Itinerary in Full

Day 1: Arrival in Koh Samui

Upon arrival at Samui Airport (please advise your arrival flight details), you will be met by your local English-speaking guide, who will assist with your transfer to your hotel.

Upon arrival at the hotel, proceed with check-in in accordance with the hotel's policy. The remainder of the day is yours to relax and enjoy at leisure.

Overnight at La Vida Koh Samui

Meals:

Day 2: Island Tour of Anghong National Park or Koh Tao & Koh Nanyuang

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, you will join a full day shared snorkelling boat tour exploring the stunning islands and scenery around Koh Samui.

- If your travel day falls on Monday, Wednesday, or Saturday, you will join the Anghong National Marine Park tour by speedboat.
- If your travel day falls on Tuesday, Thursday, or Sunday, you will join the Koh Tao & Koh Nanyuan tour by speedboat.

Please note that the program is flexible, and you may choose to swap the touring between Day 2 and Day 3 based on your preference. Please let us know your preference at the time of reservation.

Angthong Marine National Park by Speedboat

Operate: Mon / Wed / Sat



Pick up from the lobby at 08:00 AM for a full-day join-in excursion to Mu Ko Ang Thong National Marine Park. This spectacular marine park is an archipelago of around 40 islands featuring dramatic limestone mountains, dense tropical jungle, pristine white-sand beaches, fertile mangroves, waterfalls, and hidden coves and lagoons—an incredible natural oasis waiting to be explored. After boarding the boat, the first stop is a superb snorkeling site around Ko Wao, where you can discover vibrant marine life in crystal-clear waters. The journey continues with scenic cruising through the national park, offering excellent photo opportunities of the surrounding islands and limestone formations. During the day, enjoy kayaking along the coastline and climb to a panoramic viewpoint overlooking the famous Emerald Lake (Talay Nai),

a stunning hidden saltwater lagoon surrounded by towering cliffs. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant on Ko Phaluai. Afterward, relax on a beautiful and peaceful beach before returning to Ko Samui by speedboat in the afternoon. (*Approximate tour duration: 8 hours*)

Koh Tao & Koh Nangyuan by Speedboat

Operate: Tue / Thu / Sun



Spend a day island hopping in a tropical paradise with this daylong tour by speedboat. Depart from Koh Samui in the morning and board a speedboat that carries you across the azure seas for a day of swimming, snorkelling and relaxing. Visit Koh Tao and Koh Nang Yuan and marvel in the beautiful nature, on land and underwater. Tiny “turtle island” Koh Tao is one of the top destinations for diving and snorkelling. Ko Nang Yuan is a small island off the coast of Ko Tao. If time permits, you can climb up to one of the viewpoints on this tiny island and enjoy the beautiful view of the azure sea and nearby islands. Snorkel amidst expansive coral reefs and colourful marine life in several of the bays, and relax on the pristine beaches as you take in the views of lush green hills rising up on the island behind you. Along the way, enjoy a delicious lunch on Koh Tao and soak up as much of the sea as you can before heading back to Koh Samui at the end of your sun-drenched day. (The routing of the trip may be subject to change without prior notice depending on the sea level each day) (*Approximate tour duration: 8 hours*)

Notes:

- The monsoon season in Koh Samui typically runs from October to December, during which many boat operators may suspend trips due to sea conditions.
- The routing of the trip may be subject to change without prior notice depending on the sea level each day
- Ang Thong National Marine Park usually closes during the peak monsoon period, generally from 1 November to early December each year. Tours typically resume around mid-December. (*Dates are subject to change depending on weather conditions and park regulations.*)

Begin at the peaceful Wat Phu Khao Thong, a hillside temple offering panoramic island views and a strong sense of serenity. Here you will take part in a traditional monk blessing—a soulful experience believed to bring good luck and protection. Fans of *The White Lotus* will recognize this as the filming location for Piper's meditation retreat, adding a layer of pop culture allure to this sacred space. Next, visit a local coconut plantation, where you'll learn about one of the island's most iconic crops and its role in Samui's cultural and economic heritage. Discover how coconuts are harvested, processed, and used in everything from food to beauty products. Your journey concludes with a scenic drive to Overlap Rock, a dramatic granite boulder perched high above the island, offering sweeping 360-degree views of Samui's coastline, jungle, and offshore islets. It's the perfect place to pause, reflect, and capture the beauty of your surroundings. This private tour is ideal for couples, families, or solo travelers seeking a deeper, more meaningful way to experience Samui—where culture, nature, and storytelling come together in one unforgettable outing. *(Approximate tour duration: 4 hours)*

Optional tour:

Ethical Elephant Encounter – Half Day Morning or Afternoon – Shared Tour



Experience a meaningful and enriching morning at Samui Elephant Sanctuary, a pioneering ethical refuge dedicated to the care of rescued elephants. Set across 25 acres of peaceful, natural surroundings, the sanctuary provides a safe home for retired elephants that were once used in logging and tourism. Here, they are free to roam, forage, bathe, and socialize at their own pace, without rides or forced interactions. During your visit, you will learn about each elephant's story and the sanctuary's commitment to responsible and sustainable tourism. Guests are invited to prepare nutritious treats and feed the elephants from a respectful distance, allowing

for a safe and rewarding connection. This experience offers a deeper understanding of elephant welfare while supporting a compassionate approach to wildlife conservation in Thailand.
