

# AIS ARENA

**LOCATION:** 26 LEVERRIER ST, BRUCE ACT 2617

## TRANSPORT INFORMATION:

- AIS Arena is served by public transport.
- If you are travelling from Belconnen Town Centre, catch the R9 bus stopping at Battye St opposite CIT Bruce.
- If you are travelling from the City, catch the R1 bus to Dickson, then the R9 bus stopping at Battye St opposite CIT Bruce.
- Further information to help planning your journey can be found on Transport <u>Canberra</u>.

### **PARKING:**

- Car Park 5 located across from the AIS Arena and at the corner of Leverrier Street and Battye Street has parking available for a fee. Payment can be made by card only.
- This car park can accommodate buses.
- Access to Car Park 5 is available via Battye Street and Podium Way. • Dedicated accessible parking facilities are available close to the AIS' main
- entrances. Cars may exit the AIS via Battye and Leverrier Street.

### Hot snacks, packaged food and drink options will be available for purchase within the AIS Arena during the game.

- conjunction with each event: Alcohol
- Knives or other dangerous weapons

- Incendiary devices (e.g., flares, fireworks, smoke bombs)
- Firearms, explosives, chemical, radioactive, or biological substances Laser lights
- Missiles/projectiles of any description Bags over size 45cm x 35cm (40 litres and under)
- Glass containers
- Aerosols of any type Promotional items intended for resale
- Drones or unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs) Non-accredited photographic equipment or recording devices for commercial
- purposes Any signs, banners, or materials displaying offensive or inappropriate content or unauthorised commercial or promotional content
- Any item determined by the AIS that may interfere with the security of the premises or cause injury, public nuisance, or which is deemed dangerous or hazardous to fellow attendees.
- Umbrellas that are unable to fit within a small bag. **ACCESSIBILITY:** 
  - The AIS Arena is an accessible site with lift access from the Ground Level of

## the Visitor Centre to floor seating (Basement Level) and Door 2 (Level 2) for

- access to the concourse seating. Accessible bathrooms are available in the Visitor Centre on Ground Level prior to entering Door 1, and on Level 1, prior to entering Door 2 (entry vial
- Level 2). Accessible bathrooms are also available within the AIS Arena at the Northern end of the floor and concourse. We strongly encourage to leave any prams and strollers in your car to allow for a smooth access to the venue as there is no dedicated pram parking

- within the venue.
