- Were creative or innovative solutions employed to overcome retrofit challenges
- Did the project make use of new technology (e.g., wireless systems, fire modelling, modular suppression)?

Stakeholder Collaboration & User Awareness

- Explain the coordination between owners, fire engineers, contractors, authorities, and end users which helped make the project a success

Supporting Statements & Testimonials
