

## Tool 4: Red Flag Report

This rapid risk scanner is your early warning system. It helps you spot high-risk issues that may delay, derail, or overcomplicate your project.

## Use this tool to:

- Score access, zoning, site conditions, and feasibility using a simple color-coded system.
- Surface any items that require deeper investigation before you move forward.
- Set realistic expectations with your team or partners about project risks.

## **Instructions:**

Use this scanner as a quick risk assessment tool to surface high-impact concerns that could delay or derail your project. Mark each item based on what you know today. If you're unsure, mark "Red" or leave it blank and bring it up during your ARC consult.
