
#### About the lesson

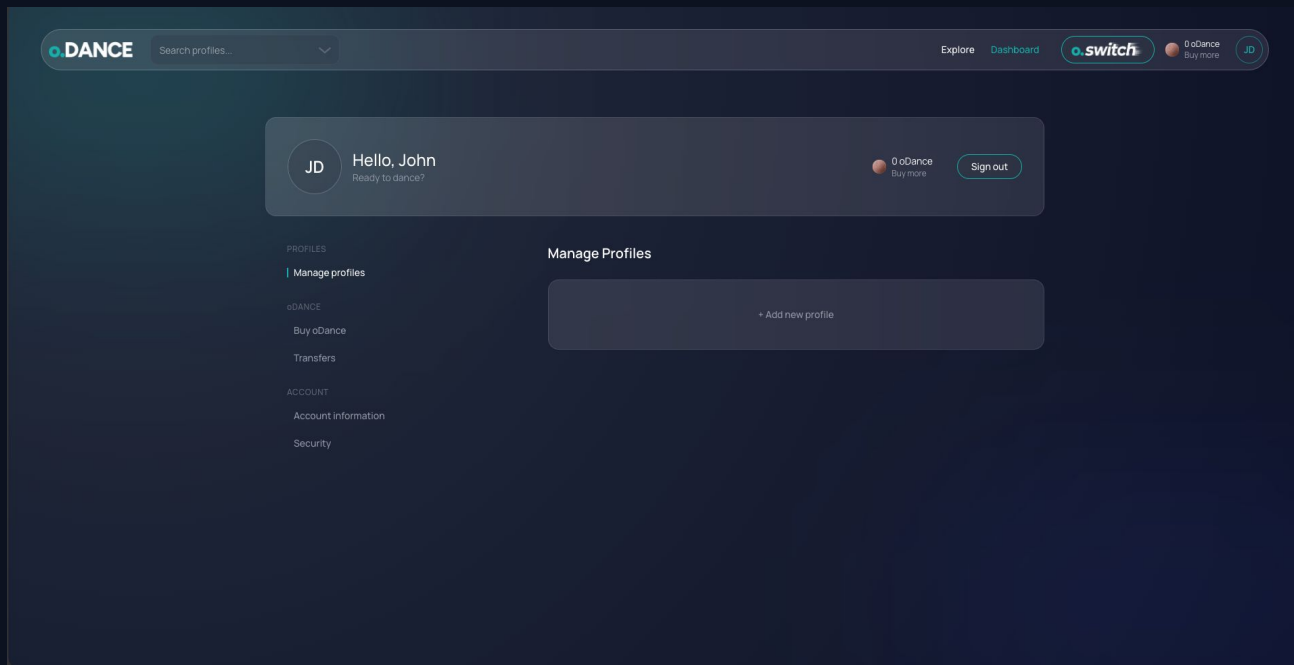


# How to Find the Dashboard

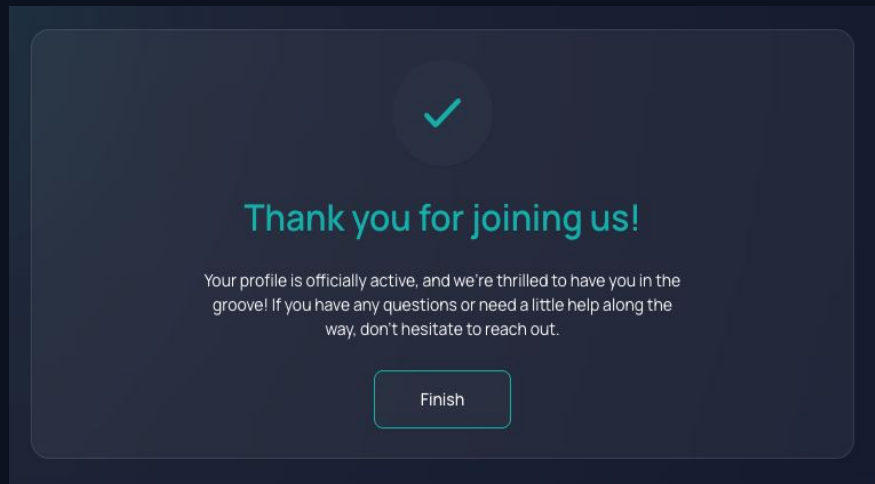
