Pokémon Colosseum: Official Strategy Guide is published by BradyGames for the GameCube game of the same name. The Limited Edition version includes a folding cover and an exclusive art book with 273 Pokémon artwork. The opening section, Pokémon Trainer School, explains the game's premise, new concepts such as Shadow Pokémon, snagging, and purification, and advises on where to train in Mt. Battle. It also reviews common series concepts like stats and type effectiveness charts. The Orre Region Walkthrough provides a complete guide to Pokémon Colosseum, including story objectives, Trainer battles, available Shadow Pokémon, Colosseum challenges, hidden items, and buyable items. All Round One Colosseum challenges are included during the walkthrough, while remaining challenges are listed at the end. The Battle Mode section lists all Trainers in the game, followed by a Pokédex section containing Shadow Pokémon found in the game with their locations. The Pokémon Moves section provides an alphabetical list of all moves, and the final section, Pokémon Extras, includes information on Natures, Berries, Poké Balls, healing items, and more. The book also includes some errors, such as the misspelling of "Poké Ball" on pages 12 and 216. The game was released in Japan on November 21, 2003, and in North America on March 23, 2004, and it features support for Pokémon Ruby, Sapphire, Emerald, FireRed, and LeafGreen games. The title is the first 3D Pokémon video game with an RPG mode, allowing players to capture Pokémon that cannot be captured in other games. It also introduces Shadow Pokémon, which cannot be traded until they lose their Shadow status.
