The NJORD immersion suit complies with the latest amendments in SOLAS. The thermal protective features in the suit therefore ensure that the body temperature will not be 2°C lower than normal temperature after immersing in 0-2°C static water for 6 hours.

The suit is made of high-quality neoprene similar to professional diving suits and comes with a pillow to support and keep the head above water even in an unconscious state.

The NJORD immersion suit is certified to MED standards and carries the Wheelmark approval and is approved to be used without the need of a separate lifejacket.

The suit is designed for a person with a max height of 195 cm.
