## Texas WIC Program

### WOMEN, INFANT, & CHILDREN SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION PROGRAM

#### Provides Healthy Foods For:

- Pregnant Women
- Postpartum women up to 6 months after pregnancy ends (includes miscarriage, stillbirth, adoption, abortion)
- Breastfeeding women until their infant's first birthday
- Infants and children up to age 5

#### Breast Feeding Education

- Advice and instruction on breastfeeding, breast pumps, nursing bras, and breast pads.
- Mom 2 Mom Breastfeeding Support Group - Referrals to additional health and social service programs

The epidemiology section maintains a public health database and collects and reports information that supports health assessment, planning, and response. Information collected includes:

- Chronic Disease
- Natural Epidemics
- Public Health Threats

Information is reported to the National Electronic Disease Surveillance System (NEDSS)
