## Career Boost

The Queensland Government are currently offering eligible Queenslanders access to government subsidised training through Career Boost funding.

To access this funding, a person must:

- be an Australian citizen or permanent resident Ŷ living in QLD;
- be aged 15 years or older and not in school;
- not have completed another certificate IV or higherlevel qualification within the last 10 years.
- not currently be enrolled in another qualification \*More eligibility criteria may apply
