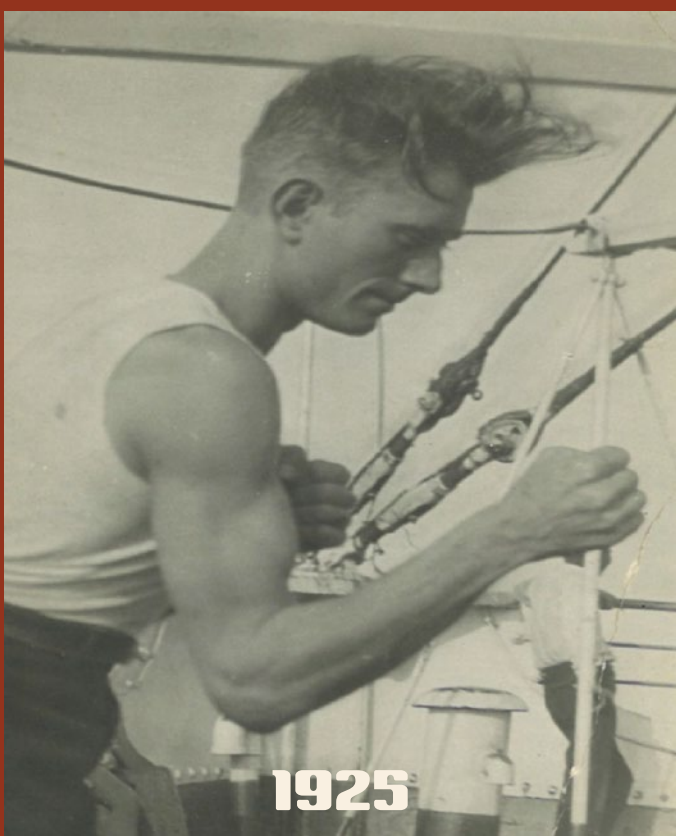

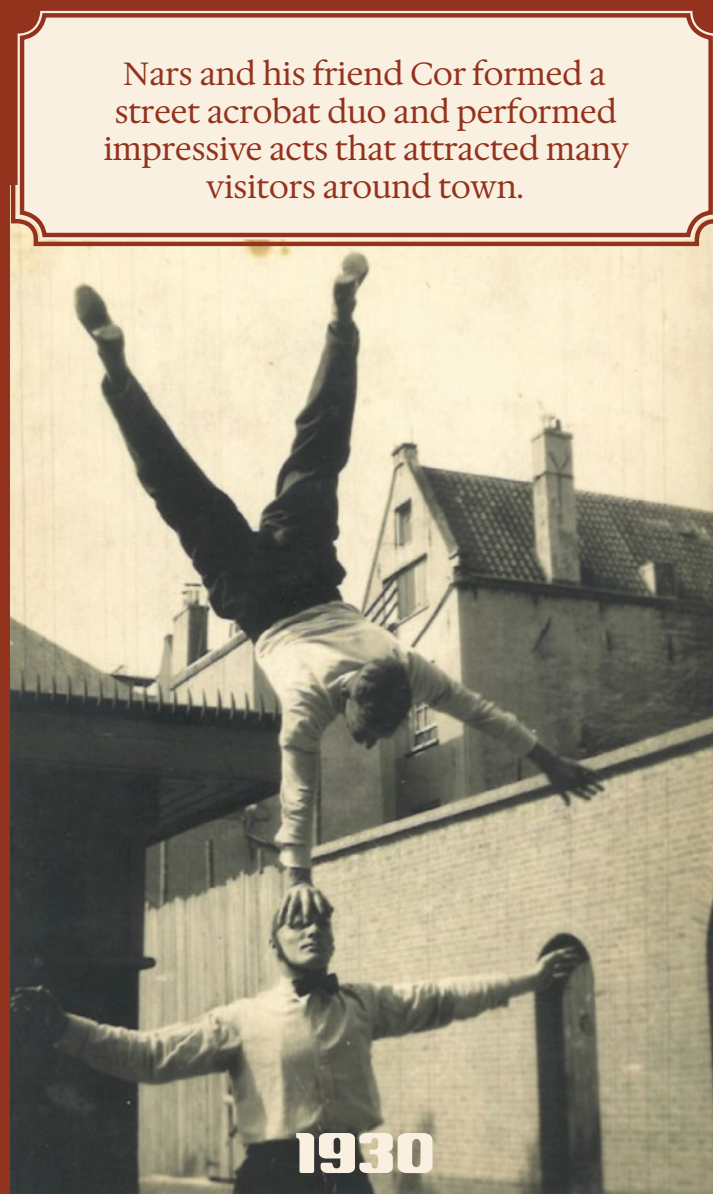

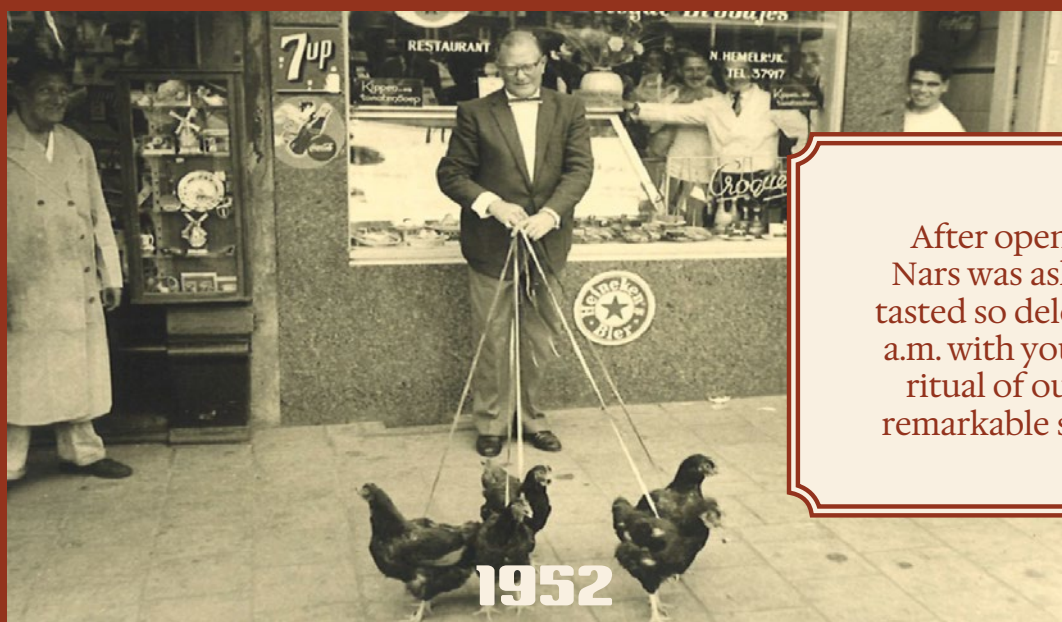

At the age of 18, Grandpa started his first job abroad, where he took care of the kitchen and gave sports lessons to passengers in his spare time. Later, he joined the Jewish sports club Maccabi, where he began wrestling and boxing under the guidance of “Ome Nelis” at gym Bisschop.



Nars and his friend Cor formed a street acrobat duo and performed impressive acts that attracted many visitors around town.



After opening his very first sandwich shop, Grandpa Nars was asked by an American journalist why the eggs tasted so delectable. “Come back tomorrow morning at 8 a.m. with your camera and you can capture the morning ritual of our chickens,” he replied. A month later, this remarkable scene was published in the New York Times.



Narco's Sandwich Shop has been run by its second generation Since 1976, who have transformed it into Amsterdam's first French-Dutch bistro. Traditional family recipes have been passed down from generation to generation, and at Heemelrijck we continue to uphold this culinary legacy to this day.
