

New UI Tabular View for Activity Screen



- Optimized loading and sorting improve responsiveness, especially when handling large datasets.


User Impact:

URL in description should be clickable in Application


Description: URLs included in the description field will be automatically converted into clickable links, allowing users to open them directly with a single tap or click.


Value Addition:
