



VERIFICATION OPINION DECLARATION GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

To: The Stakeholders of Hannon Armstrong Sustainable Infrastructure Capital, Inc.

Apex Companies LLC, (Apex) was engaged to conduct an independent verification of the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reported by Hannon Armstrong Sustainable Infrastructure Capital, Inc. (HASI) for the period stated below. This verification opinion declaration applies to the related information included within the scope of work described below.

The determination of the GHG emissions is the sole responsibility of HASI. HASI is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the GHG emissions statement in accordance with the criteria. Apex's sole responsibility was to provide independent verification on the accuracy of the GHG emissions reported, and on the underlying systems and processes used to collect, analyze, and review the information. Apex is responsible for expressing an opinion on the GHG emissions statement based on the verification. Verification activities applied in a limited level of assurance verification are less extensive in nature, timing, and extent than in a reasonable level of assurance verification.

Boundaries of the reporting company GHG emissions covered by the verification:

- Operational Control
- Offices in New York and Maryland
- Exclusions: Refrigerants

Types of GHGs: CO₂, N₂O, CH₄

GHG Emissions Statement:

- Scope 1: 0 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
- Scope 2 (Location-Based): 158 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
- Scope 2 (Market-Based): 0 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
- Scope 3:
 - Category 1: Purchased Goods & Services: 44 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
 - Category 5: Waste Generated in Operations: 3 metric ton of CO₂ equivalent
 - Category 6: Business Travel: 62 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
 - Category 7: Employee Commuting: 104 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent
 - Category 15: Investments: 142,831 metric tons of CO₂ equivalent (55% of Total Managed Assets)

Data and information supporting the Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions were in most cases historical in nature, but in some cases estimated.

Data and information supporting the Scope 3 GHG emissions statement were in some cases estimated rather than historical in nature.

- GWP: Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) Fifth Assessment Report (AR-5)
- United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Emission Factor Hub, released 2025

Period covered by GHG emissions verification:

- January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025

Criteria against which verification was conducted:

- World Resources Institute (WRI)/World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD) Greenhouse Gas Protocol, Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard, Revised Edition (Scope 1 and 2) and the GHG Protocol Scope 2 Guidance, an amendment to the GHG Protocol Corporate Standard
- WRI/WBCSD Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Accounting and Reporting Standard

Reference Standard:

- ISO 14064-3 (2019-04) Second Edition: Greenhouse gases -- Part 3: Specification with guidance for the verification and validation of greenhouse gas statements

Level of Assurance and Qualifications:

- Limited
- This verification used a materiality threshold of 5% for aggregate errors in sampled data for each of the above indicators.

GHG Emissions Verification Methodology:

Evidence gathering procedures included but were not limited to:

- Interviews with relevant personnel of HASI;
- Review of documentary evidence produced by HASI;
- Review of HASI data and information systems and methodology for collection, aggregation, analysis, and review of information used to determine GHG emissions; and
- Audit of sample of data used by HASI to determine GHG emissions.

Verification Opinion:

Based on the process and procedures conducted, there is no evidence that the GHG emissions statement shown above:

- Is not materially correct and is not a fair representation of the GHG emissions data and information; and
- Has not been prepared in accordance with the WRI/WBCSD GHG Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 1 and 2), and WRI/WBCSD Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Value Chain Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 3).

It is our opinion that HASI has established appropriate systems for the collection, aggregation, and analysis of quantitative data for determination of GHG emissions for the stated period and boundaries.

Statement of independence, impartiality, and competence

Apex is an independent professional services company that specializes in Health, Safety, Social and Environmental management services including assurance with over 30 years history in providing these services.

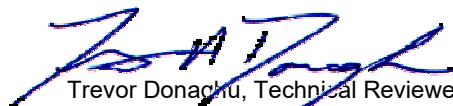
