OVERVIEW

The Certificate III in School Based Education Support is a practical course with topics relevant to the support of Educators in primary schools. You will learn individual literacy and numeracy development, contributing to the management and organisation of a classroom, safety and cultural diversity, identifying and supporting children at risk, administrative skills and more.

Through the Strategix Academy you will be better equipped for a position as a Teacher Aide and a range of other jobs. With the qualifications you gain through Strategix, you will have the edge to get the job you want. The Certificate III in Education Support also includes a work experience element.

Career Start

The Queensland Government are currently offering eligible Queenslanders access to government subsidised training through the Career Start funding.

To access this funding, a person must:

- be an Australian citizen or permanent resident living in QLD;
- be aged 15 years or older and not in school;
- not have completed another certificate III or higher-level qualification within the last 10 years.
- not currently be enrolled in another qualification *More eligibility criteria may apply
