This may include proactive maintenance, risk management, compliance, and the implementation of systems or processes that enhance safety, efficiency, and occupant wellbeing.

****Below are some tips to include in your application, not a strict list of points that have to be answered***

Team Impact & Achievements

- Show how the team has improved building operations and services such as maintenance, cleaning, front-of-house, fire safety, security, and sustainability.*
- Include evidence of initiatives, audits, risk assessments, or responses to incidents that improved safety, efficiency, or performance.*

Collaboration & Teamwork

- Show how the team works well together and with others, including contractors, emergency services, and external partners, to improve building operations and safety.*

Innovation & Initiative

- Highlight any new ideas, systems, or technologies introduced to improve services, such as digital tools, smart systems, or energy-saving measures.*
- Include examples of going beyond day-to-day duties.*

Workforce Development

- Show how the team supports training, professional development, and upskilling.*
- Include evidence of building a skilled, safety-aware, and customer-focused team.*

Compliance & Best Practice

- Demonstrate strong compliance with health, safety, fire safety, and internal policies.*
- Include any contributions to improving procedures, risk management, or emergency planning.*

Customer Satisfaction & Support

- Provide evidence of client feedback, testimonials, case studies, or performance data that shows positive impact and service quality.*
