## **The 3<sup>rd</sup> Support Hokuriku Tour**

This Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions governing participation in tours organized by JTB USA, Inc. By booking a tour, the participant acknowledges and agrees to the following:

### **1. Deposit and Payment Schedule**

1.1 A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking.

1.2 Payment Schedule:

- July 31, 2026: \$300 per person deposit (*non-refundable*)
- August 31, 2026: Half payment
- September 30, 2026: Balance payment

1.3 Failure to remit the remaining balance within the required period shall entitle JTB USA, Inc. to cancel the reservation without further notice.

1.4 In the event of voluntary cancellation, the deposit remains non-refundable but may be applied toward any other tour offered by JTB USA, Inc.

### **2. Cancellations and Change Fees**

2.1 The participant acknowledges that cancellations, regardless of reason, result in charges from travel and hotel providers. These charges include penalties and fees incurred by canceling confirmed bookings.

2.2 The following cancellation and change fees shall apply:

- Up to Aug 14, 2026: No charge (Free)
- August 15 – September 13, 2026: \$300.00 non-refundable deposit
- September 14 – September 22, 2026: 30% of the total tour fee
- September 23 – October 23, 2026: 50% of the total tour fee
- October 24, 2026 to departure: 100% of the total tour fee

2.3 Any additional individual arrangements and airfare may not be refundable.

### **3. Participation**
