We have been to Florida a number of times, we set a budget, create spreadsheets to track our spending and look for ways to save money, enabling us to maximise the enjoyment, without breaking into a hot sweat every time we checked our bank balance.

You may think that a holiday to Florida and Orlando in particular is out of you reach, but I'm here to share some invaluable tips to help save you money and I hope help you to make a dream trip actually become reality.

I hope that you find this guide useful, with tips and tricks to save money. But also offering invaluable knowledge from personal experience.

Don't get sucked into package holidays and what you think is a good price, it is ultimately over priced and you will be able to find it cheaper booking it yourself.









FLIGHTS



This without doubt is one of most expensive elements to a Florida holiday.

- Watch flights months before you intend to buy them, booking earlier tends to mean cheaper
- Make sure you go incognito to stop dynamic pricing, as your search engine will be watching your every move.
- Booking mid week is often cheaper
- Flying just before the school holidays begin, by a day or two, can save you significantly.
 (but we aware of any fines you may incur)
- Look for Flight Sales, they normally happen during Christmas and around Easter (depending on the airline)
- Look at alternative airports; They often offer cheaper flight prices when compared to Orlando.









Save Tescos points from you weekly food shop, petrol, mobiles etc to covert into Virgin points, then book reward seats to reduce cost. You can also do this with Avois and Sainsburys.

FLIGHTS

- Tampa is a much smaller airport, about 1hr 25 hour from Orlando.
- Miami is often the cheapest alternative, but factor in car hire or transportation and a hotel.
- You can get a train to Orlando called The Brightline tickets cost approx £62 per person, per journey.
- We flew into Miami with Virgin in July 2024 as the flight prices for 6 of us, including 4 adults, was £2000 less than flights to Orlando and also cheaper than Tampa.
- I found Miami airport easier to get through when compared to Orlando.
- Our hotel was £126 for a family room, our car hire was the same price from Orlando or Miami approx £800 for a 7 seater Jeep wagoner, with car seat.
- Look at economy light prices, 10KG luggage is included
- Classic economy tickets 23kg included were £800 more
- 1x 23kg is £120 return
- DO YOU NEED 23kg bags each??
- You do the maths

SELF CATERED VILLAS





- Self catered accommodation allow better bedroom options, also a washer dryer, games room and pool, often with pushchairs to borrow.
- Eat breakfast at the villa, make packed lunches to take to the parks and snacks.
- Have a mixture of takeaways, eating out and cooking in, after all you are on holiday!
- YOU DO NOT NEED TO PAY HUGE AMOUNTS FOR A THEMED PRINCESS BEDROOM YOUR CHILDREN WILL APPRECIATE EVERYTHING ANYWAY!
- There are plenty of areas around Orlando, We've stayed in Davenport twice, 20-30 mins from Disney and 45 mins from Universal, it offers more cost effective self-catering solutions.
- Many are on secure gated communities, some have shared pools with slides.
- I often use air b&b as I really like their customer favourite feature and their payment plan using Klarna is helpful to spread the cost, which is great for budget planning.
- We also book via VRBO from our own site www.kean4travel.co.uk/book/hotels

ORLANDO HOTELS

America is brilliant for large family rooms, offering two queen beds per room and often a sofa bed in the lounge area to accommodate a large family like ours. Some even offer two bedrooms with two queens beds and a kitchen/ lounge/ sofa bed.

- Some offer transportation to the parks or uber may work out cheaper than car hire and airport shuttle
- Unless you want a full Disney experience choose a non Disney hotel, there are plenty within 5 to 10 minutes from the parks, hotels on the 192 offer the best options budget hotel with lots of options for eating out.
- Look for rooms with microwaves and fridges

 The voco Kissimmee Orlando by IHG on the 192 is very well priced and offers a shuttle bus to Disney an airport shuttle, microwave and fridge. I know people who have stayed here and given it great reviews.

DISNEY HOTELS

- Disney's Value Resorts these are classed as Most Affordable....
- Price example- Family of 4 in April 2026 for 14 nts-
- All-Star Music Resort: Celebrates music with themed areas. £3018
- All-Star Sports Resort: Showcases sports-themed decorations. £3018
- All-Star Movie Resort: Features larger-than-life moviethemed decor. £3018
- Pop Century Resort: Takes guests on a nostalgic trip through different decades. £3802
- Art of Animation Resort: Immerses guests in the worlds of Finding Nemo, Cars, The Lion King, and The Little Mermaid, £4187
- Benefits of Staying at Disney Value Resorts
- These resorts offer the most budget-friendly accommodations within the Disney World Resort.
- Early theme park entry, Disney transportation, Disney dining reservations. No meals included, pick Lightning Lanes 7 day prior to arriving (if purchasing).









This is a huge cost, try to go when your kids are under 10 so you don't pay adult prices for everyone.

There are 4 parks -

- Magic Kingdom Known for its classic
 Disney fairytale experience with iconic
 landmarks like Cinderella Castle, meet
 your favourite characters, ride Tron
 and the runaway mine train.
- Epcot Is known for its diverse food area "eating around the world", Moana's journey of water and its 4 festivals.

- Disney Hollywood studios is where Star Wars fans will find iconic characters from the films, Build a drone in Galaxys edge and ride slinky dog coaster from Toy story.
- Animal Kingdom is where you'll find Pandora from Avatar, experience expedition Everest and go on a safari in Kilimanjaro.
- The are also two waterparks Blizzard beach and Typhoon Lagoon.







There are lots of options and it really depends on your time frame and what else you want to do as to what tickets you purchase.



- You can purchase 7/14 day park hopper tickets with water parks included. Book your tickets here

- Spend half a day in the parks and half the day at a waterpark.



- I book using attraction tickets or Florida tix and pay in instalments, with a small deposit.
- Most offer 14 days for the price of 7, but check the offer on at the time you book.






- Book direct from the USA Disney site, we used a VPN to be able to access their servers.
- We use VPN super unlimited proxy- with ads for free
- You will need to factor in parking costs at Disney, in 2024 it was \$30 per day
- We purchased a 3 day one park per day ticket, it was the most cost effective option with 5 adult tickets to buy. Unfortunately we couldn't go to Magic kingdom with this particular option, but we had already been.

Go to the Polynesian resort to WATCH THE MAGIC KINGDOM FIREWORKS from their beach and beat the crowds!





GETTING AROUND DISNEY

- If you plan to Drive you can park at each park for a daily fee, in 2024 it was \$30 Waterparks were free to park.
- Alternatively Book a hotel with a Disney shuttle offered
- Take Ubers or Lyft (this may work out very expensive)
- Once in the parks you can use the Monorail, bus or ferry to park hop.
- Magic Kingdom to Epcot: Take the express monorail or ferry to the TTC, then transfer to the Epcot monorail.

- Magic Kingdom to Hollywood Studios: Take a bus from Magic Kingdom's bus depot.
- Magic Kingdom to Animal Kingdom: Take a bus from Magic Kingdom's bus depot.
- Epcot and Hollywood Studios are the closest Disney parks, take the Skyliner, boats or a bus.





Buy a refillable popcorn bucket at Disney and take it with you every day you return you can refill for a few dollars and its a quick, yummy snack, take water bottles to refill for free at most vendors.

Take mini squash bottles from the UK to add to the water if you want some flavour.

• Eating in the parks can be pricey, You need to pre book restaurants on the my Disney experience app and you can order food from quick service outlets via the app too.

LIGHTNING LANE MULTI PASS

- Choose up to three Multi Pass experiences and arrival windows in a theme park each day of your trip in advance.
- Once in the park and have used your first Multi Pass reservation, you can make an additional selection (subject to availability).
- You can hold up to three at a time, making one new pass at a time throughout the day until park close.
- If you're park hopping, you can use Lightning Lane in multiple parks.
- Expect to pay \$15 to \$39 per person, per day for Lightning Lane Multipass,
- Guests of Disney Resort hotels and other select hotels can purchase and select their Lightning Lane passes up to seven days in advance for the entire length of their stay (up to 14 days)
- All other guests can purchase and select their passes up to three days in advance of their stay.

Hotels that offer 7 days in advance are -

- All Disney resort hotels
- Walt Disney world Dolphin Hotel
- Walt Disney Swan Hotel
 Shades of green
- Alternatively you can also buy individual lighting lanes for high demand attractions ranging from \$10 - \$25 per person per ride.











UNIVERSAL

Until Jan 2026 14 day unlimited tickets only include 1 day at Epic universe, from Jan 26 onwards, Epic will be included in the park hopper 14 days entry. Meaning all 4 parks are included in the park hopper and you can visit Epic as many times as you want over the 14 days.

On October 20th 2026 Volcano Bay is shut for routine maintenance, so the tickets reduce dramatically in price. You will still have 3 parks included to park hop, Universal, Islands of Adventure and Epic included to visit every day of your 14 day tickets.

- Buying on the USA site using a VPN will work work out cheaper if you only want 1 or 2 days and not a full 14.
- You can also buy them through
 Attraction tixs and Florida tix, but I highly recommend thinking about your itinerary and if it's actually worthwhile paying for 14 days.

UNIVERSAL HOTELS

Staying in a Universal hotel will offer you some perks,

- Value hotels are Endless summer Surfside and Dockside and Cabana Bay.
- All offer early park admission and a complimentary shuttle bus.
- Cabana Bay is also accessible to Universal and Islands of adventure via a pathway.
- All offer family rooms for up to 6 people.

- Prime hotel Adventura universal, it is also the closest to Volcano bay with direct access and walkable to both universal and Islands of adventure.
- Signature collection hotels, Hardrock, Lowes Royal pacific resort, Loews Portofino Bay Hotel, Loews Sapphire Falls Resort.

Perk-express passes to Universal and Islands of adventure for every day you stay on select attractions.

Note- Lowes Sapphire falls resort is a more affordable signature hotel, BUT DOES NOT COME WITH EXPRESS PASSES

Checking dates out of season via comparison sites could save you pounds

We stayed at the Lowes Royal pacific resort for one night and had express passes for both days, at both Universal and Islands of adventure.

For a family of up to 5 in July 2026 this would cost you £646 per night.

Express passes unlimited for 1 day and one park for a family of 4 would cost about the same.

Note - You will still need valid park tickets



Stay in a self catered villa for your trip, but book 1 night at Universal in a signature hotel to gain express passes for both days at Universal and Islands of Adventure.



NEW EPIC UNIVERSE HOTELS

- Prime value resorts Stella Nova Resort and Terra Luna Resort, both offer early access and complimentary shuttle bus.
- UNIVERSAL.
- Signature collection Universal Helios Grand Hotel at present does not offer express passes, but does have a Dedicated Entrance to Epic Universe.

Note - You will still need valid park tickets

CAR HIRE



Now I get that not everyone would want to drive in the US, but for us it offers freedom, the ability to explore, not only Orlando, but the whole of Florida too.

 Always compare prices using our website www.kean4travel.co.uk/book/car-rental



- Look for not only the best price, but also what the car hire company offers in terms of insurance coverage, excess damage, credit card excess, additional extra costs, like car seats and sat navs.
- It's worth noting that car seats in the UK will not meet standards in US so its not worth taking your own, rather than risking your insurance becoming invalid.
- Sat navs are also an unnecessary extra, google maps and maps on your phone work perfectly well, just buy a suction holder to attach your phone to the car from amazon and hey-presto you have a sat nav.
- If flying into an alternative airport to Orlando, check car pick up and drop off destinations and the price difference. It might be worth a round trip- Hey why not make it a road trip!
- Our car round trip from Miami cost us approx £800 for a 7 seater Jeep wagoner, with car seat.

- It is unlikely that your phone with have free data roaming in the USA
- There are lots of easy to install esims you can purchase via an app.
- We use Yesim, they are affordable (we've found them to be the cheapest), offer unlimited data and are very reliable.

We had first hand experience of this when our son had strep throat, they swabbed him and gave him antibiotics. It was easy to make an appointment online (I did it in Epcot). We paid \$200 and it was the same as our insurance excess so we didn't claim.
