Fire Safety Team of the Year

Applicants should demonstrate excellence in the delivery and management of fire safety services within buildings or organisations. This may include fire risk management, compliance, inspections, emergency planning, training, and improvements that enhance safety and protection of people and property.

***Below are some tips to include in your application, not a strict list of points that have to be answered**

Team Impact & Achievements

- *Show how the team made a measurable difference in fire risk reduction, response effectiveness in high hazard areas while maintaining occupants safety?*
- *Has the team demonstrated exceptional performance during real incidents, drills, or emergencies?*
- *Give evidence of successful fire prevention campaigns, emergency responses, or safety audits.*

Collaboration & Teamwork

*Does the team show strong internal cooperation and coordination?
Have they collaborated effectively with external emergency services to ensure seamless site access and security protocols during an emergency?*

Innovation & Initiative

- *Has the team developed or implemented innovative strategies, tools, or procedures?*
- *Have they gone beyond standard duties to proactively improve fire safety within a challenging environment?*

Compliance & Best Practices

- *Does the team maintain high compliance with fire safety regulations, policies, and inspection routines?*
- *Have they contributed to developing or refining internal safety protocols?*

Training & Professional Development

- *Has the team taken part in specialised training, do they stay up to date?*
- *Do they mentor others or promote continuous learning within the organisation and amongst the prison population?*

Endorsements & Recognition

- *Include testimonials, case studies, client endorsements, charts, photos, or other documentation that strengthen your submission. Data, case studies, performance metrics should be included to show tangible value beyond typical methods.*
