Surrounded by ancient temples and quaint shopping streets, Tamarind Village takes its name from the magnificent 200 year old tamarind tree that shelters the hotel in a shady embrace. Set around a series of garden courtyards, the 41 guest rooms and 5 suites reflect the rich ethnic diversity of northern Thailand by using fabrics and patterns drawn from various tribes of the region. Intimate, serene and relaxing, Tamarind Village is an oasis of calm and tranquility, the perfect base for exploring Chiang Mai and beyond.

Itinerary in Full

Day 1: Arrival – Chiang Mai

Upon arrival at Chiang Mai Airport (please advise your arrival flight details), you will be warmly welcomed by your Discova English-speaking guide, who will assist with your transfer to your hotel.

Upon arrival at the hotel, proceed with check-in in accordance with the hotel's policy. The remainder of the day is yours to relax and enjoy at leisure.

Day 2: Elephant Nature Park - Half Day Morning



After breakfast at the hotel, depart at 08:30 AM for a half-day visit to Elephant Nature Park, a peaceful sanctuary dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation, and lifelong care of elephants and other animals. The journey begins with a scenic drive through the lush countryside surrounding Chiang Mai. Along the way, your guide will share insights into the sanctuary's conservation efforts and introduce some of the rescued and orphaned elephants you will meet during your visit, each with its own remarkable story. Upon arrival, spend time observing the elephants as they roam freely across the expansive natural grounds. Many of these gentle giants have been rescued from difficult circumstances and are now able to live peacefully, forming social bonds with other elephants and gradually rediscovering their natural behaviors. Watching the herds interact in this tranquil environment offers a meaningful and memorable glimpse into the lives of these magnificent animals. The sanctuary follows a strict ethical approach to wildlife care; therefore, there is no riding or bathing of elephants, allowing them to live without stress or interference. In addition to the elephants, the park also provides refuge for several other rescued animals that now thrive within the protected environment.

After this inspiring encounter, return to Chiang Mai in the afternoon, where the remainder of the day is yours to relax or explore at leisure.

Day 3: Visit Doi Suthep and Wat Phalat and Lanna Dinner Experience



Enjoy an early breakfast before your 8:30 AM departure from the hotel for a short drive to the Huay Kaew Waterfall by Songtaew (local truck). Lush greenery surrounds this cascading gem awaits via an easy-to-navigate nature trail. The revered Wat Pha Lat is next on our itinerary. Also known as the "Monastery at the Sloping Rock," it is a secluded Buddhist temple nestled in a lush forest region. It has earned the title hidden gem, known for its stunning setting and distinctive Lanna-style architecture, featuring intricate carvings and colorful murals. Clients can explore the temple grounds and admire the natural surroundings, including waterfalls and meditation caves. Finally, we head out up the snaking road heading up Suthep Mountain, where our last visit slowly emerges with every turn. Tucked away in the mountains at an elevation of 1,056 meters, the 14th-century Wat Prathat Doi Suthep contains a holy relic of the Lord Buddha. The temple compound offers exhilarating views of Chiang Mai and its surroundings

Return to your hotel. Free time for lunch at your own expense.



At 03:00 PM, depart the city for the scenic Hang Dong District, located just south of Chiang Mai. Your destination is the charming village of Ban Tawai, where you will visit a beautifully preserved teakwood house dating back more than 150 years. Owned by the Ruankaew–Yanon family—whose ancestors played an important role in shaping the local Lanna community—this historic home offers a glimpse into traditional northern Thai life. Meet your welcoming hosts and learn how their lifestyle and customs remain closely connected to those of their forebears from generations past. During your visit, explore the elegant teak residence and its tranquil surroundings before rolling up your sleeves to join your host family in preparing a traditional northern Thai meal. This hands-on experience provides a wonderful opportunity to learn authentic cooking techniques and local recipes that you can take home with you.

Dinner is served on the home's second-floor terrace, where you can enjoy your freshly prepared dishes while taking in panoramic views of the surrounding Lanna countryside and village life. After this memorable cultural and culinary experience, return to the city in the evening.
