OUR ENHANCED SERVICES

Contrast-Enhanced Mammography (CEM) is more the norm than the exception at SBC.

At (SBC), we are leading the way in breast cancer detection. For over three years, CEM has become the standard of care for approximately 80% of our patients. This advanced imaging technique combines conventional mammography with an intravenous iodine-based contrast agent, significantly enhancing the detection of breast cancer due to demonstration of tumor neovasculaity. Such enhancement is particularly crucial for patients with dense breast tissue, where conventional mammograms may be less effective.

CEM has been shown to detect up to 95% of cancers. Use of this advanced technique underscores SBC's commitment to providing the highest standard of care in breast cancer detection.

IMPLANT CLINIC

Under the leadership of Dr David Littlejohn (surgeon) we offer specialised screening for patients with breast implants, addressing concerns such as capsular contracture, implant malposition, breast deformity or loss of symmetry. Implant rupture (clinical and sub clinical), infection (clinical and sub clinical), implant related illness rippling and Anaplastic Large Cell Lymphoma (ALCL).

It is recommended that implants are checked annually as well as when a new clinical finding is noted.

UNDER 40'S RISK ASSESSMENT CHECK

For under 40's, a small investment in breast health can make a significant difference. Let's work together to make early detection the norm.

The under 40's program focuses on risk assessment to optimise early detection and education for women under 40, especially those with a family history of breast cancer. The program includes risk factor assessment, clinical examination and ultrasound, and, if appropriate, mammography, with results provided before the patient leaves and reports sent to the referring GP. There is a minimal out of pocket cost for this program, as our focus is education and early detection. As reported world wide there is an increasing incidence of breast cancer in younger women, and risk assessment at a young age is recommended to optimise screening protocols.

BCAL Diagnostics – have launched a breast cancer blood test, BREASTEST *plus*, which is aimed at women with a high level of mammographic breast density. SBC are supporting by providing a space for patients to have their blood test in our clinic. If you would like to know more, scan the code .
