We're delighted to have you with us for the Full Moon Rising weekend! Please take a moment to read the important info below to help ensure everyone enjoys a safe, comfortable, and magical experience.

Entry & Wristbands

- All campers must have a valid family ticket for either Friday or Saturday night to access the campsite.
- No ticket? You'll need to purchase one at the gate before entering.
- Wristbands must be worn at all times while onsite. They are your proof of entry and must not be removed or shared.
- Anyone not wearing a wristband will be asked to leave the premises.

Camping & Motorhome Guidelines

Tent Camping:

- Adult Only
- Pitch size: 3m x 3m
- One car per tent permitted
- Please keep your space clean and be mindful of your neighbours

Motorhomes:

- Must park at least 5m apart (fire safety requirement)
- Black waste can be emptied at the designated IBC tank

H Facilities Available

• Toilets: 2-3 Portaloo's located in this area

- **Drinking Water:** Safe-to-drink water tap available please use responsibly
- Black Waste Disposal: Campervan black waste only (IBC tank provided)
- Showers: X No shower facilities on-site

Fire & Cooking Safety

- Strictly no open fires, fire pits, or fireworks.

Safety & Security

- Onsite security operates from 6:00 PM to 2:00 AM (or later if required)
- Zero tolerance for:
 - Aggression or abuse toward staff or guests
 - o Antisocial or disruptive behaviour
- Anyone violating these rules will be removed immediately without refund.

Quiet Hours

- Please keep noise levels low after midnight
- No generators, unless pre-approved for medical needs
