







WHAT WERE THE SOURCES OF OUR GRANTS



MOBILITY & HEALTH

UNHCR | Caritas | Enhancing the situation and living conditions of refugees with disabilities in Beirut and Mount Lebanon | 38,776\$
[2019] Offers on-the-job training, and provision of paramedical services and technical aid for refugees with disabilities in Beirut and Mount Lebanon with the aim of enhancing their living conditions.

Comunidad de Madrid | AIDA | Improving the living conditions of Syrian refugees and Lebanese individuals with mobility and chronic diseases in Lebanon | 50,500€
[2019-2020] Responds to the health needs of the refugee and host communities, notably people with special needs in Beirut and the Bekaa region.

Generalitat Valenciana | AIDA | Musawah: Reducing the vulnerability of Syrian and Palestinian refugees, and of Lebanese | 67,128€
[2019-2020] Aims at reducing the vulnerability of Syrian, Lebanese, and Palestinian underprivileged population in Beirut through the provision of physiotherapy sessions and technical aids.

RESPONSIBLE TOURISM & CULTURE HERITAGE

British Council | Search for common grounds | Tourathing | 41,619 GBP
[2017-2019] Bridges geographic and sectarian divisions through the promotion of a shared Lebanese cultural heritage among youth in both rural and urban areas; builds skills in recording and sharing historical information, as well as reaching across dividing lines to protect cultural heritage and contribute to healing fractures in the Lebanese society.

British Council | Dome houses from Syria: protection of an endangered cultural heritage | 84,616 GBP
[2018-2019] Protects and revives the Syrian architectural heritage of domed mud-brick houses, by providing training to refugee and host communities, constructing a pilot dome house at arcenciel's Taanayel center, drafting a manual on this endangered 5,000-year-old building technique of war-torn Syria.

SOCIAL ACTION

AFD | Social protection for vulnerable people | 1,547,500€
[2018-2020] Strengthens the capacity of few Lebanese municipalities with high concentrations of refugees; puts in place a social protection system for 10,000 Lebanese and refugees living in the Akkar, Bekaa and Beirut regions; responds to the communities' special needs with medical and paramedical care, technical aid, psychosocial activities and professional trainings as well as the identification, monitoring and referral of beneficiaries to social, health and youth services promoting the development and dignity of all.

Canton de Genève | Ushagram | Agricultural and artisan training for Syrian refugee women | 59,000\$
[2018-2019] Promotes economic resilience and autonomy of Syrian refugee families in Al Qaa through agricultural and artisan training for Syrian refugee women.

OCHA | Helpage | Promotion of access to services for persons with specific needs in Akkar district, Lebanon | 65,177\$
[2018-2019] Promotes protection and access to services for displaced Syrian and Lebanese older men and women, as well as adults with physical disabilities living in Akkar district, North Lebanon.

Junclair | Wise | Capacity building and empowerment of vulnerable Lebanese women and Syrian refugees in Lebanon | 303,042€
[2019-2021] Reduces the social and economic vulnerabilities of 120 Syrian and Lebanese women by strengthening their capacities, through promoting the sustainable development of their small businesses and through the formation of self-help groups among micro-entrepreneurs.

Bureau of Population, Refugee and Migration | Near East Foundation | Reducing Vulnerability of Syrian Refugees and Lebanese in Lebanon III | 107,130\$
[2018-2019] Aims at improving the economic wellbeing and self-reliance of 1,222 refugee and Lebanese households, measured by increased income or savings or reduced use of harmful strategies. It also provides access to 1,643 individuals to livelihoods information, skill building resources, and referrals.

Canton de Genève | Ushagram | Empower vulnerable women in the Bekaa region | 22,500\$
[2019] To perpetuate the center's work to empower vulnerable women in the Bekaa region by enhancing their socio-economic conditions through the acquisition of accredited skills.

CORE-FUNDING

Diakonia | arcenciel core-funding | 325,444\$
[2016-2020] Supports arcenciel's 2016-2020 development through core-fund for the period between January 1st, 2016 and December 31st, 2020.

Association Philippe Jabre | arcenciel core-funding
[2001- to date] Supports arcenciel's activities as well as contributes to education and health by covering scholar and hospitalisation fees. APJ has been supporting arcenciel with recurrent annual funding since 2001.

SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE & ENVIRONMENT

Agnes Varis | aec USA | Production of biogas and organic fertilizer | 50,475\$

[2018-2019] Simulates anaerobic fermentation on a small-scale pilot to produce biogas, a digestate that could be tested as an organic fertilizer and collects data on the biogas production process.

Agnes Varis Trust | aec USA | Urban gardening at arcenciel | 20,531\$
[2018-2019] Creates and cultivates an urban gardening rooftop project at arcenciel's Jisr el Bacha center.

Coopération Italienne | INTERSOS | Raising awareness of national resource management | 140,415€

[2018-2020] Contributes to the improvement of the quality of life, hygiene conditions, and the management of the environment in the Union of Tyre through implementation of a municipal integrated waste management system with a new sorting and recycling unit in Ain Baal and by raising community awareness of the area's 15,000 inhabitants.

European Union | ACF | Protection of coastal zones and maritime resources | 1,497,855\$

[2018-2020] Contributes to the protection of coastal zones and maritime resources from environmental degradation by confronting and managing land-based sources of pollution.

Private foundation | Optimisation and development of waste sorting technology | 215,300\$

[2018-2019] Optimises the waste sorting station at the arcenciel Taanayel Center and develops an app which improves collection and sorting of waste at the center.

Private foundation | Infectious healthcare waste management in Saida | 1,200,000\$

[2018-2019] Provides for a new Microwave sterilizing machine in Saida in order to maintain and expand arcenciel's Infectious Health Care Waste (IHCW) management in the region.

CEI | ENGM | Rural development of small farmers in the Bekaa | 310,576€

[2018-2022] Expands the capacities of the small farmers in the Bekaa through training and services at the Domaine of Taanayel; expands the capacities of the employees at the Domaine of Taanayel through training; rehabilitates a building to host the farmers and events.

[2019-2022] Copes with environmental, economic and social problems of organic waste mismanagement in three Mediterranean Countries, develop policy tools, innovative technical solutions and improved pilot compost sites, and support territorial enterprises actives in the circular economy, as well as information and advocacy campaigns to influence attitudes towards the zero waste and circular economy paradigm, on multiple levels.

Swiss Municipalities | Ushagram | Rural development in Lebanon for the host population and Syrian refugees | 42,555 \$

[2018-2020] Installation of drinking water and storage system in the Halba refugee camp, and equipment of the training room for the area's residents in computers, projection equipment, tables and chairs.

UNICEF | Strengthening the supply chain of UNICEF's vaccination campaign through waste management | 135,076\$

[2019] Expanded arcenciel's hospital waste processing to respond to UNICEF's Accelerated Immunization Activities in collaboration with MoPH in order to ensure that the campaign's entire value chain is properly handled from the vaccination point to the produced waste treatment.

YOUTH SUPPORT

Private foundation | Education and psychosocial activities for youth of Halba, Akkar and Beirut/Mount Lebanon | 183,290\$

[2018-2019] Provides soft skills/psychosocial activities for marginalized youth in the areas of Akkar and Beirut/Mt.Lebanon, aiming to improve social cohesion between host and refugee communities; also improving the infrastructure at the arcenciel center in Halba to host refugee and local youth communities.

UNICEF | Education, child protection, health and social inclusion services | 285,567\$

[2018-2019] Provides education, protection and health services for children with moderate and severe disabilities in the Akkar and Bekaa regions of Lebanon; enrolls 110 Syrian refugee children with disabilities in its specialized classes in Taanayel, and provides therapy to the children in Taanayel and Halba.
