Fitness, Fun and Friendly Competition

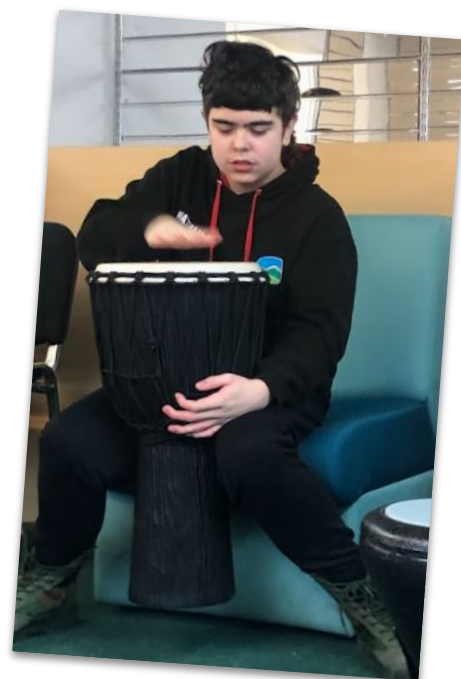
