Or take the family in Business Class with points or 48% off with cash

Ladies and gentlemen, or as we say Down Under, blokes and sheilas, g'day. It's your FCF Aussie correspondent Dazza Dundee (no relation).

Now my mate Bennett tells me that some of you are fair dinkum **busting** to come down here for a holiday, and I can't blame you. Look at me, I've just been for a dip at the lagoon and I'm on my way for a barbie at my mate Speedbump's house. They call him that because people go out of their way to avoid him. A barbie is a BBQ by the way. I thought I'd better mention that.

Anyway, there's plenty of sun and sand to share, and we love you Yanks even if you drive on the wrong side of the road.

Now I know it costs a lot of cabbage to get here, so Bennett has found a way — even if you want to bring your other half and a couple of sprogs! That's right, award availability for up to two seats in First Class and up to four seats in Business Class. That's a dead-set beauty. Crikey — come on down!

RIPPER DEAL: 2X FIRST CLASS TICKETS WITH POINTS OR 4X BUSINESS CLASS

Consider that fares Down Under can run \$19,000+ in First Class and \$9,946+ in Business Class to the South Pacific. Starve the lizards!

Qantas is an Amex partner, so you can buy points at 2.5 cents each and you'd still save up to \$11,103/56%. Mate, I could buy a ute with that.

And the Uluru-sized news flash to share is that we found First Class seats for two on the Los Angeles-Sydney route using 162,800 miles each way (which you can get via points transfers with Amex, Capital One, and Citi).

Oh, and we love kids here at FCF, so we're a great source for finding award seat availability. See our [Sweet Redeems](#) alert in the FCF newsroom.

And to that point, we found Business Class seats for 4+ travelers on the Los Angeles-Brisbane route using 108,400 Qantas miles each way, and award seats for 2+ travelers from Dallas and Los Angeles to Melbourne and New York to Auckland.



Rome in Prima Class: 58% Off with Cash, 667K Fewer Miles, Plus the St. Regis for 47% Off

April 2024

Ah, Roma.

The city where old meets new in the most spectacular way. Cobblestone streets, the Coliseum, the Spanish Steps, the Trevi Fountain, chianti with pasta carbonara, Vatican City, and St. Peter's Basilica... I could go on for *eons*.

Located on the banks of the Tiber, Italy's capital is essentially one *grande* museum with so many world-class antiquities and landmarks that the entire historic city center was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. More than 900 churches are overflowing with works by masters such as Bernini, Raphael, Caravaggio, and Michelangelo. And who can resist *la dolce vita*, that carefree celebration of life's beauty and pleasure as only the Italians know how?

An eternal visit begs an unforgettable flight and American Airlines has come to the party with their B-777 offering First Class on their New York-Rome route now through October 19.

We’ve seen fares mid-week for as low as \$3,679 (screenshot below) for travel in July and August. If you don’t grab this low First Class fare you can expect to pay anywhere from \$4,667 to \$8,800.

Compare this to non-stop **Business Class** fares on American, which range from \$2,479 to \$5,404, Delta, which range from \$2,553 to \$6,804, and ITA, which range from \$2,553 to \$4,117.

Or, compare this to one-stop **First Class** fares on British Airways with a stop in London. BA closely matches the fare for travel from July to March at \$3,696. Otherwise, fares range from \$3,984 to \$6,071. Meanwhile, Lufthansa ranges from \$6,567 to \$15,300, and SWISS ranges from \$6,592 to \$15,600. Those are ranges as high as the Alps!

GROSSO FARES? HERE'S AN ITALIAN JOB TO LOWER THEM

When fares are high (\$5,000+) consider using American miles. Award seat costs range from 72,000 to 440,000(!) each way. As we told you last month, you can [save miles by making a connection](#). The same concept rings true here, as you'll see below. Here's a trick on how to score award seats at the lowest prices.

A STUPENDA FIND

If you are flying directly from New York in July (screenshot below), you will see awards every day for 405,500 one way. But have a look at this: if you fly from Columbus to Rome via New York on July 8 — on the same flight — you will pay just 72,000 miles one way. You can find this 72,000-mile award availability using American miles for travel close to departure, randomly throughout the year, or when adding a connection through New York from an AA hub city, as shown with Columbus.

NO MILES? NO PROBLEM

When you can find low-cost award seats using American miles, you can buy 144,000 miles when they are on sale for approximately 2.4 cents each to net up to 30% savings versus published fares. Or you can buy 170,000 Alaska miles when they're on sale for about 1.74 cents each for up to 40% savings. That's pretty great when you end up in a First Class seat jetting all the way to and from Rome, an 8+-hour flight from New York.

The cost using British Airways and Iberia is 206,000 miles round-trip. British Airways taxes run around \$2,053, while Iberia's taxes are just \$430 round-trip. If you have a ton of Amex points, it's just 159,000 with British Airways' frequent 30%-40% bonus. Combine them with your Iberia Avios miles and you'll save \$1,623 on taxes. If you had to buy the miles from Amex at 2.5 cents each, you'd save about 19% when using Iberia miles. It's still not a great deal when fares are at their lowest, but if you're an inflexible traveler with firm dates, you might just have to grin and bear it.

FIRST CLASS AWARD SEAT AVAILABILITY TRENDS

A First Class flight to Rome is usually the stuff of mythology. But American Airlines has made it possible in the most *bellissimo* way — in widebody comfort.

Low-cost award seat availability using American miles is plentiful for up to four travelers in July on the outbound, with a handful of days with seats for travel in April, June, and August. We have seen quite a few days with seats for up to four travelers available on the return for close-in travel in April, June, and July, along with a handful of days with seats in May, August, and September. American is notorious for releasing low-cost award space close in, so that might be a good backup plan or a great chance to [upgrade a less attractive existing ticket](#).

Award seat availability is a bit less using partners Alaska, British Airways, and Iberia miles. You can typically find seats for up to two travelers in June, and in April for a few days outbound, and June and July on the return. Though we have seen days with seats for up to four travelers in July outbound.

OH BY THE WAY, YOU'LL WANT TO STAY AT THE ST. REGIS, ROME

We love the [American Bar Association](#) membership discount strategy here at FCF and have reported on it many times including [here](#), [here](#), and [here](#). An ABA membership offers great luxury accommodation discounts at top-end hotels such as the Four Seasons, Luxury Collection, Ritz-Carlton, Savoy (Fairmont), St. Regis, and Westin properties, among others. Membership is just \$150 annually, paltry considering how it unlocks fantastic deals. Better still, [you don't have to be a lawyer or judge to join!](#)


Case in point: with the membership, you can save 47% at the St. Regis Rome. The screenshot below shows the average price per night is \$1,291 BEFORE the ABA membership discount, and just \$636 per night AFTER the discount is applied.

First Class deals to Europe are harder to find than a pair of long trousers in a lederhosen haystack.

First off, there are only a few airlines that offer a First Class cabin to Europe and it's nearly impossible to find flash fares like you can for Business Class, apart from the odd British Airways deals. Similarly, First Class

mileage awards are often hard to find on the few airlines that offer them, especially if you don't know where to look.

So in December 2022, we clinked our steins when we reported that you could [get First Class tickets for \\$1,722 each way](#) with Lufthansa's new buy-miles program launch thanks to a discount that was good for 60 days.

And then we slapped our knees, feet, and each other when the airline brought the sale back and had four buy miles promos in 2023 offering a range from 20% to 60% bonus miles – from 1.25 cents to 1.52 cents per mile.

In March 2023, we did a deeper dive into how you could use the strategy to [get connections from all over the U.S. to all over Europe](#). And in November we showed you how use FCF's Upgrade Strategy to get Lufthansa First Class to Europe for Just \$1,480 Each way.



UND NOW THE SALE IS BACK

So far, this is the second promo of 2024; the most recent one ended on March 31 and had a 30% bonus. But here we are in April already and the sale is back – with a 50% bonus at 1.39 cents a mile through April 30, which results in First Class tickets that go for as much as \$13,753+, for just \$3,404.



Any way you put it:

You can [join Lufthansa's Miles and More program in less than five minutes](#) and [buy miles in another five](#). And that goes for anyone.

[Lufthansa's Bundle&Go](#) deal lets you purchase award miles in three increments of 10,000, 50,000, and 100,000 miles with a juicy 50% bonus coming on top of that right now. If you max out one account, with the bonus, you can get 350,000 miles for \$3,404, or about 1.39 cents a mile. Members can purchase one bundle per transaction, and bonus miles do not count towards the annual limit of 250,000. That's tremendous value given the ways you can redeem the miles. If you need even more miles, remember [FCF's special strategy to get all the miles you want!](#)

Note that Lufthansa's [fine print](#) indicates it could take up to five days for the miles to post. However, when we did it, they were credited almost instantly, minus one occasion it took about 48 hours.

REAL OR POLTERGEIST?

The success of this play depends on whether Lufthansa makes their First Class seats available when you search for them online, right? The problem is that there are always routes with deals; it's just that where they are is always changing. (Always keep in mind [positioning flights](#).)

The routes and months below had First Class available at time of publication. So, check with the airline for the most up-to-date information before buying any miles, unless you know you'll be able to use them eventually, like me, and just buy them when on sale so they are at the ready.

ROUTES WITH UP TO FOUR AWARD SEATS

From Chicago to Frankfurt, you can find more than a handful of days with four seats available for outbound travel from December to March. On the return, more than a handful of days with four seats are available for travel in January and February.

From Los Angeles to Munich, you can find a handful of days with four seats available for travel both outbound and return in April.

ROUTES TO/FROM FRANKFURT WITH UP TO TWO AWARD SEATS

From Boston to Frankfurt, you can find more than a handful of days with two seats available for both outbound and return travel from November through March.

From Houston to Frankfurt, seats are plentiful, you can find more than a handful of days with two seats available for both outbound and return travel from October through March.

From New York to Frankfurt, you can find more than a handful of days with two seats available for both outbound and return travel in January and a handful of days for both outbound and return travel in December and February.

From Washington, DC to Frankfurt, you can find more than a handful of days with two seats available for outbound travel in January and February. On the return, more than a handful of days with two seats are available for travel in July, August, January, and February.

ROUTES TO/FROM MUNICH WITH UP TO TWO AWARD SEATS

From Boston to Munich, you can find more than a handful of days with two seats available for travel outbound in July, and in June on the return. There are also a handful of days for both outbound and return travel in April, August, and October.

From Chicago to Munich, there are a handful of days for both outbound and return travel in August and September.

From New York to Munich, you can find more than a handful of days with two seats available for both outbound and return travel in July.

From Washington, DC to Munich, you can find more than a handful of days with two seats available for outbound travel in July and August. On the return, there are more than a handful of days with two seats available for travel in May, June, August, and September.

Here’s an email I received from a member who saw the alert and scored!









“Hi Mr. Upgrade,

Multi-year subscriber here, just thought I’d let you know that the flash fare LAX-Sydney/Brisbane/Melbourne, etc. in today’s email is by far the biggest savings you’ve ever helped me capture.


I fly back and forth to Brisbane almost every month and Business Class fares hover around \$12K. I just booked three flights across the rest of the year LAX-SFO-BNE for \$3,900 each or a savings of about \$7,500 per flight x 3 flights.”

Just to put that into perspective: for our reader, that’s a savings of \$22,500!

Just in case you missed it, because United is notorious for making award seats available close to departure... if you are a bags-packed traveler or looking for a last-minute upgrade, you can get Business Class award seats for 100,000 miles one way. No miles? No problem. You can buy United miles for typically around 1.8 cents each when on sale.


Not everyone [can be that flexible](#). Just because you already booked a flight doesn't mean you shouldn't continue to monitor the deals. You can usually grab the better deal, and use credit for your first booking later. Just make sure to check the rules of your ticket.

FCF's U-Turn Strategy Can Net First Class for Less than Biz

Turn around and save big

We've written recently about our highly lucrative [U-Turn strategy in Business Class](#). That's where Europe-U.S.-Europe round-trips cost WAY less than U.S.-Europe-U.S. round-trips. The strategy is that if you make a "U-Turn" and start your journey in Europe, you end up saving a lot. Today we're looking at the **U-Turn strategy in First Class**.

Of course, you need to get to Europe to start the strategy, and you'll end up in Europe at the end of the round-trip so you'll need to book a trip back to the U.S. As we'll demonstrate, with the "keep it going" strategy, you can launch more "U-Turn" trips from Europe. And, as economists will tell you: the more you make, the more you save.

For example, Oneworld round-trip fares are up to 53% less from Europe versus those from the U.S. Despite the potential negative of starting in Europe, those savings are enough to make you take notice.

Let's go to the chart for the good stuff. Here are straight-up comparisons of First Class round-trips *from* Europe and *from* the U.S. Just look at those price differences — up to 53% for Dallas-Amsterdam! And remember, these are the exact same flights and class of service, just in the opposite direction.

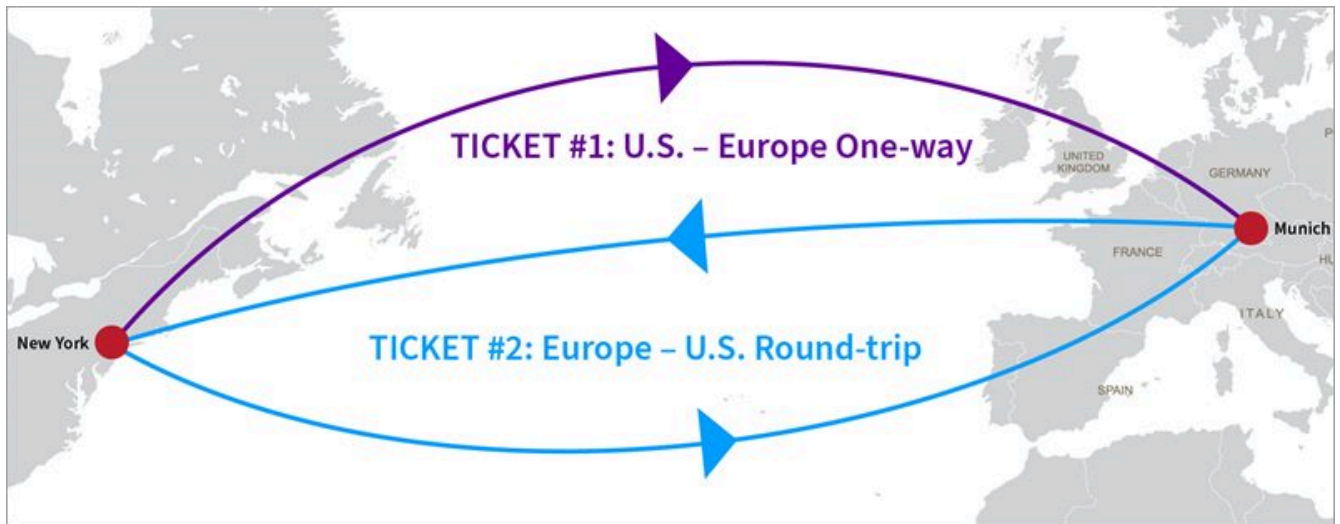
U GOTTA BE KIDDING: TWO WAYS TO FLY FIRST CLASS TO EUROPE USING THE U-TURN STRATEGY

FCF'S FIRST CLASS U-TURN STRATEGY #1: THE "KEEP IT GOING" PLAY

Start with a one-way ticket to Europe (probably with miles) then book your round-trip fares originating in Europe.

If you want to avoid high First Class fares originating in the U.S., book a low-fare round-trip from Europe to the U.S. Remember, since your fare starts in Europe, you'll have to get yourself there first. You can do this with a one-way flight, and [paying in miles is often best for one-ways](#). Then you can *keep your trip going* by buying another round-trip ticket from Europe to the U.S. as many times as you like. As mentioned, you'll multiply your savings as a result.

Here's what it looks like:

check the fare rules. But if, for example, you're taking your son to college in Europe, spending some time at home in the U.S., and then going back to Europe for vacation, or you know half of your dates in advance, it works well.

FCF'S FIRST CLASS U-TURN STRATEGY #2: "MIXED CLASS AND ALLIANCE" PLAY

Bookends With Business Class Mileage-Award/s + Low Published First Class Fare EU→U.S.→EU.

Here we're bookending the First Class round-trip that starts in Europe with two low-cost Business Class one-way awards.

Use different classes and airline alliances because there's no telling how much inter-alliance airlines communicate, and they might consider this a back-to-back ticketing situation, which is generally not allowed. WHO IS U-TURN STRATEGY #2 FOR?

The Sometimes-Flexible Travelers: Since there aren't many First Class flight options that are attainable using miles, Business Class award seats are likely more plentiful and easier to find. And remember, there's only one way to get a round-trip mileage award ticket to Europe nowadays, and that's if you're flexible. In this case, you can use miles to easily get to and from Europe in Business Class.

That said, your flight originating from Europe in the middle is a published First Class fare so you can be more selective with your dates. In other words, you only need to be flexible on the award ticket portion of your trip.

And just to further the value of this strategy, compare a round-trip booking from the U.S. to Europe in Business Class to a round-trip from Europe to the U.S. in First Class. In all of the examples in the chart, the First Class

cost is *less* than Business Class for essentially the same flights. Yes, that's an upgrade!

Air France and KLM's Low- Priced Award Opportunities Get You Premium Economy for the Price of Coach

No need to feel blue: Air France and KLM save you up to 43% in Premium Economy

Flying Blue is the joint loyalty program of Air France, KLM, and a few other smaller European carriers. We've just shone our third-degree light onto Flying Blue to uncover some opportunities in Premium Economy.

First, let's take a quick look at the current state of play for fares and awards.

CURRENT PREMIUM ECONOMY BASELINE FARE TRENDS

Air France and KLM's fares are often highest when they're booked within 14 days and between 30 to 60 days of departure; or when you [don't have the minimum-stay requirement](#). Consider [positioning flights](#) when special fares [are not offered on your route](#).

- **Air France**

- **Atlanta to Paris:** typical fares range from \$2,859 to \$4,239+.

- **KLM**

- **Atlanta to Amsterdam:** typical fares range from \$2,462 to \$3,752+.

CURRENT PREMIUM ECONOMY BASELINE MILEAGE TRENDS

Air France and KLM both have a dynamic award pricing structure and have recently reduced the cost of awards on Air France to Paris and KLM to Amsterdam starting at 35,000 miles each way on many routes from the U.S.

FOR COMPARISON

American charges between 19,000 and 68,500 miles for Economy and between 47,000 and 145,000 for Premium Economy from New York to Paris, each way.

Delta ranges from 52,000 to 100,000 miles for Economy and 90,000 to 160,000 for Premium Economy, each way.

United is between 40,000 and 70,000 miles for Economy and 88,000 to 120,000 for Premium Economy, each way.

NO MILES? JUST SAY *OUI*

Typical everyday mileage costs run about 2.44 cents each. But Flying Blue frequently offers mileage purchase bonuses, and the current one runs through April 25 with a 35% bonus if you buy 100,000 miles (the maximum allowed per year) directly from the airline. That means you can get up to 135,000 miles with the bonus.

On Air France's Atlanta-Paris route, this works out to about 1.81 cents each and a savings of up to \$1,242 / 43% when compared to typical published fares. That's smart buying — [using a strategy we absolutely love](#) here at FCF.

We often talk about buying miles [when published premium fares are high](#), such as when they're \$2,000+ for Premium Economy international tickets. Here's a look at the savings:

TRANSFER PARTNERS

Air France/KLM's Flying Blue loyalty program has many points-to-miles transfer partners including Amex Rewards, Capital One, Chase, and Citi.

You can buy up to 500,000 annually from Amex Membership Rewards for 2.5 cents each and transfer them to Flying Blue. Check out [How to buy American Express Membership Rewards points](#), and FCF's [Beginner's Guide: how to play the "Buy Miles to Fly In Style"](#).

Air France and Amex offer transfer bonuses periodically. Their most recent bonus in September 2023 was 25%. This brings the mileage transfer cost down from 70,000 to just 56,000 miles for a round-trip ticket in Premium Economy.

MILEAGE AWARD TAXES

Air France/KLM typically charge around \$350 in taxes for Premium Economy awards, round-trip, however this does vary based on the route.

Below are the routes with award availability at the time of publication, but they will certainly change with time.

NOT FLYING TO PARIS OR AMSTERDAM? GET CONNECTING FLIGHTS WITHIN EUROPE

You can fly almost anywhere in Europe on one ticket: Air France and KLM offer awards that allow connections on the flights it operates, as well as its partners. That means you can add on the following destinations as long as they're available beyond Paris or Amsterdam with the airline or its partners: Athens, Barcelona, Berlin, Bordeaux, Brussels, Bucharest, Copenhagen, Dublin, Edinburgh, Frankfurt, London, Malta, Oslo, Porto, Prague, Rome, Split, Stockholm, Venice, Warsaw, and Zurich, to name a few.

When booking a connecting flight, we recommend checking each segment separately first, starting with the most important over-the-water flight. You can add a connection to your nonstop route (depending on availability). But be aware that you'll have to spend more miles to add these connecting flights.

EASY AWARD SEAT SEARCHES

Air France/KLM have come a long way in terms of functionality. It is now possible to search for award space for many months at a time. The trick is to leave the calendar date blank as you see below and use the calendar as a guide to the lowest fares. Note that this calendar method seems to be a bit glitchy and sometimes the award amounts don't match what's on the calendar.
