Traineeship Incentives

Entry requirements

Entry to this qualification is open to students who hold:

- the Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care or
 - The Certificate III in Children's Services or Diploma of Early Childhood and demonstrate at least 12 months cumulative employment within the last 5 years
- or
- The CHCSS00147 Entry into Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care

Funding Eligibility

To access the Queensland Government subsidised funding, a person must:

- be an Australian citizen or permanent resident living in QLD;
- be aged 15 years or older and not in school;
- not have completed another certificate IV or higher-level qualification within the last 10 years.
- not currently be enrolled in another qualification
