Update on Cumulative Record Cards from DOE:

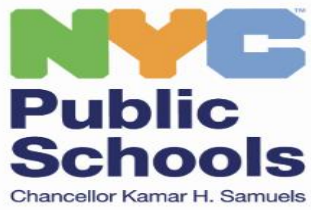
