On the 5 December 2020, around 150 Ngati Porou whanau who had lost loved ones during the COVID-19 lockdown were welcomed to Porourangi Marae, to bring their mate home and mourn together as one.

This is a reminder to all whanau of the key steps that MUST be followed if you are wanting to walk or drive up the maunga.

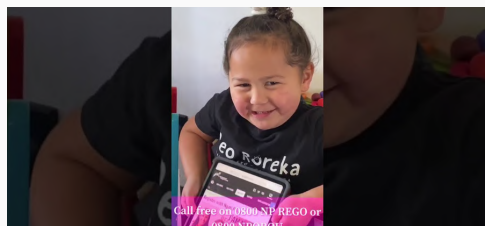
- You must apply 72 hours before your planned visit
- You should apply online or email gm@pakihiroafarms.co.nz and copy in pakihiroa@pakihiroafarms.co.nz
- You must provide contact details including details of the vehicle and who will be driving.

Access may be approved for Ngati Porou wishing to access if it is safe and does not impact on farm operations. The final decision about access rests with the farm manager as the person in charge of the workplace.

MIERE UPDATE - Extraction facility in Te Araroa, Pohutu Station
 The much-anticipated decision of the location for the Ngati Porou Miere extraction facility has been confirmed as Te Araroa. After a robust site selection process, the Ngati Porou Tairawhiti Miere Collective have confirmed that the facility will be on Pohutu Station at their Waione Road site. HoldCo have confirmed a long-term lease agreement with Pohutu and look forward to the relationship enabling business development and employment for whanau in the region. It is intended the facility will be open before the honey flow commences in 2021.

TE MANA O TE WAI

In 2016 TRONPnui worked with hapu to discuss how best to address water quantity and quality for wai in our rohe. This was due to the GDC wanting to develop a freshwater plan that would cover the Ngati Porou rohe. As a result, a Joint Management Agreement (JMA) between TRONPnui and GDC was initiated. This agreement allows Ngati Porou hapu to share decision making and co-develop a Waiapu Catchment Management Plan.

What is a Catchment Plan?

A catchment plan sets limits and outlines the way a catchment should be managed. For the Waiapu Catchment Plan it will provide Council and Ngati Porou hapu a vehicle to jointly articulate their vision and ideas about how to manage the natural resources (land and water) within that area.

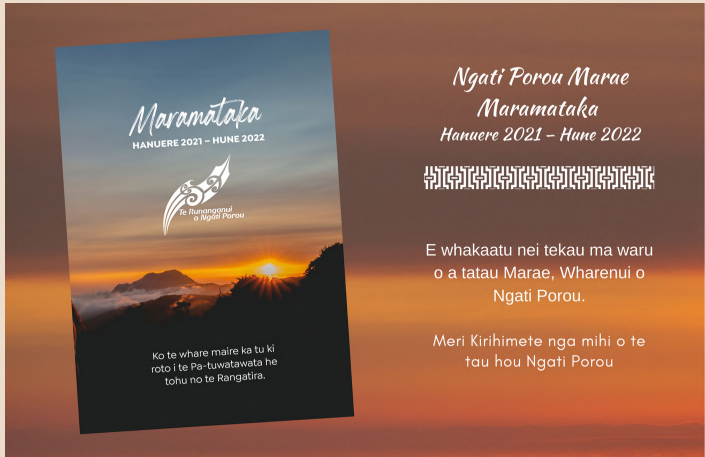
TE MANA O TE WAI

Through the development of the Waiapu Catchment Plan, we must ensure that Te Mana o te Wai is at the heart of its drafting and the setting of objectives for the management of freshwater quality and quantity. This will help Council make better decisions about land and water use in partnership with Ngati Porou.

What's next?

We intend to hold a first round of joint Council/TRONPnui engagement hui on the 10th and 11th of February, times and venues are still to be confirmed. This hui will be for hapu, landowners, ratepayers, residents, stakeholder groups and the community. Please keep a look out for these hui dates and times.
