### **► Gyeongbokgung Palace (included in Hanbok wearing experience) \*Closed on every Tuesday\***

Gyeongbokgung Palace was the main royal palace of the Joseon dynasty. Built in 1395, it is located in northern Seoul, South Korea. It is the largest of the Five Grand Palaces, and it was served as the home of Kings of the Joseon dynasty, the Kings' households, as well as the government of Joseon.



### **► National Folk Museum**

The National Folk Museum of Korea is a national museum of South Korea, located within the grounds of the Gyeongbokgung Palace. It uses replicas of historical objects to illustrate the history of traditional life of the Korean people from the past to present day.



### **► Bukchon Hanok Village**

Bukchon Hanok Village is a Korean traditional village in Seoul with a long history located on the top of a hill between Gyeongbok Palace, Changdeok Palace and Jongmyo Royal Shrine. The traditional village is composed of many alleys, hanok and is preserved to show a 600-year-old urban environment.



## ► Korean Tea Therapy Experience

A Korean tea experience is an immersive program where participants can explore the rich tradition and culture of Korean tea. This experience includes learning about the history, types, and preparation methods of Korean tea, as well as enjoying the unique flavors and health benefits it offers.



## ► Myeongdong Street

This busy shopping district is famous for its beauty and skincare products, along with many popular Korean and international fashion brands. The street is lined with food vendors selling Korean street food and there are a number of popular Korean restaurants in the area. The area's central location also makes it a convenient base when visiting Seoul.

## ► Korean Folk Village (included in lunch with meal coupons)

Korean Folk Village introduces traditional culture from the late Joseon period to both local and international visitors through cultural classes experience, shaman faith, seasonal customs and others. It recreated the past through the restoration of houses from the Joseon dynasty.



## ► Suwon Hwaseong

Suwon was one of four main regional government centers during the Joseon dynasty. Hwaseong Fortress, built to protect the city, was designated as a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site in 1997 for its historical value. The walls stretch for 5,700 kilometers, with Paldalsan Mountain at the center. The fortress, constructed from 1794 to 1796, was built as a display of King Jeongjo's filial piety towards his father and to build a new pioneer city with its own economic power.



## ► Hwaseong Haenggung Palace

Hwaseong Haenggung Palace, the largest temporary royal residence from the Joseon era, was used by King Jeongjo both during wartime and for visits to his father's tomb. It hosted significant events such as his mother's 60th birthday celebration and national exam ceremonies. Today, it serves as a venue for traditional cultural performances and experiences.



## ► **Suwon Chicken Street**

Suwon Chicken Street is a 100-meter alley in Suwon known for whole fried chicken cooked in large cauldrons. It offers a chance to experience one of Korea's most beloved foods—fried chicken—in its original, local style. With affordable prices and rich flavor, the street draws visitors from across Korea, especially students and food lovers.

## ► **Lotte Tower Mall (included in Observatory)**

Lotte World Tower is a 123-story skyscraper located in Seoul and is one of the tallest buildings in the world. It features a variety of attractions, including an observation deck, luxury hotel, offices, and retail spaces. The tower is a prominent landmark in Seoul, offering stunning views of the city and the Han River.



## ► **Yeouido Hangang Park**

Situated in Yeouido, the heart of politics, media, banking and finance, Yeouido Hangang Park is easily accessible via public transportation. The park hosts many exciting events, from the Yeouido Cherry Blossom Festival in spring to the International Fireworks Festival in fall, as well as concerts and marathons throughout the year.



## ► Han River Cruise

The E-Land Cruise cuts across the Hangang River along the east-west axis. It connects two terminals, one in Yeouido and the other in Jamsil. The company offers a number of different programs, such as the Han River Tour Cruise, a daytime cruise that takes one along the views of Hangang River, and the Moonlight Music Cruise, which offers a beautiful view of Seoul at night with jazz music. ### ► Nami Island

Nami Island is a beautiful destination to visit all year round. Known for appearing in many Korean dramas, the island has numerous lanes lined with pine trees, gingko trees, redwood giants and more. Take a scenic walk along the wooden riverside path and snap a photo with the Winter Sonata statue in Gongsawon Garden.



### ► Garden of Morning Calm

The Garden of Morning Calm is an arboretum located at the east of Seoul, in the Gapyeong district of South Korea. On 300,000 m<sup>2</sup>, it houses 5,000 species of plants, some rare or endangered and attracts 600,000 tourists per year. The name of this garden reminds that Korea is often nicknamed the "country of the morning calm". Also, it is the setting of many well-known Korean dramas, including "Moonlight Drawn by Clouds."

### ► Gwangjang Market

The Gwangjang Market is a traditional street market in Jongno-gu, Seoul. The market is one of the oldest and largest traditional markets in South Korea, with more than 5000 shops and 20,000 employees in an area of 42,000 m<sup>2</sup>.

Approximately 65,000 people visit the market each day.



### ► Cheonggyecheon Stream

It was created as a place for meetings, harmony, peace, and unification, to celebrate the significance of the restoration of Cheonggyecheon Stream. There are also interpretive panels about the 22 bridges that cross Cheonggyecheon stream. Fountains of various shapes create beautiful scenery. Cheonggyecheon Stream is accessible from the square through stairs on the left and Cheonggye Trail on the right. There is also an 18-meter tunnel on the Cheonggye Trail, providing a unique experience for citizens entering Cheonggyecheon Stream from the plaza.
