Applicants should demonstrate outstanding leadership and influence in the field of fire safety. This may include driving innovation, shaping strategy, leading teams, promoting best practice, or contributing to industry advancement through thought leadership and collaboration. Submissions must relate to work undertaken within Ireland within the past 2–3 years.

Summary

- *In 250 words summarise why this person deserves to win this award*

Impact on the Organisation

- *Show the impact the nominee has on the organisation, team, and the overall workplace. Provide evidence of tangible contributions to the organisation.*

Contribution to the Fire Safety Community

- *Do they share knowledge through training, publications, mentorship, or public speaking?*
- *Are they involved in standards development, professional bodies, or safety advocacy?*

Impact on Client Safety

- *Has the nominee significantly improved fire safety for clients through their advice or strategies?*
- *Are there examples of reduced risks, successful audits, improved evacuation plans, or code compliance outcomes?*

Training & Professional Development

- *Do they stay up to date with evolving codes, technologies, and fire science?*
- *Do they pursue CPD (Continuing Professional Development) and encourage knowledge sharing?*

Client Satisfaction & Trust

- *Are there strong endorsements or testimonials from clients? Do they maintain long-term relationships based on trust, professionalism, and performance?*
