Emperor Uriel Septim VII is assassinated in flight from his own palace, but just before he dies he passes on to you—the foreordained of his dreams—the mystic Amulet of Kings. The adventure proper begins with the quest to find Uriel's lost and illegitimate son—the only heir to the throne. In a world where the forces of darkness seek their ultimate dominion over the ranks of man and mer alike, you alone stand between the future of Tamriel and the gates of Oblivion. Oblivion Remastered is a modern remaster of the game for PC, Xbox Series X|S, and PlayStation 5. It includes all 10 official downloads, uses Unreal Engine 5 for graphics rendering on top of the original Gamebryo engine, and has several technical differences from the classic version of the game. The Elder Scrolls IV: Oblivion Game of the Year Edition and Game of the Year Edition Deluxe are available to buy from Steam or GOG.com; the former can also be bought from the Microsoft Store. Oblivion is also available for Xbox 360 and PS3, and is backwards compatible on Xbox One. It is available to play on PS4 via the PlayStation Now cloud gaming service. After years of rumors and reports, Bethesda and Virtuos have revealed Oblivion: Remastered with a new gameplay trailer streamed live on YouTube and Twitch today. Even better, the game is now available on PC, PS5, and Xbox Series X/S (including via Game Pass) in both Standard and Deluxe Editions priced at \$60 and \$80. The Deluxe Edition features exclusive Akatosh and Mehrunes Dagon armor and weapons, plus horse armor, a direct reference to the original game's controversial micro DLC. Oblivion: Remastered combines the original title's Gamebryo engine with Unreal Engine 5, delivering a massive visual upgrade while preserving the 2006 RPG's core gameplay. However, key mechanics like sneaking, third-person view, sprinting, blocking, and stamina have been updated for modern players, along with changes to the HUD and menu designs. Its previously criticized levelling system has also been reworked, blending elements from Oblivion and Skyrim. During the reveal livestream, Todd Howard from Bethesda explained the remaster's goal: to offer players the same experience as the original release. Fortunately, the game's small but iconic voice cast remains intact, including Patrick Stewart as Uriel Septim and Wes Johnson as Sheogorath. However, Virtuos has recorded new dialogue for all in-game races, finally giving characters unique voices. Oblivion's acclaimed DLC expansions, Knights of the Nine and the Shivering Isles, will be included alongside other minor add-ons like the Wizard's Tower. Rumors of an Oblivion remake first surfaced a few years ago when a former Virtuos employee claimed the project was underway. Leaked Microsoft documents later confirmed the remake existed by 2020, though the title was never officially mentioned again except in insider reports. Last month, it was claimed the remaster would launch as early as April via a shadow drop, which was later supported by screenshot leaks from Virtuos' website.
