



FIRE SAFETY AWARDS

Fire Safety Officer of the year

This category recognises an outstanding individual working in a fire safety role in Ireland who has demonstrated exceptional commitment, leadership, and impact in improving fire safety standards within their organisation or across the wider industry.

Nominees may come from any sector, including healthcare, education, commercial, industrial, residential, or public service.

**Below are some tips to include in your application, not a strict list of points that have to be answered*

Professional Role & Responsibilities

- Overview of the nominee's role and organisation
- Scope of responsibility
- Key duties (e.g. compliance, audits, training, incident response)

Leadership & Influence

- Demonstration of leadership in fire safety
- Ability to promote a positive fire safety culture
- Examples of going beyond the expected scope of the role

Impact on Fire Safety Standards

- Tangible improvements delivered
- Evidence of measurable impact across the organisation
- Contribution to safer environments for occupants and staff

Fire Safety Management & Compliance

- Development and implementation of fire safety policies and procedures
- Oversight of fire risk assessments and corrective actions
- Engagement with regulators, fire authorities, and auditors

Training, Awareness & Engagement

- Innovative approaches to staff engagement and awareness
- Organisation and management of fire drills
- Ability to communicate fire safety effectively to diverse audiences

Collaboration & Stakeholder Engagement

- Working with internal teams (facilities, management, staff)
- Coordination with external stakeholders
- Ability to build strong, effective working relationships

Supporting Evidence (Required)

Nominations should include:

- Examples of work (policies, reports, initiatives)
- Evidence of training programmes or engagement activities
