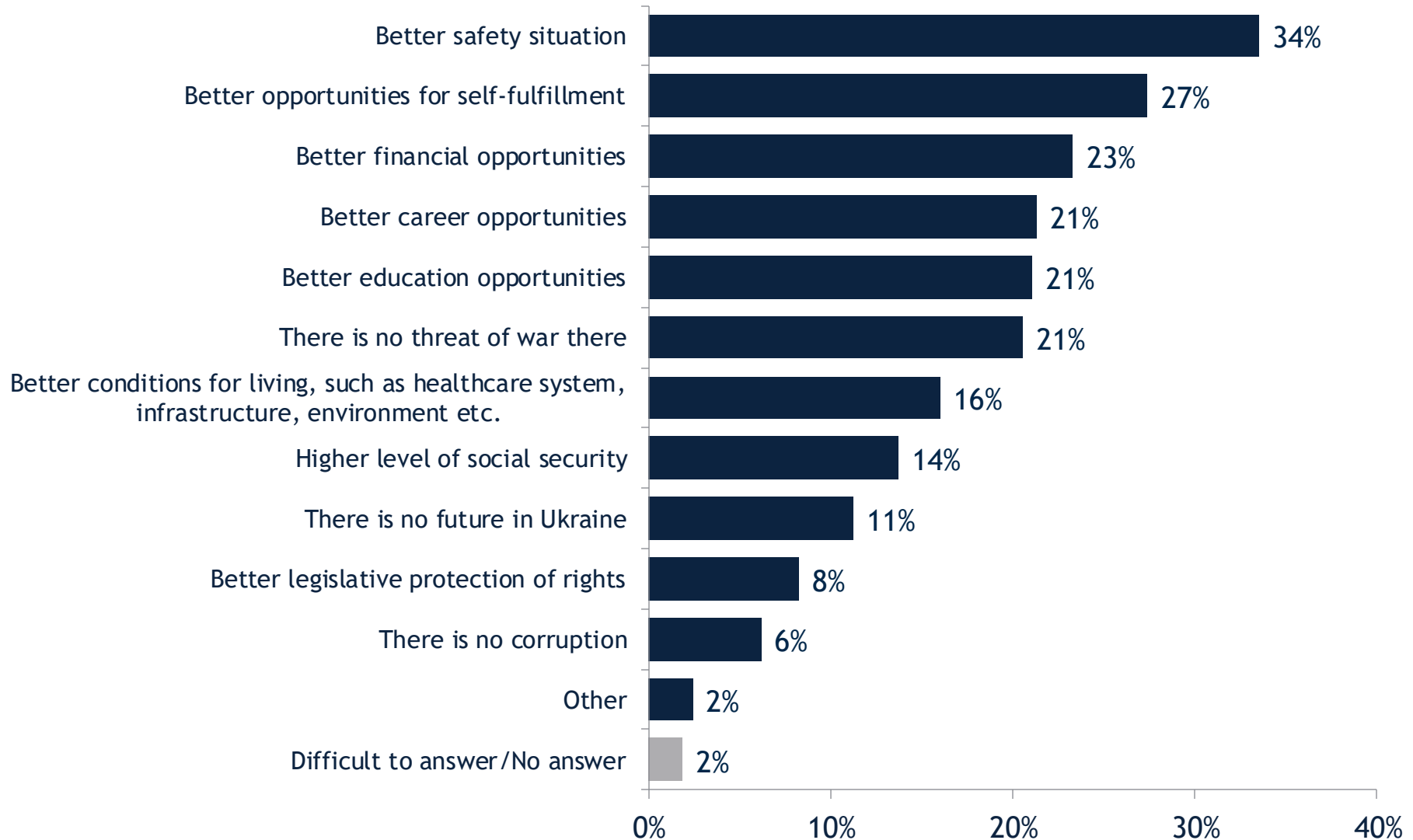
Do you want your children or grandchildren to live abroad permanently?

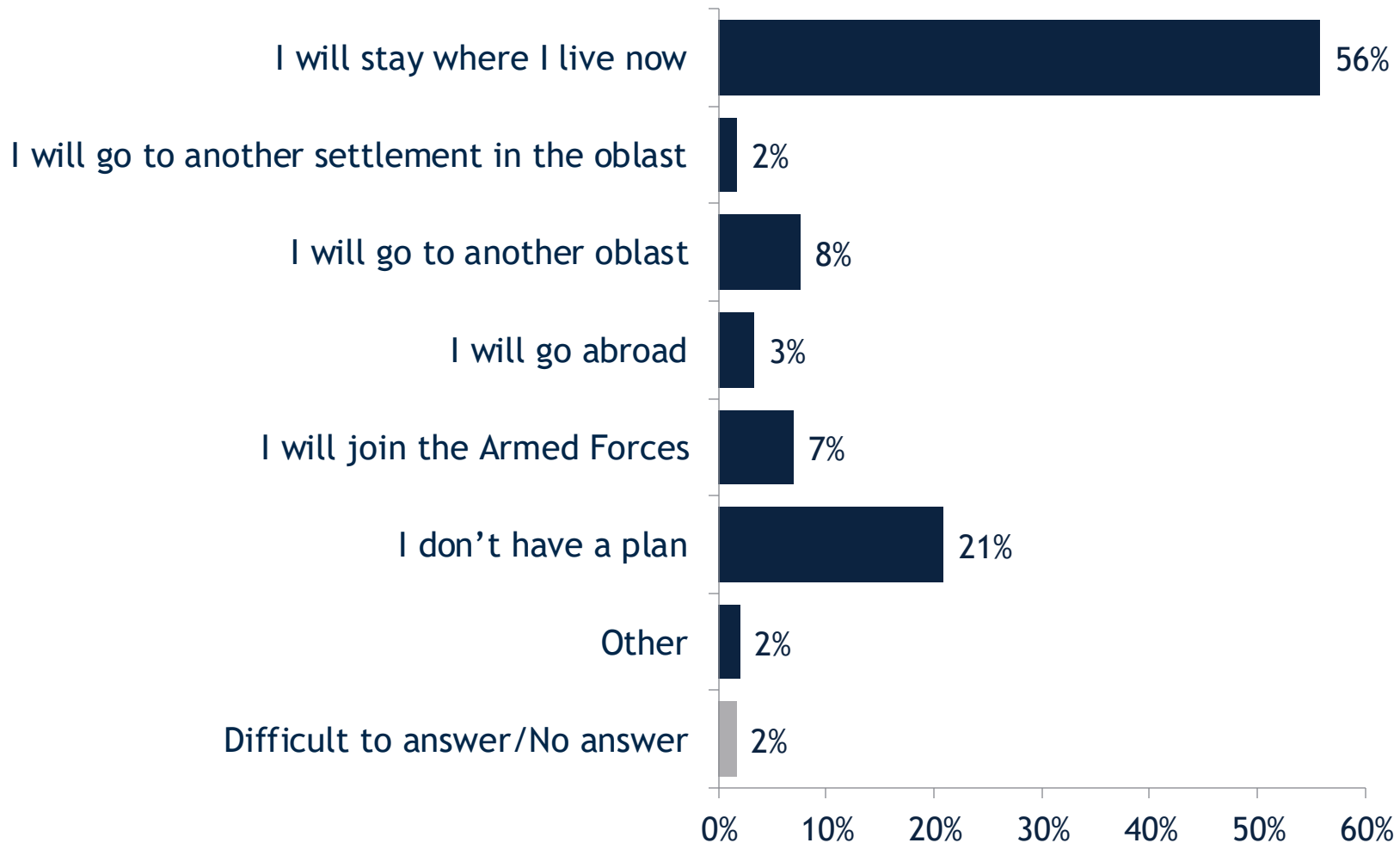

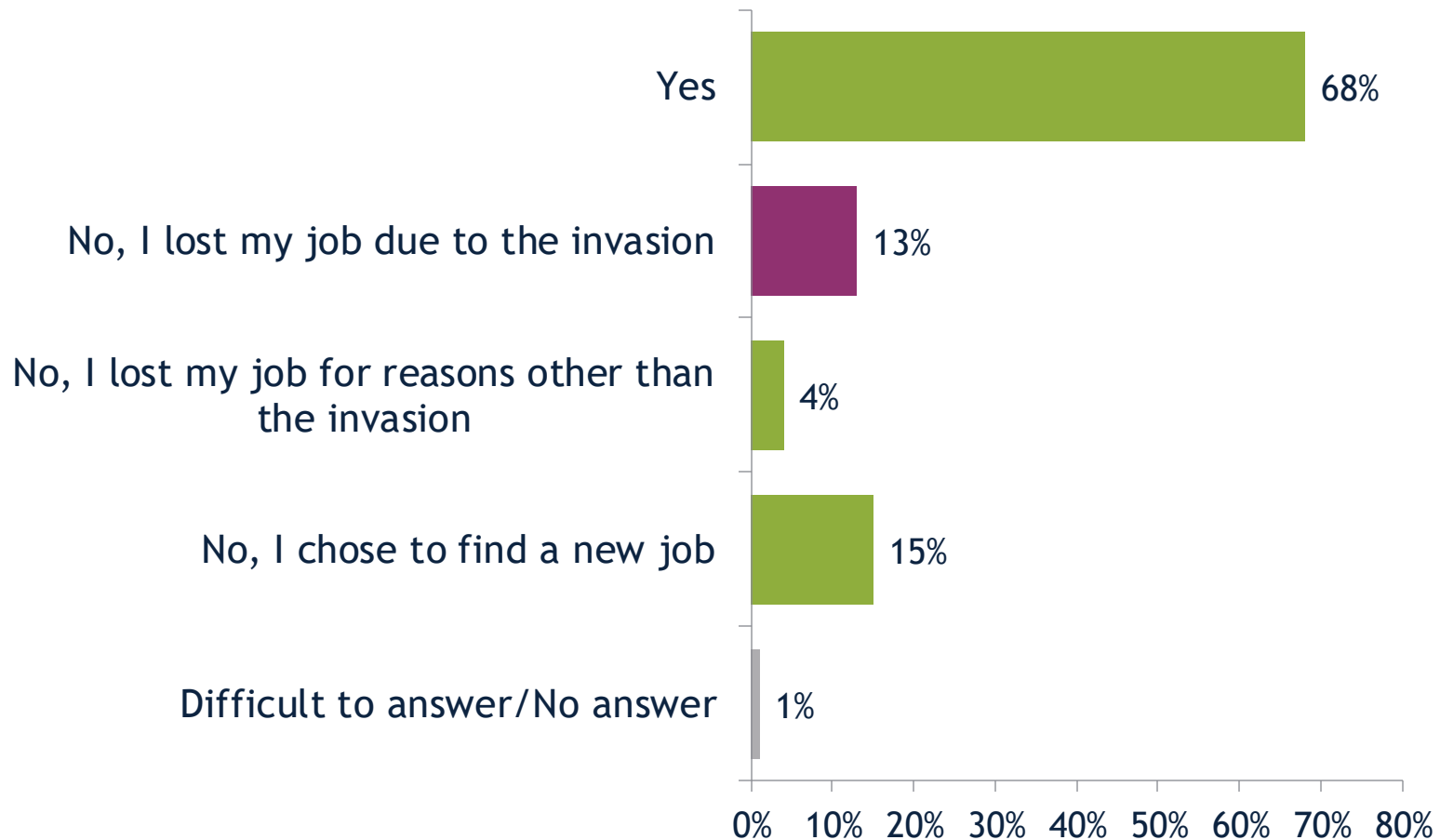

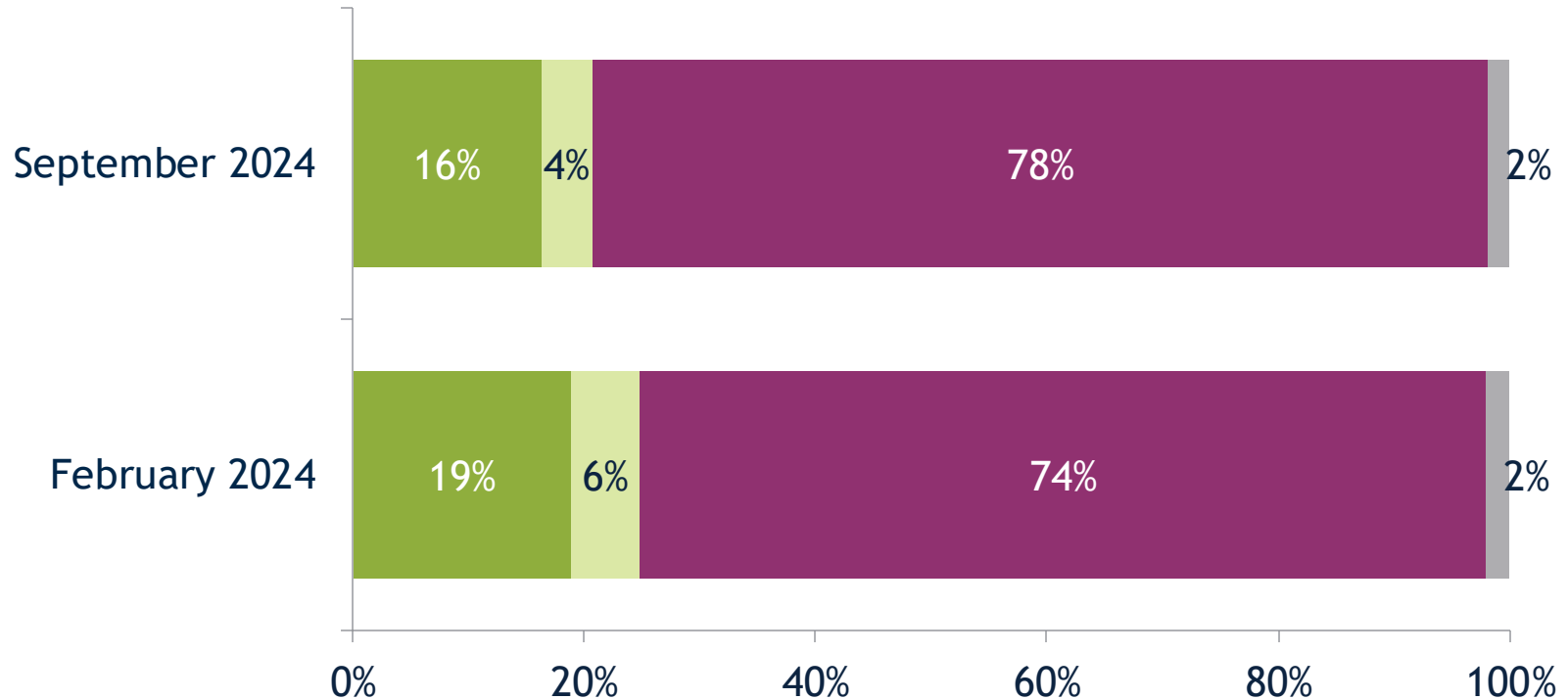

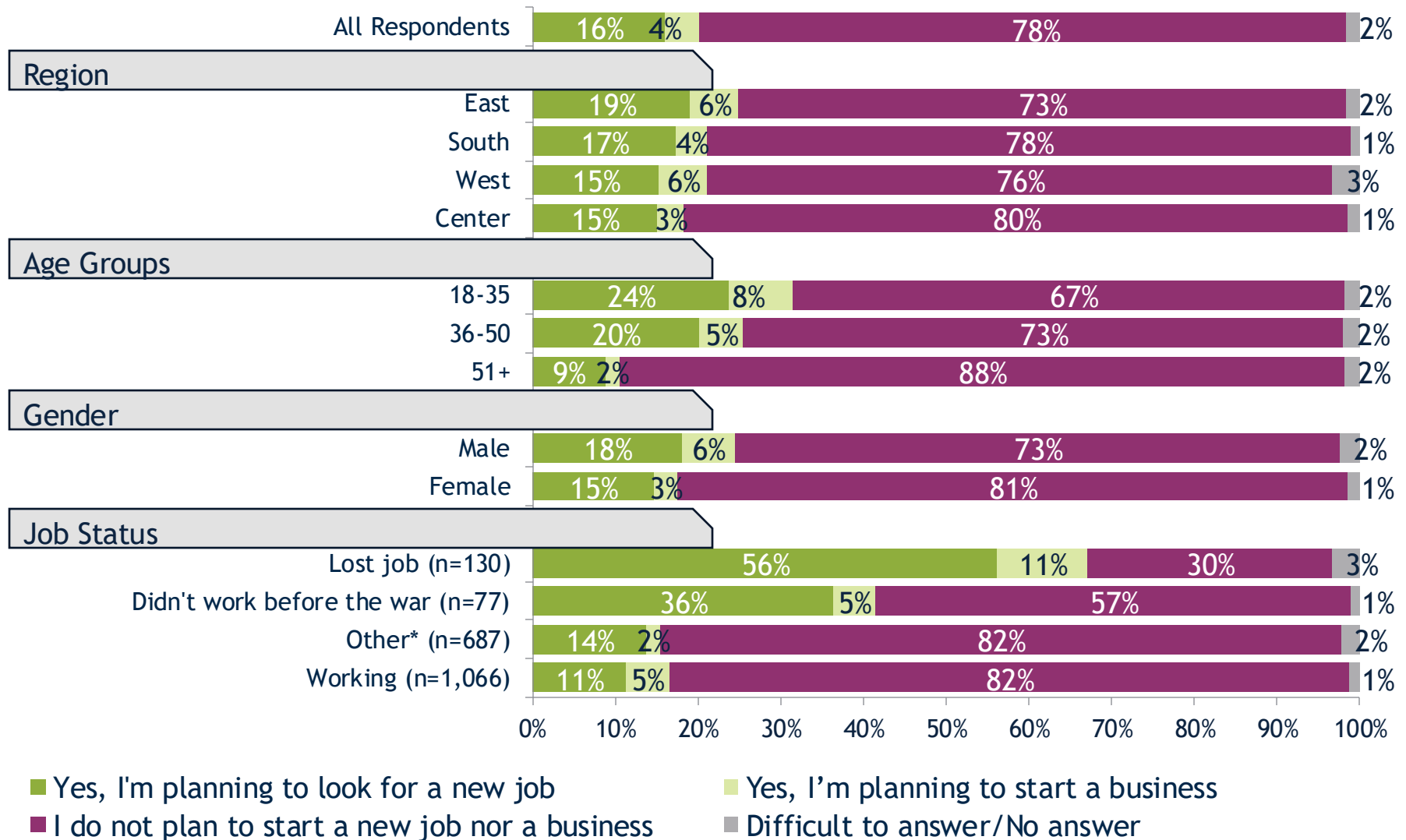

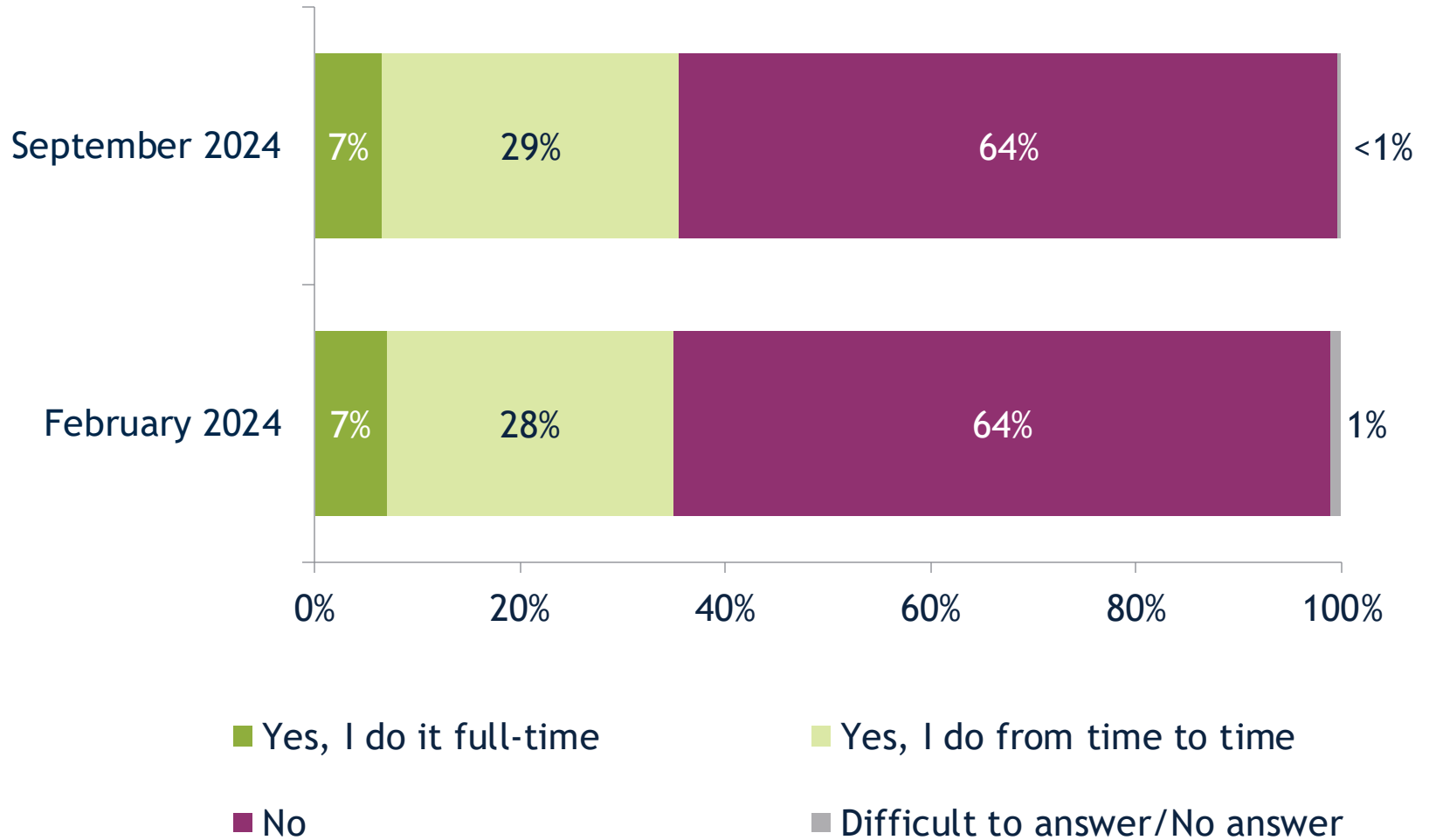

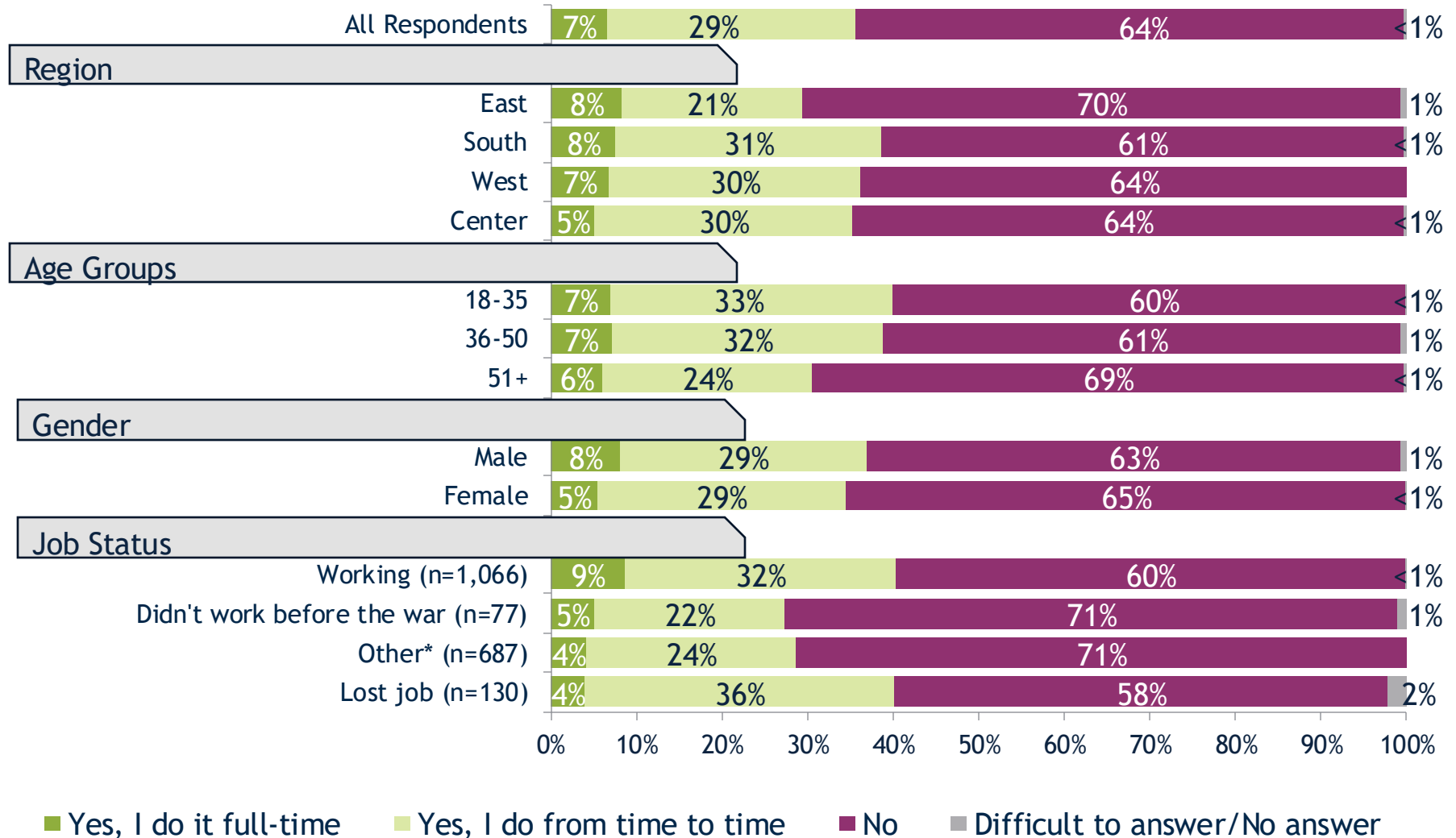

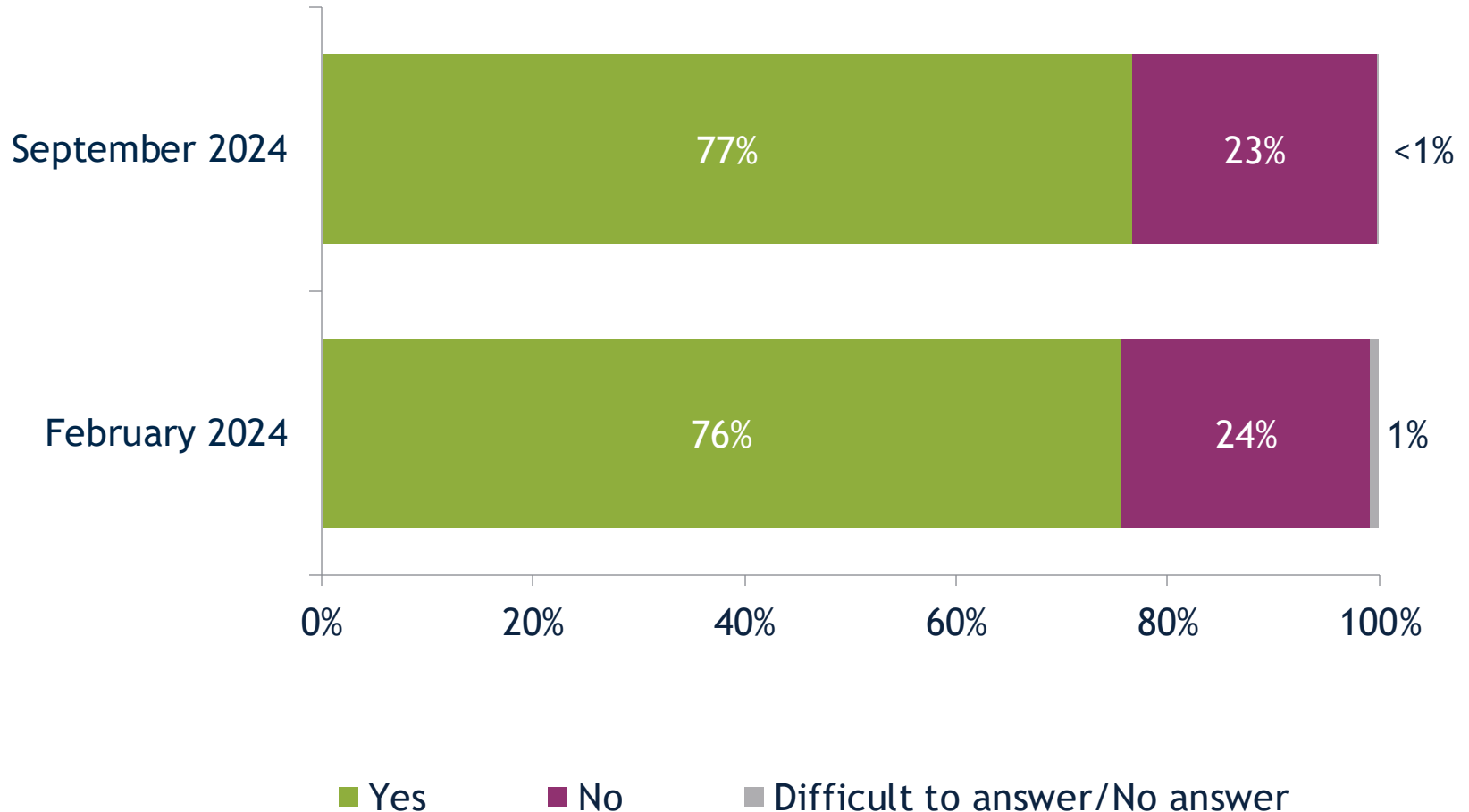

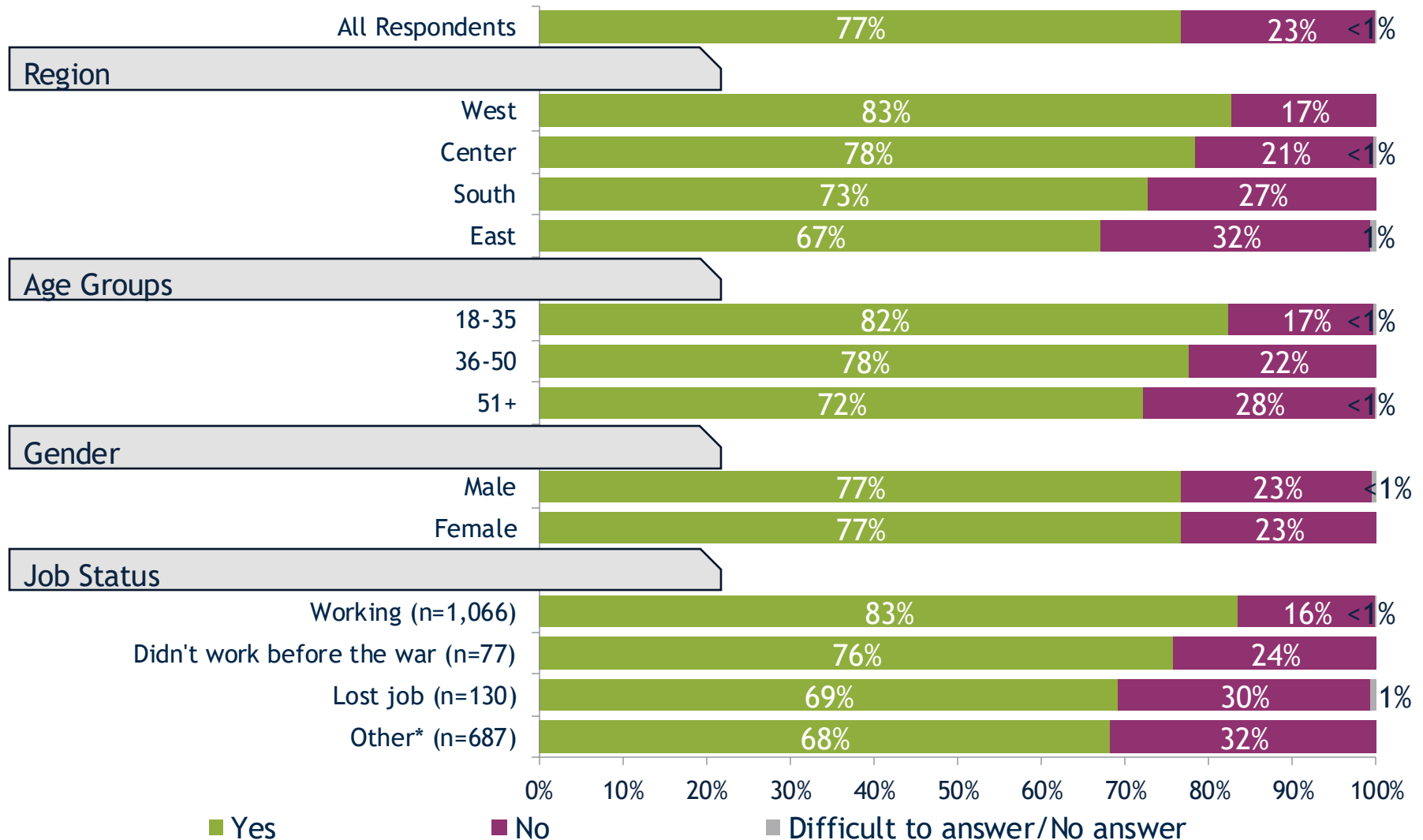

Have you donated money to the Armed Forces during the last three months?

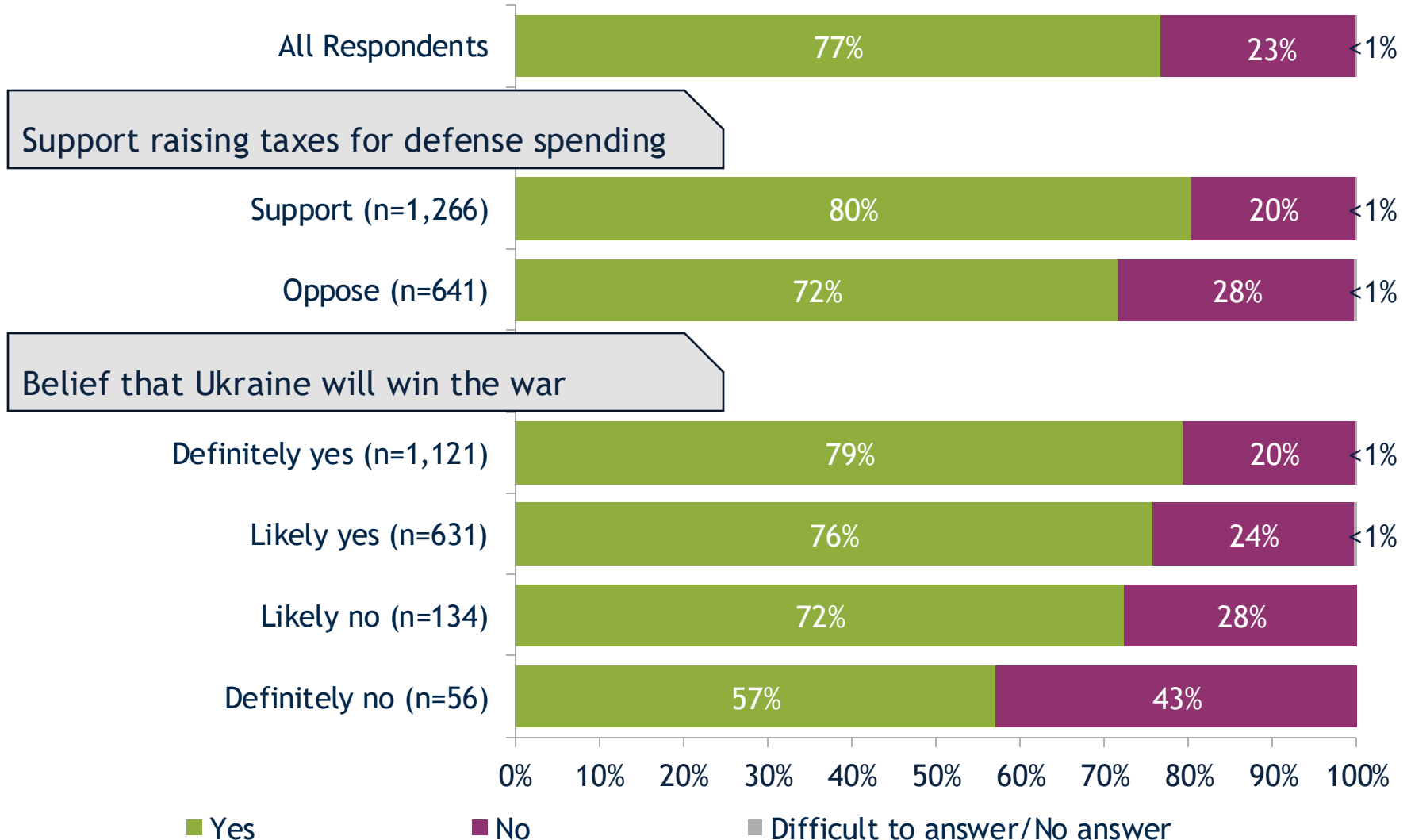

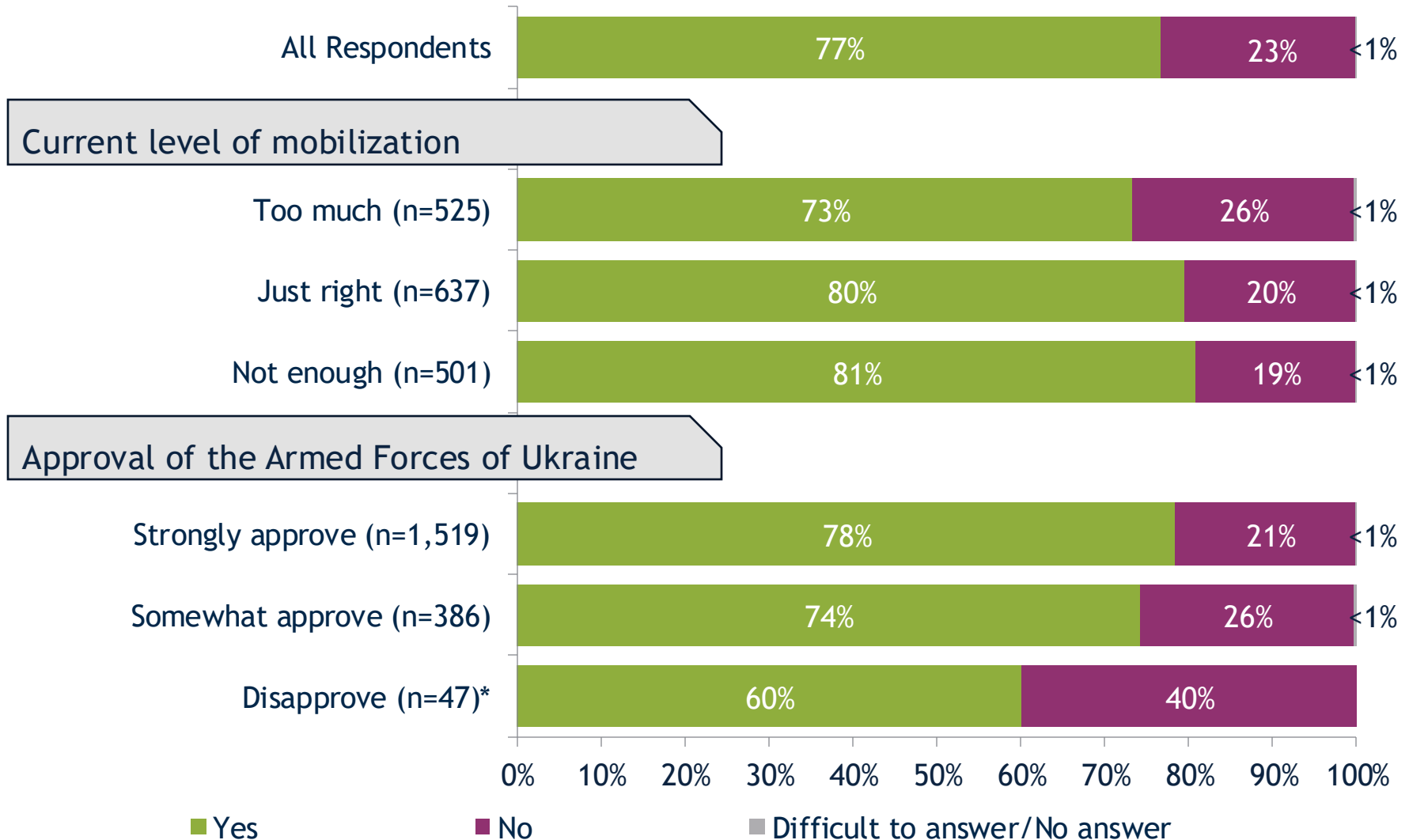

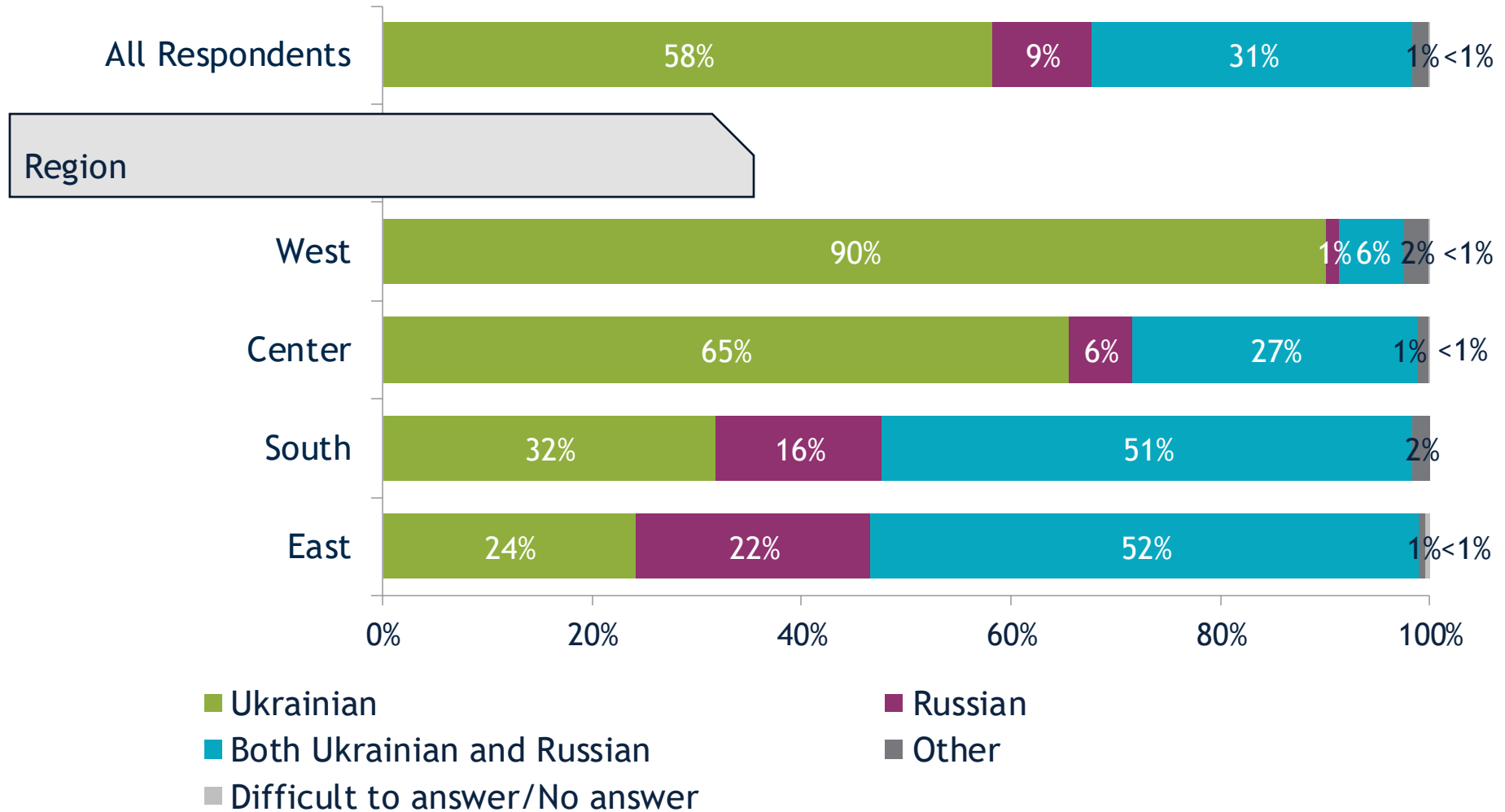

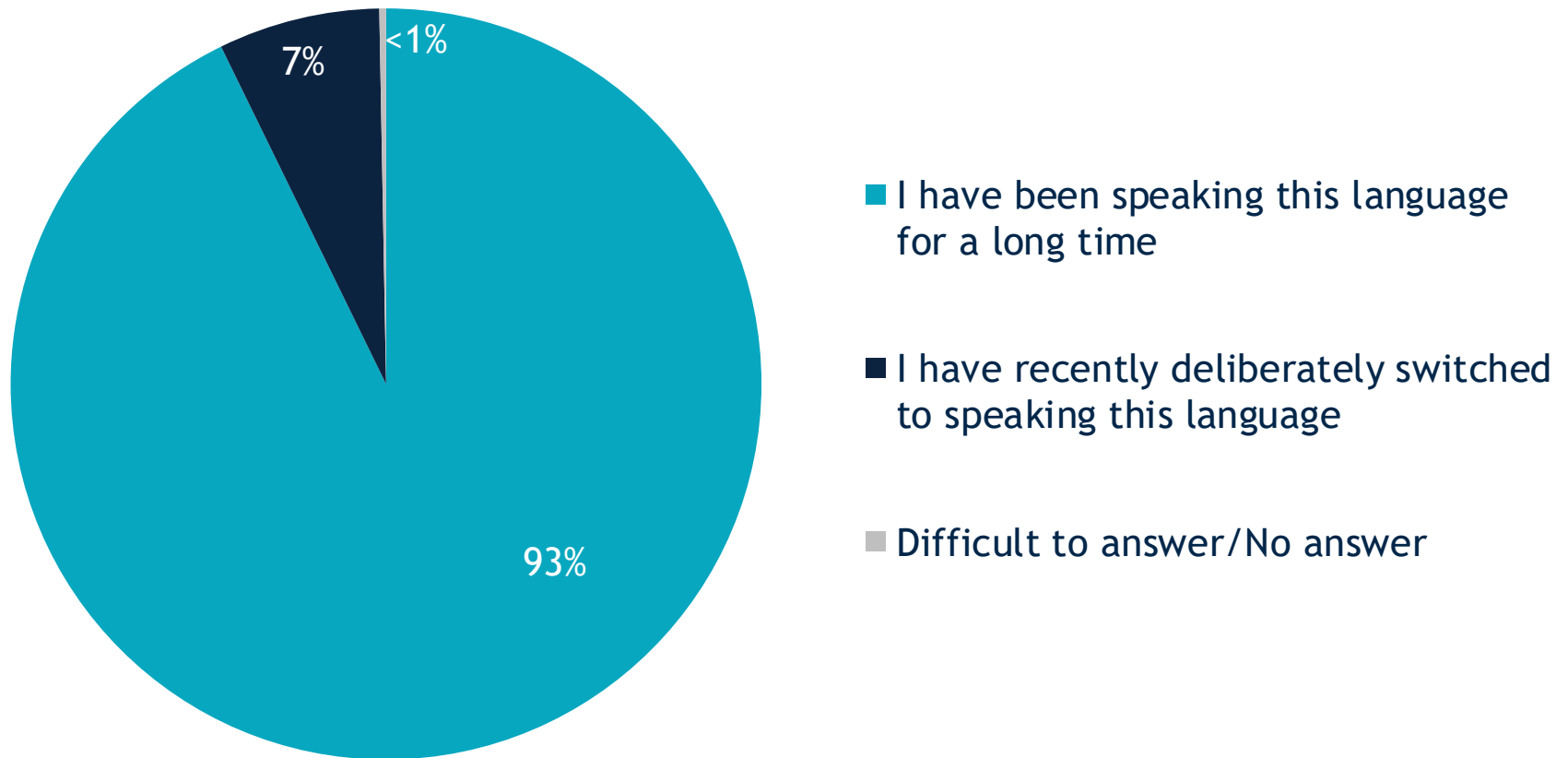

Which language do you usually speak at home?



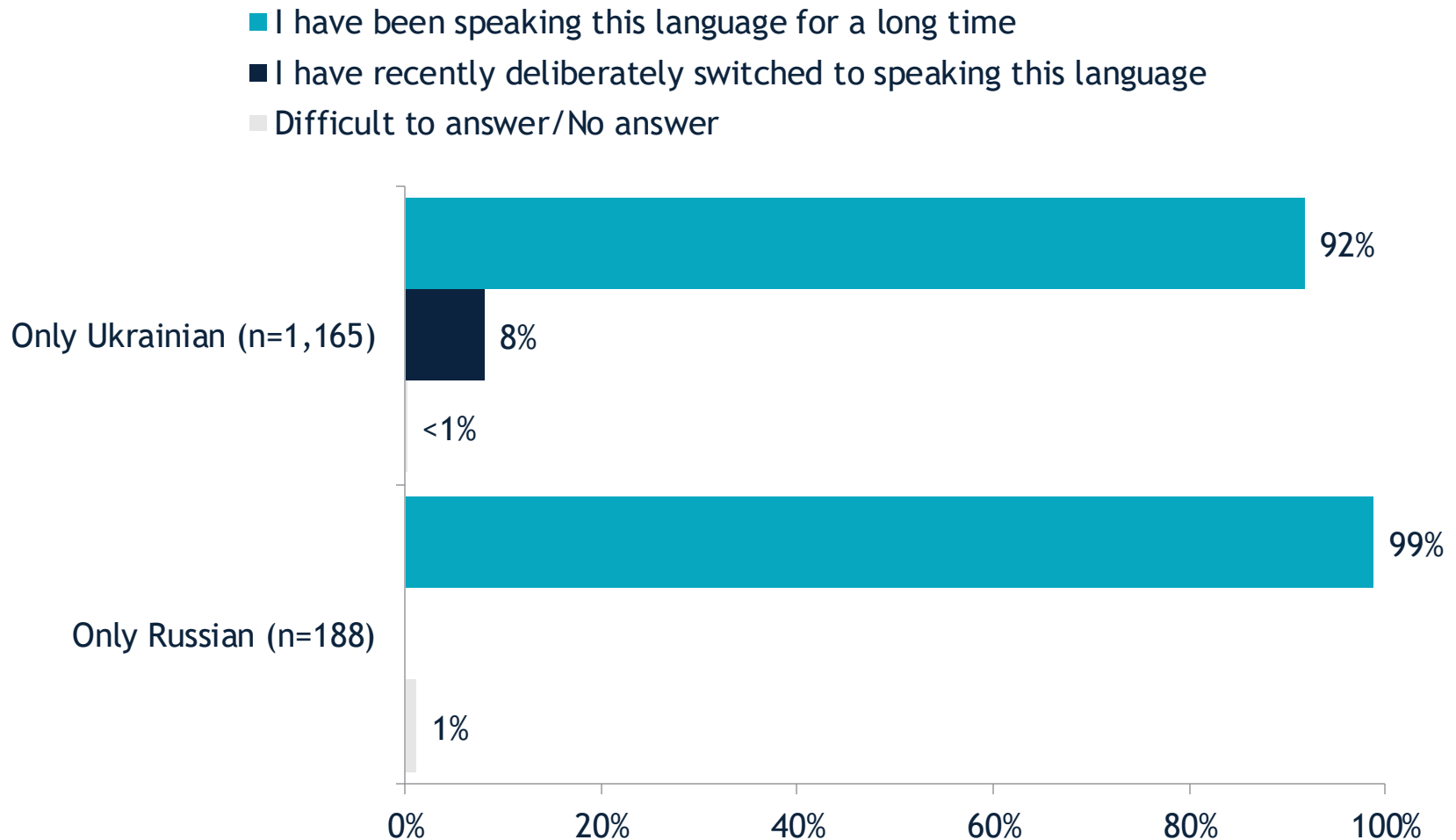
Have you been speaking this language for a long time or have you specifically switched to this language recently?

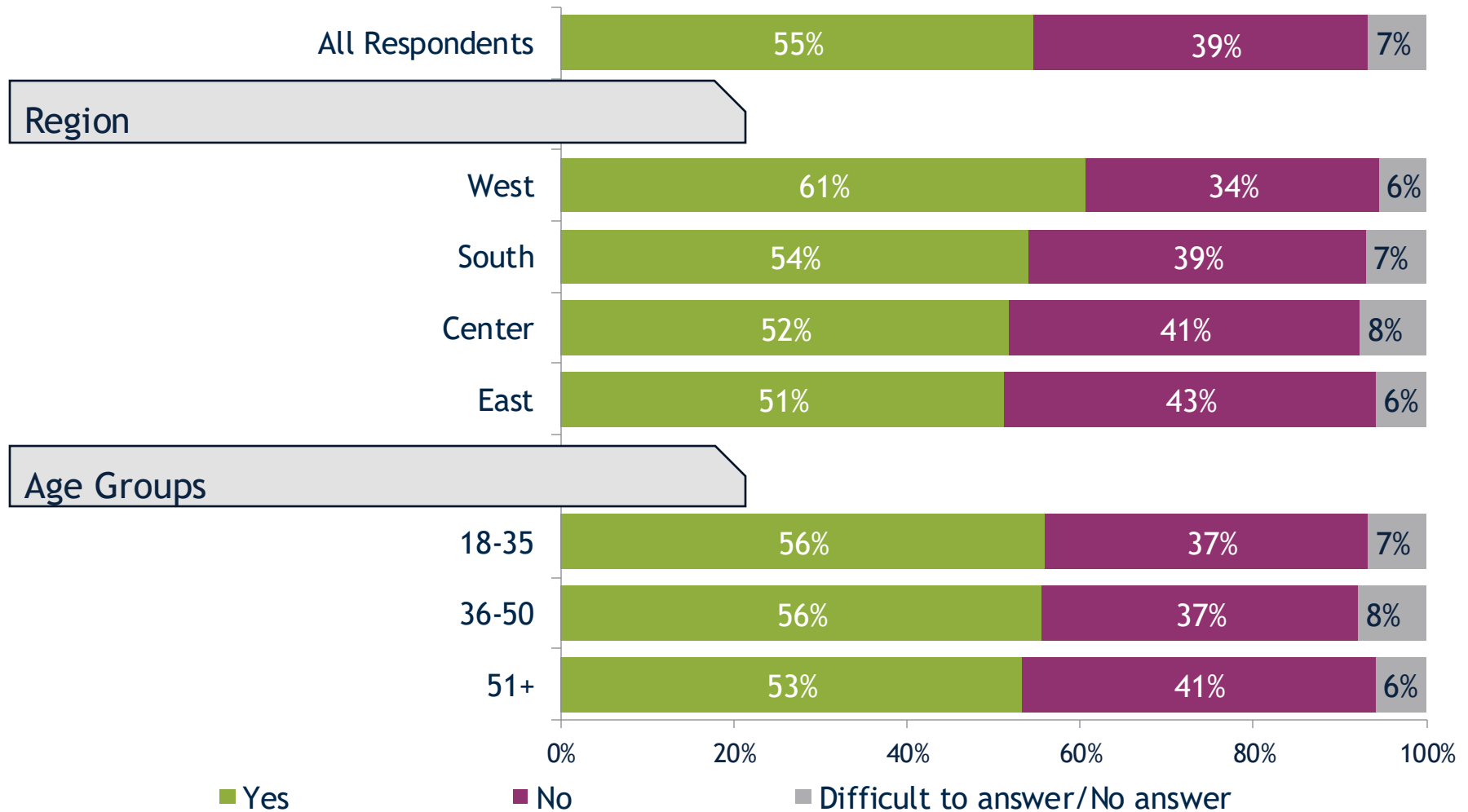

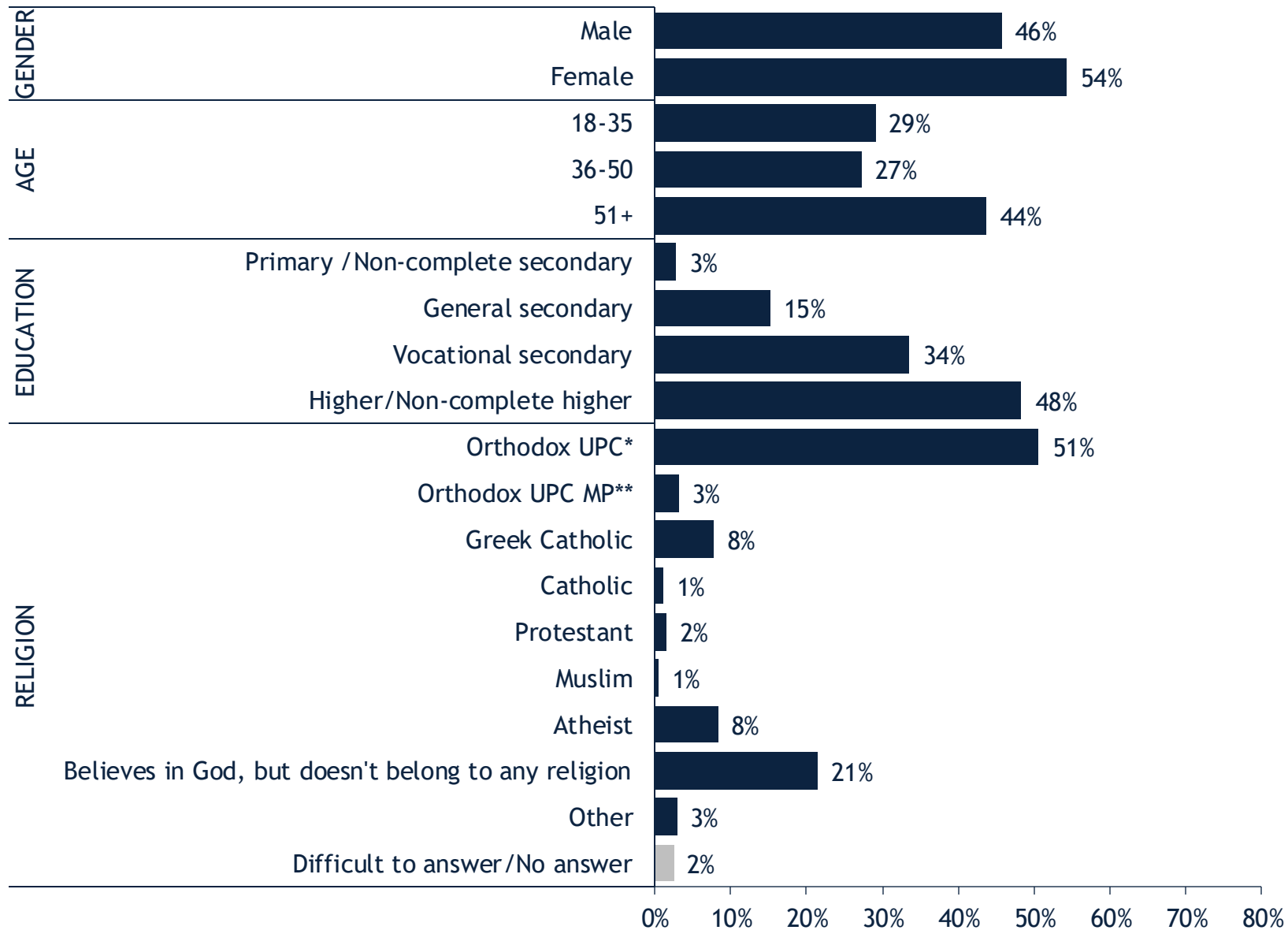
Do you support ending the time conversion for winter and summer time?

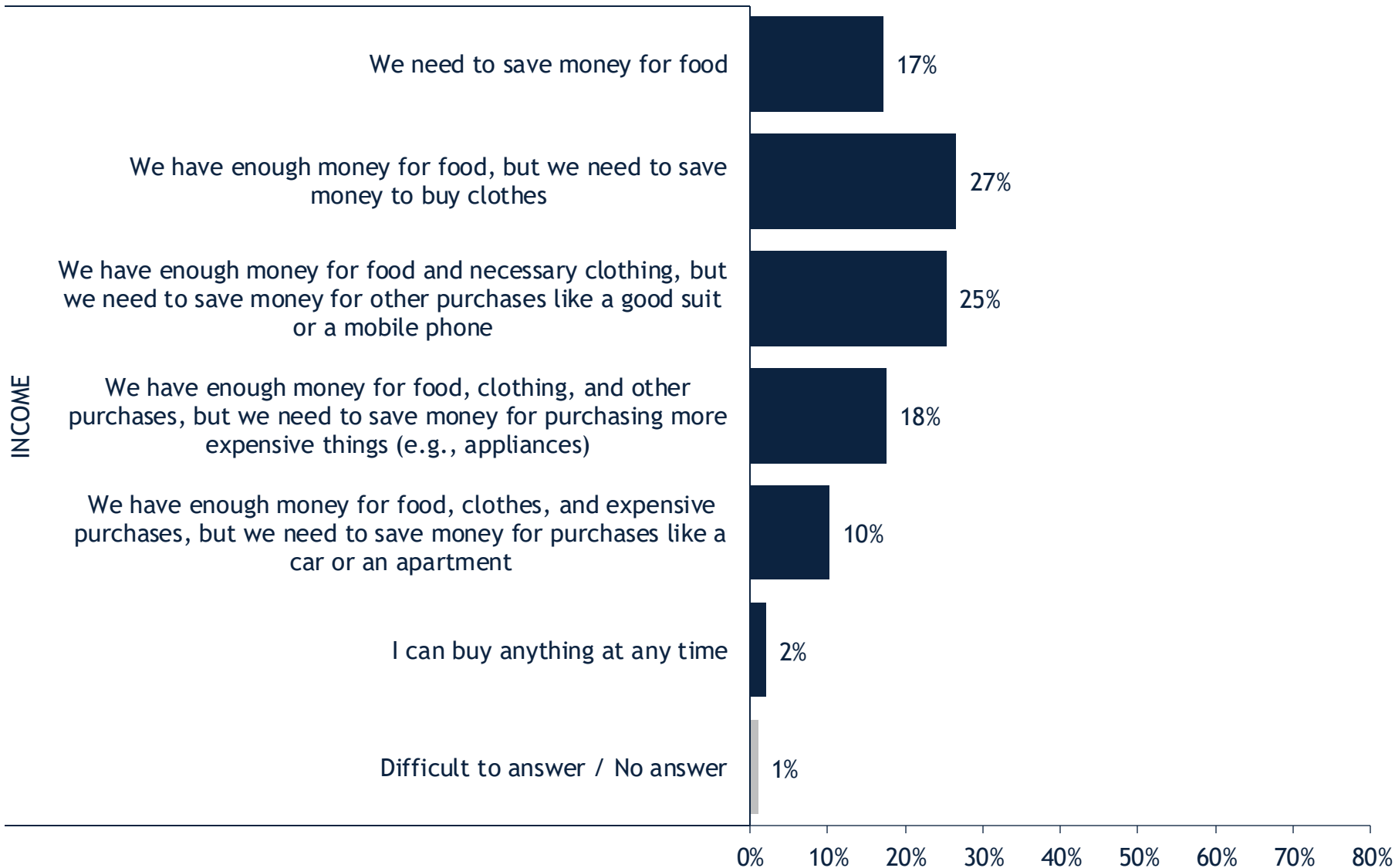
