



## SUGGESTED REPERTOIRE FOR STRING MUSICIANS

The Paradise Symphony is a friendly, unintimidating group of amateur and semi-professional musicians who strive to perform to the best of their ability. We are "getting better and better, all the time," to quote our conductor, Dr. Lloyd Roby! Most of our regular attending instrumentalists would agree that they are playing at a much higher level after playing with us for a number of years than when they first joined the PSO.

The following pieces are examples of the level of music that we play to give you an idea of what you can expect as you consider joining our orchestra.

You should be able to play Major and Minor scales: 3 octaves for 1st violins, 2 octaves for 2nd Violin, Viola, and Cello, 1 octave for bass.
