

Security Safety Team of the Year - Education Facility

This category will recognise a healthcare based security safety team that has demonstrated outstanding performance, collaboration, and impact in advancing security safety within an education facility

Team Impact & Achievements

- Show how the security team has made a measurable difference in creating a safer environment for staff, students, and visitors.
- Demonstrate performance in managing real security incidents, medical emergencies, missing persons,
- high-risk behaviours, or campus disturbances. Provide evidence of successful prevention measures, improved incident response times, safeguarding interventions, or risk-reduction strategies across your education facilities.

Collaboration & Teamwork

- Does the team work effectively with senior management, staff, administration, estates, and safeguarding leads?
- Show collaboration with local Gardaí, emergency services, mental health professionals, social care agencies, or community partners when required.
- Highlight instances where teamwork directly improved safety outcomes or supported vulnerable individuals

Innovation & Initiative

- Has the team implemented innovative approaches tailored to education settings, such as: improved reporting/incident-tracking tools, enhanced communication systems, safeguarding measures, behavioural risk protocols, technology-supported monitoring.
- Have they taken proactive steps to identify and mitigate risks, improve campus security, or support staff dealing with challenging situations?

Compliance & Best Practices

- Provide evidence of strong compliance with education-specific requirements, building regulations, fire codes, and internal hospital policies.
- Show how the team ensures safety standards are consistently upheld in areas with complex risks.

Training & Professional Development

- Has the team maintained a high level of expertise through ongoing training?
- Do they mentor others or promote continuous learning within the organisation?

Endorsements & Recognition

Are there testimonials, commendations, or records of praise from peers or stakeholders?
