- Complete the problem to the best of your ability.
- Show your work and explain your thinking whenever possible.
- It is okay if you do not know how to solve the problem.
- Mistakes are expected and can help teachers understand what concepts may need review.
- Try to answer the question independently before asking for help.
- Spend reasonable time on the problem, but do not worry about perfection.
- Neatness and effort matter more than accuracy.

This assignment is meant to provide an honest picture of your current understanding, not to be stressful or graded for correctness. Your work will help your teacher create the best possible starting point for learning in September.
