PREFINISHED: Available in light, medium, and heavy-burnt finishes.



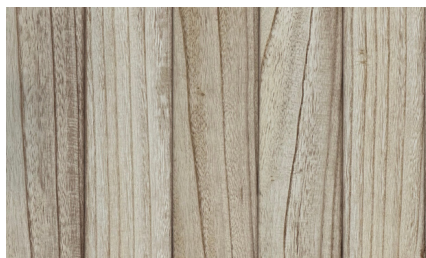

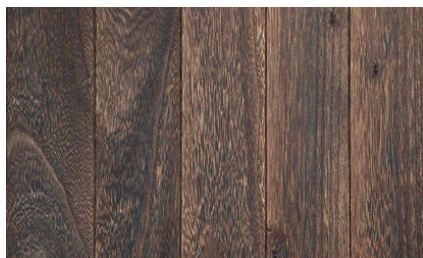

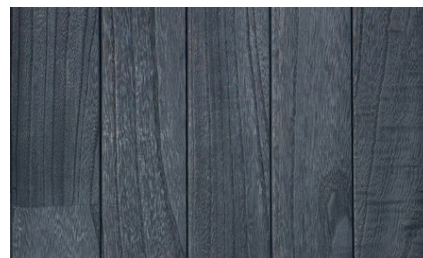
