Fire Safety Educator of the Year

Applicants should demonstrate excellence in the design, implementation, and management of fire safety strategies within complex or high-risk built environments. Submissions must relate to a project, building, or portfolio operational within Ireland within the past 2–3 years.

**Below are some tips to include in your application, not a strict list of points that have to be answered*

Training Quality & Content Relevance

- *Tell us about the training courses you offer?*
- *Are the courses accessible to diverse audiences, including different learning needs and language groups?*

Instructional Excellence

- *Tell us about the trainers qualifications and experience?*
- *Is there evidence of interactive methods, real-life scenarios, or hands-on practical sessions?*

Impact & Outcomes

- *Has the training demonstrably improved safety awareness, behaviour, or performance in real situations?*
- *Are there metrics such as reduced incident rates, successful drills, or positive feedback from clients?*

Accreditation & Certification

- *Are the courses accredited or certified by recognized bodies (e.g., IOSH, NEBOSH, IFE, RoSPA)?*
- *Are participants issued valid and widely accepted certificates upon completion?*

Commitment to Continuous Improvement

- *Does the provider evaluate their own performance regularly?*
- *Are they responsive to feedback, regulations, and evolving risks?*

Client Satisfaction & Trust

- *Are there strong endorsements or testimonials from clients?*
- *Do they maintain long-term relationships, do clients return for refresher or additional courses?*
