- 3. Communicate the change with parents and staff to protect their payments, bank details will never be shared via email.

2. Ensure parents know how to pay 🔽

Use our staff and parent resources to ensure your parents understand how to pay.



Well-informed parents = fewer late payments, reduced admin, and fewer finance queries.

How to Implement:

- Share esenda <u>parent resources</u>, including <u>videos</u> and payment guides, both via <u>email</u> and on your <u>website</u>.
- Include in Termly Communications, like newsletters and fee notices, to reassure and remind parents.

How to Implement:

- Create a dedicated "How to Pay" section or page on your website, linking out to the appropriate <u>parent resources</u>, and using our <u>website wording</u> guide.
- Embed your school's unique Payment Link to enable parents to make quick, secure payments (It will look something like https://epay.esenda.com/your-school)
- 3. Ensure finance and admissions teams always refer parents to this page.
