1.2 Payment Schedule:

- June 15, 2026: \$300 per person deposit (*non-refundable*)
- August 13, 2026: Half payment
- September 03, 2026: Balance payment

1.3 Failure to remit the remaining balance within the required period shall entitle JTB USA, Inc. to cancel the reservation without further notice.

1.4 In the event of voluntary cancellation, the deposit remains non-refundable but may be applied toward any other tour offered by JTB USA, Inc.

### **2. Cancellations and Change Fees**
