The location of this double-island layout links soft seating, dining and the outside entertaining area. It creates the perfect environment to spend time together in this traditional Cotswold-stone home.

DETAIL: b3 furniture in gravel and anthracite with a stainless-steel work surface and a black-brown oak bar.

TIMELESS LIVING

A classic monochrome palette brings a timeless feel to this integrated family space. The layout has been designed to maximise views of the garden, while also ensuring the working zone of the kitchen connects to the dining, relaxation and media areas.

DETAIL: b3 furniture in grey aluminium and gravel with a structured oak bar.



EXTEND IN STYLE

A room to socialise with uninterrupted access to the garden were key considerations to this all-season kitchen living space. Maximising space and light within a glass-box extension, finishes were chosen to complement the sympathetic addition to this period family home.

DETAIL: B3 furniture in graphite and gravel with an oak bar.

CONTEMPORARY NEW BUILD

Double islands linked by a bridging bar create a sociable space for the cook and the whole family to enjoy. The stylish coffee area, with its multifunctional wall for bespoke shelving, provides a welcoming space for rest and relaxation.

DETAIL: b3 furniture in black-brown oak, grey aluminium, and platinum with an oak bridging bar.

CALM AND CONNECTED

Two large islands feature double sinks and hob in this calm and connected multifunctional space. Designed for a sociable cooking experience, the cook takes to the stage and remains central to conversation, enjoyment and entertainment.

DETAIL: b3 furniture in anthracite and flint with a black-brown oak bar.

THE VAULTS

An open-plan space for the whole family to enjoy. Connecting kitchen island, dining and outdoors, the finishes create a luxurious and textured feel in this glazed extension to a period family home.

DETAIL: b3 furniture in gravel and black-brown structured oak with sand-beige aluminium wall panels and porcelain work surfaces.

CONTEMPORARY RESTORATION

Elegant elements combine to create a sociable family kitchen connecting to the adjoining seating area. Tall units for refrigeration and pantry-style storage were built around an AGA, overlooking two islands to create a dedicated cooking zone.

DETAIL: b3 furniture in gravel and clay with a vintage oak bar and composite stone work surface.

ORCHESTRATED ORANGERY

Time spent together has been transformed by this curated living space, combining all elements essential to modern family life. Cooking, dining and relaxation are fully integrated in this sociable kitchen living space, which enjoys panoramic views of the stunning grounds.

DETAIL: b3 furniture in flint, sand-beige aluminium and walnut with ceramic marble-effect work surfaces.

NATURAL SHADES

This light-filled kitchen living space has been designed for family entertaining. With sociability being a key consideration, maximum storage creates a calm, clutter-free environment, while textured finishes add warmth to this open-plan space.

DETAIL: b3 furniture in kaolin with a 10-mm stainless steel work surface.

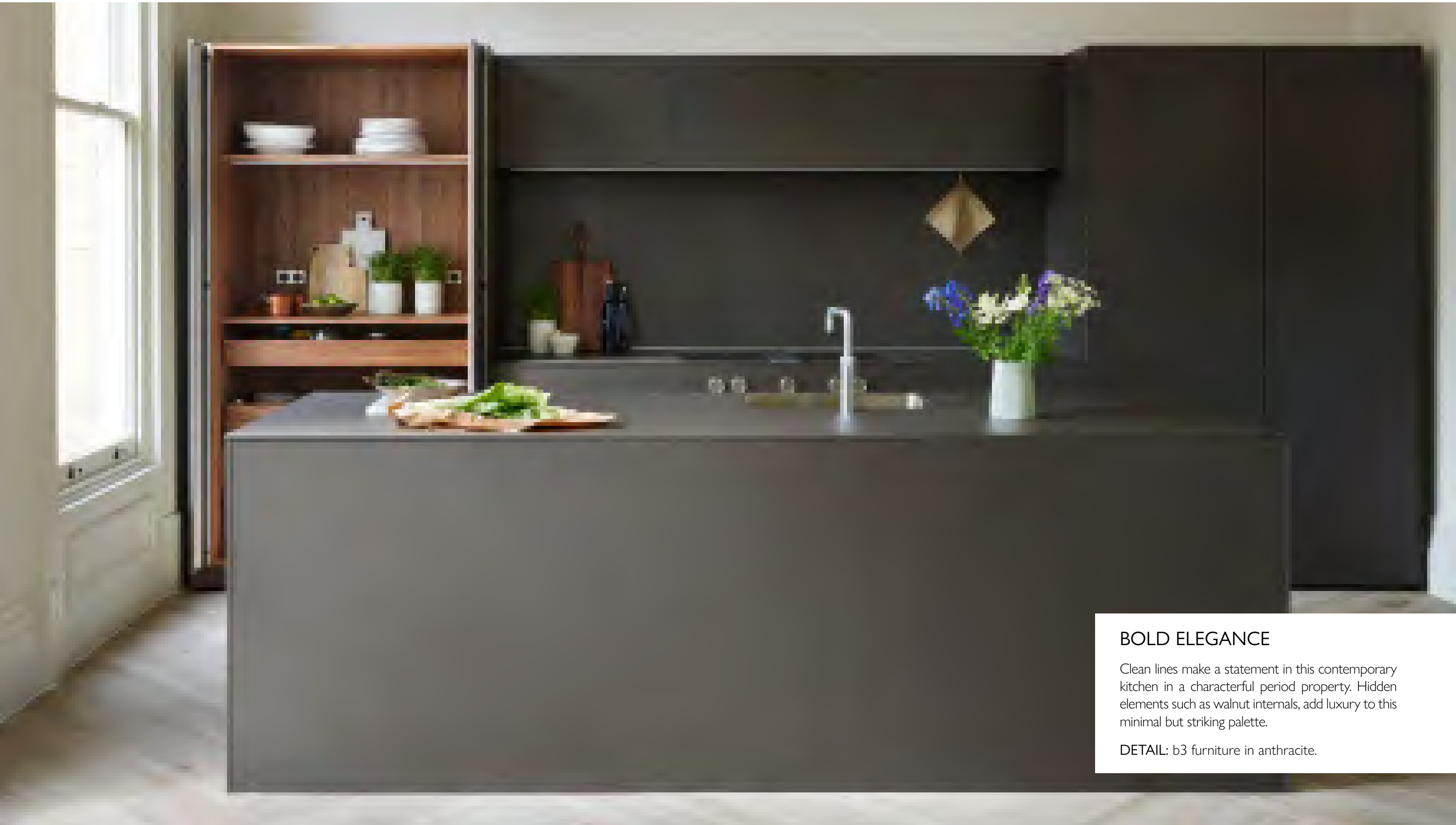
CITY LIVING

DETAIL: b3 furniture in platinum and grey stained structured oak with a black stained oak bar and a 10-mm stainless steel work surface.







BOLD ELEGANCE

Clean lines make a statement in this contemporary kitchen in a characterful period property. Hidden elements such as walnut internals, add luxury to this minimal but striking palette.

DETAIL: b3 furniture in anthracite.

CONNECTED LIVING

A double-island layout with a raised bar creates a connected cooking environment for family and friends to come together. Floor-to-ceiling glazing links the garden to this sociable living space and bespoke elements add a personalised and luxurious feel.

DETAIL: b3 and b1 furniture in graphite and gravel with a white oak bar and vintage-style glass.

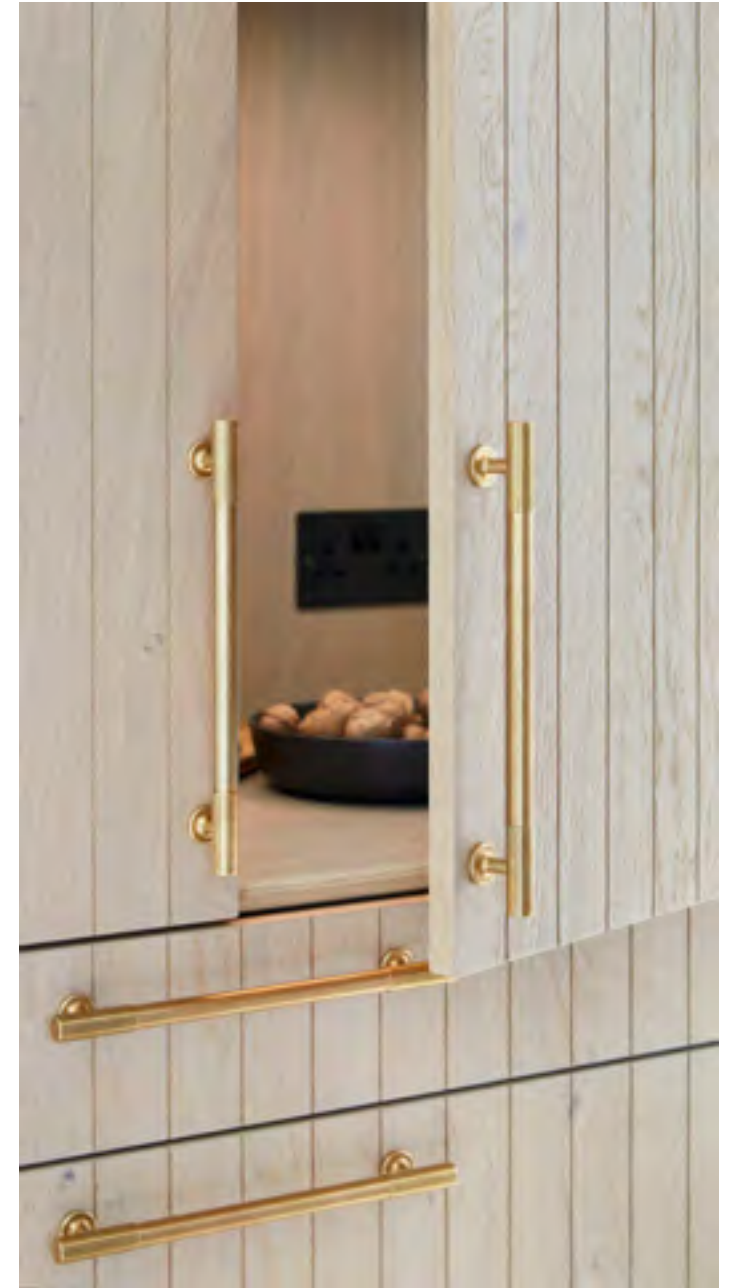


BREAKFAST CLUB

PALETTE: Kitchen Architecture's systemKA furniture in reeded light grey oak and satin matt lacquer with Rimadesio Zenit shelving and natural marble composite-stone work surfaces.



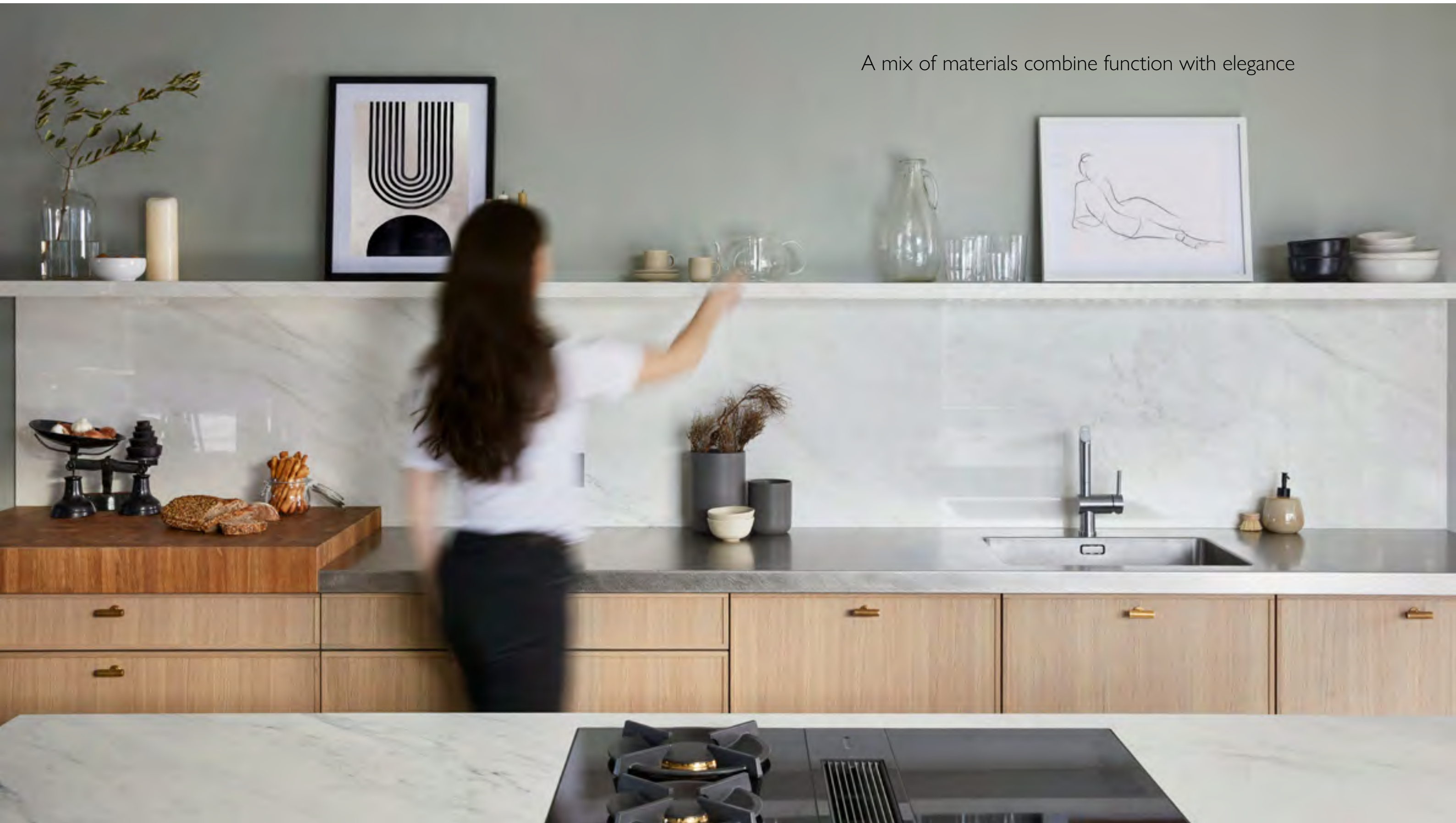


NATURAL TONES

A marriage of material, texture and tone. A choice of two timbers warms up the cool palette created by the steel surface and smooth marble on the island. Practical and elegant, this systemKA design also features a functional shelf to keep prep surfaces free from clutter.

PALETTE: Kitchen Architecture's systemKA furniture in clay dark, light stained oak and planked oak with marble-effect composite-stone and brushed stainless steel work surfaces.

THE STABLES

The layout of this sociable island in a narrow space has been designed to maximise garden views from both sides. The mix of reeded oak wall units and stone finishes complement the natural palette and character of this personalised systemKA space.

PALETTE: Kitchen Architecture's systemKA furniture in stone and fluted natural oak with 60-mm natural stone and 4-mm stainless steel work surfaces.





COUNTRY RETREAT

The stunning location inspired this double-island layout, which maximises the panoramic view and provides a central prep and cooking zone, with direct access to the AGA and double ovens. The dark oak works in harmony with the natural stone of the building.

PALETTE: Kitchen Architecture's systemKA furniture in a mocha oak finish with 50-mm composite stone work surfaces.

CLASSIC SHADES OF GREY

Intelligent design connects the island to all essential components of a sociable kitchen living space – easy access to cooking and food storage, soft seating and dining as well as maximising views of the garden. Classic in-frame doors in a cool palette showcase the versatility of our systemKA range.

PALETTE: Kitchen Architecture's systemKA furniture in mocha oak and a pearl grey painted finish with a 50-mm composite stone work surface.

OLD MEZZANINE

PALETTE: Clay dark and grey stained oak finishes on Kitchen Architecture's systemKA furniture with a 20-mm textured composite stone work surface and a grey stained oak bar.

A modern classic

Teddy Edwards is Kitchen Architecture's own brand of classic British furniture. Handcrafted for today's lifestyles, it embraces the warmth, colours and textures of bespoke cabinetry.

The Teddy Edwards story

The inspiration for Teddy Edwards can be traced back three generations to a time when British engineering was carving a reputation for itself. This furniture range inherits its name from our owner's Great Uncle, Harry Norman Edwards (Teddy to his friends and family), who was one of the founding members and the first secretary of the British Racing Drivers' Club.

Teddy and his friends, known as The Bentley Boys, were a group of British drivers who dominated the racing scene in the late 1920s. Their dedication and drive to become the best-of-the-best set the standard for future generations and, like the British Racing Drivers' Club, Teddy Edwards celebrates the very best of British design, craftsmanship and engineering.



DARK ALLURE

A mews house transformed into a pied-à-terre to share sociable moments with family and friends. In contrast to the dark-painted finishes of the furniture, glass is used to maximise light and the addition of recessed-bar seating creates an inclusive experience for all.

MATERIAL: Kitchen Architecture's Teddy Edwards furniture in natural oak with fluted glass and black-stained oak with a pavilion grey hand-painted finish and a composite stone work surface.





THE THRESHING BARN

This country-style kitchen was designed around a classic range cooker, where tall elements create a symmetrical, balanced look. The soft colour palette provides the perfect canvas for the Cotswold stone in this restored threshing barn.

MATERIAL: Kitchen Architecture's Teddy Edwards furniture hand-painted in green smoke and pavilion grey finishes with a vintage oak bar and composite stone work surfaces.



BESPOKE INTEGRATED LIVING
