# School Leadership Team Meeting Summary

Date: September 30th, 2025 Next Meeting: October 14th, 2025

## Main Topics Discussed

#### 1. SLT Meeting Scheduling & Calendar

- Meetings to be held on the second Tuesday of every month:
  - o October: October 14th, 2025
  - November: November 25th to accommodate other schedules (not the usual second Tuesday); will coincide with Thanksgiving; may not meet due to Thanksgiving event.
  - o December: December 9th, 2025
  - o January: January 13th, 2026
  - o February: **February 10th, 2026**
  - o March: March 10th, 2026
  - o April: April 14th, 2026
  - o May: May 12th, 2026
  - o June: **June 9th, 2026**
- If a scheduled meeting cannot be held, alternatives will be discussed during meetings.
- All SLT meetings and documentation (agendas, minutes) will be available under the "Families SLT" section on the school website.

## 2. Welcoming New Members & Electing Officers

- New SLT members were welcomed and congratulated for their election.
- Officer elections:
  - o Damaris Sanabria was elected as PA Treasurer.
  - Chairperson: Mrs. Cano-Lawson elected to run meetings, organize agendas, and ensure minutes/agendas are uploaded.
  - Note Taker identified.
- By-laws update:
  - o Two absences result in removal from SLT to maintain quorum.
  - o Bylaws and officer names need to be updated and uploaded as soon as possible.

## 3. After-School Program CBO (Community-Based Organization) Discussion

- The PAL (Police Athletic League) organization was terminated due to ongoing dissatisfaction (e.g., not catering to student interests, missing gaming equipment, lack of trips).
- SLT is tasked with selecting a new CBO for the school:
  - o PAL will continue Summer Rising for one more summer.
  - o Candidates for the new organization (to present at upcoming meetings):
    - Graham Windham (first to present on October 14th meeting)
    - Casa Maria
    - We Got Next
    - PAL may be allowed to interview again, but leadership is not inclined to select them.
- Final selection will consider parent and SLT input, but principal will make the final decision, followed by a PA (Parent Association) meeting and virtual candidate presentations.

## 4 Comprehensive Education Plan (CEP) and Academic Performance

- CEP is a collaborative document setting school goals.
- ELA and Math goals:
  - o **By June 2026:** 
    - Grades 3–5 ELA proficiency: Increase from 28% to 33% (5% gain) on state ELA exam.
    - K-2 Acadience literacy at/above grade: Increase from 43% to 48%.
    - Students at Level 1 I Ready: Decrease from 72 to 67.
- Current performance:
  - o 187 students have 100% attendance; 89 students at 90–99%; 96 are at risk; 73 are currently chronically absent (>5 days).
  - o In Math (grades 4–5): 26 at grade level, 3 above, 40 just below, 27 far below.
  - o ELA saw marked improvement from 63% at Level 1 in 2022 to 39% in 2025.
  - o Math Level 1 reduced from 72% (2022) to 37% (2025).
  - o District ranking remains low (34th of 38), with the goal to advance to at least 25th.
- Approach:
  - o Focus on standard-based instruction and targeted intervention.
  - o Use of data tools (SOLVE, I Ready) to monitor and tailor instruction.
  - Concern over students not taking I Ready assessments seriously, leading to distorted data.

#### 5. Teacher & Staff Feedback

- Teachers expressed the early positive impact of targeted standard-based instruction, particularly in ELA.
- Examples provided of academic and behavioral improvements in students with previously challenging profiles.
- Teacher Ms. Branch highlighted resilience and effectiveness in classroom management and student engagement.

#### 6. School Culture, Parent Engagement, and Community Relations

- Positive shift in school culture noted.
  - o Increased teacher and student participation in events (Spirit Days, "Dad Brings Your Child to School Day" with 95 fathers attending).
  - o Focus on celebrating and promoting school identity and community.
- Encouragement for parents to contribute testimonials and promote school websites.
- Noted ongoing concerns with local charter schools (e.g., Blaze), including their origins, community impact, and facilities.
- Emphasis on not chasing after lost students to charter but rather making PS 48 the best environment to attract and retain families.

### 7. Logistics and Reminders

- All relevant dates, policies (discipline, dress code, etc.), and school updates will be continuously made available online.
- Request for parents and members to promote school and assist in community advocacy where possible.
- Specific note to ensure all participants sign in and provide requested contact information to Mrs.Cano-Lawson.

#### 5. Prepare CEP Monitoring:

o Regular review of progress towards academic goals; collect data each marking period.

#### 6. Promote Website and Parent Testimonials:

 Request written testimonials from parents; ensure all relevant information is centralized online.

#### 7. Community Awareness:

 Encourage parent attendance/awareness of community board meetings for advocacy.

#### 8. Reminders for Next Meeting:

- o October 14, 2025, featuring Graham Windham presentation.
- Updated bylaws and officer information to be reviewed.
- o Progress toward CEP goals to be discussed with more data.

## Follow-up

- **Next Meeting:** October 14th, 2025—First candidate (Graham Windham) presentation, CEP update, new bylaws and officer review.
- **CBO Selection Process:** Sequential interviews at following meetings until selection is made; final decision to be discussed at PA meeting (virtual), with parent questions allowed.
- Academic Progress Review: Ongoing, with next check-in on test data.
- **Community Events:** Continue to track participation and school climate shifts.
