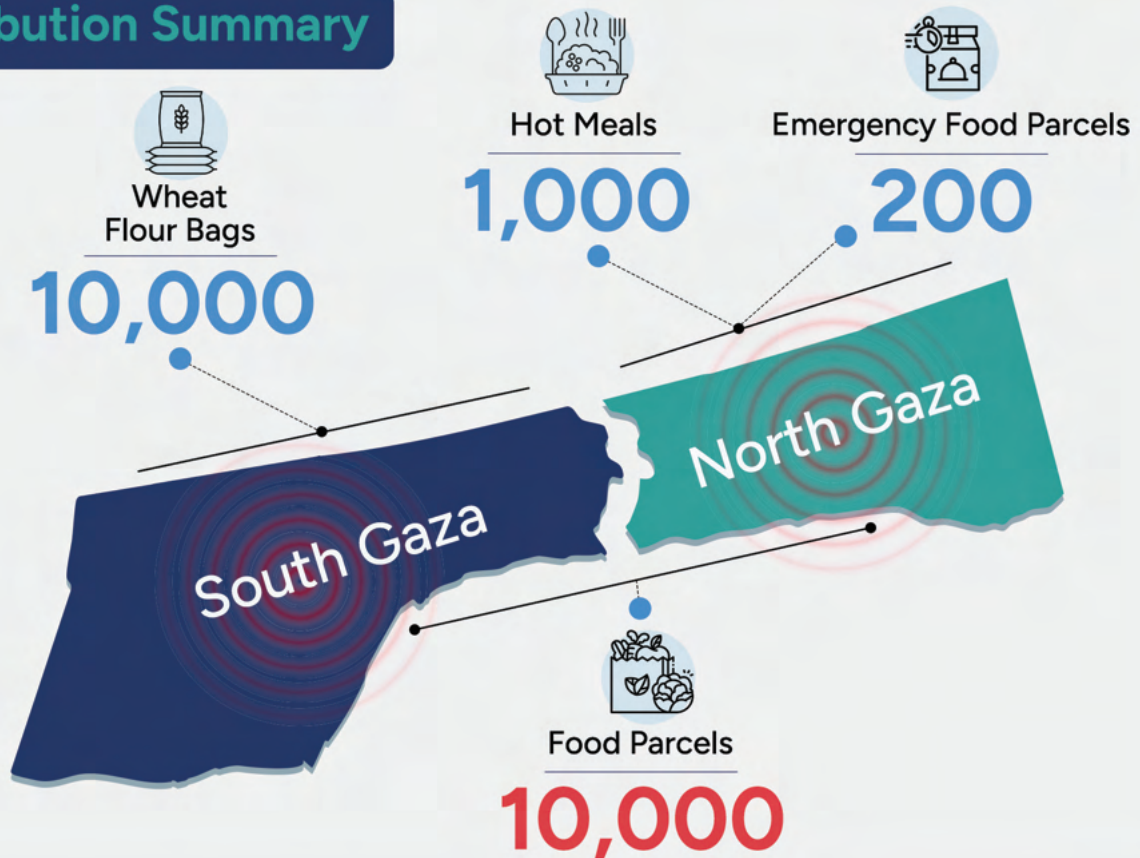

Distribution Summary



Cost of the Food Parcel Project: **\$1,021,900.00**

The Food Parcel Project aims to provide urgent support to families in need by distributing parcels containing essential food items. The cost of each food parcel in the project is approximately \$100, and they are sourced directly from local farmers in Gaza.

Surgical Impact Brief

Multispecialty Mission – Nablus, Palestine

Over the course of 4 months, FAJR Global conducted a multispecialty surgical mission in Nablus, delivering advanced operative care while embedding structured medical education into daily clinical practice.

Clinical Reach

- More than **300** patient encounters
- **150** verified surgical procedures
- Inpatient care, outpatient evaluations, and postoperative follow-up

Operating Room Utilization

- Minimum verified operative time: **~291.5 hours**
- Operating room use reflected procedural complexity rather than volume

Education & Capacity Building

- Intraoperative teaching during all surgical cases
- Formal seminars for physicians, residents, nurses, and staff
- Multidisciplinary case discussions
- Training in OR setup, sterility, and workflow standardization

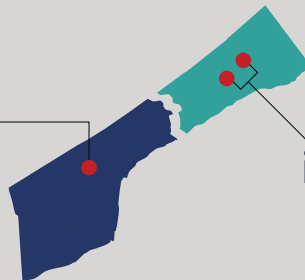

Targeted Grades

Grades 1–9

**Operating in 3 daily shifts
to reach more students**

- Education aligned with the Ministry of Education and UNICEF curriculum
- Psychosocial support for children affected by the crisis
- One daily meal provided for each student
- Distribution of full school stationery kits to all students
- Each school includes 8 classrooms and essential facilities

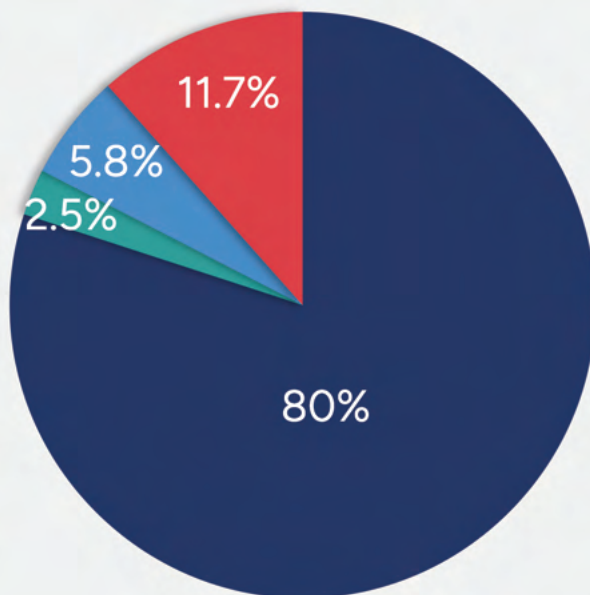
