## Training Provider of the Year

This category celebrates organisations or individuals who are delivering exceptional fire safety, H&S or security education, improving knowledge, preparedness, and compliance

### **Training Quality & Content Relevance**

- Are the training courses accurate, up-to-date, and aligned with national and international standards (e.g., ISO, BS 9999)?
- Do they cover critical areas such as hazard identification, threat mitigation, emergency response, incident management, and regulatory compliance?
- Are the courses accessible to diverse audiences, including different learning needs and language groups?

### **Instructional Excellence**

- Are trainers highly qualified, experienced, and engaging in their delivery?
- Is there evidence of interactive methods, real-life scenarios, or hands-on practical sessions?
- Has the provider contributed to raising safety standards or awareness on a wider scale?

### **Impact & Outcomes**

- Has the training demonstrably improved safety awareness, behaviour, or performance in real situations?
- Are there metrics such as reduced incident rates, successful drills, or positive feedback from clients?

### **Accreditation & Certification**

- Are the courses accredited or certified by recognized bodies (e.g., IOSH, NEBOSH, IFE, RoSPA)?
- Are participants issued valid and widely accepted certificates upon completion?

### **Commitment to Continuous Improvement**

- Does the provider evaluate their own performance regularly?
- Are they responsive to feedback, regulations, and evolving risks?

### **Client Satisfaction & Trust**

- Are there strong endorsements or testimonials from clients?
- Do they maintain long-term relationships, do clients return for refresher or additional courses?
