



Case Study - Medical Archive Relocation - Royal Brompton to Harefield Hospital

Scope and Requirements

J.A. Steel & Son Ltd, a specialist relocation provider with 40+ years of experience, was appointed principal contractor for the secure relocation of the Royal Brompton Hospital's medical library and archive storage to Harefield Hospital, both sites within the same NHS Trust. Our longstanding relationship with Royal Brompton Charity enabled collaborative planning for this highly sensitive task.

This case study is **directly aligned with the Lot's scope**, covering secure medical facility relocations requiring handling of classified materials, specialist logistics, and NHS operational compliance. It is tailored specifically to this Lot and is not applicable across multiple Lots.

Project Summary & Delivery Approach

The objective was to securely transfer over 2000 metres of clinical, academic, and reference materials from a live-working hospital environment. The operation required minimal disruption to hospital activity, strict safety controls, and complete inventory integrity. An in-house **Move Manager** was appointed to design a phased programme structured around the hospital's operations. Move teams operated out of hours where possible, coordinating daily with the Royal Brompton Charity's Estates team to uphold infection control, access restrictions, and noise thresholds.

Key actions included:

- Systematic packing of shelving contents into sealed, lidded crates
- Real-time crate inventory using a bespoke barcode tracking system
- Secure transport to Harefield Hospital and reinstallation of archive systems
- Staff trained to NHS archival standards for data confidentiality and material integrity

Risk Management and Challenges

The hospital remained operational throughout, creating multiple risks. Our **Health & Safety team** conducted full site assessments pre-move, and stayed on-site for live monitoring.

Key mitigations included:

- Segregated pedestrian & operational walkways, signposted and cordoned
- Colour-coded access control system for staff clearance
- Sound-dampening trolleys & sealed crates to control noise and contamination
- Daily safety briefings and stakeholder updates

No incidents or disruptions occurred during the project. Health, safety, and patient wellbeing were maintained throughout.
