

ASYLUM PROCEDURE IN GREECE



REGISTRATION INTERVIEW

You will be asked basic personal questions to establish your identity, details about your family and journey, and provide brief reasons for seeking asylum

Admissibility Interview

Not everyone has this extra interview. You will only have an admissibility interview if:

- You are from **Syria, Afghanistan, Somalia, Pakistan, and Bangladesh** and you travelled to Greece via **Turkey***

Or

- You are of any nationality and travelled to Greece via **Albania** or **North Macedonia***

In the admissibility interview, you are questioned about Turkey, Albania or North Macedonia (depending on which country you travelled through), you are not questioned about your home country

ASYLUM INTERVIEW

An in-depth questioning on your reasons for seeking asylum. You will need to describe the reasons you left your country and why you cannot return. Provide as much detail as possible.

APPEAL

If you are refused asylum you have the right to appeal the decision to an Appeals Committee free of charge

COURT APPEAL

If the first appeal is rejected, you may be able to submit an appeal to the Administrative Court. There are fees.

SUBSEQUENT APPLICATION

If your appeal is rejected, you can make a subsequent application. You will need to provide new evidence or new reasons for claiming asylum. The first subsequent application is free, after that it costs €100 per person.

POSITIVE DECISION

If your case is accepted, you are recognised as a refugee and receive a residence permit
