## **Romans 5:6-8 (NLT)**

<sup>6</sup>When we were utterly helpless, Christ came at just the right time and died for **us sinners**. <sup>7</sup>Now, most people would not be willing to die for an upright person, though someone might perhaps be willing to die for a person who is especially good. <sup>8</sup> But God **showed his great love for us** by sending Christ to die for us **while we were still sinners**.

<sup>9</sup> And since we have been made right in God's sight by the blood of Christ, he will certainly **save us from God's condemnation**. <sup>10</sup> For since our **friendship with God** was restored by the death of his Son **while we were still his enemies,** we will certainly be saved through the life of his Son. <sup>11</sup> So now we can rejoice in our wonderful new relationship with God because our Lord Jesus Christ has made us **friends of God**.

## 2 Corinthians 8:13;17-18 (NLT)

<sup>13</sup> We are not like Moses, who put a veil over his face so the people of Israel would not see the glory, even though it was destined to fade away... <sup>17</sup> For the Lord is the Spirit, and wherever the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. <sup>18</sup> So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. **And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image.**

## Romans 10:8b-10;13-15 (NLT)

...And that message is the very message about faith that we preach: <sup>9</sup> If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved... <sup>13</sup> For "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

<sup>14</sup> But how can they **call on him** to save them **unless they believe in him**? And how can they believe in him **if they have never heard** about him? And how can they hear about him **unless someone tells them?** <sup>15</sup> And how will anyone go and tell them **without being sent**? That is why the Scriptures say, "How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!"
