Day 01: Depart for Bangkok

Leave Honolulu for Bangkok

Day 02: Arrive in Bangkok

Arrival at Suvarnabhumi Airport (BKK)

Stay at **Hyatt Regency Bangkok Suvarnabhumi Airport** which is connected to the airport

Day 03: Arrive Samui Island (B)

Breakfast at the hotel

Depart BKK for Samui Island Airport

Upon arrival at Samui Airport, welcome by our local representative will assist you for private transfer by airconditioned vehicle to your hotel, check in your room and rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight at your selected hotel

Day 04: Around Samui Island (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Today we will pick you up with air-conditioned Vehicle between 9:00 a.m. and 9:45 a.m. at your specified accommodation and then guide you to the first stop of the trip, in the east of Koh Samui. Step by step, all other participants are collected for this day trip until the entire travel group is completely together. **Wat Bo Phuttharam:** The Statue of the praying monk Luang Phor Thuad is sitting on a 2-tiered structure above a man-made lake. Luang Por Thude who was the legendary monk in southern Siam around 250 years ago. He made a miracle by soaking his foot in the seawater and changing it into fresh drinking water, to rescue survivor's people who stopped because of a shipwreck on the way to Bangkok.

Wat Plai Laem: The Wat Plai Laem is the largest Buddhist temple complex in Samui and shows Guanyin, the goddess of mercy and compassion. Here you will get an insight into Chinese Thai beliefs as artistic Buddhist themes and architecture. The temple and the art techniques used to create it are centuries old and based on old beliefs.

Viewpoint: Lad Koh is one of the largest viewpoints on Koh Samui and is located between Chaweng and Lamai. From here you have an unforgettable view over the beach of Chaweng and the Gulf of Thailand. Many locals bring offerings to the nearby memorial in the early morning.

Hin Ta & Hin Yai: From here we will drive to the famous grandfather and grandmother rocks in the south of Samui's island. It represents a bizarre rock formation that is reminiscent of the male and female sex. You will get more



information on the prehistory of its origins on-site from our multilingual, trained tour guides. After word transfer back to your hotel.

Day 05: Samui Island (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Free day to enjoy optional activities.

Day 06: Depart Samui Island

Breakfast at the hotel. At the indicated time, private transfer with English speaking guide to the airport to take the flight to your next destination.

Leave Samui Island for Bangkok

Upon arrival at Bangkok airport, you will be welcomed by our representative from Tour East. You will then be transferred to your hotel, checked into your room, and the rest of the day is free at your leisure.

Day 07: Bangkok – HD Three Icons of Bangkok (B)





Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Today, discover the Grand Palace and three of Bangkok's top temples with a knowledgeable guide who will provide deeper insights into these iconic landmarks, as well as Thai culture, history, and architecture. Visit the Reclining Buddha at Wat Pho, then cross the Chao Phraya River by boat to Wat Arun, the Temple of Dawn. Finally, explore the Grand Palace and Wat Phra Kaew, home to the Emerald Buddha

9:00 a.m. Meet the tour guide in the hotel lobby.

Half-day Top 3 Major Monuments; you will visit and see

■ **Wat Pho**, the largest temple complex in Bangkok, famous for its impressive reclining Buddha that is 46 meters in length and ornate royal tombs called chedis

■ **Chao Phraya River**, cross the Chao Praya on a boat to reach Wat Arun by river. Our guide will be company you during all the journey and will help you on this round-trip transportation

■ **Temple of Dawn (Wat Arun)**, Continue your journey by crossing the Chao Phraya River by boat to reach Wat Arun, also known as the Temple of Dawn. With its 70-meter-high Khmer-style spire decorated with colored glass and Chinese porcelain, this sacred temple is one of the most photographed landmarks in all Bangkok. Your guide will accompany you and provide explanations at each stop along the way

■ **Grand Palace & Wat Phra Kaew**, this is the most beautiful example of a traditional Siamese Court. Previously the residence of royalty, there are various buildings for different functions, including the Funeral Palace, the Reception Palace, the Throne Hall, the Coronation Hall, the Royal Guest House and the famed Emerald Buddha Temple

Afterwards, transfer back to your hotel.

Day 08: Bangkok – Train Track Market and Floating Market (B, L)



Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Today, after an 85-kilometer drive from Bangkok to Baan Kalong Station, take the 8:00 train for a short journey to one of the most amazing attractions in Samut Songkhram province, the Maeklong Railway Market (Hoop Rom Market). Commonly called Siang Tai, or Life-Risking Market, it is situated beside and on top of the actual train tracks. Seconds before the train is about to pull into Maeklong Station, the vendors rush to pull back their parasols and umbrellas, clearing their goods to within inches of the passing train. Less than a minute later, they hurry to put everything back in place to continue selling their seafood, fruits, meat, and vegetables to local shoppers.

After a brief wander around the market, you will be driven to a pier. From here, take an exhilarating narrow long-tailed speedboat ride through the marshes and stilt houses to reach the world-famous Damnoen Saduak Floating Market. Watch the Thai-style canoes laden with colorful fruits, vegetables, sweets, and meats gently ply their way through the canal from the water's edge, or for an additional cost payable directly at the market, get an even closer look by taking a paddle boat ride. Afterward, transfer back to your hotel
